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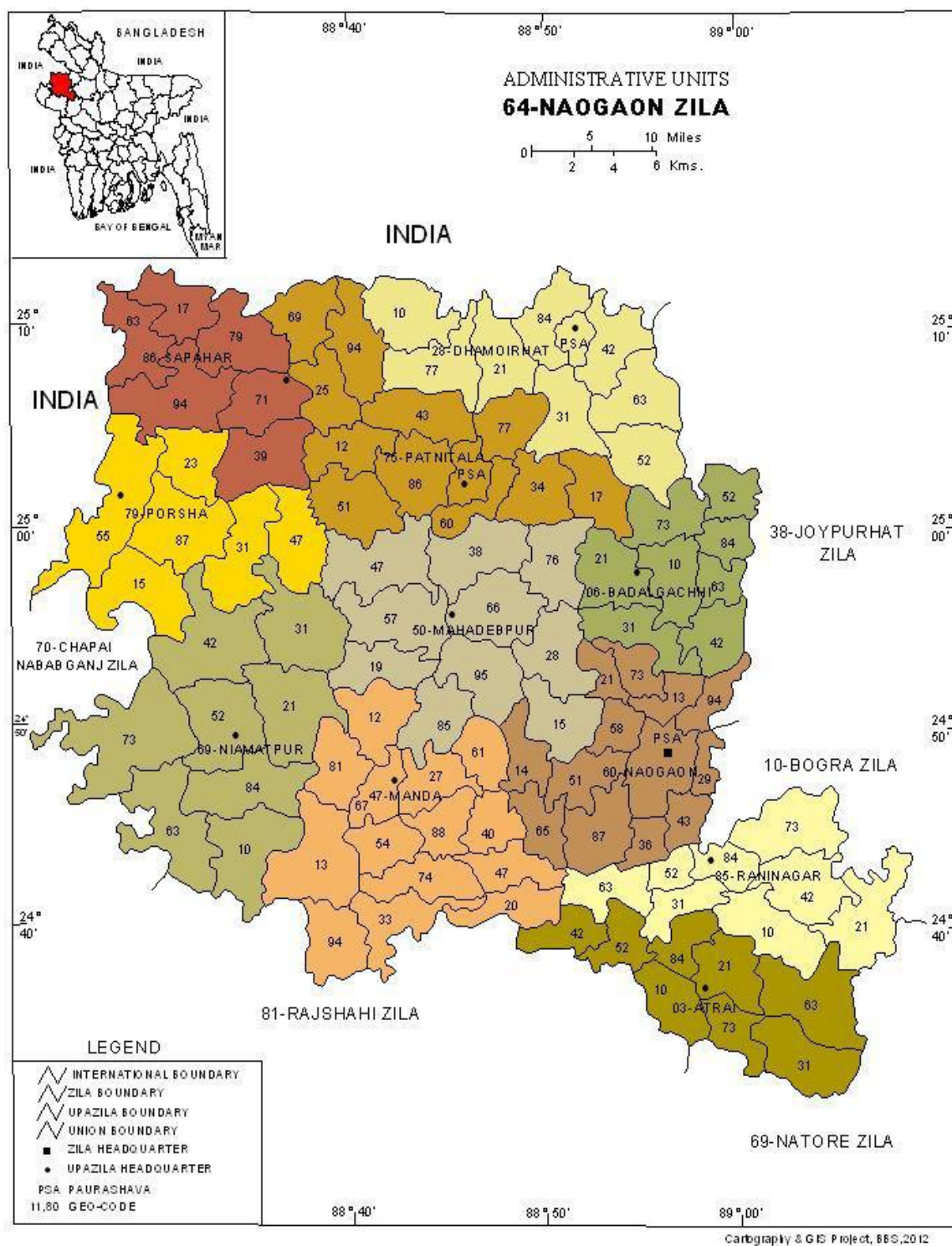
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District Map

