

CHAPTER 1

Introduction

District at a Glance

Background, Geographic Area and Location: Narsingdi District was previously a sub-division of Dhaka District. It was upgraded to a district in 1984. The popular view on the origin of Narsingdi district name is that about 110 years ago there was lived an influential Zamindar named Narsingha Paul who was well known to the people for his benevolent activities. The district might have derived its name after the name of that Zamindar. The district is bounded on the north by Kishoreganj District, on the east by Kishoreganj and Brahmanbaria Districts, on the south by Brahmanbaria and Narayanganj Districts and on the west by the Gazipur District. It lies between 23°29' and 23°45' north latitudes and 90°10' and 90°43' east longitudes. The total area of the district is 1150.13 sq. km.

Administration: Narsingdi District consists of 6 upazilas, 70 unions, 598 mauzas, 1048 villages, 6 paurashavas, 54 wards and 151 mahallas. The upazilas are Belabo, Monohardi, Narsingdi Sadar, Palash, Raipura and Shibpur.

Climate: The climate of the district is relatively mild both in the summer and the winter. The maximum and minimum mean temperatures during the winter vary from 19°C to 23.7°C. During the summer maximum and minimum mean temperatures vary from 26°C to 29°C. The dry winter season starts from November and continues up to the end of February. Summer comes from mid of March and continues up to the mid of June. The rainfall is generally heavy during July and August. Heavy rainfall occurs during the monsoon. Annual average rainfall of this district 2376 millimeters.

River System: The main rivers flowing through Narsingdi District are the Meghna, the Brahmaputra and the Sitallakhya. Besides these, the Arialkhan, the Horidoa and the Paharia are also important rivers in the district contributing to seasonal water reservoir system and local transportation. The Meghna, the Brahmaputra and the Sitallakhya are navigable throughout the year. The flowing length of the rivers is about 56.46 km. It occupies an area of 78 sq km, which is 6.84% of area of the district. There are high hills with red soil on the northern region of the district.

Soil Condition: The soil of the district is mainly formed with recent and sub recent alluvial sediments of low parts of the old Brahmaputra floodplain and the new Brahmaputra floodplain. Tract upland soil mixed with the old Brahmaputra floodplain is found in the north eastern part of the District. The central part is formed with the ridges and basins of the Brahmaputra floodplain having grey-clay loam. The soil of the southern part of the District is formed by grey silty complex clay for the young Brahmaputra floodplain. The soil condition of the district is very favorable for producing different types of vegetables and high yielding varieties of crops.

Archaeological Heritage and Relics: Silver coin discovered at Wari Batteshwar village (third century AD), Imitated gold coin (eighth century AD) discovered at village Wari, Stone image (Sena period) found at Narsingdi town, Silver coin of Gias Uddin Azam Shah at Algi village, Silver coin (Sultani period) at Panchdona, Three domed mosque (1524) at Ashrafpur, single domed mosque (eighteenth century) and Tomb of Shah Monsur at Kumardi, Bibi Joynab Mosque (1719), Parulia Mosque (1716) are notable archaeological heritage and relics of this district.

Historical Events: During the mass upsurge in 1969, three persons were killed and many wounded on 29 December when police fired indiscriminately on procession at Hatirdia Bazar (Monohardi). Shaheed Asad of 1969 was one of them.

Main Crops: Paddy, jute, wheat, sugarcane, vegetables etc. are main crops of this district.

Main Fruits: Banana, jackfruit, mango, papaya, pineapple, black berry, guava, olive, lotcon, lichi etc. are main crops of this district.

Economic Situation: The economy of Narsingdi is mixed type with agriculture and non-agriculture. Out of total 414,892 holdings, 212,498 holdings (51.22%) are agriculture farm holdings that produce varieties of crops, namely, local, HYV and hybrid rice, wheat, vegetables, jute, spices, cash crops, pulses, oilseeds and others. Various fruits like banana, mango, guava, jackfruit, black berries, coconut, papaya, palm, lichi, dates etc. are grown in the district. Fish of different varieties are caught from rivers, ponds, tributary channels and creeks and even from paddy fields during rainy season. The most common fishes are ruhi, katla, kalbous, magur, singi, pabda, koi etc. Narsingdi is famous for vegetables. Different types of vegetables are grown here. Most of the vegetables available in Dhaka city are from Narsingdi. Besides crops, livestock and fishery are the main source of household income.

