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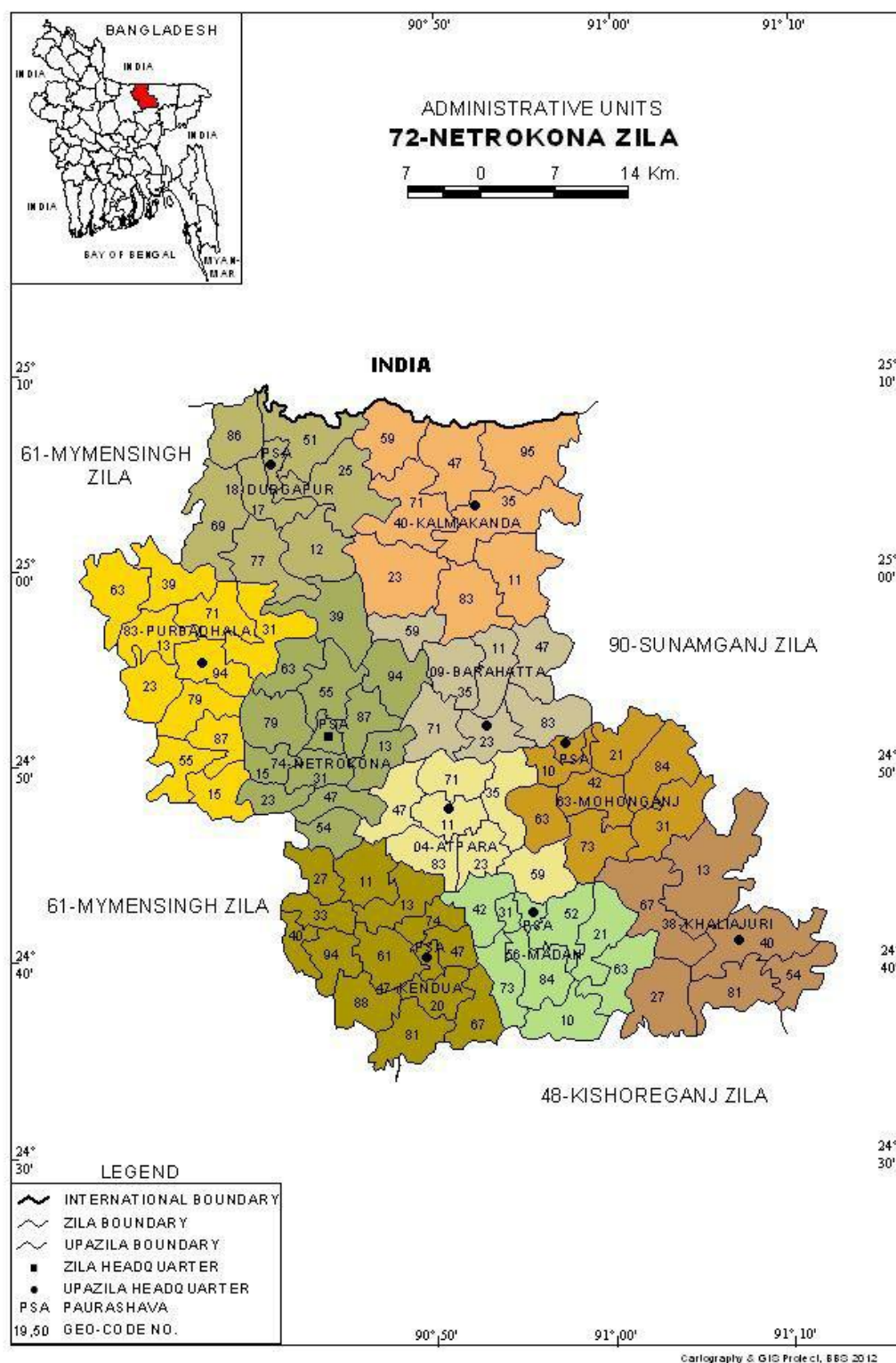
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District Map

CHAPTER 1

Introduction

District at a Glance

Background, Geographic Area and Location: Netrokona was one of the subdivisions of former Mymensingh Zila. Netrokona subdivision was established in 1882 and was turned into a district on 1st February, 1984. The district is bounded on the north by Garo Hills of Meghalaya (India), on the east by Sunamganj district, on the south by Kishoreganj district and on the west by Mymensingh district. The total area of the district is 2794.28 sq.km.(1078.87 sq.mile) of which 9.17sq.km. is under forest. The district lies between 24°34" and 25°12" north latitudes and between 90°00" and 91°07" east longitudes.

