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Foreward

As a National Statistical Office (NSO), Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics (BBS) is entrusted to the compilation of Producer Price Index (PPI) and has recently accomplished the revision and rebasing of the PPI under Improvement of GDP Compilation and Rebasing of Indices Project. For documentation of rebasing activities BBS has prepared a handbook namely 'Revision and Rebasing of Producer Price Index (PPI) from 2005-06 to 2015-16 (Sources and Methods)'. This document could be used as an independent reference on the detail concepts, terminology, and detailed structure of manufacturing activities, data sources. It discusses the revised and updated methodology for the PPI compilation based on current practices and recent development in the index. The updated methodology described in this handbook that are internationally comparable aims at facilitating the future compilers of PPI and national accounts statistics and the users of different manufacturing units in its scope.

In price statistics Producer Price Index is a key economic indicator in most countries and used for a varieties of different purposes. It is a general public interest in knowing the extent to which the prices of goods produced domestically have risen. It is a useful tool to adjust the level of wages, pensions and payments in long term contract escalation. It measures the inflation of domestically produced goods which helps designing policies to control inflation. Besides, PPI is used as an important deflator for national accounts compilation. So it is important to update the weights for PPI compilation and sample of establishments in order to reflect the real price changes at producer level. BBS has revised and rebased the Producer Price Index related to industrial goods. We hope that the use of revised indices will improve the accuracy of estimated gross value added of different economic sector.

I would like to convey my thanks to Mr. Ziauddin Ahmed, Director, National Accounting Wing and Project Director, Improvement of GDP Compilation and Rebasing of Indices Project, BBS for his continuous monitoring and coordination in bringing out this document timely. I extend my thanks to his colleagues involve in the process with special recognition.

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Preface

Producer Price Index (PPI) as a high frequency indicator that plays an important role in the reflection of economic performance over time. It measures the rate of change in the prices of goods and services brought and sold by producers. It serves the needs of different users. Its measurement is classified by industrial products like consumer goods, capital goods, intermediate goods. A vital use of PPI is as a deflator of nominal values of output or intermediate consumption of production volumes and for the deflation of nominal values. PPI is a composite indicator that measures the short term changes in the price of a basket of industrial products during a given period with respect to that in a chosen base period. The base year is fixed at 2015-16, i.e. the year was assigned an index level of 100.

Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics (BBS) compiles and publishes PPI monthly on a regular basis. Since the production structure of the different sector changes with the continuous process of industrialization, it is important to revise and rebase the underlying indices with a regular interval. From this point of view, BBS took the initiative for revision and rebasing the PPI from base year 2005-06 to 2015-16 under Improvement of GDP Compilation and Rebasing of Indices Project. This report is developed as a part of documentation of the sources and methods of revision and rebasing of indices and take into account other recently revised international standards and recommendations.

Information incorporated in this report is expected to be useful widely to the concerned policy makers, planners, researchers in general and to compilers of national accounts statistics of Bangladesh in particular.

I express my deep gratitude to Mr. Md. Matiar Rahman. Director General, Bangladesh Bureau of statistics for his valuable suggestions and guidance to complete the task properly in due time.

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Chapter-01

Introduction

Producer Price Index (PPI) is a key economic indicator in most countries. Price index is a measure of the proportionate or percentage changes in a set of prices over time. Such measures are distinguished from changes in the volume of domestic production and such changes are in nominal term. Compilation of Gross Domestic Product (GDP) is one of the core activities of Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics (BBS). For compilation of GDP, all economic activities of Bangladesh are classified into 19 industrial sectors following International Standard Industrial Classification (ISIC), Rev.4. Manufacturing is one of the most important sectors of the national economy. In order to measure the real growth of estimated gross value added (GVA) of manufacturing sector, it is important to eliminate the effect of price fluctuation from the estimate and to estimate GVA at constant price. In this case, PPI is the most appropriate index that can be used as a deflator to obtain GVA at constant price. A monthly detailed industry data allows short term price inflation to be monitored through price indices. Users also need the data to look at the price pressures that different sectors of the economy are facing. PPI is compiled to monitor the price changes in producer level for domestically produced commodities in the economy. Considering its importance, BBS generally strives for the rebasing of base year and revision of the coverage and methodology once at every ten year.

Two basic questions are the focus on price indices:

1. Exactly what sets of prices should be covered by the index?
2. What is the most suitable way in which to average their movement?

2) Historical Background and Origins of Price Indices:

A very early example is a simple index compiled by William Fleetwood in 1707, which was intended to estimate the average change in the prices paid by Oxford University students over the previous two and a half centuries. Another 18th century example is an index compiled by the legislature of Massachusetts in 1780 in order to index the pay of soldiers fighting in the Revolutionary War against England.

During the 19th century, interest in price indices gathered momentum. In 1823 Joseph Lowe published a study on agriculture, trade, and finance in which he developed the concept of a price index as the change in the monetary value of a selected set, or basket, of goods and services, an approach still used today. He also noted the various uses for a price index, such as the linking

of wages and rents, and the calculation of real interest. Diewert (1993a) argues that Lowe can be considered “the father of the consumer price index.”

