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
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District Map

CHAPTER 1

Introduction

District at a Glance

Background: Bandarban was originally thana during British Period. Later it was turned into a Sub-division of Chittagong Hill Tracts District during Pakistan period. It was up-graded to a district in 1981. In the remote past, the present place of the district headquarters was abound with a large number of monkeys. The monkeys of this place used to cross the Sangu river every day forming a chain like line over the river in quest of fruits from the other side of the river forest and returned to the same place in the evening. The formation of chain like line by monkeys drew the attention by the local people who used to term it in their own language Myok Chay .In Bengali, Myok means **Bandars** and Chay means **Bands**. The name of Bandarban might be originated from these two words Bandars and Bands.

Geographic Area and Location: Bandarban district is bounded on the north by Rangamati district, on the east by Rangamati district and Myanmar, on the south of Myanmar and on the west of Chittagong and Cox's Bazar districts. It lies between $21^{\circ} 11'$ and $22^{\circ} 22'$ north latitudes and between $92^{\circ} 04'$ and $92^{\circ} 41'$ east longitudes. The total area of the district is 4,479.03 sq.km(1729.36 sq miles) of which 2653.54 sq.km is under forest. The area of Bandarban town is 51.80 sq.km.

Main Rivers: The Shankha (Sangu) Matamuhuria and Bakkhali are the main rivers of this district.

Annual Average Temperature and Rainfall: The annual average temperature of this district varies from maximum 37° C to minimum 12.5° C. Annual average rainfall is 3031 mm.

Administration: Bandarban district was established in 1983, the district consists of 7 upazilas, 31 unions, 96 mauzas, 1554 villages, 2 paurashasavas, 18 wards and 103 mahallas. The upazilas are Banderban Sadar, Rowangchhari, Ruma, Thanchi, Lama, Alikadam and Naikhongchhari.

Historical Events: The British rulers declared Bandarban as a forest zone because of its vast forest area devoid of human settlement. The Arakanese were permanently settled in Banderban after the British ascendancy in Arakan.

Ethnic Nations: Marma, Murong, Tripura, Bawm, Tanchanga Chakma, Chak, Khyang, Khumi, Lushei and the Pankho are main ethnic nations of this district.

Educational Institutions: The numbers of educational institutions of this district are government college 5, government secondary school 9, non-government secondary school 28, residential school 3, government primary school 219, registered primary school 87, non-registered primary school 36, madrasah 10.

Locally Published Newspapers and Periodicals: The notable locally published newspapers and periodicals are Daily Natun Bangladesh, Daily Sangu, Daily Shochitra Monitry, Weekly Bandarban, Monthly Chimbuk, Monthly Nilachol etc.

Cultural Organizations: The numbers of cultural organization of this district are shishu academy1, shilpakala academy 1, public library 9, club 84, cinema hall 3 and tribal cultural institutions 1.

Main crops: Paddy, Cotton, tobacco, vegetables etc. are the main crops of this district.

Main fruits : Banana, pineapple, Jackfruit, Orange, Papaya, mango, lichi etc. are main fruits of this district.

NGO Activities: Operationally important NGOs are CCDB, CARITAS, BNKS, Green Hill, BITA, World Vision, GROUSE etc.

Health Centers: The numbers of health centers of this district are district sadar hospital 1, upazila health complex 7, union health and family planning centers 27.

Economic Situation: The economy of Bandarban is predominantly agricultural. Out of total 63,744 holdings of the district, 71.26% holdings are arriculture farm holding that produce varieties of crops, namely, local and HYV rice, wheat, vegetables, spices, cash crop, pulses, oil-seeds, maize and others. Various fruits like banana, jackfruit, coconut, guava etc are grown in the district. Fish of different varieties abound in this district and as in other parts of the country, varieties of fish are caught from rivers, tributary channels and creeks and from paddy fields during season. Besides crops livestock, forestry and fishery are the main source of household income. Out of 4479.03 sq. km. area of the district, forest and riverine areas occupy about 2730.48 sq. km. (60.96%) and 3.16 sq. km. (0.07%) respectively.

Non-agricultural activities are still sparse and an impression about their extent can be obtained from the following table-1 that shows the type of number of establishments together with persons engaged in those establishments by activity.