Administration:Netrokona district consists of 10 upazilas, 86 unions, 1537 mauzas, 2282 villages, 5 paurashavas, 45 wards and 140 mahallas.The upazilas are Atpara, Barhatta, Durgapur, Khaliajuri, Kalmakanda, Kendua, Madan, Mohanganj, Netrokona Sadar and Purbadhala.The paurashavas are Barhatta, Durgapur, Kendua, Mohanganj and Netrokona.

Annual Average Temperature: The annual average temperature of this district varies from maximum 33.3°C to minimum 12°C. The annual average rainfall is 2174 mm.

Historical Events: Peasant Revolt, Pagalpanthi Revolt, Tonk and Tebhaga Movements took place in the district during the British rule. The leaders of the Swadeshi Movement killed Balak Saha of Borail Village in 1913 and Zamindar Mallick Bahadur of e Sahildeo Village in 1930 and looted their wealth. The three day All India Peasant Conference was held in Nagara of the district head quarters in 1945.

Main Rivers: The Someshwari, Kangsha, Magra, Dhanu, Dhala and Teorkhali are main rivers of this district.

Archaeological Heritage and Relics: Roail Bari Fort at Kendua, Khoja Dighee, Palace of Maharaja at Susang Durgapur, Dighee of Kamol Rani, and Buddhist Math at Krishnapur of Atpara etc. are notable archaeological heritage and relics of this district.

Educational Institutions: The numbers of educational institution of this district are government college 2, non-government college 31, government high school 6, non-government high school 239, madrasah 88, government primary school 629, registered primary school 504, non-registered primary school 84, primary teacher's training institute 2, law college 1, nursing institute 1, Sanskrit college 1, homeopathy college 1, technical institute 1 and music school 2.

Cultural Organizations: The numbers of cultural organizations of this district are public library 6, theatre group 5, opera party 7, circus party 1, literary society 6, women's organisation 4, cinema hall 11, auditorium 2, shilpakala academy 1, tribal cultural academy 1, cultural institutions 76 and sports organisation 43.

Main Crops: Paddy, jute, wheat, mustard seed potato etc. are main crops of this district.

Main Fruits: Jackfruit, mango, banana, lemon, coconut, papaya, palm etc. are main fruits of this district.

NGO Activities: Operationally important NGOs are CARE, BRAC, Grameen Bank, ASA, Concern Bangladesh, Swabalambi, Nari Pragati Sangha, SCI etc.

Health Centres: The numbers of health centres of this district are Modern hospital 1, upazila health complex 10, maternity hospital 1, health and family welfare centre 69, leprosy and tuberculosis hospital 1, eye hospital 1, diabetic hospital 1, red crescent hospital 1, heart foundation 1, family health services clinic 1, nursing home 1 and mission hospital 1.

Economic Situation: The economy of Netrakona is predominantly agricultural. Out of total 458,472 holdings of the district, 61.65 % are agriculture farm holdings that produce varieties of crops, namely, local and HYV rice, wheat, vegetables, spices, cash crops, pulses, and others. Various fruits like banana, betel nut, guava, coconut are also grown. Fish of different varieties abound in the district. Varieties of fish are caught from rivers, channel and creeks and from paddy fields during rainy season. Catching fish is an important source of income to the fishermen, especially in haor areas.

Non-farm activities also play important role in economic development of this district. The following table-1 shows total establishments in the urban and rural areas and persons engaged by sex and activity in Netrakona.

The table shows there are 44,292 establishments in the district in which 102,838 persons are engaged in different types of non-farm activities. The participation of women in non-farm activities is very low. They comprise only 6.85% while the share of males is 93.15%. Wholesale & retail trade constitute the single largest activity (56.62%) with 25,078 establishments and 48,967 persons engaged (47.62%) in the establishment.

