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
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District Map

CHAPTER 1

Introduction

District at a Glance

Background, Area and Location: Gopalganj was a sub-division of former Faridpur district. It was up-graded to a district on the 1st February, 1984. The original name of the district was Rajganj. In 1793, the local Zamindar renamed Rajgang to Gopalganj after the name his grandson who was popularly known as Gopal. Gopalganj is bounded on the north by Faridpur district, on the east by Madaripur and Barisal districts, on the south by Pirojpur and Bagerhat districts and on the west by Narail district. It lies between 22°50' and 23°01' north latitudes and between 89°40' and 90°02' east longitudes. The total area of the district is 1,468.74 sq. km. (567.08 sq. miles).

Temperature and Rainfall: The maximum and minimum average temperature in Gopalganj district varies from 23.3°C to 8.6°C. Total rainfall of the district is recorded as 1620 mm.

Administration: Gopalganj district was established in 1984. Earlier it was a sub-division under Faridpur district. Gopalganj municipality was established in 1972. The total area of the district headquarters' town is 8.59 sq km. The district consists of 5 upazilas, 68 unions, 618 mauzas, 889 villages, 4 paurashavas, 36 wards and 84 mahallas. The upazilas are Gopalganj Sadar, Kashiani, Kotalipara, Muksudpur and Tungipara.

Historical Events: A battle between Babor (the Mughal Emperor) and Nusrat Shah (Sultan of Bengal) was held on the bank of the river Ghargara (presently known as Ghagar). **Fakir Sannyasi Resistance** took place in the region during the early part of the British rule. Mr. Dharendra Nath Bishwas of Kotalipara was killed in Anti British Movement and Mr. Mahananda Bishwas Jalilpar was killed during the mass upsurge of 1969.

Historical Place: The Mazar (graveyard) of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman, the father of the nation, is located at Tungipara, upazila of Gopalganj district.

Famous Personalities of the District: Gopalganj is the motherland of so many illustrious and noble personalities of which the great leader, the father of the nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman is the heroic son of this soil. His long cherished dream of independence came into existence with the emergence of Bangladesh as an independent state in 1971. He was the first President and later on, Prime Minister of the new born Bangladesh. Honourable Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina, daughter of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman, was born in this district.

Marks of the War of Liberation: There are two mass graves, one mass killing site, two memorial monuments in Gopalganj district.

Population: Total population of Gopalganj district is 1172415 persons of which male is 577868 and female is 594547.

Literacy: Literacy rate of Gopalganj district is total 58.1%, male 60.3% and female 56.0%.

Main Rivers: The Garai, the Madhumati, the Kaliganga and the Ghagar are the notable rivers of Gopalganj district.

Main Crops: Paddy, jute, sugarcane and ground nut are the main crops of Gopalganj district.

Main Fruits: Mango, black berry, palm, banana are the main fruits of Gopalganj district.

Economic Situation: The economy of Gopalganj is predominantly agricultural. Out of total 230494 holdings of the district, 67.88 holdings are farms that produce varieties of crops namely local and HYV paddy, sugarcane, wheat, vegetables, spices, jute, pulses, and other minor cereals.

Various fruits like mango, banana, jackfruit, guava, coconut etc. are grown in the district. Almost all kinds of vegetables are cultivated particularly; bitter guard (karala), pumpkin (misti kumra), potato and brinjal are abundantly grown. Pisciculture and rearing of livestock and poultry adds an additional income to the rural households. Fish of different varieties abounds in the district. Moreover, varieties of fish are caught from rivers, tributary channels, even from paddy field during the rainy season.

Non-farm activities also play an important role in the economic development of Gopalganj district. The following Table: 1 shows total establishments both in the urban and rural areas and person engaged by sex and activity in Gopalganj district.

According to the table, there are 27,343 establishments in the district of which 59,975 persons are engaged in different types of non-farm activities. Female participation in non-farm activities is very poor. They constitute about 8.59% as against 91.41% of the males. Wholesale & retail trade emerges as the single largest activity (50.96%) with 13,935 establishments and 24,964 person engaged (41.62%) in the establishments.