Flora and Fauna

Flora: Bandarban, one of the hilly districts of Bangladesh, has 61% of its area under forest. There are two reserve forests in this district. These are Sangu reserve forest and Matamuhuri reserve forest.

These reserve forests are maintained to manage the catchments areas of the Sangu and the Matamuhuri rivers. Sangu reserve forest is the only virgin forest area in Bangladesh with 86,000 acres of forest land. The region of Bandarban is more related to Indo-China from the floristic point of view; however, there is also a significant admixture of Chachar and Khasia elements in its floristic composition.

The forest of Bandarban, like those of the other hill districts of Chittagong division broadly represent four categories of natural vegetation. These are :

- (1) Rain forests,
- (2) Semi deciduous,
- (3) Bamboo brakes and
- (4) Grasslands.

Jhooming or shifting cultivation, an age-old practice of tribal people, has systematically destroyed many areas of virgin forests of this district. This has reduced the forest to secondary regrowth, and in many areas scrub jungles or grasslands are the result; there are also open canopies with such fire resistant varieties of trees like Koroy (*Albizia procera*) and gamar (*Gamelina arborea*).

The dominant species of the upper storey include ajuli (*Dillenia pentagyna*), duabanga grandiflora, civit, gamar (*Gmelina arborea*), garjan (*Dipterocarpus turbinatus*), telsur (*Hopea odorata*), kamdev (*Callophylum polyanthum*), champa (*Michelia champaca*), bailam (*Anisoptera scaphula*), haritaki (*Terminalia chebula*) and banshpata (*Podocarpus neritolia*), makrishal (*Sohima wallichii*), chickrassi (*Chickrassia tabularis*), toon (*Toona ciliata*), nagkashar (*Mesua nagassarium*), etc.

The second storey comprise mostly of jarul (*Legerstroemia speciosa*), capalish (*Atrocarpus chapalish*), jam (*Eugenia jambolanavav*), bhadi (*Lanuea grand*), indian olive (*Flaeocarpas robustus*), ashoka (*Saraca Indica*), chalmugra (*Hydnocarpus kurjii*), neelvadhi (*Garuga pinnata*), shona (*Oroxylum Indicum*), kanju (*Holoptelia integrifolia*), kukirecot (*Hymenodictyon excelsum*), glochidian and shrubby or low tress like maesa rameutacea and micremelum pubesennce. Some bamboo brakes occur in different areas of Bandarban. These are mooli (*Melacanna bambusoides*), tuda (*Bambusatulda*), barua (*Dendrocalamus longipathus*) and dulua (*Teinostachyeum dulooa*).

Various types of climbers, liamas and epiphyts consisting of ferns, mosses and orchids are abundant in these forests. The grassland develop as a result of felling and clearing along the banks of the rivers and awamps; the more common species are *Imperata cylindrica* and *Saccharum spontaneum*.

Various exotic plants like teak (*Tectona grandis*), babla (*Acacia nilotica*), pine (*Pinus longifolia*) and mahagoni (*Swietenia macrophylla*) etc have also been introduced in this district.

In the farmlands, varieties of crops namely local and HYV rice, wheat, vegetables, spices, pulses, oilseeds and maize etc are produced. The village homesteads are usually covered by dense and lush green foliage of a wide variety of trees, like betel nut (*Areca catechu*), coconut (*Cocos nucifera*), palm (*Borassus flabellifer*), jack fruit (*Artocarpus heterophyllus*), guava (*Psidium guajava*), jam (*Syzygium cumaini*), mango (*Mangifera indica*) etc and shrubs and thickets like banana and

bamboo. Wayside trees are banyan (*Ficus benghalensis*), sissu (*Dalbergia sissoo*), devdaru (*Polyalathia longifolia*), bel (Aegle marmelos) and Indian plums, etc.

