

CHAPTER : 1

Introduction

District at a Glance

Background, Geographic Area and Location: Bhola zila, the largest riverine delta island of the world became a sub-division in 1845 bearing the name of South Shahbazpur. At that time it was a part of Noakhali zila which was then transferred to Barisal zila in 1869. The sub-division was renamed as Bhola in 1876 when its headquarter was shifted from Daulatkhan to Bhola. It was upgraded to a zila in 1984. It is bounded on the north by Barisal zila, on the east by Lakshmipur and Noakhali zilas, on the south by the Bay of Bengal and on the west by Barisal and Patuakhali zilas. It lies between 21°54' and 22°52' north latitudes and between 90°34' and 91°01' east longitudes. The total area of the zila is 3403.48 sq.km (1314.08 sq.miles) of which 1456.87 sq.km. is under forest.

Bhola Zila (BARISAL division) an offshore island with an area of 3403.48 sq km, is bounded by LAKSHMIPUR and BARISAL zilas on the north, BAY OF BENGAL on the south, Lakshmipur and NOAKHALI zilas, MEGHNA (lower) river and Shahbazpur Channel on the east, PATUAKHALI zila and TENTULIA river on the west. Zahiruddin, Patila, Dhalchar, Kukri-Mukri and such other chars of different sizes have formed at the river mouths.

Annual Average Temperature: Highest 32.7°C and lowest 11.6°C and annual rainfall 2360 mm.

Noted Rivers: Kalabador, Lower Meghna, Tetulia, Ilisha.

Administration: Bhola sub-division was established under Noakhali zila in 1845. At that time its administration centre was at Amania of Daulatkhan. The sub-division was included in Barisal zila in 1869. The sub-division was then consisted of Daulatkhan and Burhanuddin Hat Thanas and three outposts such as Taltali, Gazipur and Tazumuddin. The sub-divisional head quarters was shifted from Daulatkhan to Bhola in 1876. It was elevated to a zila on 1 February 1984.

Bhola Municipal town: was established in 1920. The zila consists of 7 upazilas, 68 unions, 314 mauzas, 438 villages, 5 paurashavas, 45 wards and 68 mahallas. The upazilas are BHOLA SADAR, DAULATKHAN, BURHANUDDIN, TAZUMUDDIN, MANPURA, LALMOHAN and CHARFASSON.

Historical Events: Many people of the zila, especially of Charfasson and Tazumuddin, lost their lives in a devastating cyclone and tidal bore in 1970. During the WAR OF LIBERATION a battle between the freedom fighters and the Pak army was fought at Ghuigarhat (Bhola Sadar) in which 121 freedom fighters were killed. In another encounter at Bangla Bazar about 80 members of the Pak army were killed.

Marks of War of Liberation: Memorial sculpture at Char Jangla.

Educational Institutions: Government college 3, Non-government college 32, polytechnic & vocational institute 12, Government high school 6, Non-government high school 256, junior high school 63, government primary school 424, registered primary school 526, Non-government primary school 25, madrasah 241, kawmi madrasah 89, kinder garten school 45, Government technical institution 1, Non-government technical institute 1.

Cultural Organizations: Club 133, public library 11, cinema hall 21, literary society 26, women's organisation 65, theatre group 10, co operative society 301, auditorium 8, women's club 2, shilpkala academy 1, literary academy 1.

Locally Published Newspapers and Periodicals: Ajker Bholabani, Daily Banglar Kantha, weekly 1 (Dvipabani), Weekly Lalsurya (extinct), monthly 1.

Religious Institutions: Mosque 3473, Eid-Gah 239, temple 194, tomb 4, math 5, akhra 1.

Mineral Resources: A gas field has been traced at Kachi Union under Burhanuddin Upazila. It has been named Shahbazpur Gas Field. Quantity of gas 0.5938 TCF of which 0.3340 TCF gas is procurable.

Main Crops: Paddy, potato, onion, chilli, garlic, mustard seed, nut, betel leaf, betel nut. Extinct and nearly extinct crops Tobacco, linseed.

Main fruits: Coconut, jackfruit, papaya, amra, banana.

Traditional Transports: Bullock cart.

Manufacturing Industries: Rice mill, ice factory, saw mill, flour mill, oil mill, soap factory, bread and biscuit factory, welding, lathe machine.

Cottage Industries: Weaving, goldsmith, blacksmith, potteries, bamboo work, wood work, mat work, tailoring.