CHAPTER 1

Introduction

District at a Glance

Background, Geographic Area and Location: Naogaon is a district in Northern Bangladesh. It is the part of the Rajshahi Division. Naogaon was one of the subdivisions of former Rajshahi District. It was upgraded to district on March 1, 1984. It is believed that the present district headquarters initially developed in a mauza comprising of nine (meaning 'Nao' in Bengali) villages (meaning 'Gaon' in Bengali). The district might have derived its name as Naogaon from the words '**Nao**' and '**Gaon**'. The district is bounded on the north by India, on the east by Joypurhat and Bogra districts, on the south by Natore and Rajshahi Districts and on the west by Nawabganj and India. The total area of the district is 3435.65 sq.km.(1326.51 sq.miles) of which 9.09 sq.km.(3.51 sq. miles) is revenue and 19.45 sq.km (7.51 sq. miles) is under forest. The district lies between 24°32' and 25°13' north latitudes and between 88°23' and 89°10' east longitudes.

Annual Average Temperature: The annual average temperature of this district varies maximum 37.8°C to minimum 11.2°C. The annual average rainfall is 1862 mm.

Main Rivers: The Atrai, Punarbhaba, Little Jamuna, Nagar, Chiri Tuli Ganga etc. are notable.

Administration: Naogaon subdivision was established in 1877 under Rajshahi district and was turned into a district in 1984. The district consists of 11 upazilas, 99 unions, 2565 mauzas, 2779 villages, 3 paurashavas, 27 wards and 92 mahallas. The upazilas are Naogaon Sadar, Atrai, Badalgachhi, Dhamoirhat, Manda, Mahadevpur, Niamatpur, Patnitala, Porsha, Raninagar and Sapahar.

Archaeological Heritage and Relics: The Major Archaeological Heritage and Relics of Naogaon district are Paharpur, Kusumba Mosque and Patisar.

Paharpur: Paharpur is a small village 5 km west of Jamalganj in the Naogaon district where the remains of the most important and the largest known monastery south of the Himalayas have been excavated. This 7th century archaeological find covers an area of approximately 27 acres (110,000 m²) of land. The entire establishment, occupying a quadrangular court, measures more than 900 ft (270 m) and is from 12 to 15 ft (3.7 to 4.6 m) in height. With an elaborate gateway complex on the north, there are 45 cells on the north and 44 in each of the other three sides, for a total number of 177 rooms. The architecture of the pyramidal cruciform temple is profoundly influenced by those of South-East Asia, especially Myanmar and Java. A site museum built recently houses the representative collection of objects recovered from the area. The excavated findings have also been preserved at the Varendra Research Museum at Rajshahi. The antiquities of the museum include terracotta plaques, images of different gods and goddesses, pottery, coin inscriptions, ornamental bricks and other minor clay objects. Nine miles west-southwest of Paharpur is the archaeological site of Halud Vihara, which has been tentatively listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Kusumba Mosque: Kusumba Mosque is named after the village of Kusumba, under the Manda upazila of Naogaon district, on the west bank of the Atrai river. It lies inside a walled enclosure

with a monumental gateway with standing spaces for guards. It was built by a high-ranking official named Sulaiman, during the period of Afghan rule in Bengal, under one of the last Suri rulers, Ghiyasuddin Bahadur Shah. The platform edge has grape vine decoration, and there are rosettes on the spandrels of the arches supporting the platform, as well as on the mihrab wall.

Patisar: Patisar is situated on the banks of the river Nagor, 12 kilometres south-east of the Atrai railway station and 26 kilometers from the district town. Patisar village is associated with Rabindranath Tagore. The headquarters of the Tagore family's zamindari in Kaligram Pargana was located at Patisar. Dwarkanath Tagore, the grandfather of Rabindranath Tagore, purchased this zamindari in 1830. Rabindranath Tagore first came to Patisar in January 1891. The architectural design of the two-storied Kuthibari of Patisar is similar to that of Shilaidaha-Shahjadpur. Every year many devotees of Tagore come from home and abroad to visit Patisar.