Following World War II, a number of countries began collection of data on wholesale prices of commodities in an effort to measure price changes at an earlier level in the production process. Around 1970, Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union (EU), began a systematic program to encourage members to collect industrial output prices in an effort to get information on prices as products left producers’ factories. These price indices were thus called producer price indices (PPIs) because they attempted to measure the change in prices producers received at the factory gate.

3) Producer Price Index, Bangladesh Perspective

Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics (BBS) compiles Producers Price Index along with Index of Industrial Production (IIP) on a regular basis. The first official series of PPI compiled and released by BBS was for the base year 1988-89 (Source: Statistical Yearbook). The next revision was for the base year 2005-06. Very recently BBS has further revised and rebased the PPI to the base year 2015-16.

Current practice of BBS is to compile and publish monthly PPIs on the basis of fiscal years (i.e. July to June). Producer prices are collected for about 143 industrial class levels through field visits of BBS personnel to the sample establishments in every month. Corresponding weights for different items are determined using information on the gross value added obtained from the Survey of Manufacturing Industries (SMI) 2019 and the Cottage Industries Survey 2011.

4) Uses of the PPI: The major uses of PPI could be furnished as follows:

1. The key users of the PPIs as a short-term indicator are the central Bank, Government finance ministry or department. Other organizations such as investment bank, brokerage firms, and government agencies use PPI data for macroeconomic forecasting.
2. A vital use of the PPIs is as deflator of output or sales data for the compilation of production volumes and the deflation of capital expenditure and inventory data for use in the National Accounts.
3. Indexation is common in long term contract as an adjustment to the value of monetary amount for the goods based on the increase or decrease in the level of a price index.

4. International organizations such as Eurostat, the OECD, IMF and European, central bank are required to produce PPI data at a detailed level of aggregation under the short-term indicators for economic monitoring and comparison. The PPI is a required indicator for subscribing to the IMF Special Data Dissemination Standard (SDDS) as a useful extension of inflation measurement in the IMF-General Data Dissemination Standard (GDDS).
5. Current Cost Accounting is a method of accounting for the use of assets (capital goods, consumer goods, intermediate inputs). It is used not only in low inflation but also in high inflation countries for estimating the current value of the capital assets.
6. PPI is used as an analytical tool for business and researchers in examining competitive pressure by looking at specific industry class and market.

5) Rational for Revision and Rebasing of PPI

Bangladesh has a fast growing industry sector and the base year of existing Producer Price Index compiled by BBS was too old (2005-06) to reflect the price changes properly and also the basket used for compilation of PPI was not likely to represent the production structure of the economy. Moreover, in BBS the base year for compilation of Gross Domestic Product (GDP) is 2015-16. Since it is desirable that the indices used for compilation of GDP should be of the same base year as GDP, National Accounting Wing of BBS undertook the initiative to revise and rebase different indices to the base year 2015-16. In the meantime, Index of Industrial Production (IIP) has been rebased from 2005-06 to the base year 2015-16. In order to derive an updated and more comprehensive Producer Price Index, it is felt that the commodities used for compiling PPI should be revised and the base year should also be shifted to a more recent year, preferably 2015-16. From these point of view, BBS undertook the initiative for revision and rebasing the PPI following international guideline (*Producer Price Index Manual, ILO and others, 2004*).

6) Selection of Base year

The base period is generally understood to be the period against which other period are compared and values provide the weights for an index. Therefore, the weight reference period possesses the following characteristics: (a) reasonably normal/stable; (b) typical of recent or likely future year; (c) not too distant from the reference period and (d) clearly identified when analyzing and comparing the index results.

As already mentioned earlier that the conventional Laspeyres formula will be used for compilation of Producer Price Index, one of the key issues arises for availability of information for the base year to determine weighting pattern for PPI. So far the Survey of Manufacturing Industries (SMI)

is the main source in BBS for the required information which is available for the year 2019. Moreover, the base year for Index of Industrial Production and Gross Domestic Product (GDP) is 2015-16 in BBS. Considering the availability of information from SMI, Cottage industry Survey and requirement for GDP estimation, the Technical Committee of National Accounts Statistics and the International Monetary Fund (IMF) mission recommend choosing 2015-16 as the base year for revised PPI.

7) International and National Recommendations and Guidelines used for the compilation of Producer Price Index (PPI): The United Nations Statistics Division (UNSD) has issued the two following related publications which address the international standard recommendations and guidelines and these are followed for underlying compilation of Producer Price Index (PPI) as updated standard.

1. The International Standard Industrial Classification (ISIC) Rev.4 is the latest version of Classification that is used to define industrial production for international comparability. Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics has prepared its activities classifications at detailed levels entitled Bangladesh Standard Industrial Classification (BSIC) fitted into ISIC and adapted this system of classification as national standard.
2. The International Monetary Fund's Producer Price Index Manual 2004 describes the related fundamental concepts, definitions, principles, methods in great detail to obtain industrial item price, sources of data, compilation procedure and additional compilations issues as like revision and shifting of base year.
3. The System of National Accounts 2008 is linked to the PPI Calculation.