Non-farm activities are economically significant in Narsingdi District. The following table-1 shows the number of establishments and persons engaged by activity.

According to above table, there are 61,019 establishments in the district of which 176,983 persons are engaged in different types of non-farm activities. Female participation in non-farm activities is very poor. They constitute about 8.85% females as against 91.15% males. Wholesale & retail trade emerges as the single largest activity with 34,752 establishments (57.0%) and 70,551 persons engaged (39.9%) in those establishments.

Flora: Most of the areas under the Narsingdi District are occupied by compacted, pale brown, sandy soils on the ridges and shallow, dark grey, compact clays overlying sand in the shallow basins. Topsoils are acid when dry but near neutral when flooded. Sub-soils are often slightly acid at the top but all become moderately alkaline below.

Various agricultural crops are grown in the district. Among the rice crops, boro covers the largest area followed by aman and aus. Jute, mesta, jackfruit (*Artocarpus heterophyllus*) etc. are the major cash crops of the district. Other crops include wheat, pulse, oilseed, spices, potato, sweet potato etc. The District is famous for vegetables and banana (*Musa sapientum*). The farmers produce banana (*Musa sapientum*) and different types of vegetables, which meet the local demand and the rest are brought into Dhaka and other cities.

Mango (*Mangifera indica*), black berry (*Syzygium cumini*), jackfruits (*Artocarpus heterophyllus*), banana (*Musa sapientum*), coconut (*Cocos nucifera*), papaya (*Carica papaya*), palm (*Borassus flabellifer*), lichi (*Litchi chinensis*), date (*Phoenix sylvestris*), melon (*Citrullus vulgaris*), guava (*psidium guajava*), wood apples (*Aegle marmelos*) and palms (*Borassus monospermo*) grow in the District. A good variety of flower plants like rose (*Rosa hybrida*), palash (*Butea monosperma*), shimul (*Bombax ceiba*) and chameli (*Jasminum pubescens*) are found all over the District. The bamboo (*Bambusa sp.*) is a good examples of the complex uses to which the commonest flora of the District can be put, but the palms (*Borassus flabellifer*) are equally adaptable from the economic point of view. The trees that grows at homesteads includes kanthal (*Artocarpus integrifolia*), boroi (*Ziziphus virgata*), supari, dalim (*Punica granatum*), sajna, ataphal (*Anona squamosa*), jambura (*Citrus decumana*), lebu (*Citrus carantifolia*), kamranga (*Averrhoa karambola*), gab (*Diospyros precatorius*) etc.

The most valuable timber trees such as koroy (*Albizzia procera*), tamarind (*Tamariandus indica*), chaplasta, gundroi (*Cinnamomum glauduliforum*), kurta (*Sida acuta*), rata (*Dysoxyhum binee tariferum*) and poma (*Cerdrela toona*) are largely available in the district, and are used for construction of house and boats. Simul (*Bobbax ceiba*), mango (*Mangifera indica*), kadam (*Anthocephalus cadamba*) and harish (*Albizzia stipalata*) are used for making boxes. Common wayside trees comprises neem (*Azadirachta indica*), raintree (*Samanca saman*), debdaru (*Polyalathia longifolia*), mehogany (*Swietenia macrophylla*), arjun (*Terminalia arjuna*), kadam (*Anthocephalecs cadarba*), tatul (*Tamariandus indica*), jarul (*Legerstroemia speciosa*), krisnochura (*Delonix regia*), gamar (*Gmelina arborea*) etc. grow here. Besides many aquatic plants like kachuripana (*Telanthera philoxeroides*), khudipana (*Lemnapaucicos tata*), padma (*Nelumbo nucifera*), shapla (*Nymphaea pubescens*), kalmi (*Polygonum*), helencha (*Tilanthera philoxcroides*) and different types floating ferns are found in the shallow ponds, ditches and beels of the district.