Fauna: The big deer samber and the small barking deer (*Muntiacus mungjak*) are found in the forests of Bandarban. Elephants (*Elephas maximus*) are also seen in these forests. Jungle cat (*Felis chaus*) and fishing cat (*Felis viverrina*) are common; the beautiful clouded leopard (*Panthera Pardus*) and cats are also found. Wild boar (*Sus Scrofa*), wild dog, jackals (*Canis aureus*), fox (*Vulpes bengalensis*), weasals, honey badger (*Arctonyx collaris*), hog badger and scaly anteaters are also found. Rodents are represented by different species of squirrel (*Funambulus pennanti*), rat (*Rattus rattus*).

Bandarban has very rich avifauna. It supports large number of birds with its rich rainforests. Most of the 600 species of birds that are found in Bangladesh are also seen in Bandarban except the marine and the shore birds.

As many as 12 species of pheasants and quails are found including red jungle fowl, peacock pheasant, black breasted kalij, bamboo pheasant, white checked pheasant, hill pheasant, burmese peafowl, blue breasted kalij and Manipur bush quail etc. pigeon (*Columba livia*) and dove (*Bhalcophaps indica*) are represented by pin tailed, thick billed, gray fronted, orange breasted, yellow footed, green pigeons, imperial green pigeons, blue rock pigeon, purple wood pigeon, rufous turtle dove, ring dove and little brown dove. Parrots are represented by rose ringed parakeet, blossom headed parakeet slaty headed parakeet and tiny lorikeet etc. Among the cuckoos (*Cuculus micropterus*) are redwingad crested cuckoo, hodgesons hawk-cuckoo, Indian cuckoo, banded bay cuckoo, emerald cuckoo, shirker malkoha etc. Owls (*Bubo zeylensis*) are represented by more than a dozen species including jungle owl, spooted owl, grass owl, barn owl, eagle owl, brown hawk owl etc. 6 or 7 species of kingfishers are found in Bandarban including pied by the common kingfishers, blue eared kingfishers, three toed king fishers, stock billed king fishers, ruddy king fishers etc.

Among the wood peckers, yellow napped, golden backed, pale headed, great slaty, fulvous brested peed, yellow frosted pied and gray fronted pied ones are found. Among the beautiful bird bulbul black headed, red whiskered, red vented, white throated and olive bulbul are found. Also found are babblers, fly catchers, warblers. Other interesting birds are raptorial birds, rails and crakes including moor then, kora, waterhen/ large number of birds of the species of Charaiidac, nughtjars, several including of swifts, horbbills, barbets, broad bills, pittus, larks, swallows and martins etc.

The drongos are represented by great racket tailed drongo, lesser racket tailed drongo and hairy crested drongo. Mynas, magpies and different species of minivets, sunbirds and flower peckers with beaueiful plumage are also found. Spider hunter, white eye, several munias, finches and buntings are also found. Among the water birds little grebee, commorants, shags, darters, herons and storks, white and black ibises are found but geese are not common except whilling teals.

Among the reptiles reticulated python, rat snakes are found. The poisonous common species includes Bengal cobra, spectacled cobra, king cobra, common krait and branded krait and different

species of vipers etc. Lizard, gekkos skunks and monitor lizards are represented by more-than a dozen species. There are amphibians like toad, frogs and tree frogs.

Most of the fresh water fishes found in other parts of Bangladesh, like ruhi (*labeo rohita*), catla (*Catla catla*), mrigel (*Cirrhinus mrigala*), gohina (*Labeo gonius*), punti (*Barbus puntius*), bain (*Mastacembelus armatus*), shoil (*channa striatus*), boal (*Wallago attu*), airh (*Mystus aor*), tengra (*Mystus vittatus*), chapila (*Gudusia chapra*), koi (*Anabus testudineus*), shing (*Heteropneustes fossilis*), magur (*Clarias batrachus*) etc are also found in Bandarban. Exotic fishes like grass carp (*Ctenopharyngodon idella*), silver carp (*Hypophthalmichthys molitrix*), mirror carp (*Cyprinus carpio*), tilapia (*Oreochromis mossambicus*), nailotica (*Oreochromis niloticus*) etc have also been introduced in Bandarban.

Concepts and Definitions

1. Population and Housing Census 2011

The population and housing census is the unique source of reliable and comprehensive data about the size of the population of the country, major socio-economic and socio-demographic characteristics.