8) Guidelines in the rebase and revision of PPI: This section provides steps which outlines by topic to facilitate quick reference.

- 1) **Statistical Unit:** The statistical unit to compile Producer Price Index (PPI) is the establishment.
- 2) **Industrial Classification:** The manufacturing sectors in broad economic structure under ISIC Rev.4 includes the 23 (twenty-three) divisions namely
 - i) Food products, ii) Beverage, iii) Tobacco Products, iv) Textile, v) wearing apparel (Readymade garments), vi) Leather and related Products, vii) Wood and products of wood and cork except furniture, articles of straw and plaiting materials viii) Paper and paper products, ix) Printing and reproduction of printing media, x) Coke and Refined petroleum products, xi) chemicals and chemical products xii) pharmaceuticals, medicinal chemical and botanical products, xiii) Rubber and plastics products, xiv) other non-metallic mineral products, xv) basic metals xvi) fabricated metal products

except machinery and equipment, xvii) Computer, electronic and optical products, xviii) Electrical equipment, xix) Machinery and equipment n.e.c, xx) Motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers, xxi) Other transport equipment, xxii) Furniture, xxiii) Other manufacturing.

- 3) **Determination of weights for PPI at the industry level of Index:** Weights are key element in the construction of a PPI. Producer Price Index (PPI) is calculated from many prices collected from all types of establishments covering the selected economic activities and products. Weights for PPI are mainly derived using information on contribution to value added from the Survey of Manufacturing Industries (SMI) 2019 and the Cottage Industry Survey 2011 reports. Gross value added at basic prices data is recommended as weighting variable to compile the PPI at the industry class (4-digit) level of the ISIC structure. Since PPI measures the rate of change in the price of products sold by the producer and of the inputs of goods and services purchased by the producer, the value-added PPI serves the needs of both users. Industry level weight should be updated annually. BBS updates the weights at every 10 (ten) year due to a variety of reasons including resources and data availability constraints. To derive weights at class (4-digit) level into appropriate industry groups, value added resulted from SMI 2019 and Cottage Industry Survey 2011 is combined to use as benchmark data by interpolation and extrapolation method. There exists a significant change in weighting variables at industry class (4-digit) level between SMI 2005-06 and SMI 2019.

Because of the difficulties involved in obtaining current period information on value added, PPI is based on the use of the Laspeyres formula and the Fixed based system. The Laspeyres-type index which requires value added weights for the price reference period only. The index reference period is the period when the price index is equal to 100. The price reference period, the weight reference period and the index reference period are the same. The weight reference period is the time period-usually. The whole year to which the weight relates. The accuracy and reliability of a PPI are determined by the weighting structure. For this reason, the choice of the period covered by the weights is crucial. The period chosen as a weight reference period should be i) reasonably normal/stable and ii) not too distant from the price reference period.

- 4) **Procedure of Sample Selection:** Since the Producer Price Index and the Index of Industrial Production represent same set of manufacturing establishments (domain), the establishments that are selected for IIP are generally retained for the PPI also. The sample establishments have been selected from the list of 4-digit level industry groups with employment size 10 and over available from Business Register-2018 and with employment size 1 to 9 available from the Economic Census 2013. Within 4-digit level groups, establishments are selected for data collections which are observed to have higher contribution in value added. In the 2015-16 based PPI basket a total of 143 industry class are included at 4-digit levels which cover 190 items for data collection. A sample of 1163 establishments has been selected for collecting information on price in the revised PPI. A single page short questionnaire has been designed for PPI as well as for IIP to collect monthly production and producer price data from the selected establishments.

Among the 143 class of PPI basket 75 classes are newly addressed, i.e. these items were not treated as significant in the old PPI. It was a bit challenge to collect historical data on monthly basis for the newly included items. It took quite a long time to collect data for new items and enumerators needed repeated visits to get this information from new establishments.

The Industrial Policy 2010 is followed for selection of sample establishments. The sample list is then sent to 64 districts and finally updated for the missing establishments and the names, address, telephone number of the sample units through the concern Divisional Statistics Offices, District Statistics Offices and Upazila Statistics Offices at field level.

9) Data Collection: Data collection is a vital part of the overall PPI compilation process. The questionnaire is designed to help the respondent extract information quickly. Developing good relations with data provider and gaining trust is an integral part of producing good estimates. Without quality data collection procedure, it is difficult to produce accurate and reliable results at the remaining steps of producing PPI. Prior to data collection operation, in-depth training was imparted to data collectors and supervisors of the field level and head quarter of BBS. There were about 200 data collectors and 93 supervisors from 64 District Statistical offices, 8 Divisional Statistical Offices and the Head Quarter of BBS. The district wise data collection team is formed with 2-10 persons depending on the number of sample

establishments of the district. Some data items are available from public sources such as publications, regulatory data sources etc.

