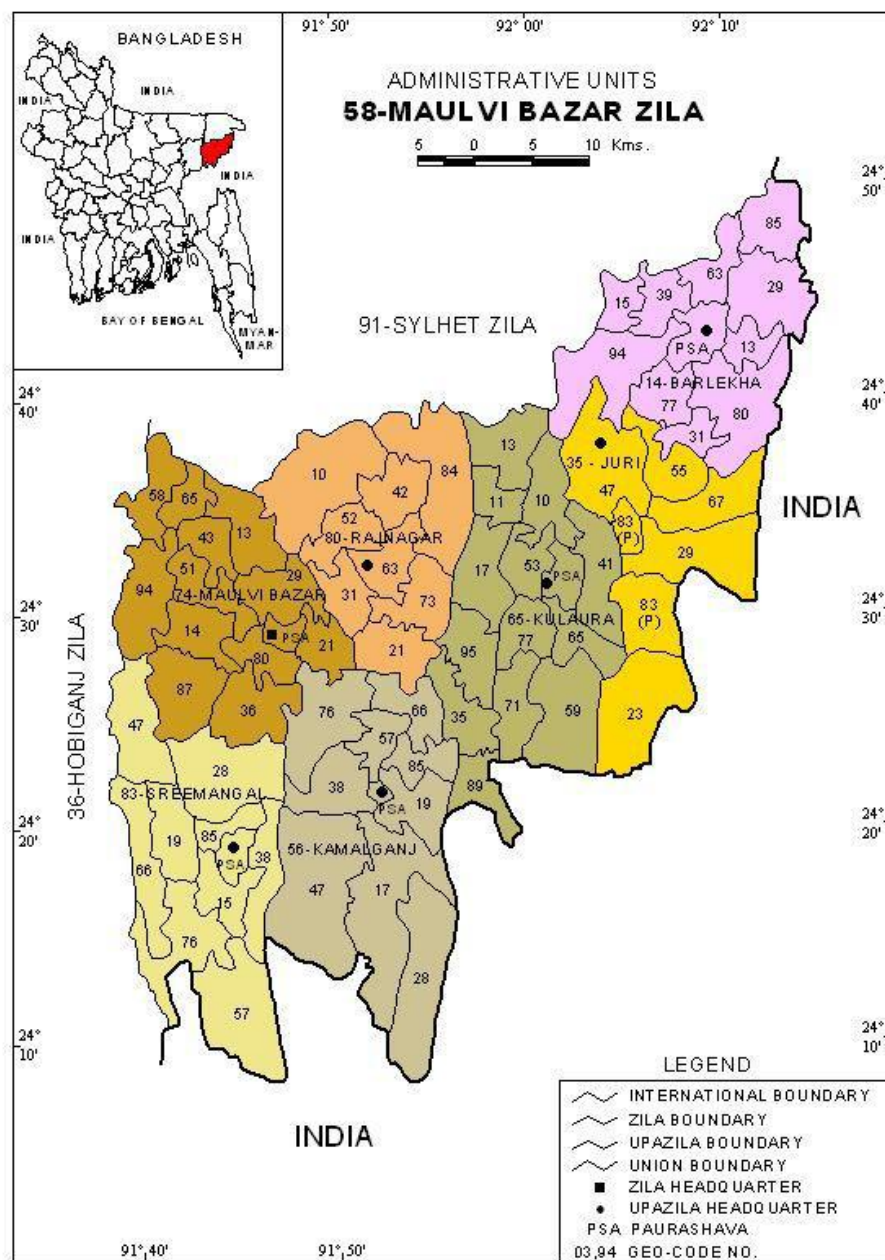

CHAPTER 1

Introduction

District at a Glance

Background: Moulvibazar, one of the sub-divisions of former Sylhet District, was set up in 1882. It is up-graded to a district in 1984. It is generally believed that there lived a man named Maulvi Qudratullah who became prominent for social work. He set up a bazar at the present place of the district headquarters which was named as Maulavibazar after his death. The district might have derived its name from the name of that bazar.

Area and Location: Moulvibazar district is bounded on the north by Sylhet District, on the east by Assam State and Tripura State of India, on the south by Tripura State of India and on the west by Habiganj District. The total area of the district is 2799.38 sq. km. (1080.00 sq. miles) of which 310.41 sq. km. (49.85 sq. miles) is under forest. The district lies between 24° 08' and 24°29' north latitudes and between 91°36' and 92°17' east longitudes.

Temperature and Rainfall: The maximum and minimum temperature in Moulvibazar District varies from 33.2°C to 13.6°C. The annual average rainfall of the district is 3334 mm.

