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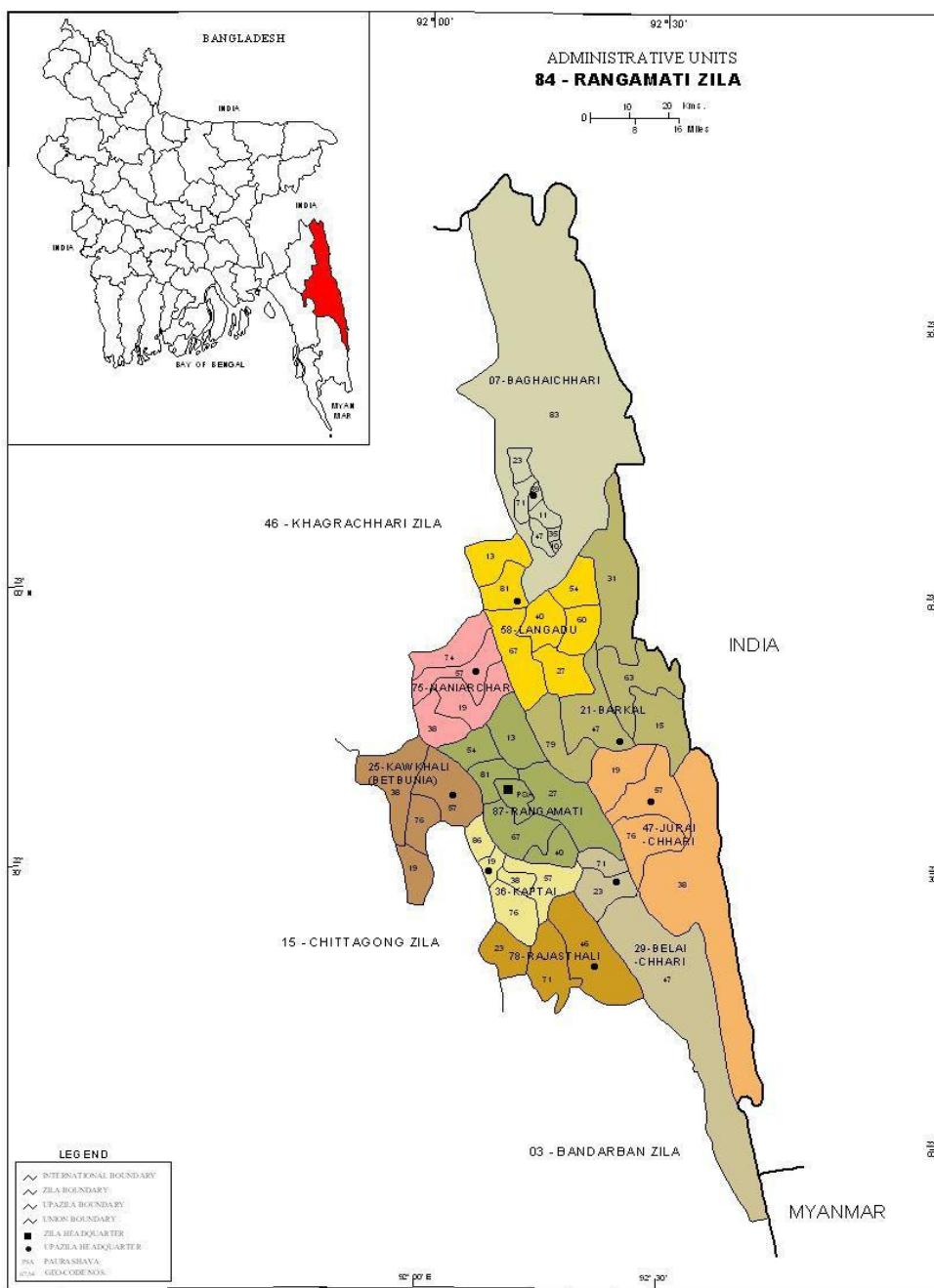
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District Map

