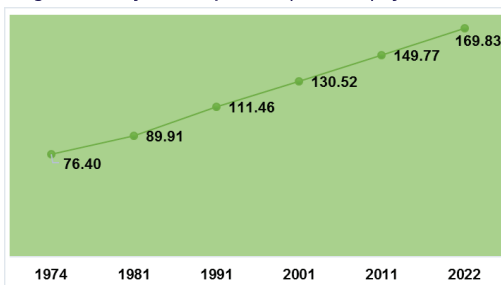

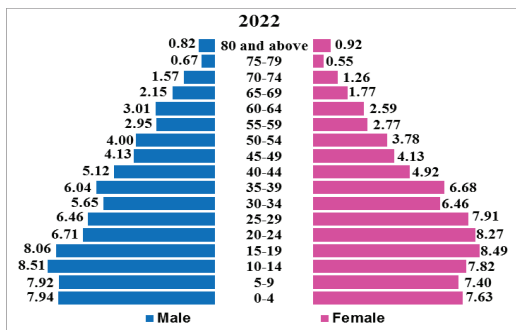

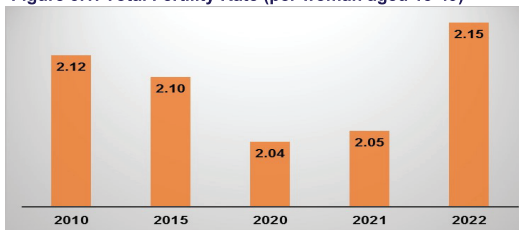

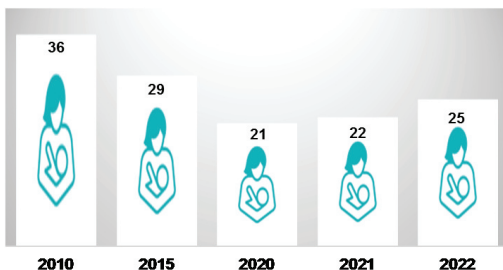

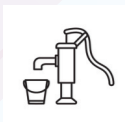

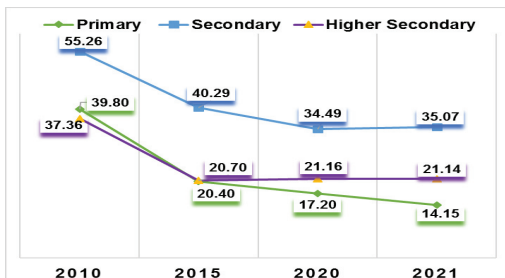

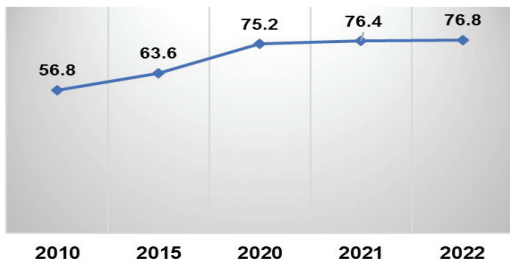

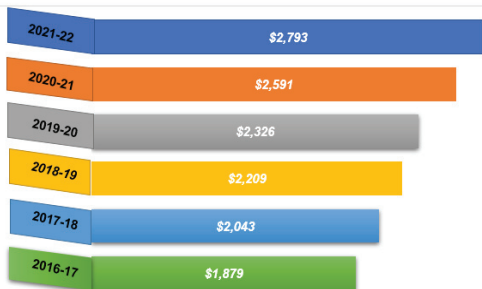

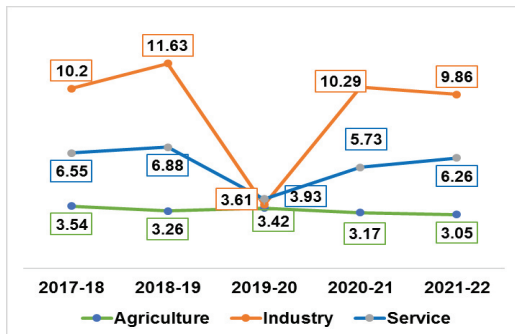

Figure 6.1: Per Capita Income by year



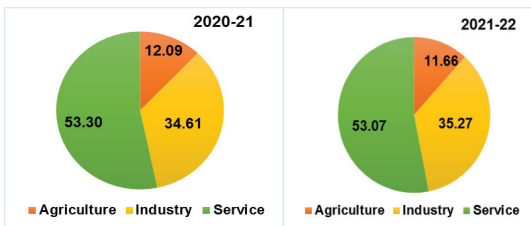