Flora and Fauna

Flora: Flora means a catalogue of all plants and trees growing in a country or in a specified part thereof. Netrakona district borders Garo Hills of India on the north and the biggest haor area of Sunamganj district on the east and as such a large variety of heterogeneous plants and trees grow in the district.

Among the important trees, some of which are important for timber, are the gazari (*Shorea robusta*), banyan (*Ficus benghalensis*), tamarind (*Tamarindus indica*), karoi (*Albizia procera*), simul (*Bombax ceiba*) and aswatha (*Ficus religiosa*).

The main fruit trees of the district are the mango (*Mangifera indica*), jackfruits (*Artocarpus heterophyllus*), litchi (*Litchi chinensis*), tamarind (*Tamarindus indica*), peach (*Prunus persica*), guava (*Psidium guajava*), limon (*Citrus carantifolia*), pomelo (*Citrus decumana*), plantains (*Musa sapientum*),

Pineapples (*Ananas comosus*), custard apple (*Anona squamosa*), nona (*Anona reticulata*), wood apple (*Aegle marmelos*), papaw and various kinds of plums which grow practically wild. Among the fruits, the most important are certainly the plantain and the jack-fruit. Both are among the chief commodities at every bazar and the latter is so prolific and grows to such an immense size that it forms a staple article of diet with the poorer people.

A very useful tree is the coconut (*Cocos nucifera*), the shell of the fruit is used for hookah, bowls and the fiber for mats coir, mattresses and for many other purposes. Coconut oil is the valuable product of the kernel. Betel-nut (*Areca catechu*) is more common than the Coconut. Its trunk is remarkable for its extreme slenderness and straightness. Date-palm (*Phoenix sylvestris*) is another common tree. Parts of this tree are used for many purposes, but the fruit is hardly edible and this palm is chiefly cultivated for juice which is made into sugar. Palmyra palm (*Borassus flabelliformis*) is useful for its juice and fruit. Its trunk is used for house building purposes.

In addition to the gazari and the mango, the other trees used for timber are: jarul (*Lagerstroemia speciosa*), rangi, karoi (*Albizia procera*), ajuli (*Dillenia pentagyna*), jack-fruit (*Artocarpus heterophyllus*), jarn and roya. The chambal and the sisso (*Dalbergia sissoo*) grow on small scale in the district and are used for doorframes. The gab tree is a common one. It bears a rough fruit normally used for caulking the seams of boats. The simul or cotton (*Bombax ceiba*) tree is common all over the district. It is widely used for making tea boxes. Nearly all the common vegetables grow splendidly in the cold weather. Tomatoes, cabbages, beans, etc continues till quite late in April. The main indigenous vegetables are melons, brinjals, gourds, pumpkins and arums.

The bamboo and the cane (bet) are good examples of the complex uses to which the commonest flora of the district can be put, but the palms are equally adaptable from the economic point of view.

In addition to all the plants used mainly for medicinal purposes, doctors extract remedies for common diseases from the bark and roots of the mango (*Mangifera indica*), tulsi (*Ocimum americanum*), simul (*Bombax ceiba*) and other generally useful trees. The wood apple (*Aegle marmelos*), gab (*Diospyros precatorius*) and babul (*Acacia arabica*) trees provide gum, the seeds of the tamarind yield oil, which is used in painting idols, and the bark of the guava is used for tanning. Scent is manufactured from the keora (*Sonneratia apetala*), a plant rather like the pineapple (*Ananas comosus*), which grows in most busti jungle.

Fauna: In the middle of nineteenth century, the chars in the north- west of the district had as many tigers as in any other district of the sub-continent and that rhinoceros had occasionally been shot. Tigers are not found at present even at the foot of the Garo Hills. Wild elephant used to play havoc in the northern villages in the middle of twentieth century. But the elephants are not seen now-a-days. Similar is the case with the buffaloes.

The pig is seldom to be found. Among the smaller animals, the mongoose and civet cat are very common. Hares (*Lepus nigricollis*) as well as foxes (*Vulpes bengalensis*) and jackals (*Canis aurues*) can be seen on an open char. The black rabbit (*lepus hespidus*) are also seen in some area of the district.