CHAPTER 1

Introduction

District at a Glance

Background, Geographic Area and Location: Rangamati district is located at South-eastern side of Bangladesh. It is under Chittagong Division. Rangamati is the largest district of Bangladesh by Area. Rangamati is a part of the Chittagong Hill Tracts. Rangamati is a district of natural beauties and cultural heritages. Rangamati became a subdivision in 1891 and was upgraded to a district in 1983. Nothing is definitely known about the origin of the name of the district. It is said that the name Rangamati has been originated from the **Radish Soil** of the land which in Bengali means **Rangamati**. It is bounded on the north and on the east by India on the south by the Bandarban district and on the west by Khagrachhari and Chittagong districts. It lies between 22°27' and 23°44' north latitudes and 91°56' and 92° 33' east longitudes. The total area of the district is 6,116.11 sq. km. (2361.41 sq. miles) of which 2233.84 sq. km. is under forest.

Temperature and Rainfall: Annual average temperature of this district varies from maximum 36.5°C to minimum 12.5°C and annual rainfall is 2673 mm.

Main Rivers: The Karnafuli, Thega, Horina, Kassalong, Shublang, Chingri, Rainkhiang and Kaptai are main rivers of Rangamati district.

Ethnic Nationals: In Rangamati district, there are 52 percent peoples are ethnic and 48 percent peoples are non-ethnic. The local ethnic nationals are the Chakma, Marma, Tripura, Murang, Rakhain, Lushai, Khyang, Bawm, Khumi, Chak, Tanchangya and Pankua. They have different culture and heritages.

Historical Events: Before the Muslim conquest Rangamati region was a contesting ground between the kings of the Tripura and the Arakan. In 1966 this region came under the Mughals. It was leased to the English East India Company in 1760-61. In 1737 one tribal leader Sher Mosta Khan took refuge with the Mughals. From this time onward the Chakmas settled in this region that was followed by other ethnic nationals.

Administration: Rangamati subdivision was turned into a district in 1983. The area of the Rangamati town is 64.75 sq km. The district consists of 10 upazilas, 49 unions, 162 mauzas, 1555 villages, 2 paurashava, 18 wards and 90 mahallas. The upazilas are Baghaichhari, Barkal, Kawkhali, Belaichhari, Kaptai, Juraichhari, Langadu, Naniarchar, Rajasthali and Rangamati Sadar.

Archaeological Heritage and Relics: Palace, dighee and mosque of Raja Jan Bashk Khan, Remnants of the residence of Raja Harish Chandra Roy and the hanging bridge are some archaeological heritage and relics of this district.

Place to Visit: Rangamati is a very attractive place for the adventurous tourist. The district is the combination of Hills, Jungle, River, Lake and plain land area. Rangamati is famous for beautiful Landscape, Hills, Lake, Hanging Bridge, Handicraft products, Ivory jewellery, Tribal Museum, Chakma Rajbari, Rajbonbihar pagoda. Main attractions of Rangamati are boating, hiking on the hilly area, enjoying the nature, tribal lifestyle and many more. Every year thousand of tourist from all over the country and abroad comes to visit Rangamati. Usually they visit the Kaptai lake which is the largest in South Asia, Sovalong fountain, Hanging bridge, Rajbanbihar, Rajbari, Tribal Cultural Institute, Tribal Market etc.

Hanging Bridge: Hanging Bridge (*Jhulonto Bridge* in Bengali) is the landmark icon of Rangamati. It's a popular tourist. Gagra waterfall is one of the great combinations of nature.

Kaptai Lake: Kaptai Lake is a wonderful spot for boating and cruising. Parjatan and private tour operators offer a number of cruises by mechanical boats. One can go to various scenic spots in Shuvalong, Barkal, Longadu, Mainimukh and other areas by boat from Rangamati. The district is also known to all for having a hydraulic Power Plant at Kaptai and Terrestrial Earth Satellite at Betbunia, Kawkhli.

Indigenous Museum: The only Indigenous Cultural Museum in the Chittagong Hill Tracts region was established at Rangamati town in 1978 and run by the Tribal Cultural Institute. It preserves valuable objects and articles of different tribes depicting their socio-economic, cultural and historical tradition. These include typical indigenous dresses, ornaments, arms and ammunitions, coins, statues made of wood, bronze and other metals, musical instruments, ivory products, handicrafts, paintings on tribal life etc.