10) Data Entry, Processing and Validation: Data editing is a process closely linked to the calculation of the index for the elementary aggregates. Data editing involves two steps; (1) the detection of possible error and outliers and (2) the verifying and correction of data. Effective monitoring and quality control are carried out to ensure the reliability on which the quality control of the overall index depends.

After completing data collection, the filled-in-questionnaires were sent to the BBS Headquarter. The data entry program was developed in excel sheet which allows data collectors to transfer data from the field offices almost in real time using E-mail. Then the transferred data were promptly examined and verified for calculation of index. In case of inconsistencies in data, it is sent back to the relevant District Statistical Offices for required corrections and removed the discrepancies properly. Thus, the data were substantially cleaned and validated right at the field level.

Chapter 2

Concepts and Definitions

This chapter presents the fundamental concepts and definitions underlying the compilation of Producer Price Index. These key concepts are introduced in this chapter to provide the reader with a broad understanding of the PPI prior to addressing these and related concepts in greater detail.

2.0) Fundamental concepts and definition related to PPI:

Base period: The base period usually a year is generally understood to be the period against which other periods are compared and whose values provide the weights for an index.

Basket: The term commonly used for the list of goods and services, together with their relative values of output or input, for which a sample of prices is collected for the purpose of compiling the PPI.

BSIC Class: Class is denoted by four-digit category under the ‘Group’. Group is a sub-category of a division; aggregation of group’s activities constitutes the division’s activities. For an example, class 0111, i.e. BSIC category at 4-digit level covers the activities on growing of cereals (except rice) leguminous and oil seeds. There are 512 classes in BSIC.

BSIC Division: Divisions represent major classification of economic activities. Division is denoted by 2 digit category. For an example, division 01 covers Agriculture, hunting and related service activities. There are 89 divisions in BSIC.

BSIC Group: Group refers to more detailed activities than a division and is denoted by 3-digit category under the concerned division and section. For an example, Group 011 covers growing of non-perennial crops. Divisions are further sub-divided into a total of 239 groups.

Business Register: A Statistical Business Register is a register of business units engaged in production of goods and services. The business units of the business register is usually the enterprise and has identifiable links to their establishments and is classified by economic activity.

Cottage Industry: In manufacturing, micro industry will be deemed to comprise enterprises with either the value (replacement cost) of fixed assets excluding land and building of less than Tk. half a million, or with up to 9 workers, including household members.

Current period: In principle, the “current period” should refer to the most recent period for which index has been computed or is being computed. However, the term is widely used to refer to any period that is compared with the price reference or index reference period. It is also widely used simply to mean the later of the two periods being compared. The exact meaning varies according to the context.

Deflation: The division of the value of some aggregate by a price index—described as a “deflator”—to revalue its quantities at the prices of the price reference-period or to revalue the aggregate at the general price level of the price reference period. Deflation is defined as isolating the volume component (that is quantity and quality) from variables that have price and volume elements

Double deflation: A method whereby gross value added at constant prices is derived by subtracting the value of intermediate inputs at constant prices from the value of output at constant prices. The method is feasible only when the values at constant prices are additive.

Establishments: An Establishment is defined as an enterprise or part of an enterprise that is situated in a single location and in which only a single productive activity is carried out or in which the principal productive activity is done.

Factory gate price: A basic price with the “factory gate” as the pricing point, that is, the price of the product available at the factory, excluding any separately billed transport or delivery charge.

Goods: Physical objects for which a demand exists, over which ownership rights can be established, and whose ownership can be transferred from one institutional unit to another by engaging in transactions on the market. They are in demand because they may be used to satisfy the needs or wants of households or the community or used to produce other goods or services.

Gross Value Added: Value created by the process of production known as value added. Gross Value added is the value of output less the value of intermediate consumption such as materials and purchased business services. The value of output less the value of the intermediate inputs used to produce the output. It is a measure of the contribution to GDP made by an individual producer, industry, or sector.

Index: The word ‘Index’ comes from Latin and means a pointer, sign, indicator, list or register. An index number is generally a ratio that measures changes in key economic variables with the ultimate aim of monitoring the short- and long-term movement of the economy over time. Actually, an index number is a number adapted by its variations to indicate the increase or decrease of a magnitude not susceptible of accurate measurement.

Inflation: Inflation is the rate of increase in prices over a given period of time. In economics, it is a general increase of the prices. Inflation is usually measured using the consumer price index. When the general price level raises, each unit of currency buying fewer goods and services; consequently, inflation corresponds to a reduction in the purchasing power of money.

Intermediate basket: Basket derived as the average of the baskets of two time periods, usually the base and current periods. The average can be arithmetic, as in the Marshall-Edgeworth price index, or geometric, as in the Walsh price index.

Intermediate Consumption: Intermediate consumption consists of the value of the goods and services consumed as inputs by a process of production, excluding fixed assets whose consumption is recorded as consumption of fixed capital. The goods or services may be either transformed or used up by the production process.

Large Industry: In manufacturing, large industry will be deemed to comprise enterprises with either the value (replacement cost) of fixed assets excluding land and building in excess of Tk. 300 million or with more than 250 workers.