Gopalganj district with fertile land falls in the Gangetic basin land area and is very rich in respect of flora and fauna. The district faces flood during the monsoon almost regularly. Its impact is however very much felt in the flora and fauna of the district.

Flora: In the farmlands, varieties of crops namely local and HYV rice, jute, vegetables, spices, pulses, oilseeds, cotton, sugarcane etc. are produced. Rice covers about 71.15 percent of the gross temporary cropped area. The district is also famous for good quality of jute and sugarcane.

Although there is no organized forest area in the district, the plain land is mostly covered under homestead forests containing varieties of fruit trees and other trees. The southern part of the district is comparatively low lying area where one can find homestead forests with luxuriant growth. Those contain indigenous timber trees like karoi (*Albizia procera*), haldu, bazna (*Zanthophyllum*

flavescens), karobi, sheora (*Streblus asper*), margazaj, mehogoni (*Swietenia macrophylla*), jalpai (*Elaeocarpus tectorius*), bohera (*Terminalia bellirica*), amloki (*Phyllanthus emblica*), etc. However all these trees are scattered.

Mango (*Mangifera indica*), betel nut (*Areca catechu*), jack fruit (*Artocarpus heterophyllus*), jam (*Eugenia jambolanavav*), banana (*Musa sapientum*), coconut (*Cocos nucifera*), litchi (*Litchi chinensis*), blackberry (*Syzygium cumini*), papaya (*Carica papaya*), jambura (*Citrus decumana*), lime, palm (*Borassus flabellifer*), citrus fruits, melon etc. are among common fruits found in this district. Besides, trees found in this district are gab (*Diospyros precatorius*), haritaki (*Terminalia chebula*), keora (*Sonneratia apetala*), sonali (*Cassia fistula*), etc. Marsh plants and weeds are found in great variety and luxuriance and in the beel area, the surface of the marshes are covered with huge stretches of inundated rice or with mottled floating islets of sedges and grasses and with various water-lilies, the striking of which is the makana (*Eurale ferox*). They are made in to closely woven mats, while the reed called hogla is used for roofing huts.

Lotus and blue green algea and other living organism are also seen in the district. Almond, banyan (*Ficus benghalensis*), jam (*Eugenia jambolanavav*), tamarind or tetul (*Tamarindus indica*), bel (*Aegle marmelos*), kamranga (*Averrhoa karambola*), dumur (*Ficus hispida*), and some other varieties are found in this district.

The chief species of palm are the date palm (*Phoenix sylvestris*) and the betel-nut (*Areca catechu*). Date-palms are rarely grown in plantations, but usually on the embankments of the fields. Clumps of bamboos are found everywhere. Medicinal plants include balola (*Acacia*), madar (*Erythrina ovalifolia*), bhat (*Caleroendrom*), haritaki (*Terminalia chebula*), chireta (*Swertia chirita*), dhuteira (*Datura metel*), etc are also found.

Fauna: Gopalganj district has a rich diversity of land invertebrate mammals, amphibian birds, reptiles and fresh water animals, spiders, multipedes and innumerable insects. Leeches, earthworm slugs, snails, silk moths are commonly found in the district.

Mammals: The mammalian fauna that are usually seen in the district of Gopalganj comprise domestic cow (*Bos pourus*), goat (*Capra lircus*), sheep, buffalo and horses (*Equus cabollus*). The wild buffalo was once used to be found in the district. Domestic cow, goat, sheep, buffalo and horses are quite common in the district. Carnivorous animals are also found include fox (*Vulpes bengalensis*), dog, bear (*Ursus thibetanus*), boar (*Sus scrofa*), etc.

