

Biography of Md. Emdadul Haque



An eminent civil servant Md. Emdadul Haque was a member of Bangladesh Civil Service: Administration. He retired as Secretary to the govt. of Bangladesh in 2017. Earlier up to HSC he was a student of science group, later shifted to dept. of law. He completed Honors and Masters in Law from Rajshahi University in 1979 and 1980 (held in 1981) respectively.

Afterwards being qualified in BCS Exam. of 1984 (5th BCS) joined in Administration Cader as Assistant Commissioner and Magistrate at Bogra Collectorate. From beginning to end (as secretary to the govt.) he has a long service carrier of 32 years. Both in field administration and in different ministries at secretariate level he got opportunity to serve the nation in many capacities. He was UNO of Kamarkhand Upozila at Sherajgonj district in 1997-98, ADC Feni in 2001-02, DC and District Magistrate of Habiganj district in 2003-05. He worked at policy level in number of ministries; like M/O Planning (IME division), M/O Health and Population, M/O Education (Primary and Mass Education division), M/O Establishment (present M/O Public Admin.), M/O Land (Land Reforms Board) and NBR/IRD.

In service he got foreign training on “Control and Surveillance of Communicable Deases” under M/O Health and Population in Indonesia, from 31-07-2000 to 11-08-2000. Again, at National Institute of Rural Development (NIRD), Hyderabad, India on “Human Development for Rural Reconstruction” from 01-10-2001 to 30-11- 2001. He visited Pakistan on official study tour Program for two weeks in 1996 and China in 2002. Mr. Haque also have got experience of visiting Thailand and Australia several times.

Born in Chuadanga district town in 1958, he is married to Farida Emdad. The couple have got three children. They are: 1) two daughters (married and lives in USA and Australia respectively) 2) Son (completed graduation in EEE and doing job as research assistant under his professor).