Flora and Fauna:

Fauna: Despite importance of ecological integrity and bio-diversity, loss of species and their natural habitats are rapidly increasing in recent years. Bio-diversity is being affected by over exploitation, deforestation, inefficient forest management, agricultural and industrial pollution etc. a proper inventory of the rich biological resources of the country should be made and the economic, social, ecological and ethical values of bio-diversity are yet to be realised and disseminated by all concerned. However, in Narsingdi District, there has been fairly good stocktaking of the vertebrate fauna.

The mammals that are usually found in the Narsingdi District are: Shial (*Canis aureus*), benji (*Herpestes edwardsi*), ban biral (*Felis chaus*), indian pipistrelle (*Pipistrellus coromandra*), tickell's bat (*Hesperoptenus tickellis*), badur (*Rousettus leschenaulti*), three striped palm squirrel (*Funambulus palmarum*), rat (*Bandicota bengalensis*), common house rat (*Rattus rattus*), metho indur (*Mus booduga*), chika (*Suncus murinus*) etc.

The birds that are commonly seen in the district are: Tia (*Psillacula krameri*), kalo kokil (*Eudynamis scolopacea*), tila ghugu (*Streptopelia chinensis*), laxmi pencha (*Tyto alba*), khuruley pencha (*Athene brama*), machranga (*Alcedo atthis*), choto fingey (*Dicurus macrocercus*), bhat shalik (*Acridotheres tristis*), jhuti shalik (*Acridotheres fuscus*), bulbuli (*Picnonotus cafer*), doyel (*Copsychus saularis*), tuntuni (*Orthotomus sutorius*), mautushi (*Nectarinia zeylonica*), charui (*Passer domesticus*), babui (*Ploceus philippinus*), tila munia (*Lonchura punctulata*), sada bok (*Ardea alba*), kana korchey bok (*Ardeola grayii*), lalchil (*Haliastur Indus*), dahuk (*Amaurornis phoenicurus*), choto harial, crow (*Corvus splendens*) etc.

A large number of migratory birds come from abroad during autumn and winter. Some of them are seen in different water bodies of the district. Hen, duck (*Cairina sentulaca*), pigeon (*Columba spp*) are the domestic birds found almost in every household of the District. Snipe, jungle fowl and marsh partridges are also found.

There are different varieties of poisonous snakes such as the krait and poisonous water snakes (*Enhydris enhydris*), cobra (*Naja naja*) is now rarely found in the district. Lizards (*Hemidactylus brooki*) and guisaps of all the sizes inhabit in patches of jungle even in towns.

Fish is an essential staple and plays a very important role in the economy of the locality. Most of the ponds, beels, ditches, marshy lands, and rivers abound in fish. A large variety of indigenous fishes including carps and many smaller species are available in the District. In the fresh water the popular species are ruhi (*Labeo rohita*), katla (*Catla catla*), mrigal (*Cirrhinus mrigala*), kalboush (*Labeo calbasu*), airh (*Mystus aor*), gonia (*Labeo gonius*), shoil (*Channa striatus*), boal (*Wallagonia attu*), gozar (*Channa marulias*), golsha (*Mystus bleekeri*), koi (*Anabas testudineus*), shing (*Heteropneustes fossilis*) and magur (*Clarias batrachus*), pabda (*Ompok bimaculatus*), puti (*Barbus puntius*) etc.

In addition, few exotic varieties of fish like tilapia (*Oreochromis mossambicus*), nilotica (*Oreochromis niloticus*), grass carp (*Ctenopharyngodon idella*), silver carp (*Hypophthalmichthys molitrix*), etc. are now being cultivated in the village ponds in the district.

Concepts and Definitions

1. Population and Housing Census 2011

The population and housing census is the unique source of reliable and comprehensive data about the size of the population of the country, major socio-economic and socio-demographic characteristics.

It is the total process of collecting, compiling, evaluating, analyzing and publishing or otherwise disseminating demographic, economic and social data pertaining, at a specified time, to all persons in a country. The essential features of a population census are individual enumeration, universality within a defined territory, simultaneity and defined periodicity.

