The data used in this report have been collected from administrative sources. Merchandise trade data are primarily sourced from the National Board of Revenue (NBR), while data on trade in services are obtained from Bangladesh Bank (BB).

BBS has prepared HS Codes at the 2 to 4digit level to cover all commodities under foreign trade.

Executive Summary

Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics (BBS) compiles and publishes Foreign Trade Statistics (FTS) on a regular basis. This publication presents monthly trend of Bangladesh foreign trade statistics on top trading partners, essential import commodities and last twelve months scenario of major export and import goods especially for December, 2025.

Merchandise trade data of this publication are provided by National Board of Revenue (NBR) while data on services from Bangladesh Bank. Data presented in this publication are provisional and subject to revision. All these provisional data will be subsequently reviewed and revised. Revised data are being presented in next issues.

In for December, 2025 total export and import of goods and services is recorded at increased by Tk. 608.55 and increased by Tk. 1108.92 billion respectively resulting in a trade deficit at goods and services of Tk. 500.37 billion. The growth of export and import in for December, 2025 increased by 7.29 and increased by 10.62 percent respectively comparing to November, 2025 and it decreased by 6.86 and increased by 4.08 percent respectively comparing to for December, 2024.

For the three months ending for December, 2025 the average of export of goods and services was Tk. 568.233 billion, while the moving average of import of goods and services was Tk. 1050.497 billion resulting in an average trade deficit of Tk. 482.26 billion. For the three months ending November, 2025 the average trade deficit was Tk. 507.60 billion reflecting average exports of Tk. 539.16 billion and average imports of Tk. 1046.75billion.

In December, 2025 Bangladesh's merchandise trade was highly concentrated among top ten trading partners. China ranked first with a total trade value of Tk. 295551 million (19.82 percent), followed by United States with Tk. 143161 million (9.60 percent) and the India with Tk. 120673 million (8.09 percent). Other major partners included Indonesia, Germany, the United Kingdom, Japan, Brazil, Spain and Canada. These ten countries together accounted for the dominant share of Bangladesh's total foreign trade in goods during the reference month.

Indicators of this publication are expected to provide a good idea about the trend of export and import of the country over the previous months of a year. This monthly release would be a useful document for planners, policy makers, researchers, development partners/agencies, academicians and other stakeholders.












Graph 16: Top trading partners – total trade (goods), December-2025.


