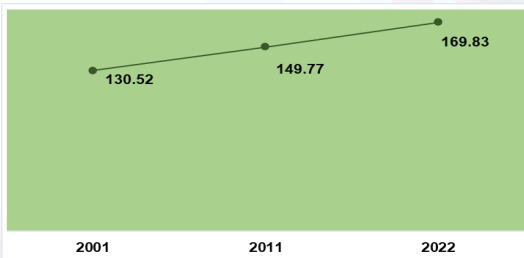

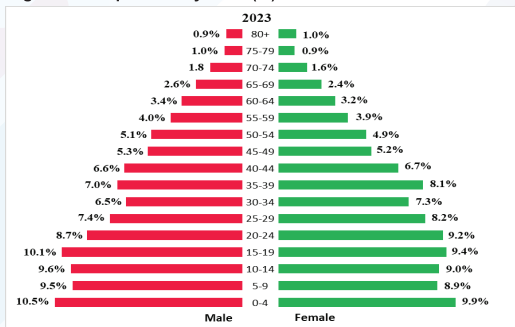

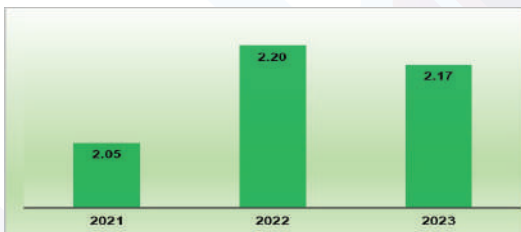

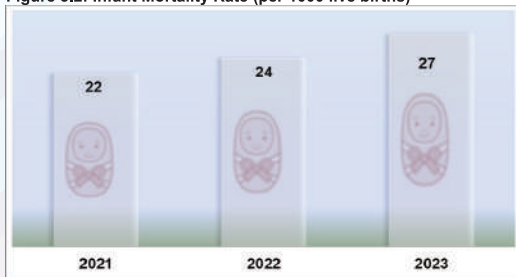

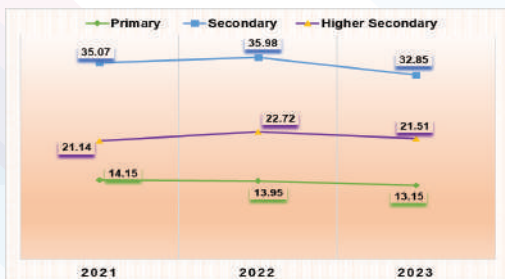

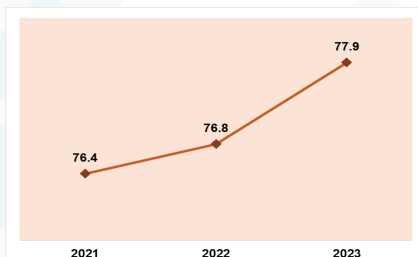

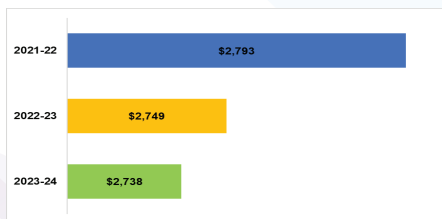

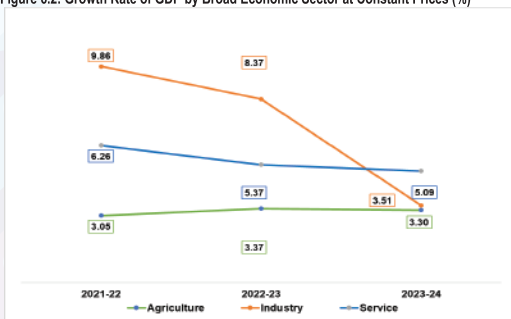

**Figure 6.1: Per Capita Income by year (USD)**



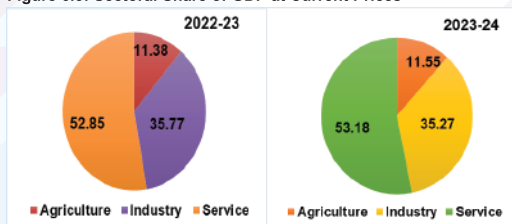

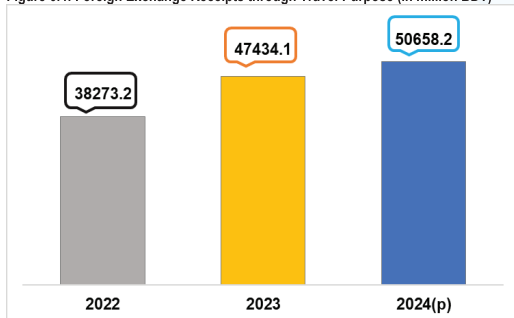

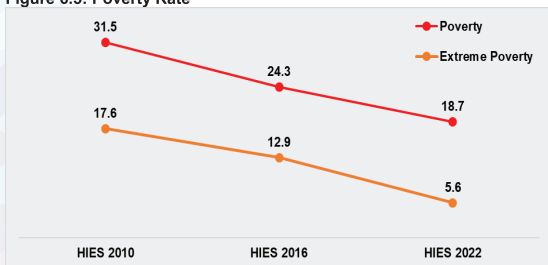