It is the total process of collecting, compiling, evaluating, analyzing and publishing or otherwise disseminating demographic, economic and social data pertaining, at a specified time, to all persons in a country. The essential features of a population census are individual enumeration, universality within a defined territory, simultaneity and defined periodicity.

The population and housing census provides information on the geographic and administrative distribution of the population and household in addition to the demographic and socioeconomic characteristics of all the people in the country. The data from the census are classified, tabulated and disseminated so that political leaders, election officials, planners, national organizations including NGOs and civil society, regional and international organizations can use the data in decision-making.

The purpose of community report is to disseminate census data by communities (ward/mahalla in urban area and union/mauza/village in rural area). Data on all key variables namely area, household, population by sex and age group, ethnic population, literacy rate, marital status, school attendance, employment status and religion as well as physical facilities such as source of drinking water, sanitation, electricity and dwelling units have been presented in this report. The planners, researchers and policy makers as well as development partners and community administrators will find this report as a valuable reference for use in advising plans and programs for advancing welfare and well-being of the common people, in particular and the community in general.

Household

Persons, either related or unrelated, living together and taking food from the same kitchen constitute a household. A single person living and eating alone forms one-person household.

Literacy

It denotes ability to write a letter in any language. Literacy status assessment is made for population 7 years and over.

Community

It refers to the following five lower geographic, administrative or revenue units:

- i) **Union:** Smallest administrative rural geographic unit comprising of mauzas and villages and having union parishad institution.
- ii) **Mauza :** Mauza is the lowest administrative unit having a separate jurisdiction list number (J.L. No.) in revenue records. Every mauza has its well-demarcated cadastral map. Mauza should be distinguished from local village since a mauza may consist of one or more villages.
- iii) **Village:** Lowest rural geographic unit either equivalent to a mauza or part of a mauza.
- iv) **Ward:** Smallest administrative urban geographic unit comprising of mahallas and having ward council institution.
- v) **Mahalla:** Lowest urban geographic unit having identifiable boundaries.

Urban Area

It corresponds with area developed around a central place having such amenities as metalled roads, improved communication, electricity, gas, water supply, sewerage, sanitation and also having comparatively higher density of population with majority population in non-agricultural occupations.

i) City Corporation: It includes city corporation area declared by the Ministry of Local Government.

ii) Paurashava/Municipality Area: It includes paurashavas incorporated and administered by local government under Paurashava Ordinance, 1977.

2. Agriculture Census year and reference period

The census year extends over twelve consecutive months having for different census items the different reference periods or days of data collections. Some items have a year or week reference period. Some others have a specific reference day. The different census items by their reference periods or days are shown below:

Agriculture holding

An agriculture holding is a techno-economic unit of agricultural production under single management comprising all livestock kept and all land used wholly or partly for agricultural production purposes without regard to title, legal form or size. Single management may be exercised by either an individual holder or jointly by two or more individuals or holders or by a judicial person such as a corporation, co-operative or government agency. A holding may consist of one or more parcels (fragments of land) located in one or more areas or mauzas or in more than one administrative unit or division provided that all separate parcels of fragments form parts of same technical unit under operational control of same management.

The definition covers practically all holdings/households engaged in agricultural production of both crops and livestock. Some agriculture holdings may have no significant agricultural land, e.g. holdings keeping livestock, poultry and hatcheries for which land is not an indispensable input for production.

Farm holding

A farm holding is defined as being an agricultural production unit having cultivated land equal to or more than 0.05 acres. Farm holdings are classified into following three broad groups:

(a) **small:** Farm holdings having minimum cultivated land 0.05 acre but operated land more than this minimum but upto 2.49 acres.

(b) **medium:** Farm holdings having operated land in between 2.50 to 7.49 acres.

(c) **large:** Farm holdings having operated land 7.50 acres and above.

Small cultivated land 0.04 acre or less is generally used for kitchen garden growing mainly vegetables. Often seeds of white gourd, water gourd, pumpkin and other strains are sown on households; but these creepers spread out around house roofs and other structures. As such, the minimum cultivated land considered for qualifying to be a farm holding is 0.05 acres.

Non-farm holdings

A non-farm holding is defined as being the one which has neither cultivated nor operated land or has cultivated land less than 0.05 acre.