Main Crops: Cashew nut, Paddy, jute, potato, cotton, corn mustard seed etc. are main crops of this district.

Main Fruits: Banana, pineapple, Mango, water melon, jackfruit, litchi, black berry etc. are main fruits of this district.

Newspapers: The daily Banabhumii, Gairika, Giripath, Parbatya Barta, etc are locally published newspapers of this district.

Economic Situation: The economy of Rangamati is predominantly agricultural. Out of total 108,263 holdings of the district, 74.10% holdings are farms that produce varieties of crops namely local and HYV rice, wheat, vegetable, cash crops and others. Rangamati district is famous for jackfruits and pineapples, which is abundantly grown in the district. The other important fruits are banana, guava, olive, papaya etc. Fish of special varieties ruhi, katal & chital abound in this district. All these varieties of fish are caught from lake. Besides crops, livestock, forestry and fishery are the main sources of household income. The district is very rich in forest resources.

The status of non-farming activities in the district is rather low. The following table-1 shows the number of establishments and their distribution by major industries provides some evidence of non-agricultural activities in Rangamti district.

Flora and Fauna

Flora: The general aspect of the topography of the district of Rangamati is a mass of hills, rivers and cliffs covered with bamboo brakes, tall trees and creeper jungles. The valleys are covered with thick virgin forests interspersed with small water courses and swamps of all sizes and descriptions.

The district has two big reserve forests such as Kasalong and raing khiang reserve forests and few smaller ones like Sitapahar, Barkal and Kaptai reserve forests. The major and the most important part of Kaptai reserve forest has been devoured by the Kaptai hydro-electric project. This has changed the pattern of vegetation over a considerable area of Rangamati district. Moreover, jhuming or shifting cultivation, an age-long practice of tribal people has systematically destroyed many areas of virgin forest of the district.

The composition of the existing forests of the district can be classified broadly into four categories. These are: (i) Evergreen forests consisting of tropical wet-evergreen and tropical mixed evergreen, (ii) Deciduous forests comprising tropical moist deciduous riverine and open deciduous, (iii) Bamboo brakes and (iv) Sa.

Both types under evergreen category consist of three stories. In the wet-evergreen type the tallest trees form a tom canopy at about 100ft. chundul (*Tetrameles nudiflora*), telsur (*Hopea odorata*), narikeli (*Cocos nucifera*) etc. The second storey is formed by trees such as pitraj (*Aphanamixis*)

polystachia), nageswar (*Mesua nagassarium*), toon (*Toona ciliata*) and others. The third storey consists of such growth as kamini (*Murraya paniculata*), horina (*Vitex peduncularis*) and wild banana (*Musa sapientum*) etc.

In the mixed-evergreen type, the highest canopy is nearly 150ft. up and formed by civit (*Swintonia floribunda*), garjan (*Dipterocarpus turbinatus*), chundul, narikeli and other trees. The second storey has Tali (*Dichopsis polyantha*), koirjam (*Eugenia cymosa*), kamdeb (*Callophylum polyanthum*), chapalish (*Artocarpus chapalish*) and other medium sized trees. The third storey consists of smaller trees like sutagula (*Machilus bombacyns*), Jiyal (*Jatropha gossypifolia*), hargoza (*Dillenia pentagyna*), haritaki (*Terminalia chebula*), gamar (*Gmelina arborea*) Jarual (*Legerstroemia speciosa*) and chhatim (*alstonia scholarsis*).

The main trees in the tropical moist deciduous riverine type of forests are kadam (*Anthocephalus cadamba*), banderholla (*Duabanga sonneratoides*), shimul (*Bombax ceiba*) etc. In the open deciduous type of forests, the main trees are Cahmpa (*Michelia champaca*), chikrasi (*Chukrassia tabularis*), karai (*Albizzia procera*), hargoza, Banderholla and Toon.

The bamboo brakes occupy large areas. They spread only where the forest cover has been removed by overcutting or buring. The common species of bamboo are muli (*Melconna bambusoides*), mitenga (*Bambusa tulda*), orah (*Dendrocalamus longispathus*), dalu (*Tenisotachyum dullua*) etc. In the moister localities, there are small cane brakes. The main types of cane available here are gallak (*Calamas flagellum*), kerak (*Calamas talifolum*), jaitber (*Calamas viminalis*) and bandari (*Calamas tenuis*).

