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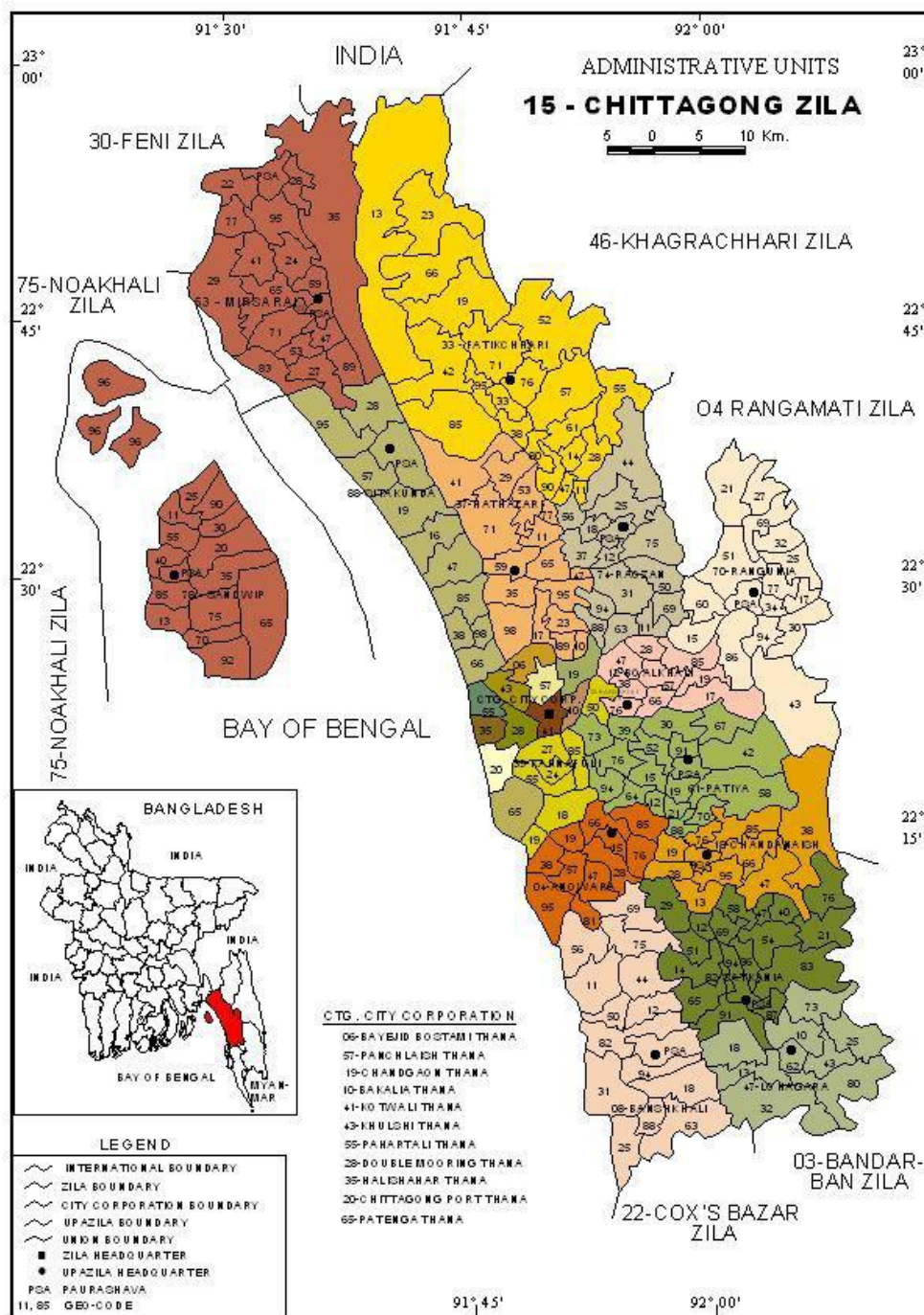
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District Map