Hats, Bazars and Fairs: Hats and bazars are 241, most noted of which are Bank Hat, Deola, Ramnewaz, Charfasson, Goldar, Letorganj, Chairman Bazar, Daulatkhan Hat, Bangla Bazar, Ramaganj, Hariganj, Nazirpur, Yasinganj, Tazumuddin, etc; fair 6, most noted of which are Bhuban Thakur Mela (Tazumuddin) and Krishna Prasad Mela (Manpura).

Main Exports: Paddy, betel nut chilli and fish.

NGO Activities: ASA, BRAC, PROSHIKA, CARITAS, ACTION AID, Vision, Char Development Project, Bandhujan Parishad, RASA, Coast, Social Development.

Health Centres: Zila Hospital 1, Upazila Health Complex 7, Non Government Health Complex 09, Clinic Diagnostic Private 09, Union Health and Family Planning Centre 68, Satellite Clinic 11.

Economic Situation: The economy of Bhola is predominantly agricultural. Out of total 347,515 holdings of the zila, 64.01 % holdings are farms that produce varieties of crops namely local and HYV rice, wheat, vegetables, jute, spices, cash crops, pulses, and others. Various fruits like banana, mango, guava, jackfruit, black berries, coconut, papaya, palm, lichi, dates etc. are grown. Fish of different varieties abound in this zila which enjoys the advantages of marine fishing. More varieties of fish are caught from rivers, tributary channels and creeks and from paddy fields during rainy season. Hilsa, a popular fish of the country, is abundantly available in the zila. Dry fish is an important source of income to the fishermen. In the fresh water the popular species are ruhi, katla, marigale, kalabous, airh, ghania, shaol, boal, gagar, gulsha, kai, shing, magur etc. Besides crops livestock and fishery are the main sources of household income.

According to 2001-03 Census of Non-Farm Economic Activities, the broad types of non-farm activities are developing in the zila. The following table shows total establishments in the urban and rural areas and persons engaged by sex and activity in Bhola. There are 39,305 establishments in the zila in which 90,709 persons are engaged in different types of non-farm activities. The participation of female persons in non-farm activities is very poor. They are only 3.6% while the

males are 96.4%. Wholesale & retail trade emerges the single largest activity 62.5% with 24577 establishments and 42084 persons engaged (46.4%) in the establishments of the zila.

Flora and Fauna

Flora: Much of the Bhola district is an intermediate level island, but falls within the active delta as there has been diluvion in the east and accretions in the north-west. The whole island is affected by the movements of the lower Meghna channel.

Various types of agricultural crops are cultivated in the island. Among cereal crops, aman covers the largest area followed by aus, boro and wheat. The acreage under jute is the minimal. Other crops include khesari, mug, musur, gram, potao, sugarcane, onion and garlic, betel leaf, and tobacco and different kinds of vegetable, betelnut, betelleaf and chillies are the main cash crops.

Common fruit crops that are grown in the area are mango, jackfruit, guava, banana, papaya, amra, chalta, coconut etc.

The groves that surround the village homesteads, represent various types of commonly planted trees. These are mango (*Mangifera indica*), kalojam/black berry (*Syzygium cumini*), amra (*Spondia pinnata*), guava (*Psidium guajava*), coconut (*Cocos nucifera*), betelnut (*Arccia catechu*), kantal/jackfruit (*Artocarpus heterophyllus*), kadam (*Anthocephalus cadamba*), jambura (*Citrus decumana*), and mandar (*Erythrina variegata*).

Common way side trees are karoy (*Albizzia procera*), tentul (*Tamariandus indica*), neem (*Azadirachta indica*), hijol (*Barringtonia acutangula*), banyan (*Ficus benghalensis*), oshot (*Ficus religiosa*), raintree (*Samanca saman*), and pitraj (*Aphanamixls polystachia*).

Besides the above, the entire coastal belt of the island has recently been covered with trees like Australian acacia, babla (*Acacia nilotica*), jarul (*Lgerstroemia speciosa*), coconut (*Cocos nucifera*), betel nut (*Areca catechu*) etc.

Moreover, in different ponds ditches and beels of this area, various hydrophytes like vallisneria, hydrilla, potamogetan, lemna and floating ferns like salvinia and azola gown in abundance. Other aqua plants like lotus (*Nelumbo nucifera*), various species of water-lily (*Nymphaea nouchaliq*) and the introduced weed known as water hyacinth (*Eichhornia crassipes*) are spectacularly seen in different shallow water bodies.