Birds: Many kinds of colorful and singing birds are seen in the district include the national bird robin magpie (*Copsychus saularis*), shalik (*Acreidotheres tristis*), kokil (*Cuculus micropterus*), halde pakhi (*Oriolus xanthornus*), king crow (*Dicrurus adsimilis*), moyna (*Sturnus malabarica*), shama (*Copsychus malabaricus*), sparrow (*Passer domesticus*), several species of pheasants, quails, pigeons (*Treron phoenicoptera*) and doves (*Streptopela*), duck (*Cairina sentulata*), gees, balihash (*Nettapus coromandelianus*), cocks, and hens, kingfisher (*Alcedo atthis*), lark, swallow, crow (*Corvus splendens*), crane, pelicans, woodpecker (*Picus myrmecophoneus*), and many other varieties of small birds. Raptoral birds include king vulture (*Trogos calvus*), laner falcon or baj (*Falco biarmicus*), gochila (*Circus aeruginosus*), cheel (*Milvus migrans*), several species of stork are found. Some migratory birds like greenleg goose (*Anser anser*), rajhans (*Anser indicus*), pitail (*Anas acuta*) etc. are also seen during winter season.

Fish: With large water area the district is well stocked with fish. Some of the commonly available fishes are ruhi or salmon (*Labeo rohita*), mrigal (*Cirrhinus mrigala*), kalbous (*Labeo*), katla or carp (*Catla catla*), etc. soal fish (*Chann striatus*), scorpion-fish or singi (*Heteropneustes fossilis*) are also found in large quantity in beels and khals, Many other species of fishes are also found in the river and fresh water of the district. Of these the principal varieties are boal/sheat fish (*Wallago attu*), koral (*Latas ealcarifer*), tapsi (*Polynemus paradiseus*), dhain, chital (*Notopterus chitala*), ghona, airh (*Mystas aor*), bagair (*Bagarius yarrellii*), pangas (*Pangasius pangasius*), rita (*Rita rita*), bain or eel (*Mastacembelus armatus*), chapila (*Gudusia chapra*), bhagna (*Labeo boga*), golhsa (*Mystas bleekeri*), tengra (*Mystus vittatus*), chanda (*Mene muculata*), tekchanda (*Gerres argyreus*), kachki (*Corica soborna*), baila (*Glossogobius giuris*), bheda (*Pseudoutropius atherinoides*), gausa, kakila (*Strogylura strogylura*), phalli or flat fish (*Notopterus notopterus*), tatkeni (*Crosscheilus latius*), pabda (*Ompok bimaculatus*), chela (*Chela cachius*), gangchela, gazar (*Channa marulius*), koi or climbing fish (*Anabas testudineus*), kholisha (*Colisa fasciatus*), puti (*Barbus puntius*), sharputi (*Puntius sarana*), taki (*Channa punctatus*), walking fish (*Ophicephalus striatus*), malandi, bashpata (*Danio devario*), kakra (*Scylla serrata*), meani, shrimps, and prawn are found in the district. However, some of these varieties, specially those which inhabit the marshes and tanks, are dwindling due to over catching and other reasons such as use of insecticides and pesticides for crop production, etc.

In addition, some exotic varieties of fish such as telapia (*Oreochromis mossambicus*), nilotica (*Oreochromis niloticus*), and grass carp (*Ctenopharyngodon idella*) are also cultivated in the district and they are also becoming very popular.

Reptiles and Amphibians: The district contains in its area few species of reptiles and amphibians. The reptiles include different species snakes, lizard, and tortoises (*Trinix hurum*), iguana, python, cobra (*Naja naja*) and other varieties of poisonous snakes are found almost all over the district. The amphibians consist of toad, frogs (*Bufo melanostictus*) and tree frogs (*Rhacophorus maculatus*).

Concepts and Definitions

Population and Housing Census 2011

The population and housing census is the unique source of reliable and comprehensive data about the size of the population of the country, major socio-economic and socio-demographic characteristics.