Township: Moulvibazar (Town) stands on the bank of the River Manu. Moulbviazar Municipality was established in 1930. The town has one Circuit House and some Rest Houses. Pashchim Bazar and Chowmuhana are the main commercial centers.

Administration: Moulvibazar subdivision was established in 1882 and was turned into a district in 1984. The district consists of 7 upazilas, 67 unions, 917 mauzas, 2015 villages, 5 paurashavas, 45 wards and 151 mahallas. The upazilas are Baralekha, Kamalganj, Kulaura, Moulvibazar Sadar, Rajnagar, Sreemangal and Juri.

Archaeological Heritage and Relics: Khoja Mosque of Laghati village in Dasher Bazar (Baralekha, 16th century), Madhab Mandir located near the Madhabkunda water fall, Rangirkul Vidyashram (established in the first quarter of 19th century, Kulaura upazila), Nawab Bari of Pritthim Pasha (first quarter of 18th century), Khoja Mosque (14th century, Goiyghar), the temple of Agnian Thakur, Nirmmai Shib-Bari (1454), Gaiyebi Eter Masjid at the premises of the tomb of Kazi Khandker (R), Persian manuscripts of Firoz Shah Tuglak's period (1330 AD), statue of Ananta Narayan (11th century, preserved in the Calcutta Museum) are the important archaeological heritage and relics of this district.

Historical Events: A battle between the great Pathan warrior Khawasa Osman and Raja Subidha Narayan was fought in 1595 at Rajnagar. During the *Sepoy Revolt*, in 1857 some 300 sepoys looted the Chittagong Treasury and took shelter to Gaus Ali Khan, zamindar of Pritthim Pasha. The physiography of the region was seriously changed due to the earthquake of 12 July 1897. In 1921 Deshbandhu Chittaranjan Das, Maulana Hossain Ahmed Madani and Sarojini Naidu attended the Khilafat Conference and inspired people to join the anti-British movement. At that time, Purnendu Kishore Sengupta established the Viddia Aashram at Rangirkul of Kulaura. Beside these, the *Nankar Movement* in 1931-32 and Haor Karaiya Movement in 1968-69 are noted historical events of Moulvibazar. A movement, known as Vanubal Peasant Movement, led by Panchanan Singh,

Kasem Ali, Baikuntha Shawrma and Themba Singh was occurred in 1307 BS. During the **War of Liberation** in 1971 many sanguinary battles took place at Shamsdernagar, Sherpur and other places. Martyr Birsrestha Sipoy **Hamidur Rahman** was killed at village Aambasa (a border-side village of Kamalganj).

Marks of the War of Liberation: There are 6 mass killing sites, 9 mass graves and 6 memorials in the district. In addition North Bharaura (Sreemangal), Kulaura Hospital and Nabinchandra High School were used as torturing centers that bear the testimony of War of Liberation in the district.

Ethnic Origins: Manipuri, Khasia, Tripura, Halam of this group have their own languages are the main ethnic groups found in this district.

Main Crops: Various agricultural crops are grown in the district. Among the rice crops, boro covers the largest area followed by amon and aus, jute, mesta etc. are the mahor cash crops of the district. Other crops include wheat, pulse, oilseed, spices, potato, sweet potato etc.

Main Fruits: Mango (*Mangifera indica*), black berries (*Syzygium cymini*), jackfruits (*Artocarpus heterophyllus*), banana (*Musa sapientum*), coconut (*Cocos nucifera*), orange (*Citrus sinensis*), lichi (*Lichi chinensis*), dates (*Phoenix sylvestris*), guava (*Psidium guajava*), wood apples (*Aegle marmelos*), and palms (*Borassus flabelliter*) grow in this district.

Mineral Resources: Coal, Glass Sand and Lignite have been found in Moulvibazar and Patharia. There is possibility of exploring petroleum and Natural Gas. Exploitation of natural gas is very much hampered due to the blowouts in Magurchhara Gas Field.

Economic Situation: The economy of Moulvibazar district is predominantly agricultural. Out of total 3,09,441 holdings of the district, 58.07% holdings are farms that produce varieties of crops namely local and HYV paddy, pulses, vegetables, spices, cash crops and others. Various fruits like mango, jack fruit, black berry, pineapple, banana, coconut, betel nut, guava, lemon, tamarind, olive, bel, barai, betel leaf etc. are grown. Pineapple, banana, lemon etc. are produced in huge quantity. Moulvibazar district is rich in producing forest products like heavy volume of various kinds of valuable timber trees, large quantity of bamboo of different sorts, cane (bet) and numerous plants that are used for preparing medicine and for fuel. Fish of different varieties are abundant in this district. Varieties of fishes are caught from rivers, rivulets, tributaries, channels, haor, beel, marshi land and even from paddy fields during the rainy season. The district is predominant in tea cultivation. Out of 158 tea gardens of the country, 91 gardens are located in Moulvibazar district.