Birds: The game birds are mainly the red jungle fowl, which can be seen feeding in the evenings at the foot of the Garo Hills in parties of ten or more. Quails occur in small numbers in many scattered parts of the district. The blue breasted quail (*excalfactoria chinensis*) and gray quail (*columix communis*) are sometimes met with in patches of grass jungle, feeding in the recently cut paddy fields at the foot of the hills. Other birds which occur only can be seen near hills are the swam patridge or kaya (*Francolinus gularis*), the black breasted kalij or pheasant known as durug among Garos and mathura among Bengali shikaris and the rare wood snipe. On the chars of big rivers, there are all varieties of ducks, including the rare shaldrake (*Tadorna cornuta*), but they are harder to approach. The bar headed goose (*Anser indicus*) arrives about the first week of November and departs at the end of February. Besides these, the other birds of the district include bulbul (*Picnonotus cafer*), oriole, white eyed tit, brown backed tit, babbler, yellow breasted wren babbler, the common babbler or seven sisters, tailor bird (*Orthotomus sutorius*), crow (*Corvus splendens*), magpie (*Copsychus saularis*), moyna (*Sturnus malabarica*), shrike, koel (*Eudynamis scolopacea*), cuckoo (*Culculus microplerus*), canary, fly-catcher (*Anthus rufulus*), wood peaker (*Picus myrmrcophoneus*), common barbet, king fisher (*Alcedo atthis*), owl (*Bubo zeylenensis*), osprey, vulture (*Gyps bengalensis*), eagle (*Spilornis cheela*), pigeon (*Treron phoenioplora*) and dove (*Streptopelia tranquebarica*).

Reptiles and Amphibians: There are different varieties of poisonous snakes such as the krait (*Bungarus fasciatus*) and poisonous water snakes, Cobra (*Naja naja*) is rarely found in the district. Pythons are not unknown. Lizards and guisaps (*Varanus salvator*) of all sizes inhabit in patches of jungle even in the towns.

Fishes: Most of the rivers and beels abound in fish. With the drop of rains fishing starts in every paddy field and ditch. Some of the commonly available fishes are ruhi or salmon (*Labeo rohita*), mrigel (*Cirrhinus mrigala*), kalbous (*Labeo calbasu*), katla or carp (*Catla catla*), etc. Shoel fish (*Channa striatus*), scorpion-fish or singi (*Heteropneuster fossilis*) are also found in large quantity in beels and khals. Many other species of river and fresh water fishes are also found in the district. Of these the principal varieties are boal/sheat fish (*Wallago attu*), dhain, chital (*Notopterus chitala*), ghona, airh (*Mystas aor*), bagair, pangas (*Pangasius pangasius*), rita (*Rita rita*), bain or eel (*Mastacembelus armatus*), chapila (*Gudusia chapra*), bhagna (*Labeo boga*), nandail bacha, pon, gargle (*Arius gagora*), kaulia, kapali, khorsols mehsir, golsa (*Mystus bleekeri*), tengra (*Mystus vittatus*), chanda (*Mene muculata*) tekchanda (*Gerres argyreus*), kachki (*Corica soborna*), baila (*Glossogobius giuris*), bheda (*Nandus nandus*), batashi (*Pseudotropius atherinoides*), gulsha (*Mystus bleekeri*), kakila (*Strogylura strogylura*), phalli or flat fish (*Notopterus notoppterus*), tatkeni (*Crosscheilus latius*), pabda or butter fish (*Ompok pabda*), chela (*Chela cachius*), gangchela, gazar (*Channa marulius*), koi or climbing fish (*Anabas testudineus*) kholisha (*Colisa*

fasciatus), puti (*Barbus punti*), sharputi (*Puntius sarana*), taki (*Channa punctatus*), walking fish (*Ophicephalus striatus*), malandi, bashpata (*Danio devario*), tengra (*Mystus vittatus*), kakra (*Scylla serrata*), meani, shrimps, and prawn are found in the district. However, some of these varieties, specially those which inhabit the marshes and tanks, are dwindling due to over catching and other reasons such as use of insecticides and pesticides for crop production, etc.

Concepts and Definitions

1. Population and Housing Census 2011

The population and housing census is the unique source of reliable and comprehensive data about the size of the population of the country, major socio-economic and socio-demographic characteristics.

