

Executive Summary

Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics (BBS) compiles and publishes Foreign Trade Statistics (FTS) on a regular basis. This publication presents monthly trend of Bangladesh foreign trade statistics on top trading partners, essential import commodities and last twelve months scenario of major export and import goods especially for November, 2024.

Merchandise trade data of this publication are provided by National Board of Revenue (NBR) while data on services from Bangladesh Bank. Data presented in this publication are provisional and subject to revision. All these provisional data will be subsequently reviewed and revised. Revised data are being presented in next issues.

In for November, 2024 total export and import of goods and services is recorded at decreased by Tk. 564.09 and decreased by Tk. 801.74 billion respectively resulting in a trade deficit at goods and services of Tk. 273.65 billion. The growth of export and import in for October, 2024 decreased by 1.37 and decreased by 19.40 percent respectively comparing to October, 2024 and it decreased by 7.29 and decreased by 12.44 percent respectively comparing to for November, 2023.

For the three months ending for November, 2024 the average of export of goods and services was Tk. 553.66 billion, while the moving average of import of goods and services was Tk. 2343.87 billion resulting in an average trade deficit of Tk.1802.15 billion. For the three months ending October, 2024, the average trade deficit was Tk. 1795.68 billion reflecting average exports of Tk. 545.51 billion and average imports of Tk. 1822.36 billion.

Indicators of this publication are expected to provide a good idea about the trend of export and import of the country over the previous months of a year. This monthly release would be a useful document for planners, policy makers, researchers, development partners/agencies, academicians and other stakeholders.