Non-agricultural activities also play important role in the economy of Moulvibazar district. The following table 1: shows the number of establishments and persons engaged by sex and activity.

Flora and Fauna

Flora: The district is a broad and level valley surrounded on the east by Cachar district of Asam (India) and on the south by the hills of Tripura (India). All these hills are of considerable height. The district is only a few feet above the sea level. It is intersected by numerous tortuous and sluggish rivers and is dotted over with huge sauce like depression in some places. These points are filled with water in the rainy season. Due to the existence of the aforesaid peculiarities trees and plants growing in the district are somewhat different from those growing in most of the other districts of the country.

Moulvibazar is famous for growing tea which is one of the important cash crops and earning a huge amount of foreign exchange. More than 70% of tea gardens of Bangladesh are located in this district. Tea grows in moist and hot climate. It grows on the slope of hills or hilly regions. It requires excessive rain water must not stay at any root. The conditions required for the growth of tea prevail in this district and as such plenty of tea grows here.

The topography and the climate of the district are suitable for the growth of pineapples which is an important juicy fruit of the country. Heavy volume of pineapples is grown here and they serve a substantial part of Bangladesh. The cultivators earn a huge amount of money by selling this delicious fruit.

Mango (*Mangifera indica*), blackberry (*Syzygium cumini*), jack fruit (*Artocarpus heterophyllus*) banana (*Musa sapientum*), coconut (*Cocos nucifera*), orange (*Citrus reticulata*), papaya (*Carica papaya*), date plam/khajur (*Phoenix sylvestris*), lichi (*Litchi chinensis*) water melon, guava (*Psidium guajava*), wood apple/bel (*Limonia acidissima*) and palmyra palm grow in the district. A good varieties of flower

plants like rose (*Rosa hybrida*), palash (*Butea monosperma*), simul (*Bombax ceiba*), christmas, chameli (*Jasminum pubescens*) etc. are found all over the district. There are several small hills covered with green grass and bamboo bushes. Sungrass and bamboo trees are abundant all over the district.

The most valuable timber trees, viz. jarul or ajhar (*Lagerstroemia speciosa*), chaplast; gundroi (*Inamonomum glauduliformum*), kurta (*Sida acuta*), rata (*Dysoxylum binectrariferum*) and poma (*Cerdrela toona*) are largely available in the district, and are used for construction of house and boats, shimul (*Bombax ceiba*), mango (*Mangifera indica*), kada (*Anthocephalees Cadurba*) and harish (*Albizzia stipitata*) are converted into tea boxes. The following trees, viz. shundi (*Mechelin sp*), ping (*Cynometra polejandra*), koroy (*Albizzia procera*), kai (*Dipterocarpus sp*), siturijat (*Enchinocarpus titiacons*) and also black barry (*Syzygium cumini*), gamir (*Citrus limettoides*) marai, kai-eng Banak, jack fruit (*Artocarpus heterophyllus*) trees, haritaky (*Terminalia chebula*), bazang, barun, hizal (*Barringtonia aculangua*) and kuma are also found in abundance in district. Some of these trees and plants normally do not grow in most of the other districts of Bangladesh..

Fauna: About 100 years ago elephants were found in the hilly area of the district. Gradually they turned rare and ultimately vanished. Tigers are also rarely found in the hilly part of the district. Leopards (*Panthera pardus*), wild buffaloes (*Bubalus bubalis*), wild boars (*Sus scrofa*), Sunbar hog, barking deer (*Muntiacus muntjak*), Swamp deer, (*Cervus duvauceli*) are available in the district.

Various kinds of wild birds have increased its beauty. Many birds of different colour, size and habits are found here. Tearing birds like crow (*Corvus splendens*) and kite are found in good number. Game birds namely spotted dove (*Streptopelia chinensis*), pigeon (*Ducula badia*), snipe, heron and pankura (*Phalacrocorac niger*) are found all over the district. Song birds like cuckoo (*Cuculus micropterus*), shyama (*Copsychus malabaricus*), doyel (*Copsychus saularis*), koel (*Eudynamis scolopacea*), mayna (*Seridotheres tristis*) and nightingale (*Phenonotus cafer*), are found in different season. The cuckoo the most popular song bird comes to our country at the beginning of the spring. Many migratory birds come from foreign land during autumn and winter. Hen duck pigeon are the domestic birds found almost every household of the district. Snipe, jungle fowl and marsh partridges are also found.