CHAPTER 1

Introduction

District at a Glance

Background: Chittagong is a district located in the south-eastern region of Bangladesh. It is a part of Chittagong Division. Chittagong is a metropolitan city and second largest city of Bangladesh and situated on the banks of the Karnaphuli River. Chittagong had been a sea port since the ancient time. Traders from different countries including Arab had business transactions with this port since 9th century. Sultan Fakruddin Mubarak Shah of Sonargaon conquered Chittagong in 1340. After the defeat of Sultan Giasuddin Mahmud Shah by Sher Shah in 1538 AD, the Arakanise again captured Chittagong. The region was under the kingdom of Arakan during sixth and seventh centuries. During 17th century, this region faced many attacks of Portuguese pirates. Before the Muslim conquered, Chittagong had been either under the control of the Arakans or under the kings of Burma. The Mughal Commander Bujurg Umed Khan expelled the Portuguese pirates from the region and established Chittagong district in 1666 and named Islamabad. Next the region was named Chattla and Chandgaon. The Chittagong Hill-Tracts were separated from Chittagong in 1860. Cox's Bazar was separated from Chittagong district in 1984 after the liberation of Bangladesh. Chittagong District is quite different from other districts for its unique natural beauty characterised by hills, rivers, sea, forests and valleys.

Geographic Area and Location: Chittagong District is bounded on the north by Tripura State of India, on the east by Khagrachhari, Rangamati and Bandarban Districts, on the south by Cox's Bazar District and on the west by the Bay of Bengal, Feni and Noakhali Districts. The total area of the district is 5282.92 sq. km. (2039.74 sq. miles) of which 1700 sq. km. (456.37 sq. miles) including coastal area. The district lies between 21°54' and 22°59' north latitude and between 91°17' and 92°13' east longitude.

Annual Average Temperature and Rainfall: The annual average temperature of this district varies from maximum 32.5°C to minimum 13.5°C. The average rainfall is 3378 mm.

Administration: The area of Chittagong is 5282.92 Sq Km. It is also a divisional headquarter. The district consists of 14 upazila and 12 thana, 194 unions, 985 mauzas, 1267 villages, 1 city corporation, 41 city ward, city mahallah 207, 10 paurashavas, 90 wards and 199 mahallas. The upazilas are Anwara, Banskhali, Boalkhali, Chandanaish, Fatikchhari, Hathazari, Lohagara, Mirsharai, Patiya, Rangunia, Raozan, Sandwip, Satkania and Sitakunda. The thanas are Chandgaon, Chittagong Port, Double Mooring, Kotwali, Pahartali, Panchlaish, Bakalia, Bayejid Bostami, Patenga, Halishahar, Karnafuli and Khulshi.

Population: The total population of Chittagong district is 76,16,352 (Male- 38,38,854 and Female- 37,77,498), Sex ratio 102:100, Population Density 1442 sq. km. and annual growth rate is 1.40%.

Literacy: The Literacy Rate of Chittagong district is 58.90% (Male- 61.10% and Female- 56.70%). School attendance rate is 52.30% for 5 to 24 years age group.

Main Rivers: The Karnafuli, Halda and Sangu are the main rivers of this district.

Historical Events: The city was a Portuguese colony before falling under Mughal rule during the 16th and 17th centuries. An Islamic Preach Hazrat Badar Aawlia arrived in this city from the seas and chose Cheragi Pahar to live and started to spread the message of Islam among the locals More than six hundred years ago. It carries the history of revolutionary activities during the British Raj. During World War II, the British used Chittagong as an important military base for Allied forces. Masterda Surya Sen formed the secret Republican Army and he set up camps for revolutionary youths to train in guerilla here. On 24 September 1932, 8 young rebels led by Pritilata Waddadar attacked the European Club. During 1930-1932, 22 officials and 220 non-officials were killed by the revolutionarists in separate incidents. During the Liberation War of Bangladesh, Chittagong had some of the heaviest fighting with the Mukti Bahini attacking Pakistani navy ships and the Indian navy firing missiles at Pakistani naval installations. Chittagong Awami League leader M A Hannan and Liberation war hero Major Ziaur Rahman announced the declaration of independence on behalf of independence leader Sheikh Mujibur Rahman from Kalur Khat, Chittagong.