It is the total process of collecting, compiling, evaluating, analyzing and publishing or otherwise disseminating demographic, economic and social data pertaining, at a specified time, to all persons in a country. The essential features of a population census are individual enumeration, universality within a defined territory, simultaneity and defined periodicity.

The population and housing census provides information on the geographic and administrative distribution of the population and household in addition to the demographic and socioeconomic characteristics of all the people in the country. The data from the census are classified, tabulated and disseminated so that political leaders, election officials, planners, national organizations including NGOs and civil society, regional and international organizations can use the data in decision-making.

The purpose of community report is to disseminate census data by communities (ward/mahalla in urban area and union/mauza/village in rural area). Data on all key variables namely area, household, population by sex and age group, ethnic population, literacy rate, marital status, school attendance, employment status and religion as well as physical facilities such as source of drinking water, sanitation, electricity and dwelling Number of unit have been presented in this report. The planners, researchers and policy makers as well as development partners and community administrators will find this report as a valuable reference for use in advising plans and programs for advancing welfare and well-being of the common people, in particular and the community in general.

Household

Persons, either related or unrelated, living together and taking food from the same kitchen constitute a household. A single person living and eating alone forms one-person household.

Literacy

It denotes ability to write a letter in any language. Literacy status assessment is made for population 7 years and over.

Community

It refers to the following five lower geographic, administrative or revenue Number of unit:

- i) **Union:** Smallest administrative rural geographic unit comprising of mauzas and villages and having union parishad institution.
- ii) **Mauza:** Mauza is the lowest administrative unit having a separate jurisdiction list number (J.L. No.) in revenue records. Every mauza has its well-demarcated cadastral map. Mauza should be distinguished from local village since a mauza may consist of one or more villages.
- iii) **Village:** Lowest rural geographic unit either equivalent to a mauza or part of a mauza.

iv) **Ward:** Smallest administrative urban geographic unit comprising of mahallas and having ward council institution.

v) **Mahalla:** Lowest urban geographic unit having identifiable boundaries.

Urban Area

It corresponds with area developed around a central place having such amenities as metalled roads, improved communication, electricity, gas, water supply, sewerage, sanitation and also having comparatively higher density of population with majority population in non-agricultural occupations.

i) **City Corporation:** It includes city corporation area declared by the Ministry of Local Government.

ii) **Paurashava/Municipality Area:** It includes paurashavas incorporated and administered by local government under Paurashava Ordinance, 1977.

Agriculture holding

An agriculture holding is a techno-economic unit of agricultural production under single management comprising all livestock kept and all land used wholly or partly for agricultural production purposes without regard to title, legal form or size. Single management may be exercised by either an individual holder or jointly by two or more individuals or holders or by a judicial person such as a corporation, co-operative or government agency. A holding may consist of one or more parcels (fragments of land) located in one or more areas or mauzas or in more than one administrative unit or division provided that all separate parcels of fragments form parts of same technical unit under operational control of same management.

The definition covers practically all holdings/households engaged in agricultural production of both crops and livestock. Some agriculture holdings may have no significant agricultural land, e.g. holdings keeping livestock, poultry and hatcheries for which land is not an indispensable input for production.

Farm holding

A farm holding is defined as being an agricultural production unit having cultivated land equal to or more than 0.05 acres. Farm holdings are classified into following three broad groups:

(a) **small:** Farm holdings having minimum cultivated land 0.05 acre but operated land more than this minimum but upto 2.49 acres.

(b) **medium:** Farm holdings having operated land in between 2.50 to 7.49 acres.

(c) **large:** Farm holdings having operated land 7.50 acres and above.

Small cultivated land 0.04 acre or less is generally used for kitchen garden growing mainly vegetables. Often seeds of white gourd, water gourd, pumpkin and other strains are sown on households; but these creepers spread out around house roofs and other structures. As such, the minimum cultivated land considered for qualifying to be a farm holding is 0.05 acres.

Non-farm holdings

A non-farm holding is defined as being the one which has neither cultivated nor operated land or has cultivated land less than 0.05 acre.

