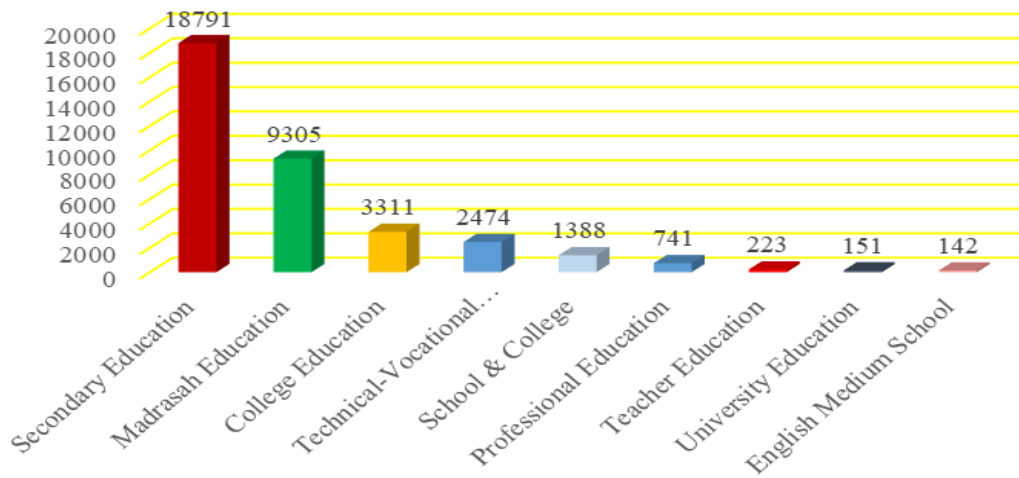

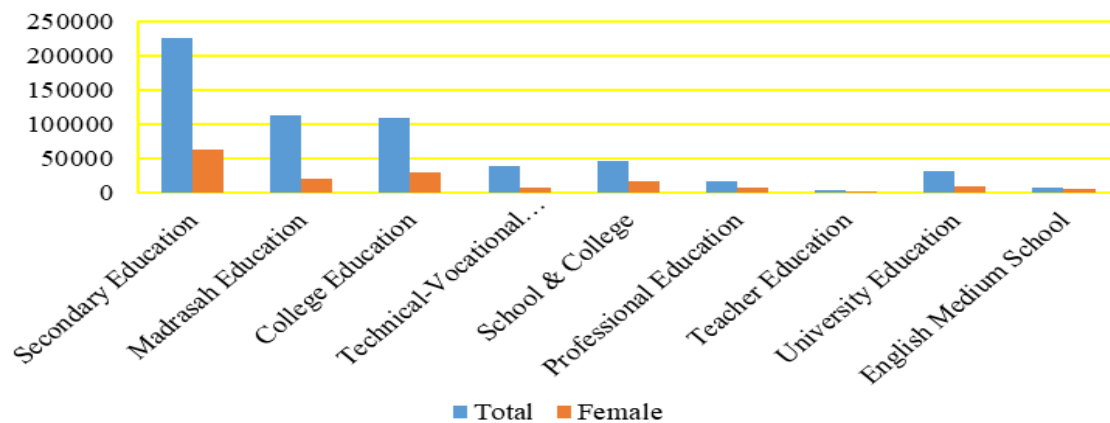

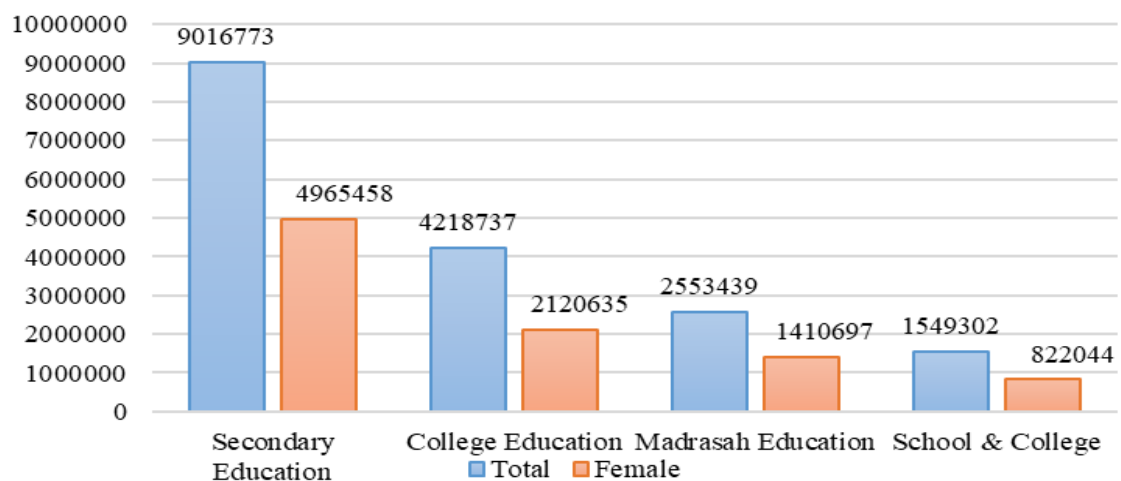
Number of Post Primary Educational Institution by Type 2020