Famous Places of Naogaon: Zila Porishad Park, Muktir more, Abdul Jolil Sishu Park, Shampur Bihar(Paharpur), Badalgacchi, Dubalhati Rajbari, Kusumba Masjid(Manda), Rabindranath Tagore's Kuthi Bari(Patishar), Alta Dighee(Dhamoirhat), Mohadevpur Razbari, Dibor Dighee, Gahon pirbabar Mazar, Kancon, Hazarat Zahor Uddin Cistia Babar Mazar, Patnitola, Katabari Mazar(Patnitola), Dudulhati Royal Palace, Balihar Royal Palace(Naogaon Sadar), Vimer Panti, Jogoddol Bihara, Mahisontos(Dhamoirhat), Halud Bihar(Badalgachi) Sri Sri Ragnath Geu Mondir(Mohadevpur) etc. are famous places of Naogaon.

Marks of War of Liberation: There are 9 Mass graves, 7 mass killing sites, 1 memorial sculpture and 1 monument of this district are the marks of war of liberation.

Ethnic Nationals: Santal, Oraon and Mahali are main ethnic nationals of this district.

Educational Institutions: The number of educational institutions are Government college 6, Non-government college 53, Government high school 4, Non-government high school 450, Government primary school 794, Non-government(Registered) primary school 583, madrasa 320, Collegiate school 7, Kindergarden 187, Technical and vocational institute 27.

Main Crops: Paddy, potato, watermelon, oil seeds, pulses etc are major crops of this district.

Main Fruits: Mango, jackfruit, banana, litchi, coconut etc. are main fruits of this district.

NGO Activities: NGOs operationally important NGOs of this district are BRAC, ITCL, CARE, Grameen Bank, Thengamara Mahila Sabuj Sangha, etc.

Economic Situation: The economy of Naogaon is mainly agro-based. Out of total 6,11,822 holdings of the district 63.83% holdings are farms that produce varieties of crops, namely, local and HYV paddy, wheat, pulses, mustard, potato, different kinds of vegetables, jute, sugarcane, spices and other minor crops. Various fruits like mango, banana, jackfruit, tal (palm), coconut, betelnut, kalojam, piyara, jambura, kamranga, jalpai, etc. are also grown in the district. Ponds, creeks, beels and rivers of the district are the natural habitat for fish population. The principal types of fishes are ruhi, catla, kalbaush, mrigel, koi, shing, magur, air, boal, pangas, saul, bele, chital,

pabda, tengra, puti etc. In addition, some exotic varieties of fish such as tilapia, nilotica, silver carp, grass carp etc, are being cultivated in the district. Besides crop, livestock and poultry are the subsidiary sources of household income.

Non-farm economic activities are also important in Naogaon. The following table-1 shows the type and number of establishments together with persons engaged in those establishments by sex and activity.

Flora and Fauna

Flora: A significant portion of Naogaon district lies within Barind region. The relief of this area is elevated and moderately undulating. A stiff soil of reddish clayey loam distinguishes it from the remaining portions of the district which lie within the flood plains of the little Jamuna, Atrai and Purnabhaha rivers where soils are mainly silty in redges and clays in basin centres in some areas and heavy clays in some other areas.

There are perennial marshes in the district. The most notable of these beels is the Manda beel. It continues in a chain of beels to south and the east. There is also an enormous stretch of perennial swamp all around Dublahati village.

The major agricultural products comprise aus, aman, boro, jute and wheat. Among rice crops, aman covers by far the largest area followed by boro and aus. Rice covers 85.25% of the gross cropped area. Rabi crops include mustard, khesari, masur, mash, potato, sesame, gram, spices, barley, maize, tobacco, sugarcane etc. Tal (palms) are abundant in the Barind portion of the district. Bambo and mango are plentiful around home steads. The fields are often bordered with bananas.

Besides, the cultivation of hemp plant (*Cannabis sativa*) is a speciality of the Naogaon district. The plant yields three narcotic products called ganja, charas, and bhang.