Famous Tourist Places: Fays Lake, Potenga Sea Beach, Chittagong Zoo, Chittagong University, Graveyard of Bayajid Bostami, Graveyard of Shah Amanat, War Cemetery, Zia Memorial Museum, Fauzdarhat Cadet College, Mahuri Project, Batali Hill, Chandranath Hill of Shitakunda, Hot Water Fall, Bashkhali Eco Park, Parky Sea Beach in Anowara, Bangladesh Military Academy, Marine Academy Chittagong Ethnological Museum etc. are famous tourist places of this district.

Archaeological Heritage and Relics: Bronze Statues (8th and 9th centuries), Fakira Mosque (Hathazari), Musa Khan Mosque (1658), Kura Katni Mosque (1806), Kala Mosque (16th century), Chhuti Khan Mosque (Mirsharai), Kadam Mobarak Mosque (1719), Andar Killah Mosque, Wali Khan Mosque (1790), Badar Awlia Dargah, Bakshi Hamid Mosque of Banskhali (1568), Chittagong Court Building (1893), Ethnological Museum (1974) etc. are notable tourist places of this district.

Religious Institutions: The numbers of religious institutions of this district are Mosque 7021, Tomb 220, Temple 992, Church 126 and Pagoda 126. The most notable of which are Chuti Khan Mosque, Daulat Bibir Mosque, Mahadia Mosque, Noi Duari Mosque, Hamidullah Khan Mosque, Tomb of Shah Jadeh (R), Three domed Khan Mosque (Dohazari and Baghica Hat), Tombs of Hazrat Shah Amanat (R), Hazrat Bayazid Bostami (R), Mohsen Awlia, Goribullah Shah (R), Hajrat

Shah Pir Awlia, Baro Awlia (Sitakunda), Miskin (R), Akbaria Jami Mosque, Nasrat Shah Jami Mosque, Jagannath Mandir (Abu Torab Bazar), World Peace Pagoda (Hathazari), Sitakunda Shankar Math, Dharmo Chakro Buddhho Vihara, Koriya Nagar and Sonakania Buddhho Viharas, Chandranath Temple Hill etc.

Educational Institutions: The numbers of educational institutions of this district are university 3, medical college 2, Bangladesh institute of technology 1, govt. college 14, non-govt. college 121, college of physical education 1, teachers training college 1, regional public administration institute 1, polytechnic institute 1, homeopathy college 2, nursing institute 1, forest research institute 1, veterinary college 1, home economics college 1, Bangladesh military academy 1, vocational institute 1, law college 2, art college 1, marine academy 1, marine fisheries academy 1, cadet college 1, madrasa 395, govt. secondary school 12, non-govt. secondary school 698, govt. primary school 1665, registered primary school 512, private (non-registered) primary school 208 and kindergarten school 1011.

Locally Published Newspapers and Periodicals: Locally published newspapers and periodicals of this district are Daily Azadi, Daily Purbokon, Daily Life, Daily Karnafuli, Weekly Chattala etc.

Main Crops: Paddy, betel leaf, potato, corn, turmeric, tea, peanut, mustard, patol (heap), brinjal, ginger, cucumber, vegetables etc. are main crops of this district.

Main Fruits: Mango, jackfruit, guava, coconut, betel nut, palm, litchi, banana, papaya, watermelon, lemon etc. are main fruits of this district.

Manufacturing Industries: Major Manufacturing Industries include Eastern Refinery, Pahartali Railway Workshops, Fouzi Flour mill, Jamuna Oil Company, Glaxo Welcome, Lever Brothers, KDS Garments etc.

NGO Activities: Operationally important NGOs are CARITAS, YMCA, BRAC, FPAB, NGO Forum for DWSS, UCEP, PROSHIKA, ASA, Nijera Kari, CODEC, Mamta, Love the Children Foundation, Sheba Shango, IMAGE, Chittagong Anti-drug Abuse Society, CWFP, Bitu, Prottashi, Palli Progati Sangstha, Grammen Projukti Kendra, Bangladesh Samaj Unnayan Sangstha, SDI, Bangladesh Nari Pragati Sangha, Gana Unnayan Prachesta etc.