Tenancy

Owner holdings are those having and operating their owned land and who may or may not be leasing out land.

Tenant holdings are those having no owned land but operating land taken from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Owner-cum-tenant holdings are those having owned land and who may or may not be leasing out their own land to others and who may be taking land from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Agriculture work

Agriculture work signifies all activities of holder and his/her labour force doing planning, management, and operation of a holding. It includes land preparation, sowing, weeding, harvesting, feeding and tending livestock & poultry, kitchen gardening, supervising agricultural workers, keeping farm records & accounts, preparing agriculture products for marketing (including packaging), repairing farm equipment, constructing farm buildings & fences, and engaging in land reclamation and improvement and other related activities. It excludes home and other family domestic chores.

Area under pond

The pond area remains under water almost through out the year. Normally, households use pond water for various domestic and sometimes agriculture purposes. Ponds are also generally used for fish culture.

In the census the pond area data were collected separately for both single ownership and joint ownership of households.

Area under temporary crops

It is the land area planted to crops having growing cycle or length of life less than one year. These are the temporary crops such as paddy, wheat, jute, cotton, tobacco, sugarcane, pulses, oil seeds, potato, vegetables and other seasonal crops. A list of temporary crops for which data were collected separately was given in back page of "Tally Sheet". The minimum area recorded for a temporary crop was 0.01 acre. Area under temporary crops and temporary-crops net area are equivalents.

Area under permanent crops

It is the land area planted to **crops** which remain standing for a long period of time and do not need to be replanted after a seasonal harvest. Mango, jackfruit, coconut, guava, lemon, and other fruit varieties are all permanent crops.

Current fallow

It is land brought into cultivation but left out uncultivated in census year for fertility regaining and improvement or for other reasons.

Net cultivated area

This is land area actually cropped during the census year regardless of number of crops grown plus current fallow. It includes areas under temporary and permanent crops and also current fallow.

Permanent fallow

It is land not available for cultivation due to coming into residence and commercial & other uses. Play ground, graveyard, wild shrubs and jungles, marshy land, and the like fall in this category.

Irrigated area

This is area of total land brought under irrigation coverage for growing crops with irrigations done through mechanical or manual means. Irrigated area classifications fall into two categories: (1) surface water irrigation with main water sources being rivers, canals, beels, ponds, and other water bodies; and (2) underground water irrigation with water lifted by shallow tube-wells, deep tube-wells, and country traditional devices. The irrigation equipments are run by electricity, diesel or petrol, or manual labour.

Temporary crops gross area

Areas aggregated for all temporary crops grown in the census year have made **temporary crops gross area** greater than **temporary crops net area** since the latter has within it the same land cropped more than once in different seasons of a year.

Intensity of cropping

It is percentage of temporary crops gross area in comparison with temporary crops net area. It is expressed as follows:

$$\text{Intensity of cropping} = \frac{\text{Temporary crops gross area}}{\text{Temporary crops net area}} \times 100$$

Cereals

Main cereals are rice and then wheat. Other cereals are jab, barley, cheena, maize, kaun, bajra and joar.

Pulses

Main and common pulses are gram, mung, lentil, arhar, gari kalai, khesari and pea.

Oil seeds

Main oil seeds are rape and mustard, sesamum, linseed, groundnut, soybean, sunflower and castor.

Vegetables

Farmers grow both summer and winter vegetables. Main vegetables are potato, brinjal, raddish, arum, lady's finger, cauliflower, cabbage, bean, tomato, patal, gourd, cucumber, pumpkin, knoll-kal-turnip, dhundal, barbati, khirai, chichinga, carrot, kakrol and sak.

Cash crop

Main cash crops are jute, mesta, sunhemp, cotton, sugarcane and tobacco.

Spices

The main spices include turmeric, ginger, chillies, onion, garlic, coriander, black cumin and ani seed.

Fuel crops

Dhaincha and other smaller plants used as cooking-fuel are included in the group.