The homestead flora of the Naogaon district represents different species of commonly planted trees. These are mango (*Mangifera indica*), jack-fruit (*Artocarpus heterophyllus*), black berry (*Syzygium cumini*), betel-nut (*Areca catechu*), coconut tree (*Cocos nucifera*), palm tree (*Borassus flabellifer*), guava (*Psidium guajava*), sajna (*Moringa obefera*), lime (*Citrus Grandis*) etc.

Other common trees include khair (*Acacia catechu*), babla (*Acacia nilotica*), kaligarjan (*Butea monosperma*), mandar (*Erythrina variegata*), kadbel (*Limonia acidissima*), batul (*Trewia nudiflora*), siris (*Abizzia lebbeck*), bhadi (*Lanea coromandelica*), cotton tree (*Bombax ceiba*), sonalu (*Cassia fistula*), carambola (*Averrhoa carambola*), motor koro (*Albizia lucidior*), pitraj (*Aphanamixis polystachia*), latkan (*Baccaurea ramiflora*), raktachandan (*Pterocarpus santalinus*), jalpai (*Elaeocarpus tectorius*), nimpitali (*Mallotus albus*), barak bamboo (*bambusa balcooa*), beora bamboo (*Bambura bambos*) etc.

Common roadside trees comprise banian tree (*Ficus benghalensis*), ashatha tree (*ficus religiosa*), neem (*Azadirachta indica*), Katbadam (*Terminalia catappa*), randi koro (*Albizia saman*), debdaru (*Polyalthia longifolia*), krishnachura (*Delonix regia*), tamal (*Diospyro montana*), tamarind (*tamarindus indica*) etc.

Besides, the floating macrophytes like kachuri pana (*Telanthra philoxeroides*), topa pana (*Pistia stratiotes*), khudi pana (*Lemna paucicos tata*), the curious floating ferns, azolla pinnata, salvinia cucullata etc. are usually seen in the village ponds. Some aquatic plants such as lily (*Nymphaea nouchalia*), lotus (*Nelumbo nucifera*) and aquatic bafy greens like kalmi (*Polygonum*), helencha (*Tilanthra philoxcroides*) etc. are also seen in the shallower ponds, ditches and beels of the ziia.

In addition, homestead thickets, shrubberies and backyards with planted trees often give support to many climbers and twiners. Bean (*Lablab purpureus*) is commonly grown, although winged bean is also occasionally planted, Pui or basil (*Besella alba*) are planted for its leafy greens.

Moreover, some plants are grown at the homesteads mainly for aesthetic purposes. These are Kamini, shefali sandhya malati, Jaba, gandhoraj patabahar, hasnahena, beli etc.

Fauna:

Mammals: The common mammalian fauna that are frequently seen in the country side of the Naogaon district are mouse (*Bandicota bengalensis*), metho mouse (*Mus booduga*), nengti mouse (*Mus musculus*), common house mouse (*Rattus rattus*), tortoise, dora kathbirali (*Funambulus pennanti*), bhondar (*Lutra perspicillata*), kola badur (*Pteropus giganteus*), Indian pipistrelle (*Pipistrellus coromandra*), tickill's bat (*Hesperoptenus tikelli*), jackal (*Canis aureus*), bon biral (*Felis chaus*), benji (*Herpestes edwardsi*), etc.

Birds: Once many different species of birds used to be seen in the country side, but now their numbers are being reduced significantly because of the reduction of bio-diversity through damage to the environment. However, the birds that are commonly found in this district are magpie (*Copsychus saularis*), sparrow (*Passer domesticus*), bhat martin (*Acredotheres tristis*), Jhuti martin (*Acredotheres fuscus*), swallow (*Ploceus phillippinus*), tuntuni (*Orthotomus sutorius*), lal kite (*Haliastur lindus*), crow (*Corvus splendens*), jackdaw (*Corvus macrorhynchos*), kingfisher (*Alcedo atthis*), wood-pecker (*Picus myrmecophoneus*), tila dove (*Streptopelia chinensis*), botkol