Economic Situation: The economy of Chittagong district is predominantly non-agricultural. Out of total 1,298,834 holdings of the district, 28.30% holdings are farms and remaining 71.70% are non-farms. Non-farm holdings largely depend on non-agricultural activities. Despite the growth of non-agriculture activities, the farm holdings also play an important role. Farm-holdings produce varieties of crops, namely, local and HYV rice, wheat, vegetables, spices, cash crops, pulses, oilseeds, maize and others. Various fruits like banana, jackfruits, guava, coconut, etc. are grown. Fishes of various species especially marine-species are abound in the district. Varieties of fish are caught from local rivers, tributary channels and creeks and from paddy fields during rainy seasons. Popular fresh water fish species are rui, katla, mrigale, kalabous, aier, ghania, shaol, boal, gulsha, kai, shing, magur, etc. In saline water hilsha, prawn and pangas fishes are caught. The district has plenty of marine fishery resources due to coast line of the Bay of Bangal. Crops, livestock, forestry

and fishery are the main source of household income. Valuable timber and other forest trees also grow in this district.

Non-farm activities are very much significant in Chittagong district. According to the, there are a variety of non-farm activities in the district. The following table-1 shows total establishments and persons engaged by sex and activity in the district.

According to the above table, there is a total of 194,962 establishments in the district where 704,351 persons are engaged in different types of non-farm activities. Female participation in non-farm activities is very poor. They constitute about 9.70% females as against 91.30% males. Wholesale & retail trade emerges as the single largest activity (62.38%) with 121,605 establishments. Males and females engaged in the sector are 315,353 (49.04%) and 552 (9.02%) persons respectively.

Flora and Fauna

Flora: The forest of Chittagong is broadly classified into: (i) tropical wet and evergreen, (ii) tropical semi-evergreen and (iii) deciduous types. The last type is always mixed with the evergreen species. All these forest types have additional undergrowth. The undergrowth is a tangled mass of shrubs with bamboo and cane brakes.

The tropical wet evergreen forest is rich in floristic composition. Common tall trees in the upper storey include kaligarjan (*Dipterocarpus turbinatus*), dhaligarjan (*Dipterocarpus alatus*), civit (*Swintorica floribunda*), dhup (*Canarium resiniferum*), champa (*Michelia champaca*), narkeli (*Pterygota alata*), chundul (*Tetrameles nudiflora*), bandarhola (*Duabanga sonneratioides*), kamdeb (*Callophylum polyanthum*), dhakijam (*Syzygium grande*), etc.

Common trees of moderate heights in the mid-stories are pitraj (*Aphanamixis polystachia*), chalmugra (*Hydnocarpus kurjii*), nageswar (*Mesua nagassarum*), gamar (*Gmelina arborea*),

chupalish (*Artocarpus chapalish*), jarul (*Lagerstroemia speciosa*), haritaki (*Terminalia chebula*), bahera (*Terminalia bellirica*), jalpai (*Elaeocarpus stectorius*), dumur (*Ficus ariculata*), bon sonalu (*Cassia nodosa*), mango (*Mangifera indica*), etc.

The top canopy species of the tropical semi-evergreen forests reach a height of 25-57 meters. Many of the evergreen as well as deciduous species are of in this type. The common evergreen to semi-evergreen species found in the canopy include: boilam (*Anisoptera scaphula*), telsur (*Hopea odorata*), kanak (*Schima wallicii*), assar (*Microcos paniculata*), barmala (*Callicarpus arborea*), kabita (*Gluta elegans*), sheora (*Streblus asper*), batana (*Quercus spp*), sindur (*Mallotus philippensis*), telya garjan (*Dipterocarpus turbinatus*), baittya garjan (*Dipterocarpus scaber*), etc.

The common deciduous species are simul (*Bombax ceiba*), bon-simul (*Bombax insignis*), hargoza (*Dillenia pentagyna*), toon (*Toona ciliata*), amloki (*Phyllanthus emblica*), bhadi (*Lannea coromandelica*), udal (*Sterculia spp*), kurchi (*Holarrhena antidysenterica*), barta (*Artocarpus lakoocha*), chapalish (*Artocarpus chapalish*), karoi (*Albizia procera*), etc.