Manufacturing: The physical or chemical transformation of materials, substances or components into new products, although this cannot be used as the single universal criterion for defining manufacturing. The materials, substances or components transformed are raw materials that are products of agriculture, forestry, fishing, mining or quarrying as well as products of other manufacturing activities. Substantial alteration, renovation or reconstruction of goods is generally considered to be manufacturing.

Market price: The amount of money a willing buyer pays to acquire a good or service from a willing seller. The actual price for a transaction agreed on by the transaction. The net price inclusive of all discounts, sur-charges, and rebates applied to the transaction. From the seller's point of view the market price is the basic price; from the buyer's point of view the market price is the purchaser's price. Also referred to as "transaction price".

Medium Industry: In manufacturing, medium industry will be deemed to comprise enterprises with either the value (replacement cost) of fixed assets excluding land and building between Tk. 100 million and Tk. 300 million, or with between 100 and 250 workers.

Micro Industry: In manufacturing, micro industry will be deemed to comprise enterprises with either the value (replacement cost) of fixed assets excluding land and building between Tk. half a million and Tk. 5 million, or with between 10 and 24, or smaller number of, workers.

Output: Output should be recorded at the time it is produced and valued at the same price whether it is sold, otherwise used or entered into inventories for sale and later use.

Physical Quantity of Output: Physical Quantity of Output is also a data variable used to approximate industrial production survey. This approach measures product output in terms of the number of items, tones, liters etc. in order to track the development of production. It is often used in the context of an IIP where the products are homogeneous.

PPI: Producer price index is a measure of the change in the prices of goods and services either as they leave their place of production or as they enter the production process. A measure of the change in the prices received by domestic producers for their outputs or of the change in the prices paid by domestic producers for their intermediate inputs. See "output PPI" and "input PPI".

Price relative: The ratio of the price of an individual product in one period to the price of that same product in some other period.

Producer's price: The amount received by the producer from the purchaser for a unit of good or service produced as output. It *excludes* any VAT (or similar deductible tax on products) invoiced to the purchaser. It also excludes supplier's retail and wholesale margins and separately invoiced transport and insurance charges. (A producer's price for a product is the basic price *plus* any non-

deductible tax on products paid by the producer *less* any subsidies on products received by the producer.)

Products: Goods and services that are the result of production. They are exchanged and used for various purposes: as inputs in the production of other goods and services, as final consumption, or for investment. Also referred to as “commodities”.

Section/Sector: This section or sector refers to very broad structure of the economy as well as economic activities such as Agriculture, forestry and fishing. The individual categories of BSIC have been divided into 21 sections.

Small Industry: In manufacturing, small industry will be deemed to comprise enterprises with either the value (replacement cost) of fixed assets excluding land and building between Tk. 5 million and Tk. 100 million, or with between 25 and 99 workers.

Value of output: Value of output includes products produced whether they are sold, otherwise used or entered into inventories for sale or constitutes, work-in-progress inventories. Output should be recorded at the time it is produced and valued at basic price.

Volume Index: A volume index is usually presented as a weighted average, measures the proportionate change in the quantities of goods and/or services consumed or produced between two periods of time.

Weight: A weight in statistical term is defined as a coefficient assigned to a number in a computation, to make the number’s effect on the computation reflect its importance.

Work-in-progress: Work-in-progress consists of output produced by an enterprise that is not yet sufficiently processed to be in a state in which it is normally supplied to others institutional units. When the process of production takes a long time to complete, i.e., more than one accounting period, output is recognized as being produced continuously as work-in-progress. Work-in-progress is essentially incomplete output that is not yet marketable: that is, output that is not sufficiently processed to be in a state in which it can easily be supplied or sold to other institutional units.

Chapter 3

Methodology and Compilation Procedures

This chapter describes the methods and process of revising and rebasing the Producer Price Index (PPI). In a PPI, detail measures are combined to arrive at an aggregate of domestically Produced industrial goods price change. PPI is compiled on a monthly basis using Lapser's formula. A description of all relevant steps for this approach is furnished in this chapter.

3.2) Updating or derivation of Weights: The weight reference period should always be the most recent period (year) for which weights is available. The use of the Laspeyre-type index formula provides some flexibility in regards to the frequency of weight updates. The laspeyre-type index formula requires a base period to be selected, and the weights are derived for the period. The concept of the 'base period' is not a precise one and may be used to distinguish the following three types of reference periods:

1. The Price reference period: The period those prices appear in the denominators of the Prices relatives used to calculate the index.
2. The Weight reference period: The period usually a year in whose values serves as weights for the index.
3. The Index reference period: The period for which the index is set equal to 100.

3.3) Procedure for derivation of weights of each class at 4-digit level: Ranking and derivation of weight is done using a top-down approach within each class at 4-digit level of ISIC Rev.4. Value added of a class is divided by the total value added of corresponding class and multiplied by 100 in order to estimate its contribution, i.e.

$$\text{Contribution of a class (4 - digit)} = \frac{\text{Value Added of the class}}{\text{Total Value Added of All classes}} \times 100$$

Value added of the classes that have too small/insignificant contribution has been merged to the upper groups within the same division.

