It covers monthly export and import trends, trade balance, commodity-wise movements, essential imports, twelve-month performance of major items, the top trading partners, Re-Exports, Re-Imports, Temporary Exports, Temporary Imports.

The data used in this report have been collected from administrative sources. Merchandise trade data are primarily sourced from the National Board of Revenue (NBR), while data on trade in services are obtained from Bangladesh Bank (BB).

BBS has prepared HS Codes at the 2 to 4digit level to cover all commodities under foreign trade.

Executive Summary

Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics (BBS) compiles and publishes Foreign Trade Statistics (FTS) on a regular basis. This publication presents monthly trend of Bangladesh foreign trade statistics on top trading partners, essential import commodities and last twelve months scenario of major export and import goods especially for January, 2026.

Merchandise trade data of this publication are provided by National Board of Revenue (NBR) while data on services from Bangladesh Bank. Data presented in this publication are provisional and subject to revision. All these provisional data will be subsequently reviewed and revised. Revised data are being presented in next issues.

In for January, 2026 total export and import of goods and services is recorded at increased by Tk. 658.46 and increased by Tk. 1130.91 billion respectively resulting in a trade deficit at goods and services of Tk. 472.45 billion. The growth of export and import in for January, 2026 increased by 8.20 and increased by 1.98 percent respectively comparing to December, 2025 and it increased by 7.42 and increased by 3.87 percent respectively comparing to for January, 2025.

For the three months ending for January, 2026 the average of export of goods and services was Tk. 611.41 billion, while the moving average of import of goods and services was Tk. 1080.77 billion resulting in an average trade deficit of Tk. 469.36 billion. For the three months ending December, 2025 the average trade deficit was Tk. 482.26 billion reflecting average exports of Tk. 568.233 billion and average imports of Tk. 1050.497 billion.

In January, 2026 Bangladesh's merchandise trade was highly concentrated among top ten trading partners. China ranked first with a total trade value of Tk. 281938 million (17.82 percent), followed by United States with Tk. 146860 million (9.28 percent) and the India with Tk. 125080 million (7.91 percent). Other major partners included Indonesia, Germany, Brazil, the United Kingdom, Spain, Malaysia and Japan. These ten countries together accounted for the dominant share of Bangladesh's total foreign trade in goods during the reference month.

Indicators of this publication are expected to provide a good idea about the trend of export and import of the country over the previous months of a year. This monthly release would be a useful document for planners, policy makers, researchers, development partners/agencies, academicians and other stakeholders.