Fauna:

Mammals: Of the mammals the following species are most familiar in the district: Indian pipistelle (*Pipistrellus corromandra*), tickel's bat (*Hesperoptenus tickelli*), benji (*Herpestes edwardsi*), dhari Indur/rat (*Bandicota bengalensis*), indur (*Rattus rattus*) metho indur (*Mus Booduga*), shial/ jackal (*Canis aureus*), ud biral (*Aonyx cinerea*) and dura kathbirali (*Funambulus pennanti*).

Some species of mammals are now rarely seen in the island. These are banar (*Macaca mullata*), khek shial (*Vulpes bengalensis*), kahrgosh (*Lepus nigricollis*), sajru (*Atherurus macrourus*), khatash (*Viverra zibetha*), shusuk (*Neophocaena phocaenoides*) etc.

Birds: Different species of birds are commonly found in the island. These are doel (*Copsychus saularis*), babui (*Ploceus philippinus*), tuntuni (*Orthotomus sutorius*), lejnachani (*Rhipidura albicollis*), tila munia (*Lonchura punctulata*), crow (*Cornus spendens*), dar kak (*Corvus macrorhynchos*), bhat shalik (*Acridotheres tristis*), sharui (*Passer domesticus*), kaliphecha (*Glaucidium radiatum*), choto fingey (*Diciris macrocercus*), holdey pakhi (*Oriolus Xanthornus*), kaththokra (*Picus myrmecophoneus*), machranga (*Alcedo atthis*), laxmi pencha (*Tyto alba*), tia (*Psillacula Krameri*), tila ghugu (*Strepto pelia chinensis*), dahuk (*Amauornis phoenicurus*), kana korchy bok (*Ardeola grayii*), panikaor (*Orilus xanthornus*) etc.

The migrant birds that come to visit different swamps of the island are tibetan shrike (*Lenius tephronotus*), khuntee hans (*Anas clypeata*), giria hans (*Anas querquedula*), goganbar (*Podiceps cristatus*) chokachaki (*Tedorna ferruginea*), badami koshai pakhi (*Lanuis cristatus*), lenja hans (*Anas acuta*), khonjan (*Motacilla cinerea*) and booted warbler (*Happlais caligata*).

Reptiles and amphibians: Due to indiscriminate destruction of their natural habitat, many of the wild fauna of the district have been declining since long. As a result some of the reptiles have now become rare. Few of the species that are still observed are gui shap (*Varanas bengalensis*), ghargini shap (*Lycodon jara*), dhora shap (*Xenodrophis piscator*), paina shap (*Enhydris enhydris*), gokhra (*Naja naja*), tiktiki (*Hemidactylus brooki*), shanda (*Gekko gecko*), dhun kasim (*Trionyx hurum*) and kori kaitta (*Kachuga tecta*).

Most common amphibians are kuno bang (*Bufo melanostictus*), venpu bang (*Kaloula pulchra*), bhawa bang (*Rana tigerina*), kotkoti kang (*Rana Cyanophlyctis*) etc.

Fishes: Fish resources of this district are represented by indigenous, exotic, brakish and marine varieties. In the fresh water the popular species are ruhi (*Labco rohita*), katla (*Catla catlaa*), mrigel (*Cirrhinus mrigala*), calbaus (*Labeo calbasu*), magur (*Clarias batrachas*), shing (*Heteropneustes fossilis*), koi (*Anumbas testudineus*), airh (*Mystus aor*), boal (*Wallago attu*), shaul (*Channa striatus*), phali (*Notopterus notopterus*) etc. Exotic fishes like silver carp (*Hypophthalmichthys molitrix*) mirror carp (*Cyprinus carpio*), telapia (*Oreochromis mossambicus*), nilotica (*Oreochromis niloticus*) etc. have also been introduced in the island.

Among brackish water fishes, koral (*Lates calearifer*), Bata (*Labco bata*), khorsola (*Rhinomugil corsula*), bacha (*Eatropicthys vacha*), pabda (*Ompok bimaculatus*), tatkini, gangchela (*Salmostoma acinaces*) etc. are the most common. Besides, marine fishes like bhetki (*Lates calearifer*), illis (*Hilsa Ilisha*), topshi (*Polynemus paradiseus*), datina (*Acanthopagrus latus*), terabhangan (*Polynemus indicus*), bhola (*Scheama semiluctuosa*) etc. are commonly found.