A large varieties of indigenous fishes including carps and many smaller species are available in the district. Fish is an essential staple and plays a very important role in the economy of the area particularly of the haor area. In the fresh water the popular species are rui (*Labeo rohita*), katal (*Catla catla*), mrigel (*Cirrhinus mrigala*), kalabous (*Labeo calbasu*), airh (*Mystur aor*), ghania (*Labeo gonius*), snail (*Channa stinsus*), boal (*wallagonia attu*), gajar (*Channa marulius*), gulsha (*Mystus bleekeri*), koi (*Anabas testudineus*), shing (*Heteropneustes fossilis*) and magur (*Clarias batrachus*) etc.

Concepts and Definitions

1. Population and Housing Census 2011

The population and housing census is the unique source of reliable and comprehensive data about the size of the population of the country, major socio-economic and socio-demographic characteristics.

It is the total process of collecting, compiling, evaluating, analyzing and publishing or otherwise disseminating demographic, economic and social data pertaining, at a specified time, to all persons in a country. The essential features of a population census are individual enumeration, universality within a defined territory, simultaneity and defined periodicity.

The population and housing census provides information on the geographic and administrative distribution of the population and household in addition to the demographic and socioeconomic characteristics of all the people in the country. The data from the census are classified, tabulated and disseminated so that political leaders, election officials, planners, national organizations including NGOs and civil society, regional and international organizations can use the data in decision-making.

The purpose of community report is to disseminate census data by communities (ward/mahalla in urban area and union/mauza/village in rural area). Data on all key variables namely area, household, population by sex and age group, ethnic population, literacy rate, marital status, school attendance, employment status and religion as well as physical facilities such as source of drinking water, sanitation, electricity and dwelling units have been presented in this report. The planners, researchers and policy makers as well as development partners and community administrators will find this report as a valuable reference for use in advising plans and programs for advancing welfare and well-being of the common people, in particular and the community in general.

Household

Persons, either related or unrelated, living together and taking food from the same kitchen constitute a household. A single person living and eating alone forms one-person household.

Literacy

It denotes ability to write a letter in any language. Literacy status assessment is made for population 7 years and over.

Community

It refers to the following five lower geographic, administrative or revenue units:

- i) **Union:** Smallest administrative rural geographic unit comprising of mauzas and villages and having union parishad institution.
- ii) **Mauza :** Mauza is the lowest administrative unit having a separate jurisdiction list number (J.L. No.) in revenue records. Every mauza has its well-demarcated cadastral map. Mauza should be distinguished from local village since a mauza may consist of one or more villages.
- iii) **Village:** Lowest rural geographic unit either equivalent to a mauza or part of a mauza.
- iv) **Ward:** Smallest administrative urban geographic unit comprising of mahallas and having ward council institution.
- v) **Mahalla:** Lowest urban geographic unit having identifiable boundaries.

Urban Area

It corresponds with area developed around a central place having such amenities as metalled roads, improved communication, electricity, gas, water supply, sewerage, sanitation and also having comparatively higher density of population with majority population in non-agricultural occupations.

i) City Corporation: It includes city corporation area declared by the Ministry of Local Government.

ii) Paurashava/Municipality Area: It includes paurashavas incorporated and administered by local government under Paurashava Ordinance, 1977.

2. Agriculture Census year and reference period

The census year extends over twelve consecutive months having for different census items the different reference periods or days of data collections. Some items have a year or week reference period. Some others have a specific reference day. The different census items by their reference periods or days are shown below:

Agriculture holding

An agriculture holding is a techno-economic unit of agricultural production under single management comprising all livestock kept and all land used wholly or partly for agricultural production purposes without regard to title, legal form or size. Single management may be exercised by either an individual holder or jointly by two or more individuals or holders or by a judicial person such as a corporation, co-operative or government agency. A holding may consist of one or more parcels (fragments of land) located in one or more areas or mauzas or in more than one administrative unit or division provided that all separate parcels of fragments form parts of same technical unit under operational control of same management.

The definition covers practically all holdings/households engaged in agricultural production of both crops and livestock. Some agriculture holdings may have no significant agricultural land, e.g. holdings keeping livestock, poultry and hatcheries for which land is not an indispensable input for production.

Farm holding

A farm holding is defined as being an agricultural production unit having cultivated land equal to or more than 0.05 acres. Farm holdings are classified into following three broad groups:

(a) **small:** Farm holdings having minimum cultivated land 0.05 acre but operated land more than this minimum but upto 2.49 acres.

(b) **medium:** Farm holdings having operated land in between 2.50 to 7.49 acres.