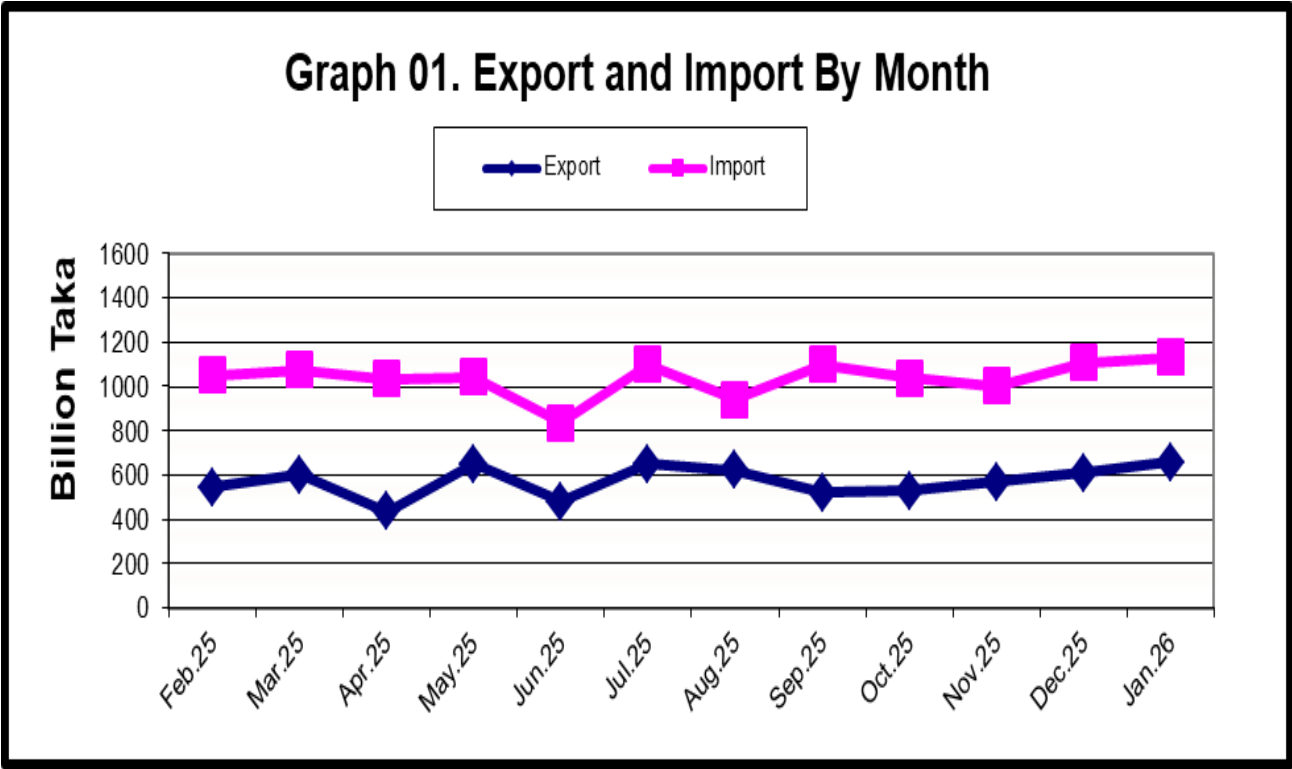

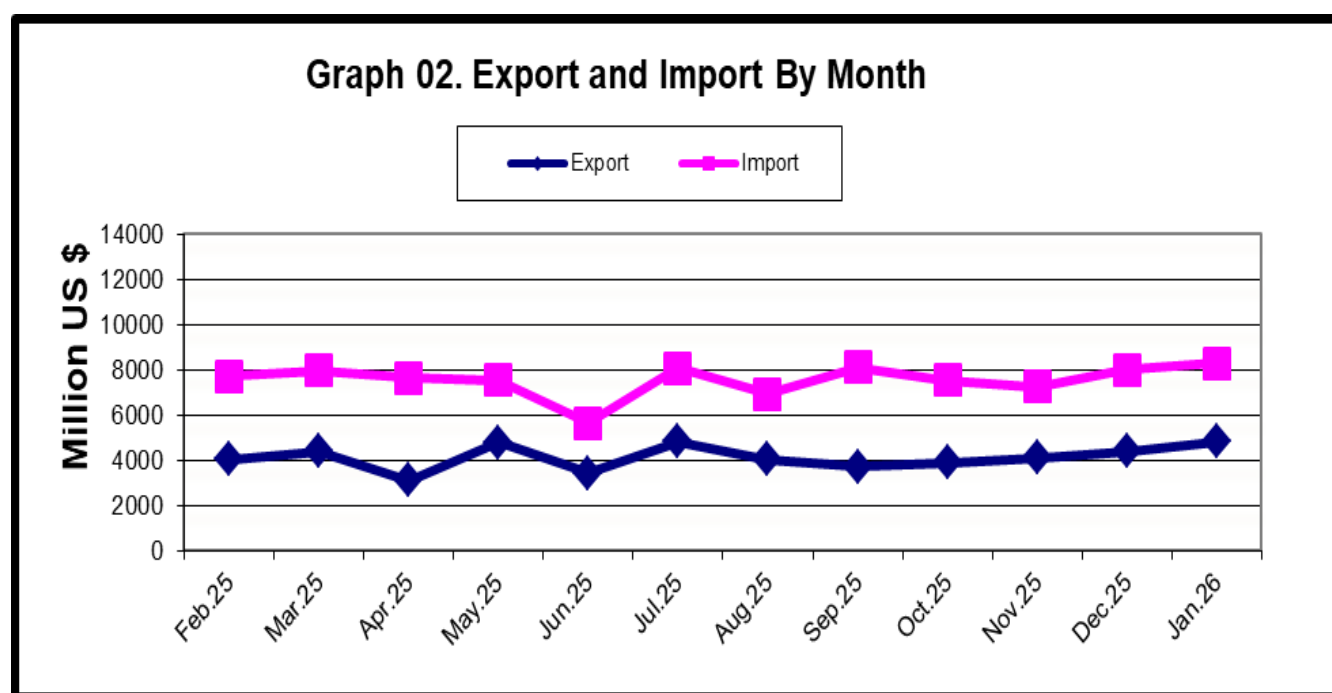