3.4) The Basic Data and the lower level Weights: The basic data are combined using weights to produce data for the class (4-digit) level and subsequently for the second lowest level of the industry classification namely the group (3-digit) level, then for the Division (2-digit) level of BSIC.

The weights of various industry classes are based on the gross value added of the respective industry class. Weights have been derived at three stages viz. (i) Class (4-digit) BSIC (ii) Group (3-digit) BSIC and (iii) Division (2-Digit) BSIC of manufacturing industries following ISIC rev.4 as below:

3.4.1) The Group (3-Digit) level BSIC industry weights are calculated simply by summing the weights of 4-digit industry class and

3.4.2) Finally the division (2-Digit) level BSIC industry weights are derived by summing the weights of industry group (3-digit) level

A concordance table has been prepared for user's convenience showing the weighting pattern of Division (2-Digit) level of Bangladesh Standard industrial Classification (BSIC)

3.5) Sampling frame

A simple definition of a sampling frame is the set of source materials from which the sample is selected. In other words, sampling frame is a list of all possible units of the target population from which the sample is drawn. It is one of the most crucial aspects of sample design in a survey. The sampling frame has significant implications on the cost and the quality of the survey. In any survey faulty sampling frames are a common source of non-sampling error, particularly under-coverage of important population sub-groups.

In case of establishment or industry survey, the underlying frame consists of name and addresses of the units along with some additional information like employment size, volume of assets, annual turnover etc.

In practice, the sample of manufacturing establishments selected for the Index of Industrial Production (IIP) is also used for the Producer Price Index (PPI). The difference is for collecting producer prices for PPI, specifications are assigned with the products in order to collect specific prices. The product specifications become crucial when there exists multiple products in the same establishment such as pharmaceuticals, chemicals/cosmetics producing industries etc. For selecting sample establishments, the business directory 2019, developed by BBS for large, medium, small and micro industries, is used as the sampling frame. The frame contains name and addresses of the establishments, employment size and the Bangladesh Standard Industrial Classification (BSIC) codes.

For cottage industries, i.e. manufacturing establishments with employment size 1 to 9 or the value of fixed assets excluding land and building of less than Tk. half a million (Industrial Policy 2010), the only list obtained from the Economic Census 2013 of BBS, is used as the frame to select the sample establishments.

3.6) Sample size

It is empirically observed that the variation in producer prices of large industries, medium, small and micro industries and the cottage industries have a strong positive correlation over time. From this point of view, the coordination committee for rebasing Producer Price Index (PPI) decided compiling a single PPI for the manufacturing industries. The PPI consists of around 74 classes at 4-digit level of the Bangladesh Standard Industrial Classification 2009 (BSIC 2009), which is the Bangladesh version of the International Standard Industrial Classification, revision-4 (ISIC, rev 4). In order to ensure representativeness of the sample, each of these classes has to be addressed while selecting sample establishments, treating the classes as stratum. But in practice, determining individual sample size for each of the 74 categories of establishments was not possible due to lack of reliable disaggregated information. Rather total sample size required for PPI is determined first and then allocated proportionally to the classes.

The following formula is used to estimate the total sample size of manufacturing establishments required for the Producer Price Index:

Where,

n = the probable sample size,

P = ratio of the establishment of large category to the total size of manufacturing industry,

Q = 1 – P = 1 – 0.08 = 0.92

Z = is set at 1.96 corresponds to the 5 percent level of significance,

d = maximum allowance for error between the true proportion and the sample proportion (d=.05)

deff = design effect , which usually lies between the number (1 to 3).

Substituting all these values in the function of n, the sample size is estimated at 1163. At the next stage, the sample is allocated to the stratum, i.e., to 4-digit level classes of BSIC following proportional allocation as below:

$$n_i = \left\{ \frac{N_i}{N} \right\} * n \dots\dots\dots (ii)$$

Where,

n_i= sample size of the ith class (4-digit level BSIC)

N_i = population size of the ith class (4-digit level BSIC)

N = population size

n = total sample size

In case of too small population size (i.e. 1 or 2 establishments), all the establishments are purposively retained in the sample. Besides, where determined sample size becomes too small (<3), it is purposively raised to at least 3 establishments.

Different types of manufacturing activities are performed in the cottage industries, where employment size ranges from 1 to 9. In this range, the sample size of this stream was estimated using list of manufacturing establishments, categorized as cottage industry, obtained from the Economic Census 2013 of BBS. In the frame, significant heterogeneity is observed in the number of industries according to the ISIC, revision-4 codes. The establishment list comprised of 352,352 establishments among which about 2,62,287 establishments are found existing under nine different ISIC codes and the rest 90,065 establishments are found under 160 different codes. These two numbers are used to determine the statistically representative number of cottage industries to be selected in the sample for PPI. Using the ratios and other values of the statistic in equation (i), the sample size for PPI of cottage industries is estimated at 731. At the next stage, the sample is allocated to the 4-digit level ISIC classes following proportional allocation.