The undergrowth is a tangle mass of shrubs with repetitive bamboo and cane brakes. Common species of bamboos found in these forests are mitenga (*Bambusa tulda*), muli (*Melocannus compactiflorus*), dolu (*Teinostachyum dullooa*), orah (*Dendrocalamus longispathus*), etc.

Different types of canes such as bandori (*Calamus tenuis*), karak (*Calamus jenkinsianus*), galak (*Daenonrops jenkinsianus*), jati (*Calamus giminalis*), etc. grown in the forest of the district.

The forest is also rich in various types of climbers, lianas and epiphytes consisting of orchids, ferns and mosses. Some soft and woody climbers like bon pan (*Piper spp*), bon pipul (*Piper rhytidocarpum*), kumarika (*Smilax spp*), gilla lata (*Entada pusaetha*) and kuki lata (*Spathobolus roxburghia*) grow in the forest.

Plants that grow in the swampy and semi-dried swampy areas and along chhars are chalta (*Dillenia indica*), pitali (*Trewia nudiflora*), sheora (*Streblus asper*), kanjal (*Bischofia javanica*), etc. Plants like patipata (*Clinogyne dichotoma*), nal khagra (*Phragmites karka*), lemna paucicostata, vallisneria spiralis, hydrilla verticillata, dalghash (*Hygrorhiza aristata*) also grow along the bank of marshy pools. Recently the government forest department has successfully introduced mehogony (*Swietenia macrophylla*), rubber, a good variety of cotton, etc. in these forests

The village homesteads are usually concealed by the dense and lush green foliage of a wide variety of trees, shrubs and thickets of bamboos and bananas. Different palm trees like date palm (*Phoenix sylvestris*), palmyra palm, betel nut (*Areca catechu*) and coconut (*Cocos nucifera*), palm (*Borassus flabellifer*) are commonly found in the vicinity of the village dwellings. Common road side trees are banyan (*Ficus benghalensis*), tamarind (*Tamarindus indica*), mango (*Mangifera indica*), debdaru (*Polyalthia longifolia*), jackfruit (*Artocarpus heterophyllus*), lichi (*Litchi chinensis*), wood apple (*Aegle marmelos*) and Indian plums.

The principal crops of the district are rice, pulses, vegetables, oil seeds, sugarcane and pan. Tea is grown on slope of hill ranges. Besides, some horticultural crops, lichis of Kalipura, guava of Kanchan nagar, water melons, etc. are also grown in this district.

Fauna

Mammals: Of the Carnivore, there are few species of Felidae. Small cats like chita biral (*Prionailurus bengalensis*), mechi bagh (*Prionailurus viverrinus*), sonali biral (*Felis remmencki*) and ban biral (*Felis chaus*) are relatively common in the forests of Chittagong, but the number of leopard (*Panthera pardus*) is becoming rarer.

Of primates, monkeys (*Macaca mullata*) are frequently seen. Of the Cervidae, the barking deer (*Muntiacus muntjak*) is fairly common in the forests but the large sambar (*Cervus unicolor*) is becoming rare. The wild boar (*Sus scrofa*) is frequently met with in these forests. Fox (*Vulpes bengalensis*), jackal (*Canis aureus*) and the common mongoose (*Herpestes edwardsi*) are also found.

A few species of bats including Indian pipistrelle (*Pipistrellus coromandra*) and different species of squirrels, rats, mice and porcupines are commonly seen. Gayal (*Bos sondaicus*) and bon chagol (*Capricornis summatraensis*) are rarely found. In the past, elephants (*Elephas maximus*) were found in the Chittagong sub-region. Some of the herds migrate into the higher mountains of Burma and India in the rainy season but others remain within Bangladesh. They are strictly protected by law. Kheda operations or the catching of elephants in stockades has been totally stopped.

Birds: The migrating bird fauna of Chittagong is one of the richest in Bangladesh. There are more than 350 residents and over 200 winter species of birds in this district. A large number of these are wet-country birds and are, therefore, confined to the forested areas of the district.