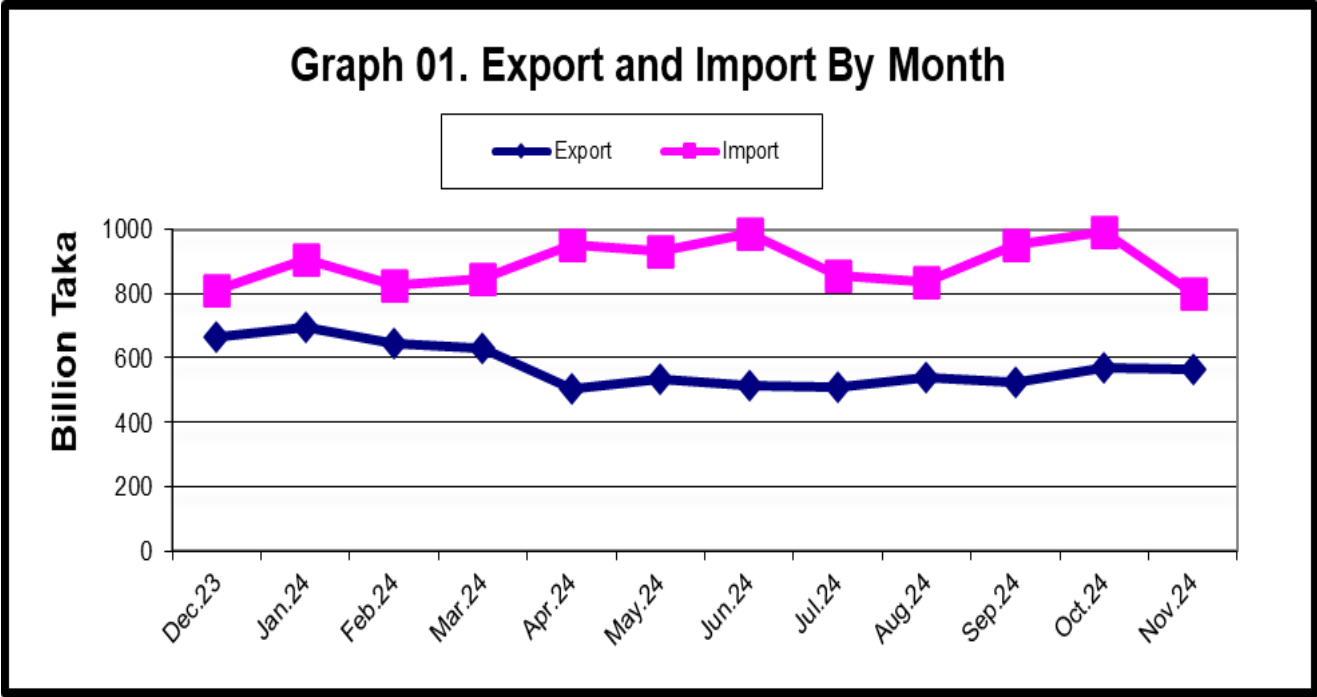

Graph 02. Export and Import By Month

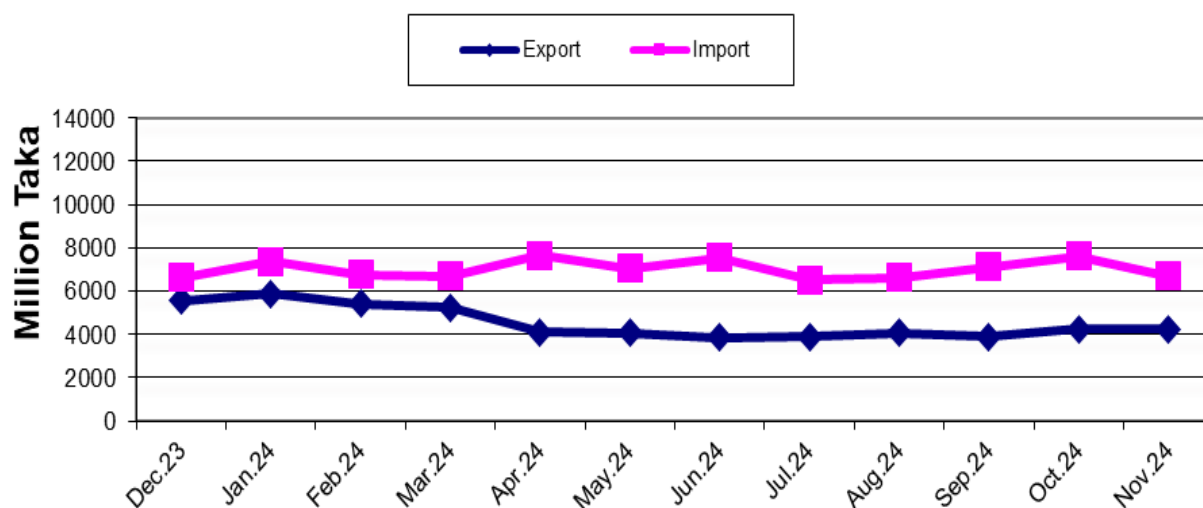