Tenancy

Owner holdings are those having and operating their owned land and who may or may not be leasing out land.

Tenant holdings are those having no owned land but operating land taken from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Owner-cum-tenant holdings are those having owned land and who may or may not be leasing out their own land to others and who may be taking land from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Agriculture work

Agriculture work signifies all activities of holder and his/her labour force doing planning, management, and operation of a holding. It includes land preparation, sowing, weeding, harvesting, feeding and tending livestock & poultry, kitchen gardening, supervising agricultural workers, keeping farm records & accounts, preparing agriculture products for marketing (including packaging), repairing farm equipment, constructing farm buildings & fences, and engaging in land reclamation and improvement and other related activities. It excludes home and other family domestic chores.

Area under pond

The pond area remains under water almost through out the year. Normally, households use pond water for various domestic and sometimes agriculture purposes. Ponds are also generally used for fish culture.

In the census the pond area data were collected separately for both single ownership and joint ownership of households.

Area under temporary crops

It is the land area planted to crops having growing cycle or length of life less than one year. These are the temporary crops such as paddy, wheat, jute, cotton, tobacco, sugarcane, pulses, oil seeds, potato, vegetables and other seasonal crops. A list of temporary crops for which data were collected separately was given in back page of "Tally Sheet". The minimum area recorded for a temporary crop was 0.01 acre. Area under temporary crops and temporary-crops net area are equivalents.

Area under permanent crops

It is the land area planted to crops which remain standing for a long period of time and do not need to be replanted after a seasonal harvest. Mango, jackfruit, coconut, guava, lemon, and other fruit varieties are all permanent crops.

Current fallow

It is land brought into cultivation but left out uncultivated in census year for fertility regaining and improvement or for other reasons.

Net cultivated area

This is land area actually cropped during the census year regardless of number of crops grown plus current fallow. It includes areas under temporary and permanent crops and also current fallow.

Permanent fallow

It is land not available for cultivation due to coming into residence and commercial & other uses. Play ground, graveyard, wild shrubs and jungles, marshy land, and the like fall in this category.

Irrigated area

This is area of Total land brought under irrigation coverage for growing crops with irrigations done through mechanical or manual means. Irrigated area classifications fall into two categories: (1) surface water irrigation with main water sources being rivers, canals, beels, ponds, and other water bodies; and (2) underground water irrigation with water lifted by shallow tube-wells, deep tube-wells, and country traditional devices. The irrigation equipments are run by electricity, diesel or petrol, or manual labour.

Cattle and Buffalo

Cattle and buffalo heads owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Goats and Sheep

Goats and sheep owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Fowls, Ducks, and Pigeons

Fowls, ducks, and pigeons owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Temporary crops gross area

Areas aggregated for all temporary crops grown in the census year have made **temporary crops gross area** greater than **temporary crops net area** since the latter has within it the same land cropped more than once in different seasons of a year.

Intensity of cropping

It is percentage of temporary crops gross area in comparison with temporary crops net area. It is expressed as follows:

$$\text{Intensity of cropping} = \frac{\text{Temporary crops gross area}}{\text{Temporary crops net area}} \times 100$$

Cereals

Main cereals are rice and then wheat. Other cereals are jab, barley, cheena, maize, kaun, bajra and joar.

Pulses

Main and common pulses are gram, mung, lentil, arhar, gari kalai, khesari and pea.

Oil seeds

Main oil seeds are rape and mustard, sesamum, linseed, groundnut, soybean, sunflower and castor.

Vegetables

Farmers grow both summer and winter vegetables. Main vegetables are potato, brinjal, raddish, arum, lady's finger, cauliflower, cabbage, bean, tomato, patal, gourd, cucumber, pumpkin, knoll-kal-turnip, dhundal, barbati, khirai, chichinga, carrot, kakrol and sak.

Cash crop

Main cash crops are jute, mesta, sunhemp, cotton, sugarcane and tobacco.

Spices

The main spices include turmeric, ginger, chillies, onion, garlic, corriander, black cumin and ani seed.

Fuel crops

Dhaincha and other smaller plants used as cooking-fuel.