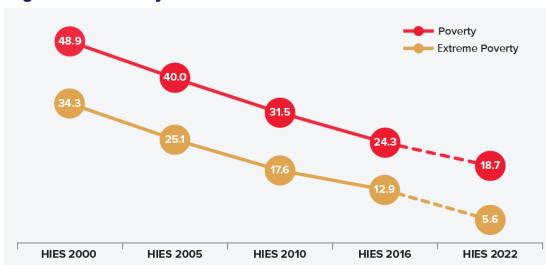

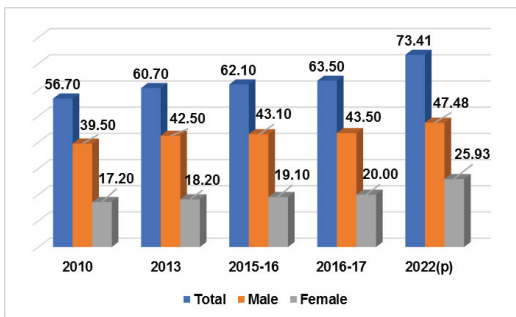

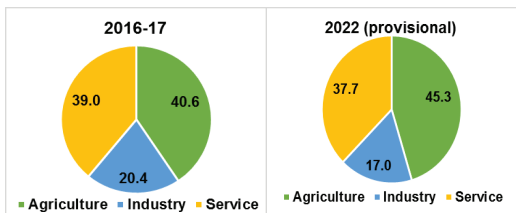

Figure 7.2: Employed by Broad Sector (%)



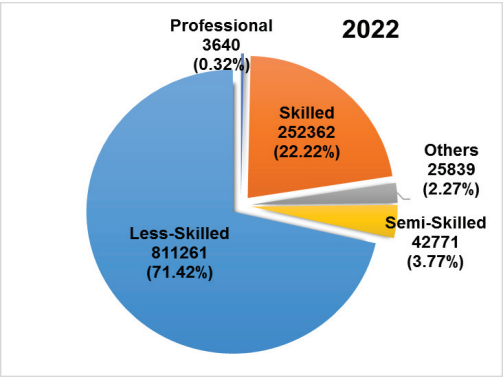

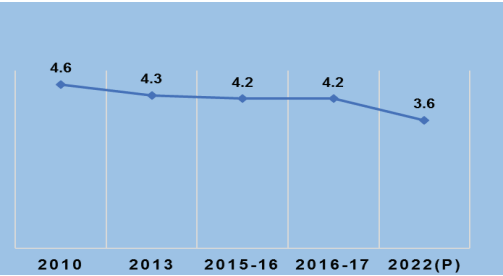

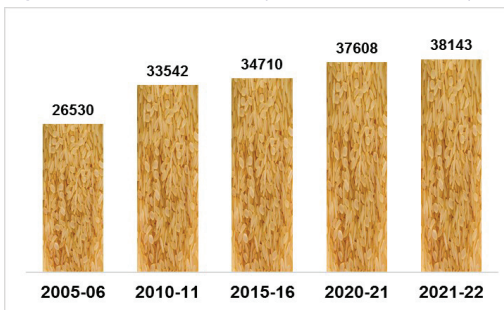

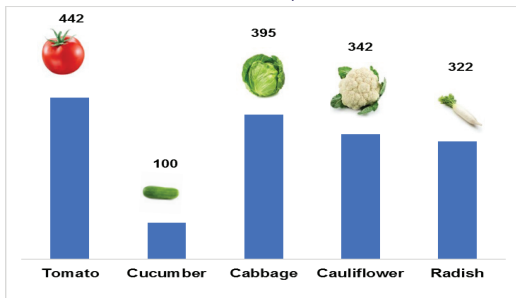

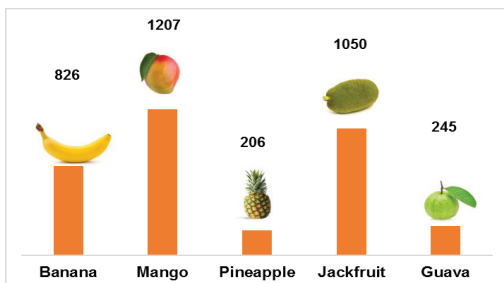

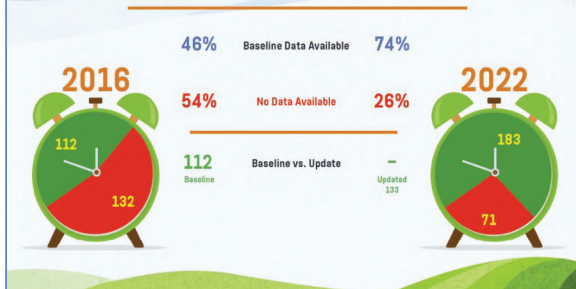

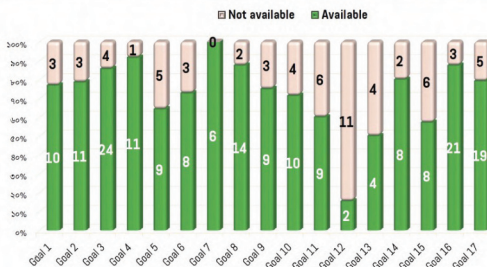