There is profusion of creepers, climber, lianas and epiphytes consisting of ferns, mosses and orchids in these forests.

The large patches of Savannah consist either of shon grass (*Imperata arundinances*), khagra (*Saccharum sponteneum*), sun grass (*imperata cylindrica*) etc.

Various exotic plants of high commercial value have been intoroduced in the district. These are teak (*Tectona grandis*), mahogony (*Swientenia macrophylla*) rubber, acacia, pine (*Pinus longifolia*), etc.

The agricultural crops that are usually grown in the district include local aus, HYV rice, wheat, maize, vergetables, pulses, oilseeds, potato, tobacco, cotton, spices etc. Some horticultural crops like banana, pine apple (*Ananas comosus*) and cashewnut are also grown. The village homesteads are surrounded with a wide variety of trees, shrubs and thickets. Trees like haritaki (*Terminalia chebula*), kat badam (*Terminalia catappa*), arjuna (*Terminalia arjuna*), sheora (*Streblus asper*), teak (*Tectona grandis*), mahogony (*Swientenia macrophylla*)etc. are found along the roadside.

Fauna

Mammals: The mammalian fauna of the Rangamati district is largely similar to that of the other adjoining hilly district. Most common mammals found in the forest of Rangamati are chita (*Panthera pardus*), gecho bagh (*Neofelis nebulosa*), marbled cat (*Felis marmorata*), chita biral (*Prionailurus bengalensis*), mechi bagh (*Prionailurus viverrinus*), ban biral (*Felis chaus*), bengal fox (*Vulpes bengalensis*), pati shial (*Canis aureus*), ban kutta (*Cuon alpinus*), Buno shukar (*Sus scrofa*),juti sajaru (*Hystrix indica*) etc. Different species of primates like monkey (*Macaca mullata*), common langur (*presbytis entellus*), leaf monkey (*presbytis obscurus*), mukhpura

honauman (*Trachypithecus pileatus*) etc. are also found. Besides, few species of bats, squirrels as well as rats and mice are frequently seen in this area.

The big deer sambur (*Cervus unicolor*) and the elephant (*Elephas maximus*), though still widely found in these forests, have of late become greatly restricted.

Some of the mammals that were once common in this area are now gradually disappearing. These are ban chagal (*Capricornis summatraensis*), chitra harin (*Axis porcinus*), barosinga (*Panthera leo*) and the like. Both the ban garu (*Bos gaurus*) and gayal (*Bos banten*), are either extinct or on the verge of extinction.

Birds: The forests of Rangamati abound in avifauna. Out of about 66 families of birds occurring in Bangladesh, as many as 55 are represented in this district like other hilly districts of the region. This is the only region to support the typically tropical evergreen forest species of birds in addition to other species to be found in open countries and cultivated areas.

Birds belonging to the pheasant group that occur in the forests of Rangamati are kat mayur (*Pavo cristatus*), kalo mayur (*Lophura leucomelana*), ban murag (*Gallus gallus murghi*), white checked partridge (*Arborophila atrogularis*), pahari titir (*Arborophila rufogularis*), bans titir (*Bambusicola fytchii*), manipur bush quail (*Perdica manipuricensis*), blue breasted quail (*Coturnix chinensis*) and others. Pigeons and doves include horial (*Treron apicauda*), choto harial (*Treron phoenicoptera*), batkol (*Treron phoenicoptera*), dhumkol (*Ducula badia*), ghugu (*Streptopelia chinensis*) and sabuj ghugu (*Chalcophaps indica*).

Parrots are represented by tia (*Psittacula krameri*), tuta (*Psittacula alexandri*), lalmatha tia (*Psittacula roseata*), kalomatha tia (*Psittacula finschii*), and lejkata tia (*Loriculus vernalis*).