The common birds of the district include crow, sparrow (*Passer domesticus*), shalik (*Acridothera tristis*), black drongo (*Dicurus macrocercus*), redvented, bulbul (*Picnonotus cafer*) and the pariah kite. Nearly as common as these are the doel (*Cophychus saularis*), tailor bird (*Orthotomus sutorius*), pied moyna, common weaver bird, green bee-eater (*Merops orientalis*) and the common kingfisher (*Alcedo atthis*). Besides these, there are broad bills, parakeets, woodpecker (*Picus myrmecophonus*), barbets (*Glaucidium radiatum*) and cuckoos (*Cuculus micropterus*). Among slender billed birds, the sun birds and hoopoe (*Upupa epops*) are found while shrikes, king crows and Indian mocking bird are common. The babblers and laughing shrike thrushes are numerous as also bulbuls and orioles. There are many robins, stone chats and warblers including tailor bird. Among finches, the weaver bird, munia and waxbill are fairly numerous. The bush lark and various kinds of pigeons are also found. Rails, water hens (*Driolus xanthornus*), storks (*Ciconia ciconia*), herons, bitterns and ibis are seen here. The pheasant family includes the burmese peafowl and the black pheasant. Red jungle fowl (*Gallus gallus murghi*) is very common but partridges are rare. A separate quality of domestic cock is nourished in some households, which is called 'Aseel' and is used only for traditional fighting (Cock-fighting) in social occasions in the district.

A large number of migratory birds come to visit this area during winter. The bar headed geese, ruddy Sheldrake and a few teal and duck are met during the season. Shovellers, gad wall, pintail ducks and pochard are also found. The little grebe is common and one species of petrel is found.

Reptiles and Amphibians: There is a variety of reptiles in Chittagong. All the sea snakes are venomous. Among the land snakes, the great hamadryads and the python (*Python molurus*) are noticeable. Cobras (*Naja naja*) are not common. Amongst vipers the dabora and green rattlesnake are found. Lizards include the shouting gecko and some monitors locally called guishap (*Varanus salvator*). Turtles are fairly numerous. Amphibians like common toad, pond frog (*Bufo melanostictus*), Indian skipper frog and bullfrog are frequently seen.

Fishes: Chittagong waters, both inland and coastal, swarm with fish of various species and of different tastes. Sea fish are less tasteful than the sweet water fish. A great variety of fish and other aquatic animals are found in the coastal and inland waters of Chittagong district. Amongst the fresh water species of fish, major carps like ruhi or salmon (*Labeo Rohita*), mrigel (*Cirrhina mrigala*), kalbous (*Labeo calbasu*), katla or carp (*Catla catla*), etc. Shoel fish (*Channa striatus*), scorpion-fish or singi (*Heteropneustes fossilis*) are also found in large quantity in beels and khals. Many other species of river and fresh water fishes are also found in the district. Of these the principal varieties are boal (*Wallago attu*), dhain, chital (*Notopterus chitala*), ghona, airh (*Mystus aor*), bagair, pangas (*Pangasius pangasus*), rita (*Rita rita*), bain or eel (*Mastacembelus armatus*), chapila (*Gudusi chapra*), bhagna (*Labeo boga*), nandail, bacha (*Eutropichthys vacha*), pon, gargle (*Arius gagora*), kaulia, kapali, khorsols mehsir, gulsha (*Mystus bleekeri*), tengra (*Mystus vittatus*), chanda (*Mene mukulata*), tekchanda (*Gerres argyreus*), kachki (*Curica soborna*), baila (*Glossogobius giuris*), batashi (*Pseudotrapelus atherinoides*), kakila (*Strogylura strogylura*), phalli or flat fish (*Notopterus notopterus*), tatkeni (*Crosscheilus latius*), pabda (*Ompok pabda*), chela (*Chela cachius*), gangchela, gajar (*Channa marulius*), koi (*Anabas testudineus*), kholisha (*Colisa fasciatus*), puti (*Barbus punctatus*), sharputi (*Puntius sarana*), taki (*Channa punctatus*), walking fish (*Ophicephalus striatus*), malandi, bashpata (*Danio devario*), kakra (*Scylla serrata*), bheda or meani (*Nandus nandus*), shrimps and prawn (*Farfantetenaes fztacus*) are found in the district. However, some of these varieties, specially those which inhabit the marshes and tanks, are dwindling due to over catching and other reasons such as use of insecticides and pesticides for crop production, etc.