Concepts and Definitions

Population and Housing Census 2011

The population and housing census is the unique source of reliable and comprehensive data about the size of the population of the country, major socio-economic and socio-demographic characteristics.

It is the total process of collecting, compiling, evaluating, analyzing and publishing or otherwise disseminating demographic, economic and social data pertaining, at a specified time, to all persons in a country. The essential features of a population census are individual enumeration, universality within a defined territory, simultaneity and defined periodicity.

The population and housing census provides information on the geographic and administrative distribution of the population and household in addition to the demographic and socioeconomic characteristics of all the people in the country. The data from the census are classified, tabulated and disseminated so that political leaders, election officials, planners, national organizations including NGOs and civil society, regional and international organizations can use the data in decision-making.

The purpose of community report is to disseminate census data by communities (ward/mahalla in urban area and union/mauza/village in rural area). Data on all key variables namely area, household, population by sex and age group, ethnic population, literacy rate, marital status, school attendance, employment status and religion as well as physical facilities such as source of drinking water, sanitation, electricity and dwelling units have been presented in this report. The planners, researchers and policy makers as well as development partners and community administrators will find this report as a valuable reference for use in advising plans and programs for advancing welfare and well-being of the common people, in particular and the community in general.

Household

Persons, either related or unrelated, living together and taking food from the same kitchen constitute a household. A single person living and eating alone forms one-person household.

Literacy

It denotes ability to write a letter in any language. Literacy status assessment is made for population 7 years and over.

Community

It refers to the following five lower geographic, administrative or revenue units:

- i) **Union:** Smallest administrative rural geographic unit comprising of mauzas and villages and having union parishad institution.
- ii) **Mauza :** Mauza is the lowest administrative unit having a separate jurisdiction list number (J.L. Number) in revenue records. Every mauza has its well-demarcated cadastral map. Mauza should be distinguished from local village since a mauza may consist of one or more villages.
- iii) **Village:** Lowest rural geographic unit either equivalent to a mauza or part of a mauza.
- iv) **Ward:** Smallest administrative urban geographic unit comprising of mahallas and having ward council institution.
- v) **Mahalla:** Lowest urban geographic unit having identifiable boundaries.

Urban Area

It corresponds with area developed around a central place having such amenities as metalled roads, improved communication, electricity, gas, water supply, sewerage, sanitation and also having comparatively higher density of population with majority population in non-agricultural occupations.

- i) **City Corporation:** It includes city corporation area declared by the Ministry of Local Government.
- ii) **Paurashava/Municipality Area:** It includes paurashavas incorporated and administered by local government under Paurashava Ordinance, 1977.

Agriculture Census year and reference period

The census year extends over twelve consecutive months having for different census items the different reference periods or days of data collections. Some items have a year or week reference period. Some others have a specific reference day.

The census year covered twelve months from 1 Baishak to 30 Choitra, 1414 Bangla Shal (BS). This year was the reference period for such census items as operated land use, crops, agriculture employment, livestock & poultry deaths and agriculture loan. A single reference day was used for items like holdings, farm size, land tenure, farm population, livestock & poultry inventories and agriculture implements.

The different census items by their reference periods or days are shown below:

Agriculture holding

An agriculture holding is a techno-economic unit of agricultural production under single management comprising all livestock kept and all land used wholly or partly for agricultural production purposes without regard to title, legal form or size. Single management may be exercised by either an individual holder or jointly by two or more individuals or holders or by a judicial person such as a corporation, co-operative or government agency. A holding may consist of one or more parcels (fragments of land) located in one or more areas or mauzas or in more than one administrative unit or division provided that all separate parcels of fragments form parts of same technical unit under operational control of same management.

The definition covers practically all holdings/households engaged in agricultural production of both crops and livestock. Some agriculture holdings may have no significant agricultural land, e.g. holdings keeping livestock, poultry and hatcheries for which land is not an indispensable input for production.

Farm holding

A farm holding is defined as being an agricultural production unit having cultivated land equal to or more than 0.05 acres. Farm holdings are classified into following three broad groups:

- (a) **small:** Farm holdings having minimum cultivated land 0.05 acre but operated land more than this minimum but upto 2.49 acres.
- (b) **medium:** Farm holdings having operated land in between 2.50 to 7.49 acres.
- (c) **large:** Farm holdings having operated land 7.50 acres and above.