(*Treron phoenicoptera*), dhumkol (*Ducula badia*), bulbul (*Picnonotus cafer*), choto fingei (*Dicrurus macrocercus*), holdey pakhi (*Oriolus xanthornus*), water-hen (*Amaurornis phoenicurus*), cuckoo (*Cuculus micropterus*), black owl (*Dicrurus adsimilis*), lakshmi owl (*Tyto alba*), khuruley owl (*Athene brama*), kana korchey heron (*Ardeola grayii*), pelican (*Phalacrocoran niger*), parrot (*Psittacula alexandrii*), etc.

Besides, a large number of migratory birds visit Bangladesh during winter season. They are usually seen in wet land areas. However some of them are also seen in the swamps and beels of this district. There are chokha chokhi (*Tadorna ferruginea*), common teal (*Anas crucea*), pintail (*Anas acuta*), grey leg goose (*Nser anser*), common pochard (*Aythya ferina*), gadwall (*Anas strepera*), plover (*Charadrius alenasdrinus*), common tern (*Sterna hirusdo*), marsh harrier (*Circus aerugingsus*), tufted duck (*Aythya fuligula*), pintailed snipe (*Gallinago gallinago*), pied wagtail (*Motacilla alba*), brown shrike (*Lanius cristatus*), common sand piper (*Tringa hypoleucos*), little ringed plover (*Charadrius alenasdrinus*), herring gull (*larus argentatus*), red breasted fly catcher (*musciapa parva*) etc.

Reptiles and Amphibians: Reptiles that are commonly seen in this district are kali kaitta (*Hardella thurjii*), kori kaitta (*Kachuga tecta*), dhum tortoise (*Trionyx gangeticus*), lizard (*Hemidactylus brooki*), shanda (*Gekko gekko*), lguana (*Varanus bengalensis*), hunguishap (*Varanus flavescens*), ghargini shap (*Lycodon jara*), dhora shap (*Xenocrophis piscator*), mete shap (*Micropisthodon plumbicolor*), daraj shap (*Ptyas mucous*), paina shap (*Enhydris enhydris*), Jait shap (*Naja kauthia*), shankhini shap (*Bungarus cacrules*) etc.

Among the amphibians, the most common are kotkoti bang (*Rana cyanophlyctis*), kuno bang (*Bufo melanostictus*) jhijhi bang (*Rana limnocharis*), bhawa bang (*Rana trgerina*) etc.

Fishes: Ponds, creeks, beels and rivers of the district are the natural babitat for fish population. The principal types of fishes are ruhi (*Labeo rohita*), catla (*catla catla*), Kalibaush (*Labeo calbasu*), mrigel (*Cirrhinus mrigala*), koi (*Anabas testudineus*), shing (*Heteropneustes fossilis*), magur (*Clarias batrachus*), airh (*Mystus aor*), boal (*Wallago attu*), pangas (*Pangasius pangasius*), shoil (*Channa striatus*), bele (*Glossogobius giuris*), chital (*Notopterus chitala*), pabda (*Ompok pabda*), tengra (*Mystus vittatus*), phali (*Notopterus Notopterus*), etc. In addition, some exotic varieties of fish such as tilapia, nilotica, silver carp, grass carp etc, are being cultivated in the district.

Concepts and Definitions

1. Population and Housing Census 2011

The population and housing census is the unique source of reliable and comprehensive data about the size of the population of the country, major socio-economic and socio-demographic characteristics.

It is the total process of collecting, compiling, evaluating, analyzing and publishing or otherwise disseminating demographic, economic and social data pertaining, at a specified time, to all persons in a country. The essential features of a population census are individual enumeration, universality within a defined territory, simultaneity and defined periodicity.

The population and housing census provides information on the geographic and administrative distribution of the population and household in addition to the demographic and socioeconomic characteristics of all the people in the country. The data from the census are classified, tabulated and disseminated so that political leaders, election officials, planners, national organizations including NGOs and civil society, regional and international organizations can use the data in decision-making.