Number of Student (School, College and Madrasah) 2020



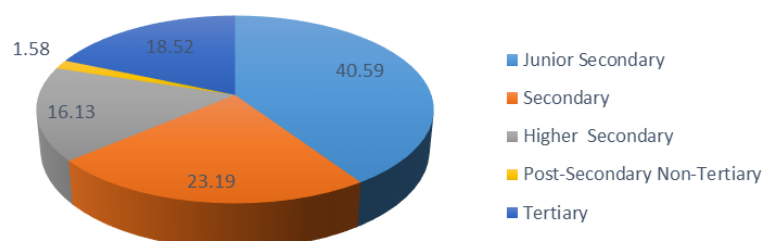

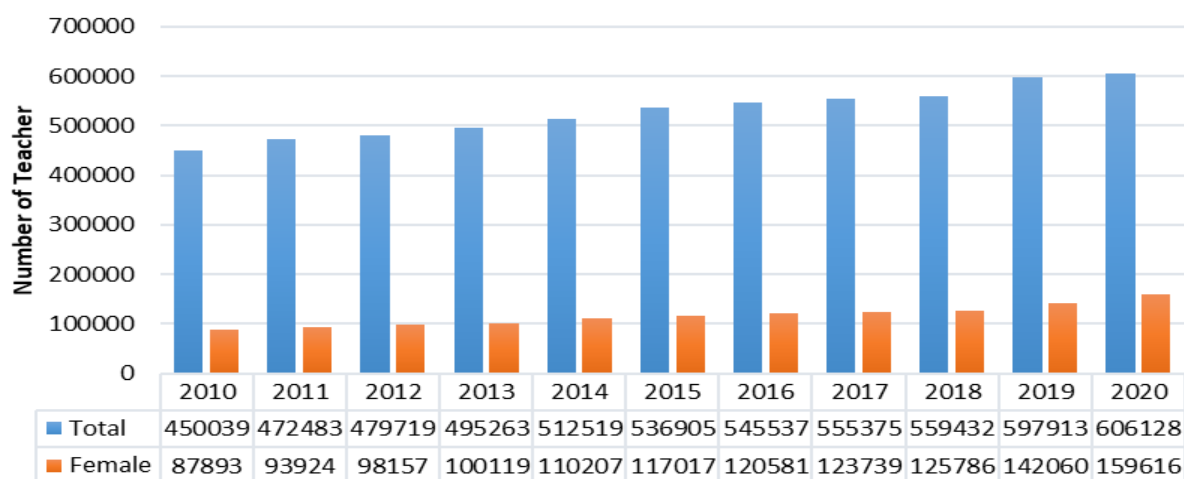

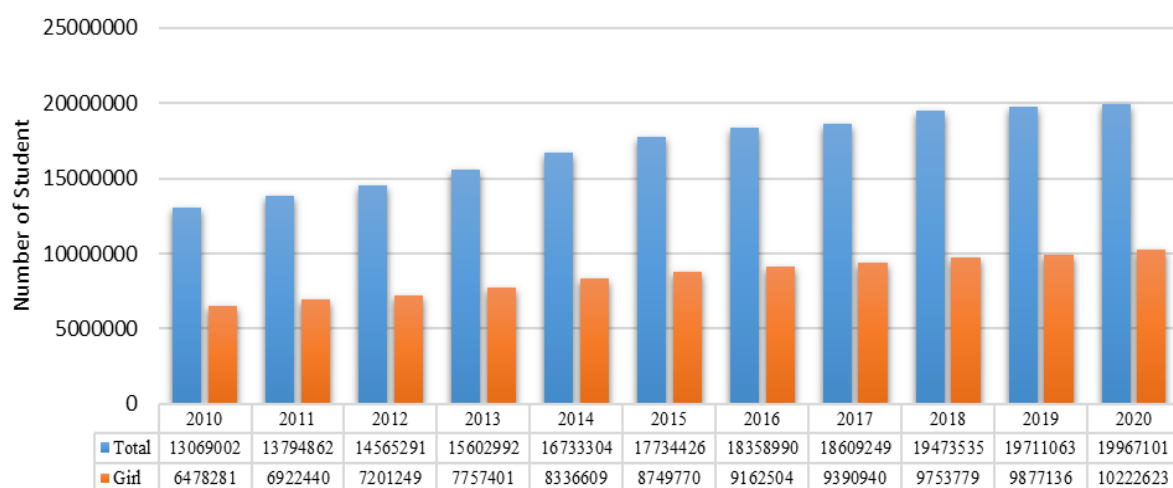