It is the total process of collecting, compiling, evaluating, analyzing and publishing or otherwise disseminating demographic, economic and social data pertaining, at a specified time, to all persons in a country. The essential features of a population census are individual enumeration, universality within a defined territory, simultaneity and defined periodicity.

The population and housing census provides information on the geographic and administrative distribution of the population and household in addition to the demographic and socioeconomic characteristics of all the people in the country. The data from the census are classified, tabulated and disseminated so that political leaders, election officials, planners, national organizations including NGOs and civil society, regional and international organizations can use the data in decision-making.

The purpose of community report is to disseminate census data by communities (ward/mahalla in urban area and union/mauza/village in rural area). Data on all key variables namely area, household, population by sex and age group, ethnic population, literacy rate, marital status, school attendance, employment status and religion as well as physical facilities such as source of drinking water, sanitation, electricity and dwelling units have been presented in this report. The planners, researchers and policy makers as well as development partners and community administrators will find this report as a valuable reference for use in advising plans and programs for advancing welfare and well-being of the common people, in particular and the community in general.

Household

Persons, either related or unrelated, living together and taking food from the same kitchen constitute a household. A single person living and eating alone forms one-person household.

Literacy

It denotes ability to write a letter in any language. Literacy status assessment is made for population 7 years and over.

Community

It refers to the following five lower geographic, administrative or revenue units:

- i) **Union:** Smallest administrative rural geographic unit comprising of mauzas and villages and having union parishad institution.
- ii) **Mauza :** Mauza is the lowest administrative unit having a separate jurisdiction list number (J.L. No.) in revenue records. Every mauza has its well-demarcated cadastral map. Mauza should be distinguished from local village since a mauza may consist of one or more villages.
- iii) **Village:** Lowest rural geographic unit either equivalent to a mauza or part of a mauza.
- iv) **Ward:** Smallest administrative urban geographic unit comprising of mahallas and having ward council institution.
- v) **Mahalla:** Lowest urban geographic unit having identifiable boundaries.

Urban Area

It corresponds with area developed around a central place having such amenities as metalled roads, improved communication, electricity, gas, water supply, sewerage, sanitation and also having comparatively higher density of population with majority population in non-agricultural occupations.

i) City Corporation: It includes city corporation area declared by the Ministry of Local Government.

ii) Paurashava/Municipality Area: It includes paurashavas incorporated and administered by local government under Paurashava Ordinance, 1977.

2. Agriculture Census year and reference period

The census year extends over twelve consecutive months having for different census items the different reference periods or days of data collections. Some items have a year or week reference period. Some others have a specific reference day. The different census items by their reference periods or days are shown below:

Agriculture holding

An agriculture holding is a techno-economic unit of agricultural production under single management comprising all livestock kept and all land used wholly or partly for agricultural production purposes without regard to title, legal form or size. Single management may be exercised by either an individual holder or jointly by two or more individuals or holders or by a judicial person such as a corporation, co-operative or government agency. A holding may consist of one or more parcels (fragments of land) located in one or more areas or mauzas or in more than one administrative unit or division provided that all separate parcels of fragments form parts of same technical unit under operational control of same management.

The definition covers practically all holdings/households engaged in agricultural production of both crops and livestock. Some agriculture holdings may have no significant agricultural land, e.g. holdings keeping livestock, poultry and hatcheries for which land is not an indispensable input for production.

Farm holding

A farm holding is defined as being an agricultural production unit having cultivated land equal to or more than 0.05 acres. Farm holdings are classified into following three broad groups:

(a) **small:** Farm holdings having minimum cultivated land 0.05 acre but operated land more than this minimum but upto 2.49 acres.

(b) **medium:** Farm holdings having operated land in between 2.50 to 7.49 acres.

(c) **large:** Farm holdings having operated land 7.50 acres and above.

Small cultivated land 0.04 acre or less is generally used for kitchen garden growing mainly vegetables. Often seeds of white gourd, water gourd, pumpkin and other strains are sown on households; but these creepers spread out around house roofs and other structures. As such, the minimum cultivated land considered for qualifying to be a farm holding is 0.05 acres.