The purpose of community report is to disseminate census data by communities (ward/mahalla in urban area and union/mauza/village in rural area). Data on all key variables namely area, household, population by sex and age group, ethnic population, literacy rate, marital status, school attendance, employment status and religion as well as physical facilities such as source of drinking water, sanitation, electricity and dwelling units have been presented in this report. The planners, researchers and policy makers as well as development partners and community administrators will find this report as a valuable reference for use in advising plans and programs for advancing welfare and well-being of the common people, in particular and the community in general.

Household

Persons, either related or unrelated, living together and taking food from the same kitchen constitute a household. A single person living and eating alone forms one-person household.

Literacy

It denotes ability to write a letter in any language. Literacy status assessment is made for population 7 years and over.

Community

It refers to the following five lower geographic, administrative or revenue units:

- i) **Union:** Smallest administrative rural geographic unit comprising of mauzas and villages and having union parishad institution.
- ii) **Mauza :** Mauza is the lowest administrative unit having a separate jurisdiction list number (J.L. No.) in revenue records. Every mauza has its well-demarcated cadastral map. Mauza should be distinguished from local village since a mauza may consist of one or more villages.
- iii) **Village:** Lowest rural geographic unit either equivalent to a mauza or part of a mauza.
- iv) **Ward:** Smallest administrative urban geographic unit comprising of mahallas and having ward council institution.
- v) **Mahalla:** Lowest urban geographic unit having identifiable boundaries.

Urban Area

It corresponds with area developed around a central place having such amenities as metalled roads, improved communication, electricity, gas, water supply, sewerage, sanitation and also having comparatively higher density of population with majority population in non-agricultural occupations.

i) City Corporation: It includes city corporation area declared by the Ministry of Local Government.

ii) Paurashava/Municipality Area: It includes paurashavas incorporated and administered by local government under Paurashava Ordinance, 1977.

2. Agriculture Census year and reference period

The census year extends over twelve consecutive months having for different census items the different reference periods or days of data collections. Some items have a year or week reference period. Some others have a specific reference day. The different census items by their reference periods or days are shown below:

Agriculture holding

An agriculture holding is a techno-economic unit of agricultural production under single management comprising all livestock kept and all land used wholly or partly for agricultural production purposes without regard to title, legal form or size. Single management may be exercised by either an individual holder or jointly by two or more individuals or holders or by a judicial person such as a corporation, co-operative or government agency. A holding may consist of one or more parcels (fragments of land) located in one or more areas or mauzas or in more than one administrative unit or division provided that all separate parcels of fragments form parts of same technical unit under operational control of same management.

The definition covers practically all holdings/households engaged in agricultural production of both crops and livestock. Some agriculture holdings may have no significant agricultural land, e.g. holdings keeping livestock, poultry and hatcheries for which land is not an indispensable input for production.

Farm holding

A farm holding is defined as being an agricultural production unit having cultivated land equal to or more than 0.05 acres. Farm holdings are classified into following three broad groups:

(a) **small:** Farm holdings having minimum cultivated land 0.05 acre but operated land more than this minimum but upto 2.49 acres.

(b) **medium:** Farm holdings having operated land in between 2.50 to 7.49 acres.

(c) **large:** Farm holdings having operated land 7.50 acres and above.

Small cultivated land 0.04 acre or less is generally used for kitchen garden growing mainly vegetables. Often seeds of white gourd, water gourd, pumpkin and other strains are sown on households; but these creepers spread out around house roofs and other structures. As such, the minimum cultivated land considered for qualifying to be a farm holding is 0.05 acres.

Non-farm holdings

A non-farm holding is defined as being the one which has neither cultivated nor operated land or has cultivated land less than 0.05 acre.

Tenancy

Owner holdings are those having and operating their owned land and who may or may not be leasing out land.