The population and housing census provides information on the geographic and administrative distribution of the population and household in addition to the demographic and socioeconomic characteristics of all the people in the country. The data from the census are classified, tabulated and disseminated so that political leaders, election officials, planners, national organizations including NGOs and civil society, regional and international organizations can use the data in decision-making.

The purpose of community report is to disseminate census data by communities (ward/mahalla in urban area and union/mauza/village in rural area). Data on all key variables namely area, household, population by sex and age group, ethnic population, literacy rate, marital status, school attendance, employment status and religion as well as physical facilities such as source of drinking water, sanitation, electricity and dwelling units have been presented in this report. The planners, researchers and policy makers as well as development partners and community administrators will find this report as a valuable reference for use in advising plans and programs for advancing welfare and well-being of the common people, in particular and the community in general.

Household

Persons, either related or unrelated, living together and taking food from the same kitchen constitute a household. A single person living and eating alone forms one-person household.

Literacy

It denotes ability to write a letter in any language. Literacy status assessment is made for population 7 years and over.

Community

It refers to the following five lower geographic, administrative or revenue units:

- i) **Union:** Smallest administrative rural geographic unit comprising of mauzas and villages and having union parishad institution.
- ii) **Mauza :** Mauza is the lowest administrative unit having a separate jurisdiction list number (J.L. No.) in revenue records. Every mauza has its well-demarcated cadastral map. Mauza should be distinguished from local village since a mauza may consist of one or more villages.
- iii) **Village:** Lowest rural geographic unit either equivalent to a mauza or part of a mauza.
- iv) **Ward:** Smallest administrative urban geographic unit comprising of mahallas and having ward council institution.
- v) **Mahalla:** Lowest urban geographic unit having identifiable boundaries.

Urban Area

It corresponds with area developed around a central place having such amenities as metalled roads, improved communication, electricity, gas, water supply, sewerage, sanitation and also having comparatively higher density of population with majority population in non-agricultural occupations.

i) City Corporation: It includes city corporation area declared by the Ministry of Local Government.

ii) Paurashava/Municipality Area: It includes paurashavas incorporated and administered by local government under Paurashava Ordinance, 1977.

2. Agriculture Census year and reference period

The census year extends over twelve consecutive months having for different census items the different reference periods or days of data collections. Some items have a year or week reference period. Some others have a specific reference day. The different census items by their reference periods or days are shown below:

Agriculture holding

An agriculture holding is a techno-economic unit of agricultural production under single management comprising all livestock kept and all land used wholly or partly for agricultural production purposes without regard to title, legal form or size. Single management may be exercised by either an individual holder or jointly by two or more individuals or holders or by a judicial person such as a corporation, co-operative or government agency. A holding may consist of one or more parcels (fragments of land) located in one or more areas or mauzas or in more than one administrative unit or division provided that all separate parcels of fragments form parts of same technical unit under operational control of same management.

The definition covers practically all holdings/households engaged in agricultural production of both crops and livestock. Some agriculture holdings may have no significant agricultural land, e.g. holdings keeping livestock, poultry and hatcheries for which land is not an indispensable input for production.

Farm holding

A farm holding is defined as being an agricultural production unit having cultivated land equal to or more than 0.05 acres. Farm holdings are classified into following three broad groups:

(a) **small:** Farm holdings having minimum cultivated land 0.05 acre but operated land more than this minimum but upto 2.49 acres.

(b) **medium:** Farm holdings having operated land in between 2.50 to 7.49 acres.

(c) **large:** Farm holdings having operated land 7.50 acres and above.

Small cultivated land 0.04 acre or less is generally used for kitchen garden growing mainly vegetables. Often seeds of white gourd, water gourd, pumpkin and other strains are sown on households; but these creepers spread out around house roofs and other structures. As such, the minimum cultivated land considered for qualifying to be a farm holding is 0.05 acres.

Non-farm holdings

A non-farm holding is defined as being the one which has neither cultivated nor operated land or has cultivated land less than 0.05 acre.