Cuckoos includes lalpakha kokil (*Calamator coromandus*), bau-katha-kou pakhi (*Cuculus micropterus*), kalo kokil (*Dudynamus scolopacea*), emerald cuckoo (*Chalcites maculatus*), bended bay cuckoo (*Cacomantis sonneratii*) hodgson's hawk (*Cuckoo fugax*) and sirkeer cuckoo (*Taccocua leschenaultii*).

Some of species of picidae family are found in the district. These are khudey kaththokra (*Picumnus innominatus*), lal khudy kaththokra (*Sasia ochracea*), pakra kaththokra (*Picodides canicapillus*), blacknaped green woodpecker (*Picus canus*), small yellownaped woodspecker (*Picus chlorolophus*), himalayan goldenbacked woodpecker (*Dinopium shorii*), Indian golderbacked woodpecker (*Dinopium javanense*) and paleheaded woodpecker (*Gecinulus grantia*). owls are represented by laxmi pencha (*Tyto alba*), grass owl (*Tyto capensis*), nimpokh (*Otus bakkamaena*), hutum pencha (*Bubo bubo*), bhutum pencha (*Bubo zeylenensis*), jungle owl (*Bubo nipalensis*), khuruley pencha (*Athene brama*) and kupokh (*Ninox scutulata*). Few species of kingfisher are generally seen here including buno machranga (*Ceyx erithacus*), lal machranga (*Halcyon coromandra*), common machranga (*Alcedo atthis*), field kingfisher (*Ceryle lugubris*), blyth's kingfisher (*Alcedo hercules*) and blackcaped kingfisher (*Halcyon chloris*).

There are bulbuls including kala bulbul (*Picnonotus atriceps*), sipahi bulbul (*Picnonotus jocosus*), bulbuli (*Picnonotus cafer*), jolpai bulbuli (*Hypispetes viridescens*) and white throated bulbul (*Criniger flaveolus*). The commonly seen drongos are greater racket-tailed drongo (*Dicrurus paradiseus*), lesser racket-tailed drongo (*Dicrurus remifer*) and hairycrowned drongo (*Dicrurus hottentotus*).

Other important and interesting birds are raptorial birds, about a dozen species of rails and crakes including moorhen, kora, waterhen, both the jacanas, large number of species of charadriidae, nightjars, several species of swifts, bee-eaters, both the Indian and broadbilled rollers, few species of hornbills etc, birds belonging to the family of babblers, flycatchers and warblers are found here. Mynas, magpies and many species of minivets, cuckoo-shrikes, tits, nuthatches, popits, fowerpeckers, sunbirds, spiderhunters, white eye, several munias, finches etc, are commonly seen in the area.

The waterbirds include the little grebe, cormorant, shags and darter, herons, storks and white and black ibises. the ducks and geese are not many and most are migratory except the whistling teal which reside at. Besides, barbets, broad-bills and pittas, larks, swallows and martins are well represented though many are migratory.

Reptiles and Amphibians: Some known reptiles of this district include pahari kasim (*Manouria emys*), halud pahari kasim (*Indotestudo elongata*), some poisonous snakes like raj gokhra (*Ophiophagus hannah*), shankhini shap (*Bungarus caeruleus*), kal keotey (*Hardella thurjii*), and kalnagini (*Chrysopelea ornate*). Different species of vipers, dhaman (*Ptyas korros*) and ajagar (*Python molurus*) are also found. Besides, various species of lizards including anjon (*riopa vosmaeri*), tokkhak (*Gekko gecko*), kalo Gui (*Varnus salvato*) etc. and amphibians like gecho bang (*Rhacophorus maculatus*), kuno bang (*Bufo melanostictus*) and bhawa bang (*Rana tigerina*) are also seen.

Fishes: The Karnafuli river is the main habitat for a large number of species of fishes. Varieties of fresh water fishes are available in the Kaptai lake of the Rangamati district. These are chapila (*Gudusia chapra*), phassa (*Setipinna phasa*), chital (*Notopterus chitala*), pholoi (*Notopterus notopterus*), ruhi (*Labeo rohita*), ghonia (*Labeo gonius*), kalibous (*Labeo calbasu*), mrigel (*Cirrhinus mrigala*), katal (*Catla catla*), sharputi (*Puntius sarana*), mohashol (*Barbus tor*), boal (*Wallago attu*), airh (*Mystus aor*), tengra (*Mystus vittatus*), pabda (*Ompok pabda*), bacha (*Eutropichthys vacha*), magur (*Clarias batrachus*), singi (*Heteropneustes fossilis*), gojar (*Channa marulius*), shoil (*Channa striatus*), chanda (*Mene mukulata*), koi (*Anabas testudineus*), baim (*Mastacembelus armatus*) etc.