Small cultivated land 0.04 acre or less is generally used for kitchen garden growing mainly vegetables. Often seeds of white gourd, water gourd, pumpkin and other strains are sown on households; but these creepers spread out around house roofs and other structures. As such, the minimum cultivated land considered for qualifying to be a farm holding is 0.05 acres.

Non-farm holdings

A non-farm holding is defined as being the one which has neither cultivated nor operated land or has cultivated land less than 0.05 acre.

Tenancy

Owner holdings are those having and operating their owned land and who may or may not be leasing out land.

Tenant holdings are those having no owned land but operating land taken from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Owner-cum-tenant holdings are those having owned land and who may or may not be leasing out their own land to others and who may be taking land from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Agriculture work

Agriculture work signifies all activities of holder and his/her labour force doing planning, management, and operation of a holding. It includes land preparation, sowing, weeding, harvesting, feeding and tending livestock & poultry, kitchen gardening, supervising agricultural workers, keeping farm records & accounts, preparing agriculture products for marketing (including packaging), repairing farm equipment, constructing farm buildings & fences, and engaging in land reclamation and improvement and other related activities. It excludes home and other family domestic chores.

Area under pond

The pond area remains under water almost through out the year. Normally, households use pond water for various domestic and sometimes agriculture purposes. Ponds are also generally used for fish culture.

In the census the pond area data were collected separately for both single ownership and joint ownership of households.

Area under temporary crops

It is the land area planted to crops having growing cycle or length of life less than one year. These are the temporary crops such as paddy, wheat, jute, cotton, tobacco, sugarcane, pulses, oil seeds, potato, vegetables and other seasonal crops. A list of temporary crops for which data were collected separately was given in back page of "Tally Sheet". The minimum area recorded for a temporary crop was 0.01 acre. Area under temporary crops and temporary-crops net area are equivalents.

Area under permanent crops

It is the land area planted to crops which remain standing for a long period of time and do not need to be replanted after a seasonal harvest. Mango, jackfruit, coconut, guava, lemon, and other fruit varieties are all permanent crops.

Current fallow

It is land brought into cultivation but left out uncultivated in census year for fertility regaining and improvement or for other reasons.

Net cultivated area

This is land area actually cropped during the census year regardless of number of crops grown plus current fallow. It includes areas under temporary and permanent crops and also current fallow.

Permanent fallow

It is land not available for cultivation due to coming into residence and commercial & other uses. Play ground, graveyard, wild shrubs and jungles, marshy land, and the like fall in this category.

Irrigated area

This is area of total land brought under irrigation coverage for growing crops with irrigations done through mechanical or manual means. Irrigated area classifications fall into two categories: (1) surface water irrigation with main water sources being rivers, canals, beels, ponds, and other water bodies; and (2) underground water irrigation with water lifted by shallow tube-wells, deep tube-wells, and country traditional devices. The irrigation equipments are run by electricity, diesel or petrol, or manual labour.

Cattle and Buffalo

Cattle and buffalo heads owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Goats and Sheep

Goats and sheep owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Fowls, Ducks, and Pigeons

Fowls, ducks, and pigeons owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Temporary crops gross area

Areas aggregated for all temporary crops grown in the census year have made **temporary crops gross area** greater than **temporary crops net area** since the latter has within it the same land cropped more than once in different seasons of a year.

Intensity of cropping

It is percentage of temporary crops gross area in comparison with temporary crops net area. It is expressed as follows:

$$\text{Intensity of cropping} = \frac{\text{Temporary crops gross area}}{\text{Temporary crops net area}} \times 100$$

Cereals

Main cereals are rice and then wheat. Other cereals are jab, barley, cheena, maize, kaun, bajra and joar.

Pulses

Main and common pulses are gram, mung, lentil, arhar, gari kalai, khesari and pea.

Oil seeds

Main oil seeds are rape and mustard, sesamum, linseed, groundnut, soybean, sunflower and castor.

Vegetables

Farmers grow both summer and winter vegetables. Main vegetables are potato, brinjal, raddish, arum, lady's finger, cauliflower, cabbage, bean, tomato, patal, gourd, cucumber, pumpkin, knoll-kal-turnip, dhundal, barbati, khirai, chichinga, carrot, kakrol and sak.

Cash crop

Main cash crops are jute, mesta, sunhemp, cotton, sugarcane and tobacco.

Spices

The main spices include turmeric, ginger, chillies, onion, garlic, coriander, black cumin and ani seed.

Fuel crops

Dhaincha and other smaller plants used as cooking-fuel are included in the group.