Besides the above, cartilaginous fishes like hangar or shark, magur (*Ophi cephalus*), shakush or sting ray, etc. are also available in the coastal water of the district. Some exotic varieties of fish like silver carp or silver carp (*Hypophthalmichthys molitrix*), mirror carp (*Cyprinus carpio*), tilapia (*Oreochromis mossambicus*), nilotica (*Oreochromis niloticus*), etc. that have been introduced in the country are also cultivated in Chittagong.

Concepts and Definitions

1. Population and Housing Census 2011

The population and housing census is the unique source of reliable and comprehensive data about the size of the population of the country, major socio-economic and socio-demographic characteristics.

It is the total process of collecting, compiling, evaluating, analyzing and publishing or otherwise disseminating demographic, economic and social data pertaining, at a specified time, to all persons in a country. The essential features of a population census are individual enumeration, universality within a defined territory, simultaneity and defined periodicity.

The population and housing census provides information on the geographic and administrative distribution of the population and household in addition to the demographic and socioeconomic characteristics of all the people in the country. The data from the census are classified, tabulated and disseminated so that political leaders, election officials, planners, national organizations including NGOs and civil society, regional and international organizations can use the data in decision-making.

The purpose of community report is to disseminate census data by communities (ward/mahalla in urban area and union/mauza/village in rural area). Data on all key variables namely area, household, population by sex and age group, ethnic population, literacy rate, marital status, school attendance, employment status and religion as well as physical facilities such as source of drinking water, sanitation, electricity and dwelling units have been presented in this report. The planners, researchers and policy makers as well as development partners and community administrators will find this report as a valuable reference for use in advising plans and programs for advancing welfare and well-being of the common people, in particular and the community in general.

Household

Persons, either related or unrelated, living together and taking food from the same kitchen constitute a household. A single person living and eating alone forms one-person household.

Literacy

It denotes ability to write a letter in any language. Literacy status assessment is made for population 7 years and over.

Community

It refers to the following five lower geographic, administrative or revenue units:

- i) **Union:** Smallest administrative rural geographic unit comprising of mauzas and villages and having union parishad institution.
- ii) **Mauza :** Mauza is the lowest administrative unit having a separate jurisdiction list number (J.L. No.) in revenue records. Every mauza has its well-demarcated cadastral map. Mauza should be distinguished from local village since a mauza may consist of one or more villages.
- iii) **Village:** Lowest rural geographic unit either equivalent to a mauza or part of a mauza.

iv) **Ward:** Smallest administrative urban geographic unit comprising of mahallas and having ward council institution.

v) **Mahalla:** Lowest urban geographic unit having identifiable boundaries.

Urban Area

It corresponds with area developed around a central place having such amenities as metalled roads, improved communication, electricity, gas, water supply, sewerage, sanitation and also having comparatively higher density of population with majority population in non-agricultural occupations.

i) **City Corporation:** It includes city corporation area declared by the Ministry of Local Government.

ii) **Paurashava/Municipality Area:** It includes paurashavas incorporated and administered by local government under Paurashava Ordinance, 1977.

2. Agriculture Census year and reference period

The census year extends over twelve consecutive months having for different census items the different reference periods or days of data collections. Some items have a year or week reference period. Some others have a specific reference day. The different census items by their reference periods or days are shown below:

Agriculture holding

An agriculture holding is a techno-economic unit of agricultural production under single management comprising all livestock kept and all land used wholly or partly for agricultural production purposes without regard to title, legal form or size. Single management may be exercised by either an individual holder or jointly by two or more individuals or holders or by a judicial person such as a corporation, co-operative or government agency. A holding may consist of one or more parcels (fragments of land) located in one or more areas or mauzas or in more than one administrative unit or division provided that all separate parcels of fragments form parts of same technical unit under operational control of same management.

The definition covers practically all holdings/households engaged in agricultural production of both crops and livestock. Some agriculture holdings may have no significant agricultural land, e.g. holdings keeping livestock, poultry and hatcheries for which land is not an indispensable input for production.

Farm holding

A farm holding is defined as being an agricultural production unit having cultivated land equal to or more than 0.05 acres. Farm holdings are classified into following three broad groups:

(a) **small:** Farm holdings having minimum cultivated land 0.05 acre but operated land more than this minimum but upto 2.49 acres.