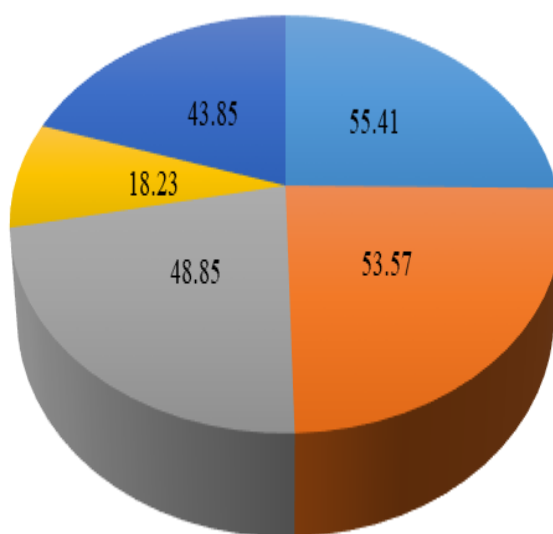

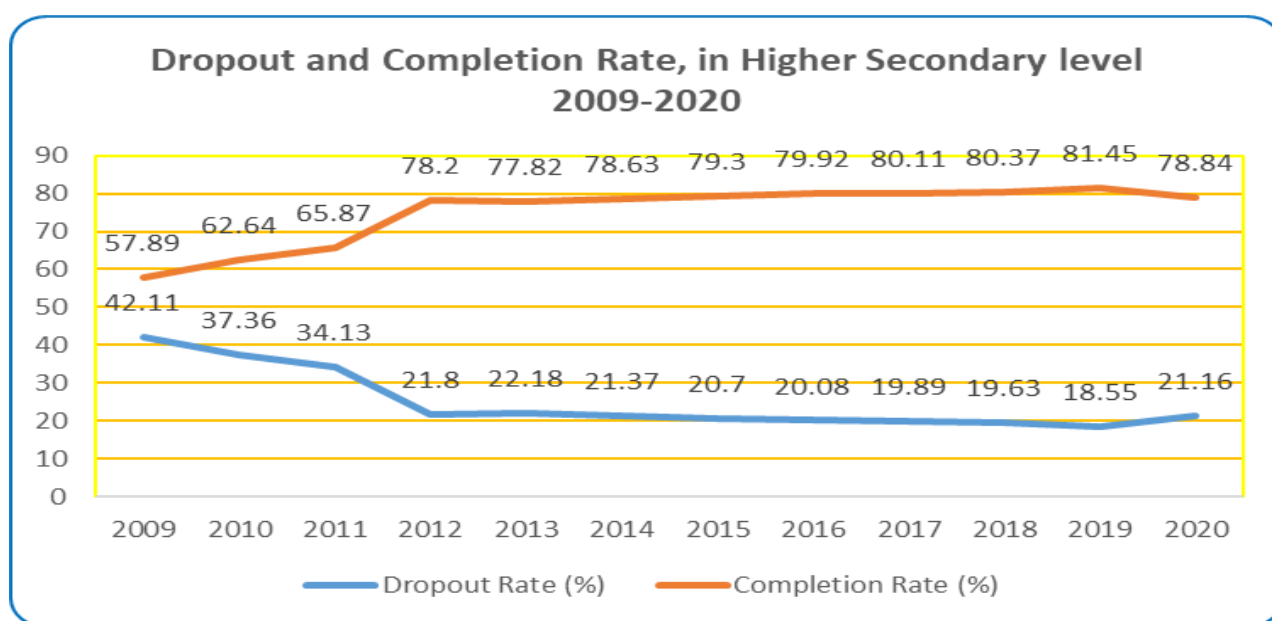