(c) **large:** Farm holdings having operated land 7.50 acres and above.

Small cultivated land 0.04 acre or less is generally used for kitchen garden growing mainly vegetables. Often seeds of white gourd, water gourd, pumpkin and other strains are sown on households; but these creepers spread out around house roofs and other structures. As such, the minimum cultivated land considered for qualifying to be a farm holding is 0.05 acres.

Non-farm holdings

A non-farm holding is defined as being the one which has neither cultivated nor operated land or has cultivated land less than 0.05 acre.

Tenancy

Owner holdings are those having and operating their owned land and who may or may not be leasing out land.

Tenant holdings are those having no owned land but operating land taken from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Owner-cum-tenant holdings are those having owned land and who may or may not be leasing out their own land to others and who may be taking land from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Agriculture work

Agriculture work signifies all activities of holder and his/her labour force doing planning, management, and operation of a holding. It includes land preparation, sowing, weeding, harvesting, feeding and tending livestock & poultry, kitchen gardening, supervising agricultural workers, keeping farm records & accounts, preparing agriculture products for marketing (including packaging), repairing farm equipment, constructing farm buildings & fences, and engaging in land reclamation and improvement and other related activities. It excludes home and other family domestic chores.

Area under pond

The pond area remains under water almost through out the year. Normally, households use pond water for various domestic and sometimes agriculture purposes. Ponds are also generally used for fish culture.

In the census the pond area data were collected separately for both single ownership and joint ownership of households.

Area under temporary crops

It is the land area planted to crops having growing cycle or length of life less than one year. These are the temporary crops such as paddy, wheat, jute, cotton, tobacco, sugarcane, pulses, oil seeds, potato, vegetables and other seasonal crops. A list of temporary crops for which data were collected separately was given in back page of "Tally Sheet". The minimum area recorded for a temporary crop was 0.01 acre. Area under temporary crops and temporary-crops net area are equivalents.

Area under permanent crops

It is the land area planted to crops which remain standing for a long period of time and do not need to be replanted after a seasonal harvest. Mango, jackfruit, coconut, guava, lemon, and other fruit varieties are all permanent crops.

Current fallow

It is land brought into cultivation but left out uncultivated in census year for fertility regaining and improvement or for other reasons.

Net cultivated area

This is land area actually cropped during the census year regardless of number of crops grown plus current fallow. It includes areas under temporary and permanent crops and also current fallow.

Permanent fallow

It is land not available for cultivation due to coming into residence and commercial & other uses. Play ground, graveyard, wild shrubs and jungles, marshy land, and the like fall in this category.

Irrigated area

This is area of total land brought under irrigation coverage for growing crops with irrigations done through mechanical or manual means. Irrigated area classifications fall into two categories: (1) surface water irrigation with main water sources being rivers, canals, beels, ponds, and other water bodies; and (2) underground water irrigation with water lifted by shallow tube-wells, deep tube-wells, and country traditional devices. The irrigation equipments are run by electricity, diesel or petrol, or manual labour.

Cattle and Buffalo

Cattle and buffalo heads owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Goats and Sheep

Goats and sheep owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Fowls, Ducks and Pigeons

Fowls, ducks, and pigeons owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Temporary crops gross area

Areas aggregated for all temporary crops grown in the census year have made **temporary crops gross area** greater than **temporary crops net area** since the latter has within it the same land cropped more than once in different seasons of a year.

Intensity of cropping

It is percentage of temporary crops gross area in comparison with temporary crops net area. It is expressed as follows:

$$\text{Intensity of cropping} = \frac{\text{Temporary crops gross area}}{\text{Temporary crops net area}} \times 100$$

Cereals

Main cereals are rice and then wheat. Other cereals are jab, barley, cheena, maize, kaun, bajra and joar.

Pulses

Main and common pulses are gram, mung, lentil, arhar, gari kalai, khesari and pea.

Oil seeds

Main oil seeds are rape and mustard, sesamum, linseed, groundnut, soybean, sunflower and castor.

Vegetables

Farmers grow both summer and winter vegetables. Main vegetables are potato, brinjal, raddish, arum, lady's finger, cauliflower, cabbage, bean, tomato, patal, gourd, cucumber, pumpkin, knoll-kal-turnip, dhundal, barbati, khirai, chichinga, carrot, kakrol and sak.

Cash crop

Main cash crops are jute, mesta, sunhemp, cotton, sugarcane and tobacco.

Spices

The main spices include turmeric, ginger, chillies, onion, garlic, corriander, black cumin and ani seed.

Fuel crops

Dhaincha and other smaller plants used as cooking-fue