(b) **medium:** Farm holdings having operated land in between 2.50 to 7.49 acres.

(c) **large:** Farm holdings having operated land 7.50 acres and above.

Small cultivated land 0.04 acre or less is generally used for kitchen garden growing mainly vegetables. Often seeds of white gourd, water gourd, pumpkin and other strains are sown on households; but these creepers spread out around house roofs and other structures. As such, the minimum cultivated land considered for qualifying to be a farm holding is 0.05 acres.

Non-farm holdings

A non-farm holding is defined as being the one which has neither cultivated nor operated land or has cultivated land less than 0.05 acre.

Tenancy

Owner holdings are those having and operating their owned land and who may or may not be leasing out land.

Tenant holdings are those having no owned land but operating land taken from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Owner-cum-tenant holdings are those having owned land and who may or may not be leasing out their own land to others and who may be taking land from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Agriculture work

Agriculture work signifies all activities of holder and his/her labour force doing planning, management, and operation of a holding. It includes land preparation, sowing, weeding, harvesting, feeding and tending livestock & poultry, kitchen gardening, supervising agricultural workers, keeping farm records & accounts, preparing agriculture products for marketing (including packaging), repairing farm equipment, constructing farm buildings & fences, and engaging in land reclamation and improvement and other related activities. It excludes home and other family domestic chores.

Area under pond

The pond area remains under water almost through out the year. Normally, households use pond water for various domestic and sometimes agriculture purposes. Ponds are also generally used for fish culture.

In the census the pond area data were collected separately for both single ownership and joint ownership of households.

Area under permanent crops

It is the land area planted to crops which remain standing for a long period of time and do not need to be replanted after a seasonal harvest. Mango, jackfruit, coconut, guava, lemon, and other fruit varieties are all permanent crops.

Current fallow

It is land brought into cultivation but left out uncultivated in census year for fertility regaining and improvement or for other reasons.

Net cultivated area

This is land area actually cropped during the census year regardless of number of crops grown plus current fallow. It includes areas under temporary and permanent crops and also current fallow.

Permanent fallow

It is land not available for cultivation due to coming into residence and commercial & other uses. Play ground, graveyard, wild shrubs and jungles, marshy land, and the like fall in this category.

Irrigated area

This is area of total land brought under irrigation coverage for growing crops with irrigations done through mechanical or manual means. Irrigated area classifications fall into two categories: (1) surface water irrigation with main water sources being rivers, canals, beels, ponds, and other water bodies; and (2) underground water irrigation with water lifted by shallow tube-wells, deep tube-wells, and country traditional devices. The irrigation equipments are run by electricity, diesel or petrol, or manual labour.

Temporary crops gross area

Areas aggregated for all temporary crops grown in the census year have made **temporary crops gross area** greater than **temporary crops net area** since the latter has within it the same land cropped more than once in different seasons of a year.

Intensity of cropping

It is percentage of temporary crops gross area in comparison with temporary crops net area. It is expressed as follows:

$$\text{Intensity of cropping} = \frac{\text{Temporary crops gross area}}{\text{Temporary crops net area}} \times 100$$

Cereals

Main cereals are rice and then wheat. Other cereals are jab, barley, cheena, maize, kaun, bajra and joar.

Pulses

Main and common pulses are gram, mung, lentil, arhar, gari kalai, khesari and pea.

Oil seeds

Main oil seeds are rape and mustard, sesamum, linseed, groundnut, soybean, sunflower and castor.

Vegetables

Farmers grow both summer and winter vegetables. Main vegetables are potato, brinjal, raddish, arum, lady's finger, cauliflower, cabbage, bean, tomato, patal, gourd, cucumber, pumpkin, knoll-kal-turnip, dhundal, barbati, khirai, chichinga, carrot, kakrol and sak.

Cash crop

Main cash crops are jute, mesta, sunhemp, cotton, sugarcane and tobacco.

Spices

The main spices include turmeric, ginger, chillies, onion, garlic, corriander, black cumin and ani seed.

Fuel crops

Dhaincha and other smaller plants used as cooking-fuel.