Tenancy

Owner holdings are those having and operating their owned land and who may or may not be leasing out land.

Tenant holdings are those having no owned land but operating land taken from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Owner-cum-tenant holdings are those having owned land and who may or may not be leasing out their own land to others and who may be taking land from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Agriculture work

Agriculture work signifies all activities of holder and his/her labour force doing planning, management, and operation of a holding. It includes land preparation, sowing, weeding, harvesting, feeding and tending livestock & poultry, kitchen gardening, supervising agricultural workers, keeping farm records & accounts, preparing agriculture products for marketing (including packaging), repairing farm equipment, constructing farm buildings & fences, and engaging in land reclamation and improvement and other related activities. It excludes home and other family domestic chores.

Area under pond

The pond area remains under water almost through out the year. Normally, households use pond water for various domestic and sometimes agriculture purposes. Ponds are also generally used for fish culture.

In the census the pond area data were collected separately for both single ownership and joint ownership of households.

Area under temporary crops

It is the land area planted to crops having growing cycle or length of life less than one year. These are the temporary crops such as paddy, wheat, jute, cotton, tobacco, sugarcane, pulses, oil seeds, potato, vegetables and other seasonal crops. A list of temporary crops for which data were collected separately was given in back page of "Tally Sheet". The minimum area recorded for a temporary crop was 0.01 acre. Area under temporary crops and temporary-crops net area are equivalents.

Area under permanent crops

It is the land area planted to crops which remain standing for a long period of time and do not need to be replanted after a seasonal harvest. Mango, jackfruit, coconut, guava, lemon, and other fruit varieties are all permanent crops.

Current fallow

It is land brought into cultivation but left out uncultivated in census year for fertility regaining and improvement or for other reasons.

Net cultivated area

This is land area actually cropped during the census year regardless of number of crops grown plus current fallow. It includes areas under temporary and permanent crops and also current fallow.

Permanent fallow

It is land not available for cultivation due to coming into residence and commercial & other uses. Play ground, graveyard, wild shrubs and jungles, marshy land, and the like fall in this category.

Irrigated area

This is area of total land brought under irrigation coverage for growing crops with irrigations done through mechanical or manual means. Irrigated area classifications fall into two categories: (1) surface water irrigation with main water sources being rivers, canals, beels, ponds, and other water bodies; and (2) underground water irrigation with water lifted by shallow tube-wells, deep tube-wells, and country traditional devices. The irrigation equipments are run by electricity, diesel or petrol, or manual labour.

Cattle and Buffalo

Cattle and buffalo heads owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Goats and Sheep

Goats and sheep owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Fowls, Ducks and Pigeons

Fowls, ducks and pigeons owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Temporary crops gross area

Areas aggregated for all temporary crops grown in the census year have made **temporary crops gross area** greater than **temporary crops net area** since the latter has within it the same land cropped more than once in different seasons of a year.

Intensity of cropping

It is percentage of temporary crops gross area in comparison with temporary crops net area. It is expressed as follows:

$$\text{Intensity of cropping} = \frac{\text{Temporary crops gross area}}{\text{Temporary crops net area}} \times 100$$

Cereals

Main cereals are rice and then wheat. Other cereals are jab, barley, cheena, maize, kaun, bajra and joar.

Pulses

Main and common pulses are gram, mung, lentil, arhar, gari kalai, khesari and pea.

Oil seeds

Main oil seeds are rape and mustard, sesamum, linseed, groundnut, soybean, sunflower and castor.

Vegetables

Farmers grow both summer and winter vegetables. Main vegetables are potato, brinjal, raddish, arum, lady's finger, cauliflower, cabbage, bean, tomato, patal, gourd, cucumber, pumpkin, knoll-kal-turnip, dhundal, barbati, khirai, chichinga, carrot, kakrol and sak.

Cash crop

Main cash crops are jute, mesta, sunhemp, cotton, sugarcane and tobacco.

Spices

The main spices include turmeric, ginger, chillies, onion, garlic, corriander, black cumin and ani seed.

Fuel crops

Dhaincha and other smaller plants used as cooking-fuel.