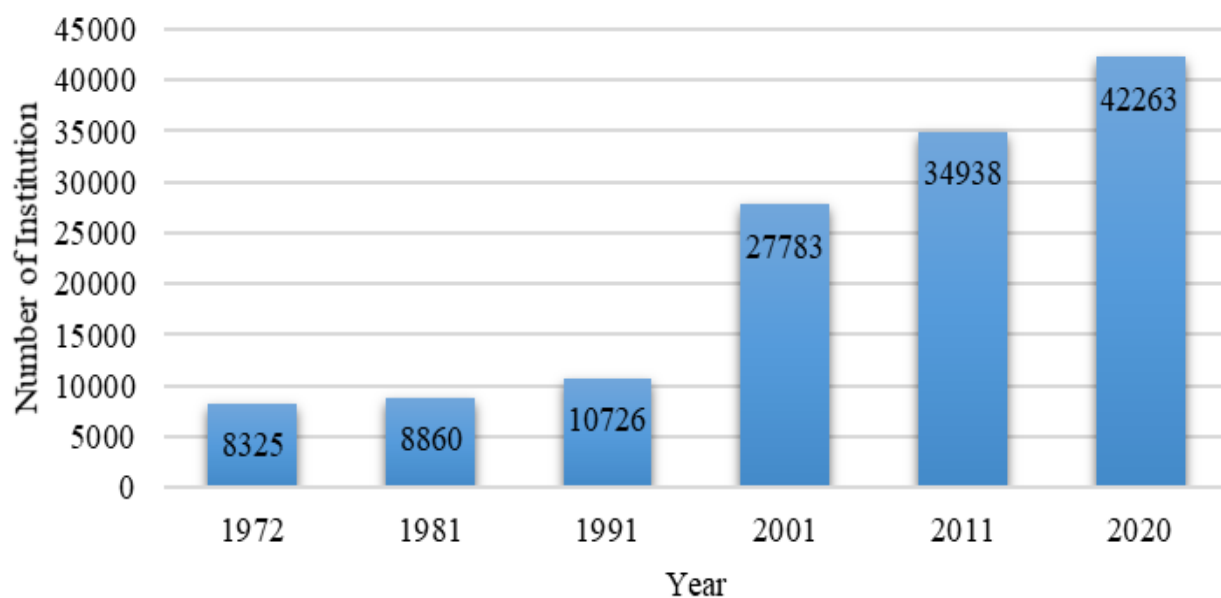

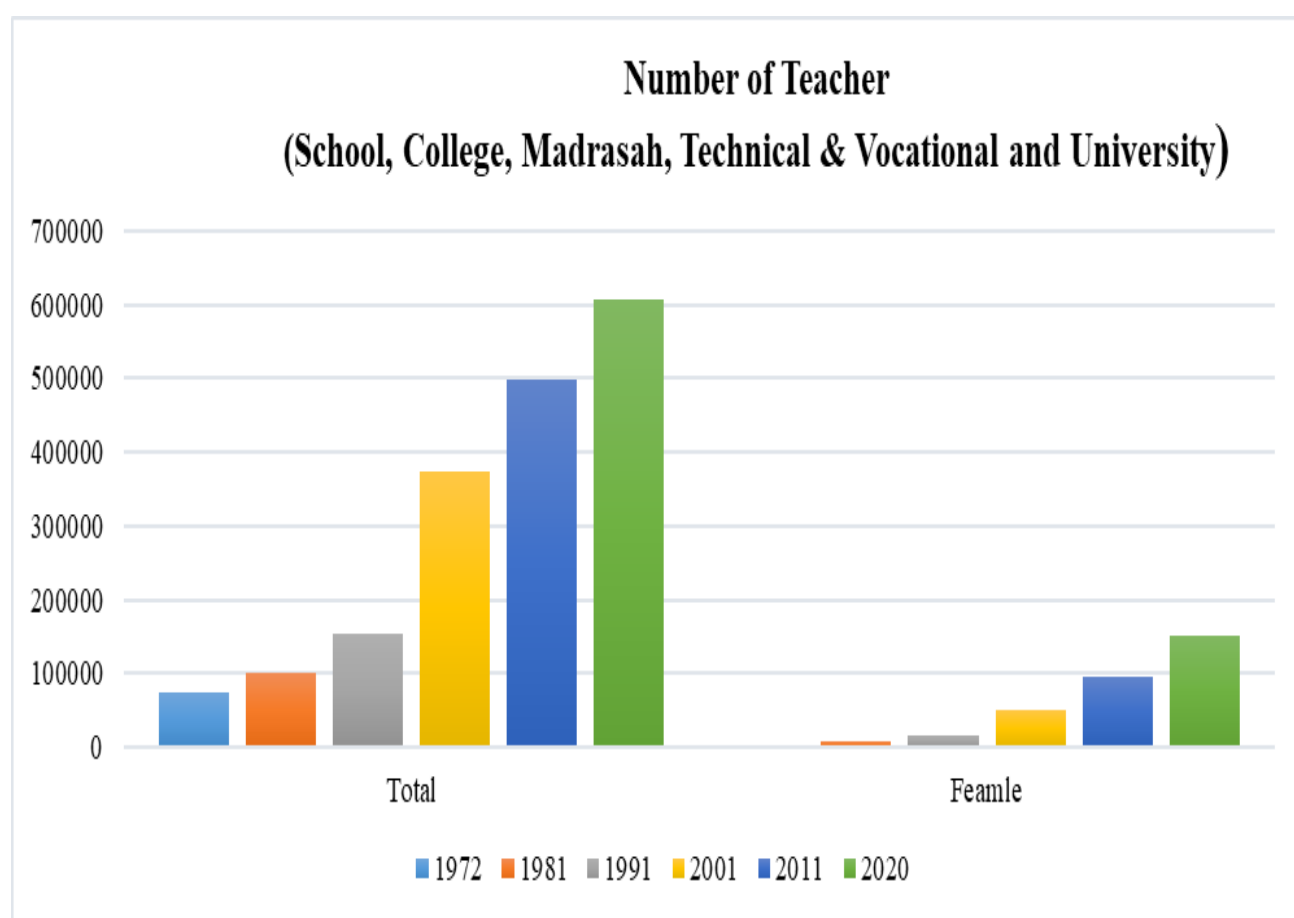