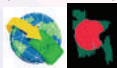

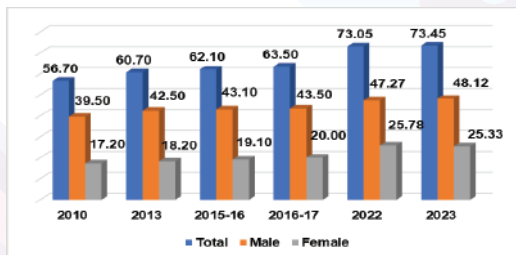

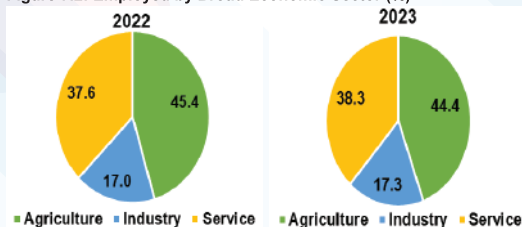

**Figure 7.2: Employed by Broad Economic Sector (%)**



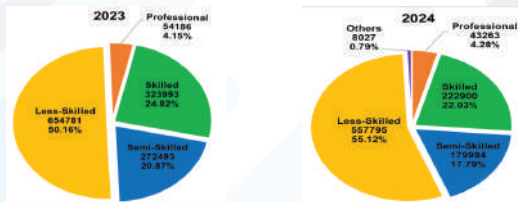

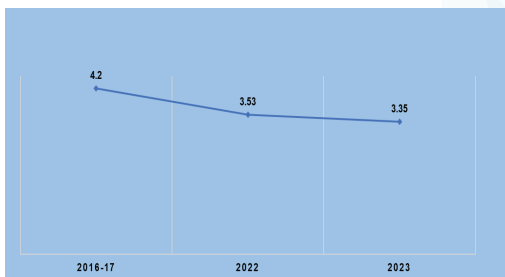

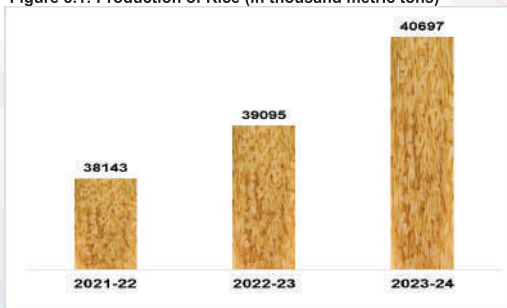

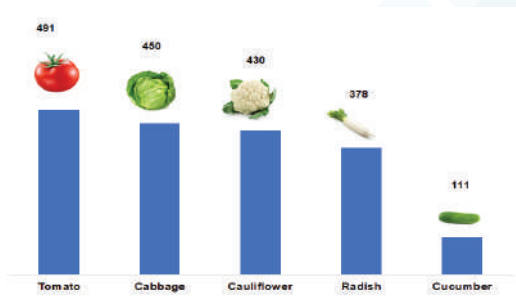

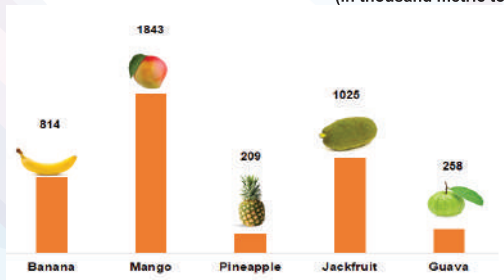

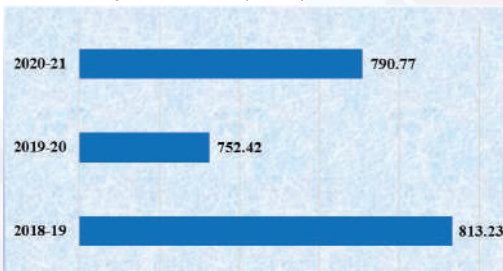

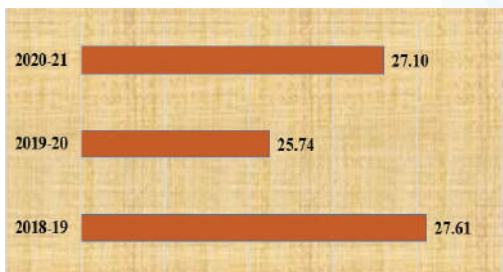