Tenant holdings are those having no owned land but operating land taken from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Owner-cum-tenant holdings are those having owned land and who may or may not be leasing out their own land to others and who may be taking land from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Agriculture work

Agriculture work signifies all activities of holder and his/her labour force doing planning, management, and operation of a holding. It includes land preparation, sowing, weeding, harvesting, feeding and tending livestock & poultry, kitchen gardening, supervising agricultural workers, keeping farm records & accounts, preparing agriculture products for marketing (including packaging), repairing farm equipment, constructing farm buildings & fences, and engaging in land reclamation and improvement and other related activities. It excludes home and other family domestic chores.

Area under pond

The pond area remains under water almost through out the year. Normally, households use pond water for various domestic and sometimes agriculture purposes. Ponds are also generally used for fish culture.

In the census the pond area data were collected separately for both single ownership and joint ownership of households.

Area under temporary crops

It is the land area planted to crops having growing cycle or length of life less than one year. These are the temporary crops such as paddy, wheat, jute, cotton, tobacco, sugarcane, pulses, oil seeds, potato, vegetables and other seasonal crops. A list of temporary crops for which data were collected separately was given in back page of "Tally Sheet". The minimum area recorded for a temporary crop was 0.01 acre. Area under temporary crops and temporary-crops net area are equivalents.

Area under permanent crops

It is the land area planted to crops which remain standing for a long period of time and do not need to be replanted after a seasonal harvest. Mango, jackfruit, coconut, guava, lemon, and other fruit varieties are all permanent crops.

Current fallow

It is land brought into cultivation but left out uncultivated in census year for fertility regaining and improvement or for other reasons.

Net cultivated area

This is land area actually cropped during the census year regardless of number of crops grown plus current fallow. It includes areas under temporary and permanent crops and also current fallow.

Permanent fallow

It is land not available for cultivation due to coming into residence and commercial & other uses. Play ground, graveyard, wild shrubs and jungles, marshy land, and the like fall in this category.

Irrigated area

This is area of total land brought under irrigation coverage for growing crops with irrigations done through mechanical or manual means. Irrigated area classifications fall into two categories: (1) surface water irrigation with main water sources being rivers, canals, beels, ponds, and other water bodies; and (2) underground water irrigation with water lifted by shallow tube-wells, deep tube-wells, and country traditional devices. The irrigation equipments are run by electricity, diesel or petrol, or manual labour.

Cattle and Buffalo

Cattle and buffalo heads owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Goats and Sheep

Goats and sheep owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Fowls, Ducks and Pigeons

Fowls, ducks, and pigeons owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Temporary crops gross area

Areas aggregated for all temporary crops grown in the census year have made **temporary crops gross area** greater than **temporary crops net area** since the latter has within it the same land cropped more than once in different seasons of a year.

Intensity of cropping

It is percentage of temporary crops gross area in comparison with temporary crops net area. It is expressed as follows:

$$\text{Intensity of cropping} = \frac{\text{Temporary crops gross area}}{\text{Temporary crops net area}} \times 100$$

Cereals

Main cereals are rice and then wheat. Other cereals are jab, barley, cheena, maize, kaun, bajra and joar.

Pulses

Main and common pulses are gram, mung, lentil, arhar, gari kalai, khesari and pea.

Oil seeds

Main oil seeds are rape and mustard, sesamum, linseed, groundnut, soybean, sunflower and castor.

Vegetables

Farmers grow both summer and winter vegetables. Main vegetables are potato, brinjal, raddish, arum, lady's finger, cauliflower, cabbage, bean, tomato, patal, gourd, cucumber, pumpkin, knoll-kal-turnip, dhundal, barbati, khirai, chichinga, carrot, kakrol and sak.

Cash crop

Main cash crops are jute, mesta, sunhemp, cotton, sugarcane and tobacco.

Spices

The main spices include turmeric, ginger, chillies, onion, garlic, corriander, black cumin and ani seed.

Fuel crops

Dhaincha and other smaller plants used as cooking-fuel.