Non-farm holdings

A non-farm holding is defined as being the one which has neither cultivated nor operated land or has cultivated land less than 0.05 acre.

Tenancy

Owner holdings are those having and operating their owned land and who may or may not be leasing out land.

Tenant holdings are those having no owned land but operating land taken from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Owner-cum-tenant holdings are those having owned land and who may or may not be leasing out their own land to others and who may be taking land from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Agriculture work

Agriculture work signifies all activities of holder and his/her labour force doing planning, management, and operation of a holding. It includes land preparation, sowing, weeding, harvesting, feeding and tending livestock & poultry, kitchen gardening, supervising agricultural workers, keeping farm records & accounts, preparing agriculture products for marketing (including packaging), repairing farm equipment, constructing farm buildings & fences, and engaging in land reclamation and improvement and other related activities. It excludes home and other family domestic chores.

Area under pond

The pond area remains under water almost through out the year. Normally, households use pond water for various domestic and sometimes agriculture purposes. Ponds are also generally used for fish culture.

In the census the pond area data were collected separately for both single ownership and joint ownership of households.

Area under temporary crops

It is the land area planted to crops having growing cycle or length of life less than one year. These are the temporary crops such as paddy, wheat, jute, cotton, tobacco, sugarcane, pulses, oil seeds, potato, vegetables and other seasonal crops. A list of temporary crops for which data were collected separately was given in back page of "Tally Sheet". The minimum area recorded for a temporary crop was 0.01 acre. Area under temporary crops and temporary-crops net area are equivalents.

Area under permanent crops

It is the land area planted to crops which remain standing for a long period of time and do not need to be replanted after a seasonal harvest. Mango, jackfruit, coconut, guava, lemon, and other fruit varieties are all permanent crops.

Current fallow

It is land brought into cultivation but left out uncultivated in census year for fertility regaining and improvement or for other reasons.

Net cultivated area

This is land area actually cropped during the census year regardless of number of crops grown plus current fallow. It includes areas under temporary and permanent crops and also current fallow.

Permanent fallow

It is land not available for cultivation due to coming into residence and commercial & other uses. Play ground, graveyard, wild shrubs and jungles, marshy land, and the like fall in this category.

Irrigated area

This is area of total land brought under irrigation coverage for growing crops with irrigations done through mechanical or manual means. Irrigated area classifications fall into two categories: (1) surface water irrigation with main water sources being rivers, canals, beels, ponds, and other water bodies; and (2) underground water irrigation with water lifted by shallow tube-wells, deep tube-wells, and country traditional devices. The irrigation equipments are run by electricity, diesel or petrol, or manual labour.

Cattle and Buffalo

Cattle and buffalo heads owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Goats and Sheep

Goats and sheep owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Fowls, Ducks and Pigeons

Fowls, ducks, and pigeons owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Temporary crops gross area

Areas aggregated for all temporary crops grown in the census year have made **temporary crops gross area** greater than **temporary crops net area** since the latter has within it the same land cropped more than once in different seasons of a year.

Intensity of cropping

It is percentage of temporary crops gross area in comparison with temporary crops net area. It is expressed as follows:

$$\text{Intensity of cropping} = \frac{\text{Temporary crops gross area}}{\text{Temporary crops net area}} \times 100$$

Cereals

Main cereals are rice and then wheat. Other cereals are jab, barley, cheena, maize, kaun, bajra and joar.

Pulses

Main and common pulses are gram, mung, lentil, arhar, gari kalai, khesari and pea.

Oil seeds

Main oil seeds are rape and mustard, sesamum, linseed, groundnut, soybean, sunflower and castor.

Vegetables

Farmers grow both summer and winter vegetables. Main vegetables are potato, brinjal, raddish, arum, lady's finger, cauliflower, cabbage, bean, tomato, patal, gourd, cucumber, pumpkin, knoll-kal-turnip, dhundal, barbati, khirai, chichinga, carrot, kakrol and sak.

Cash crop

Main cash crops are jute, mesta, sunhemp, cotton, sugarcane and tobacco.

Spices

The main spices include turmeric, ginger, chillies, onion, garlic, corriander, black cumin and ani seed.

Fuel crops

Dhaincha and other smaller plants used as cooking-fue