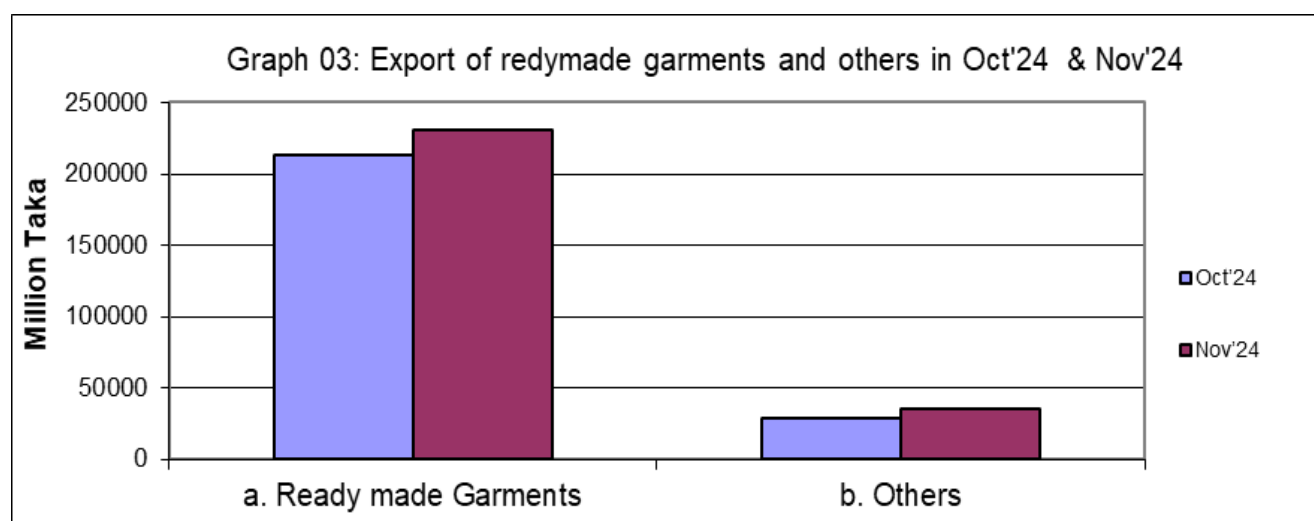

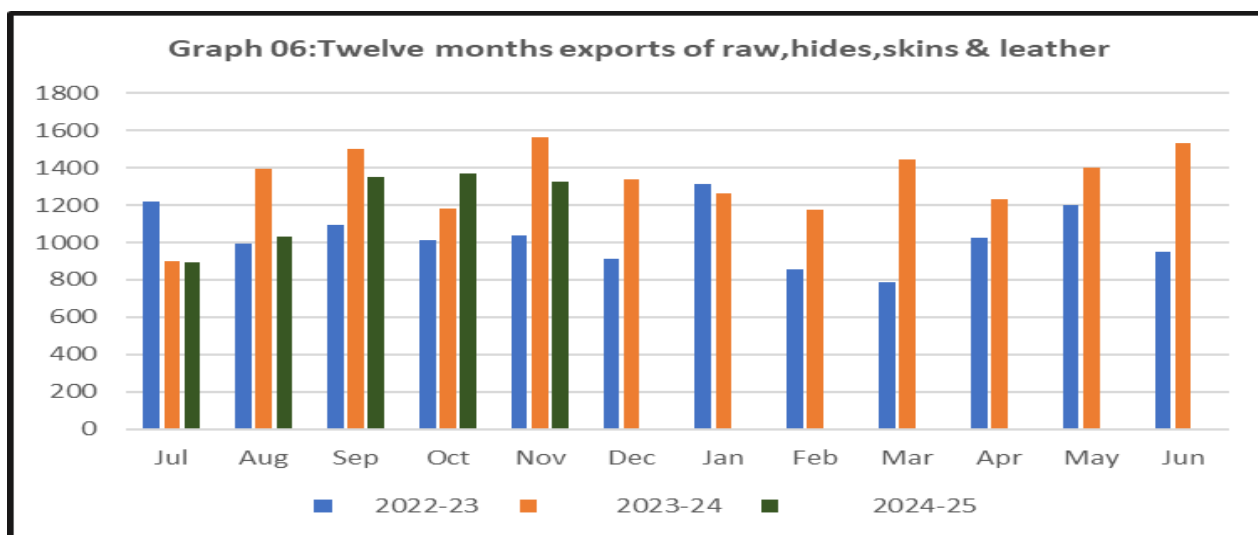

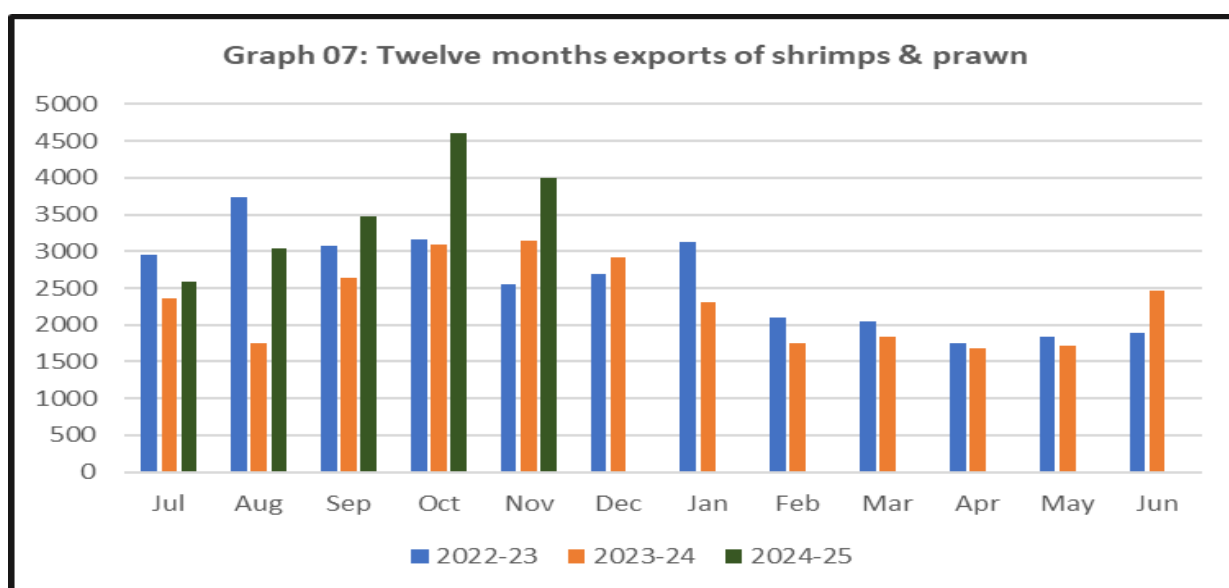