Concepts and Definitions

1. Population and Housing Census 2011

The population and housing census is the unique source of reliable and comprehensive data about the size of the population of the country, major socio-economic and socio-demographic characteristics.

It is the total process of collecting, compiling, evaluating, analyzing and publishing or otherwise disseminating demographic, economic and social data pertaining, at a specified time, to all persons in a country. The essential features of a population census are individual enumeration, universality within a defined territory, simultaneity and defined periodicity.

The population and housing census provides information on the geographic and administrative distribution of the population and household in addition to the demographic and socioeconomic characteristics of all the people in the country. The data from the census are classified, tabulated and disseminated so that political leaders, election officials, planners, national organizations including NGOs and civil society, regional and international organizations can use the data in decision-making.

The purpose of community report is to disseminate census data by communities (ward/mahalla in urban area and union/mauza/village in rural area). Data on all key variables namely area, household, population by sex and age group, ethnic population, literacy rate, marital status, school attendance, employment status and religion as well as physical facilities such as source of drinking water, sanitation, electricity and dwelling units have been presented in this report. The planners, researchers and policy makers as well as development partners and community administrators will find this report as a valuable reference for use in advising plans and programs for advancing welfare and well-being of the common people, in particular and the community in general.

Household

Persons, either related or unrelated, living together and taking food from the same kitchen constitute a household. A single person living and eating alone forms one-person household.

Literacy

It denotes ability to write a letter in any language. Literacy status assessment is made for population 7 years and over.

Community

It refers to the following five lower geographic, administrative or revenue units:

- i) **Union:** Smallest administrative rural geographic unit comprising of mauzas and villages and having union parishad institution.
- ii) **Mauza :** Mauza is the lowest administrative unit having a separate jurisdiction list number (J.L. No.) in revenue records. Every mauza has its well-demarcated cadastral map. Mauza should be distinguished from local village since a mauza may consist of one or more villages.
- iii) **Village:** Lowest rural geographic unit either equivalent to a mauza or part of a mauza.
- iv) **Ward:** Smallest administrative urban geographic unit comprising of mahallas and having ward council institution.
- v) **Mahalla:** Lowest urban geographic unit having identifiable boundaries.

Urban Area

It corresponds with area developed around a central place having such amenities as metalled roads, improved communication, electricity, gas, water supply, sewerage, sanitation and also having comparatively higher density of population with majority population in non-agricultural occupations.

i) City Corporation: It includes city corporation area declared by the Ministry of Local Government.

ii) Paurashava/Municipality Area: It includes paurashavas incorporated and administered by local government under Paurashava Ordinance, 1977.

2. Agriculture Census year and reference period

The census year extends over twelve consecutive months having for different census items the different reference periods or days of data collections. Some items have a year or week reference period. Some others have a specific reference day. The different census items by their reference periods or days are shown below:

Agriculture holding

An agriculture holding is a techno-economic unit of agricultural production under single management comprising all livestock kept and all land used wholly or partly for agricultural production purposes without regard to title, legal form or size. Single management may be exercised by either an individual holder or jointly by two or more individuals or holders or by a judicial person such as a corporation, co-operative or government agency. A holding may consist of one or more parcels (fragments of land) located in one or more areas or mauzas or in more than one administrative unit or division provided that all separate parcels of fragments form parts of same technical unit under operational control of same management.

The definition covers practically all holdings/households engaged in agricultural production of both crops and livestock. Some agriculture holdings may have no significant agricultural land, e.g. holdings keeping livestock, poultry and hatcheries for which land is not an indispensable input for production.

Farm holding

A farm holding is defined as being an agricultural production unit having cultivated land equal to or more than 0.05 acres. Farm holdings are classified into following three broad groups:

(a) **small:** Farm holdings having minimum cultivated land 0.05 acre but operated land more than this minimum but upto 2.49 acres.