3.7) Selection of Sample for PPI 2015-16

A new sample of 1907 establishments has been selected for the revised PPI from the list frame of manufacturing establishments available in the updated business register 2018 and the Economic Census 2013 updated by field offices. From the old basket of IIP-large and medium-scale industries, a total of 965 were replaced by 678 for large-scale industries and 657 for medium, small, and micro (SMME)-scale industries. A total of 612 is replaced by 731 for cottage industries in order to develop the new sample. Producer Price data from different industries is required for the preparation of the PPI. A short questionnaire is prepared for this purpose, and the required historical data has been collected for the new sample industries.

For the preparation of the monthly PPI, monthly Price data for newly selected establishments was required. Obviously, it was a big challenge to get historical monthly data for the newly selected establishments. It took a pretty long time to collect information from the new establishments, and repeated visits are required to convince the data providers and collect data.

The rebased index (2015–16 based) of large-scale industrial production covers 143 industry classes (4-digit) level, 40 industry groups (3-digit) level, and 23 divisions (2-digit) level compared to 72 industry classes (4-digit) level, 40 industry groups (3-digit) level, and 22 divisions (2-digit) level in 2005–06 based indices. The other rebased index (2015-16 based), namely small, medium, and micro scale industrial production, covers 143 industry classes (4-digit) level, 45 industry groups (3-digit) level, and 23 divisions (2-digit) level compared to 72 industry classes (4-digit) level, 40 industry groups (3-digit) level, and 22 divisions (2-digit) level in 2005-06 based indices. The rebased index (2015-16 based), namely cottage industrial production, covers 143 industry classes (4-digit) level, 45 industry groups (3-digit) level, and 24 divisions (2-digit) level compared to 67 industry classes (4-digit) level, 37 industry groups (3-digit) level, and 22 divisions (2-digit) level in 2005-06 based indices, according to ISIC Rev. 4. Most of the industrial classes were selected from 143 industrial classes to prepare the index basket.

3.9) Formula used for PPI Compilation: Laspeyre's formula has been most internationally used to aggregate economic quantities over time for Producer Price Index. It is the weighted average of price relatives of different items or products. It can be defined as the change in Price of a basket of goods and services at the reference periods. Laspeyre's –type price index can be mathematically expressed below:

Formula: Laspeyre Index

PPI= Producer Price Index

w_{oi} = Weight of Product class in the base year

n = Number of Product class included in the index

Properties:

- 1) The weights of fixed based period are used in the reference period.
- 2) It tends to register a large period to period increase over time.
- 3) This formula is used when timeliness is important.

The worksheet is prepared in such a way that when data will be entered in the data sheet, it is linked to the calculation sheets and the results will come automatically at 4, 3 and 2 digit level. Monthly and annually indices have been calculated using the above formula.

3.10) Detailed results of the compilation of Producer Price Indices using Laspeyre's formula are shown in Table 1.1 for class (4-Digit) level, Table 1.2 for Group (3-digit) level and Table 1.3 for Division (2-Digit) levels respectively (Statistical Table of PPI). A comparative view of the 2005-06 based and 2015-16 based Indices are presented in the table below.