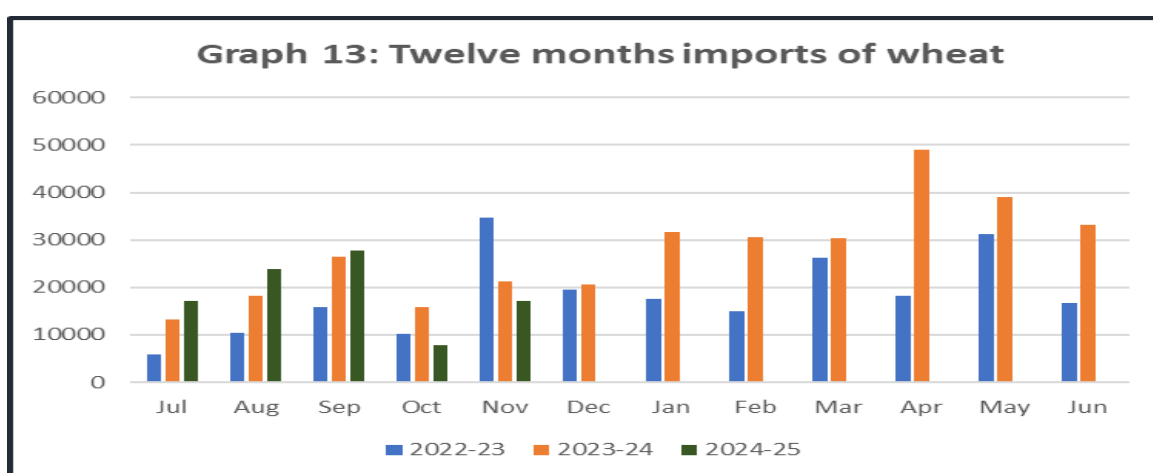

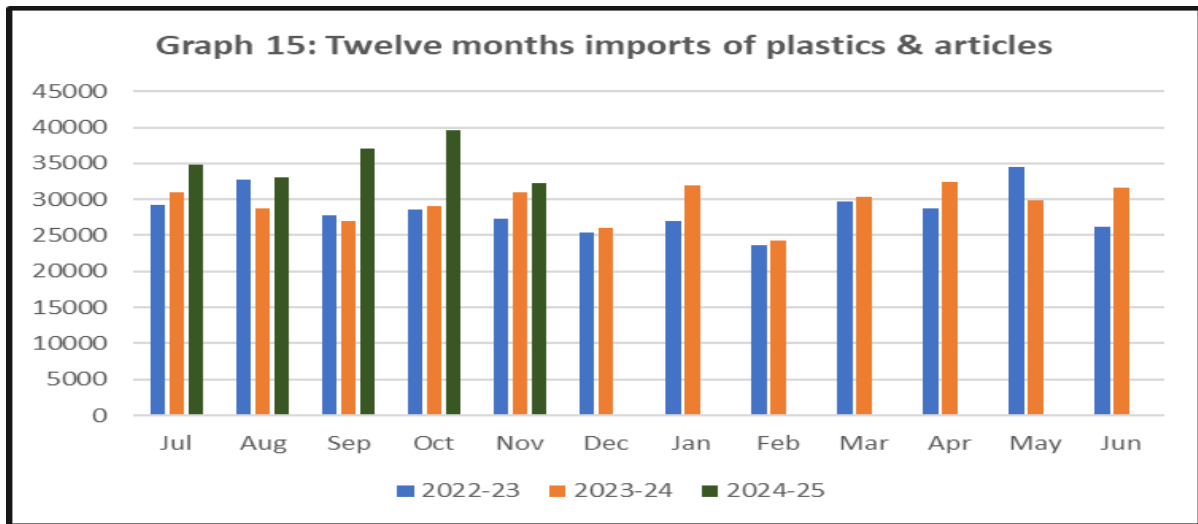
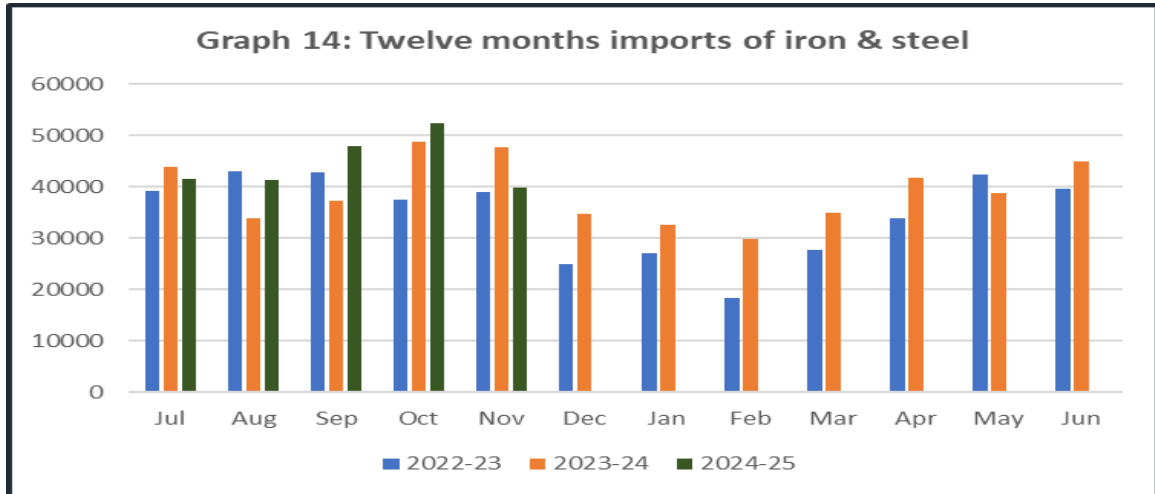