(b) **medium:** Farm holdings having operated land in between 2.50 to 7.49 acres.

(c) **large:** Farm holdings having operated land 7.50 acres and above.

Small cultivated land 0.04 acre or less is generally used for kitchen garden growing mainly vegetables. Often seeds of white gourd, water gourd, pumpkin and other strains are sown on households; but these creepers spread out around house roofs and other structures. As such, the minimum cultivated land considered for qualifying to be a farm holding is 0.05 acres.

Non-farm holdings

A non-farm holding is defined as being the one which has neither cultivated nor operated land or has cultivated land less than 0.05 acre.

Tenancy

Owner holdings are those having and operating their owned land and who may or may not be leasing out land.

Tenant holdings are those having no owned land but operating land taken from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Owner-cum-tenant holdings are those having owned land and who may or may not be leasing out their own land to others and who may be taking land from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Agriculture work

Agriculture work signifies all activities of holder and his/her labour force doing planning, management, and operation of a holding. It includes land preparation, sowing, weeding, harvesting, feeding and tending livestock & poultry, kitchen gardening, supervising agricultural workers, keeping farm records & accounts, preparing agriculture products for marketing (including packaging), repairing farm equipment, constructing farm buildings & fences, and engaging in land reclamation and improvement and other related activities. It excludes home and other family domestic chores.

Area under pond

The pond area remains under water almost through out the year. Normally, households use pond water for various domestic and sometimes agriculture purposes. Ponds are also generally used for fish culture.

In the census the pond area data were collected separately for both single ownership and joint ownership of households.

Area under permanent crops

It is the land area planted to crops which remain standing for a long period of time and do not need to be replanted after a seasonal harvest. Mango, jackfruit, coconut, guava, lemon, and other fruit varieties are all permanent crops.

Current fallow

It is land brought into cultivation but left out uncultivated in census year for fertility regaining and improvement or for other reasons.

Net cultivated area

This is land area actually cropped during the census year regardless of number of crops grown plus current fallow. It includes areas under temporary and permanent crops and also current fallow.

Permanent fallow

It is land not available for cultivation due to coming into residence and commercial & other uses. Play ground, graveyard, wild shrubs and jungles, marshy land, and the like fall in this category.

Irrigated area

This is area of total land brought under irrigation coverage for growing crops with irrigations done through mechanical or manual means. Irrigated area classifications fall into two categories: (1) surface water irrigation with main water sources being rivers, canals, beels, ponds, and other water bodies; and (2) underground water irrigation with water lifted by shallow tube-wells, deep tube-wells, and country traditional devices. The irrigation equipments are run by electricity, diesel or petrol, or manual labour.

Temporary crops gross area

Areas aggregated for all temporary crops grown in the census year have made **temporary crops gross area** greater than **temporary crops net area** since the latter has within it the same land cropped more than once in different seasons of a year.

Intensity of cropping

It is percentage of temporary crops gross area in comparison with temporary crops net area. It is expressed as follows:

$$\text{Intensity of cropping} = \frac{\text{Temporary crops gross area}}{\text{Temporary crops net area}} \times 100$$

Cereals

Main cereals are rice and then wheat. Other cereals are jab, barley, cheena, maize, kaun, bajra and joar.

Pulses

Main and common pulses are gram, mung, lentil, arhar, gari kalai, khesari and pea.

Oil seeds

Main oil seeds are rape and mustard, sesamum, linseed, groundnut, soybean, sunflower and castor.

Vegetables

Farmers grow both summer and winter vegetables. Main vegetables are potato, brinjal, raddish, arum, lady's finger, cauliflower, cabbage, bean, tomato, patal, gourd, cucumber, pumpkin, knoll-kal-turnip, dhundal, barbat, khirai, chichinga, carrot, kakrol and sak.

Cash crop

Main cash crops are jute, mesta, sunhemp, cotton, sugarcane and tobacco.

Spices

The main spices include turmeric, ginger, chillies, onion, garlic, coriander, black cumin and ani seed.

Fuel crops

Dhaincha and other smaller plants used as cooking-fuel.