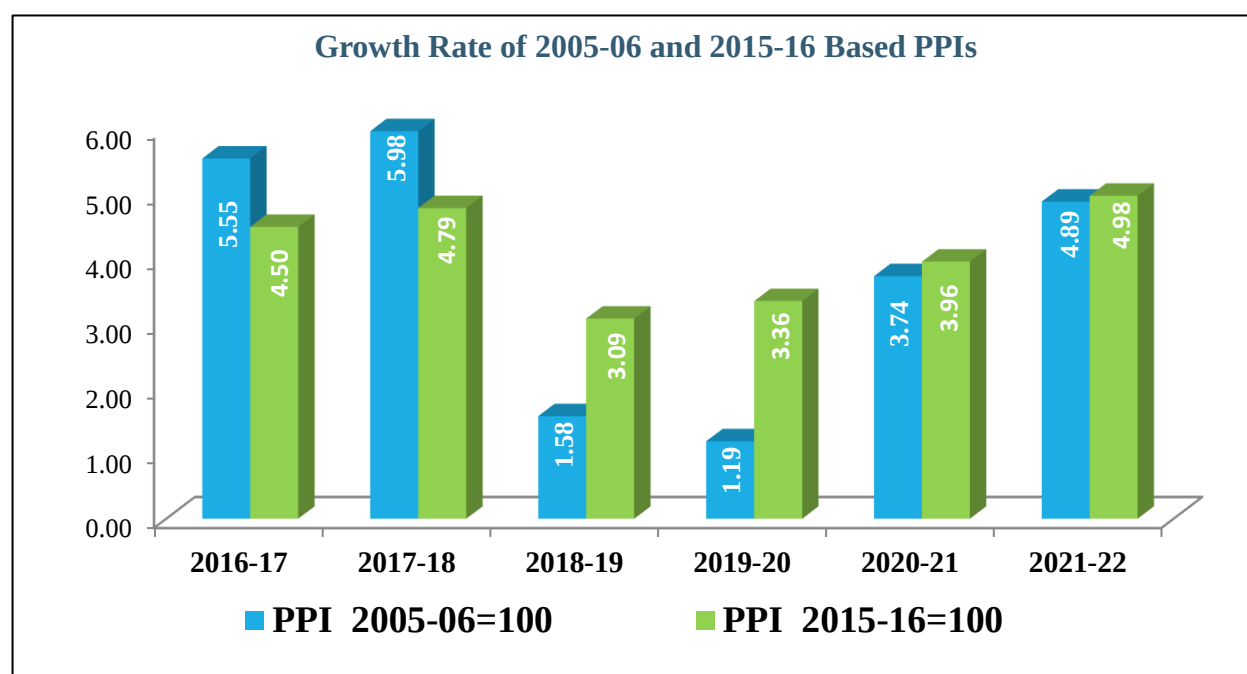
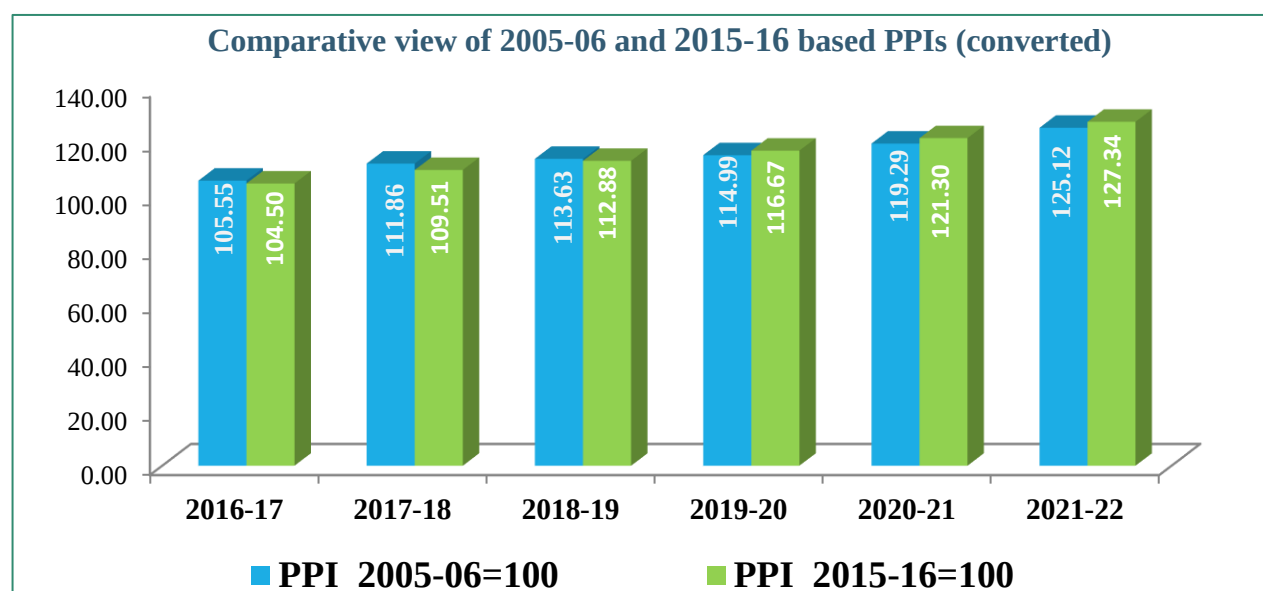

From the above table it could be observed that highest Producer Price Index was risen in the fiscal year 2017-18 both in old based and fiscal year 2021-2 in new based. The bar diagram below shows the comparative view of trend 2005-06 and 2015-16 based Indices.



Recommendations

1. Revision and rebasing of Producer Price Index (PPI) is a regular task and it should be conducted with an interval of five to ten years. In a growing economy like Bangladesh the economic structure, especially the nature of manufacturing activities changes very rapidly. In order to reflect the changes in producer prices properly, it is important to revise the basket of PPI with a regular interval.
2. An in-depth training on the concepts of producer prices, underlying indices and the procedure of data collection is of utmost importance for the data collectors of PPI. The quality of producer price data could be improved by improving capability of the concerned data collectors.
3. Basic data of industrial production and its value/price should be captured in computer just after collecting from field level. Computerization of basic data will facilitate validation or justification of basic data prior to using it for compilation of PPI. The current practice is to posting the basic data in registrar book and then putting its summary in computer for compilation of PPI.
4. For revision and rebasing of PPI, the business register needs to be updated on a regular basis, as the business register provides the basis of sampling frame for PPI or IIP.
5. Related surveys like the Survey of Manufacturing Industries, Annual Establishment and Institution Survey need to be conducted on a regular basis for rebasing of PPI or IIP with a regular interval.
6. Further rebasing (revision as well) of IIP and PPI could be done keeping similarity with the base year of Gross Domestic Product (GDP).
7. Updated results of all the related surveys need to be available in due time for using in further revision and rebasing of IIP and PPI.