Graph 16: Top trading partners – total trade (goods), November-2024.

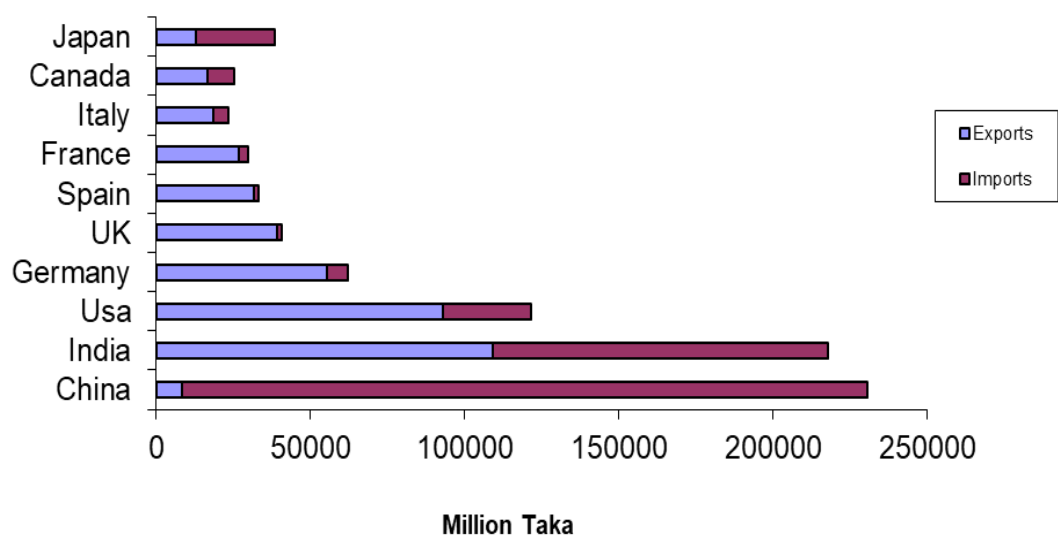