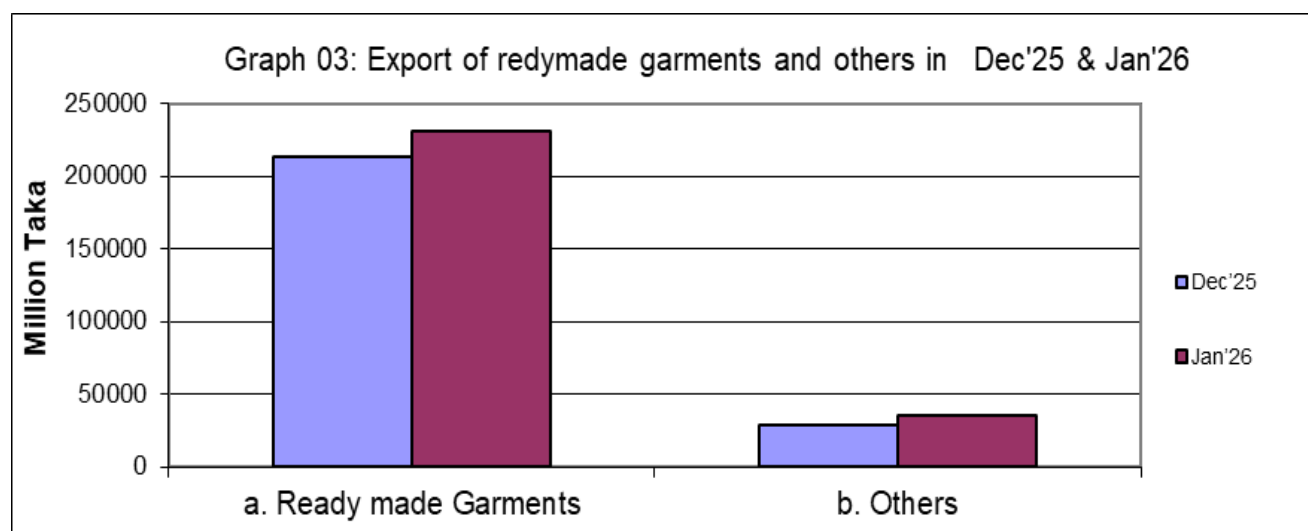

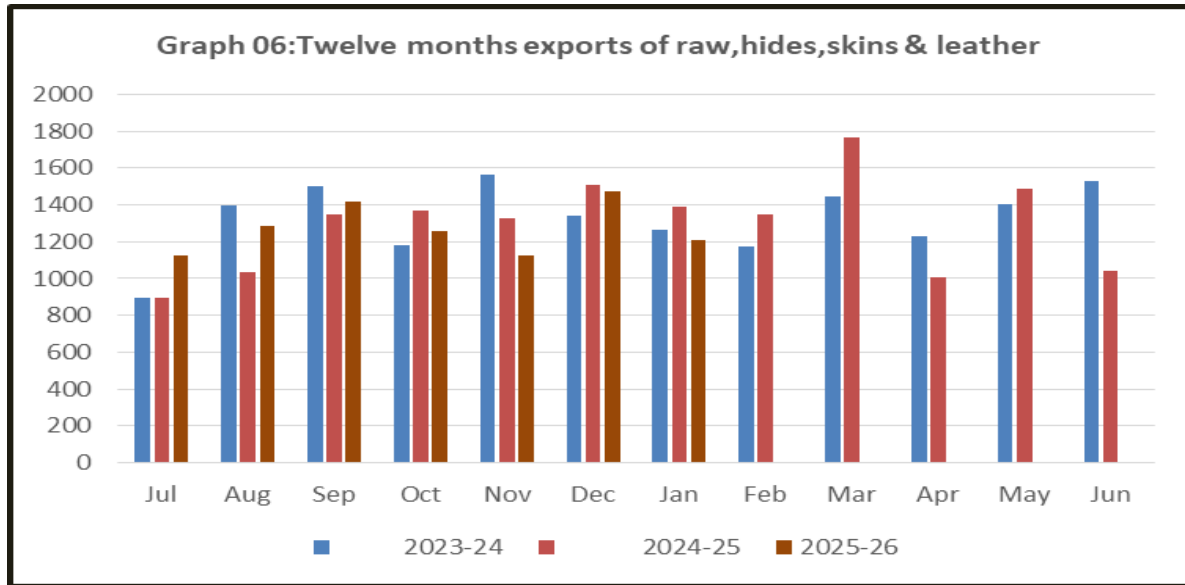

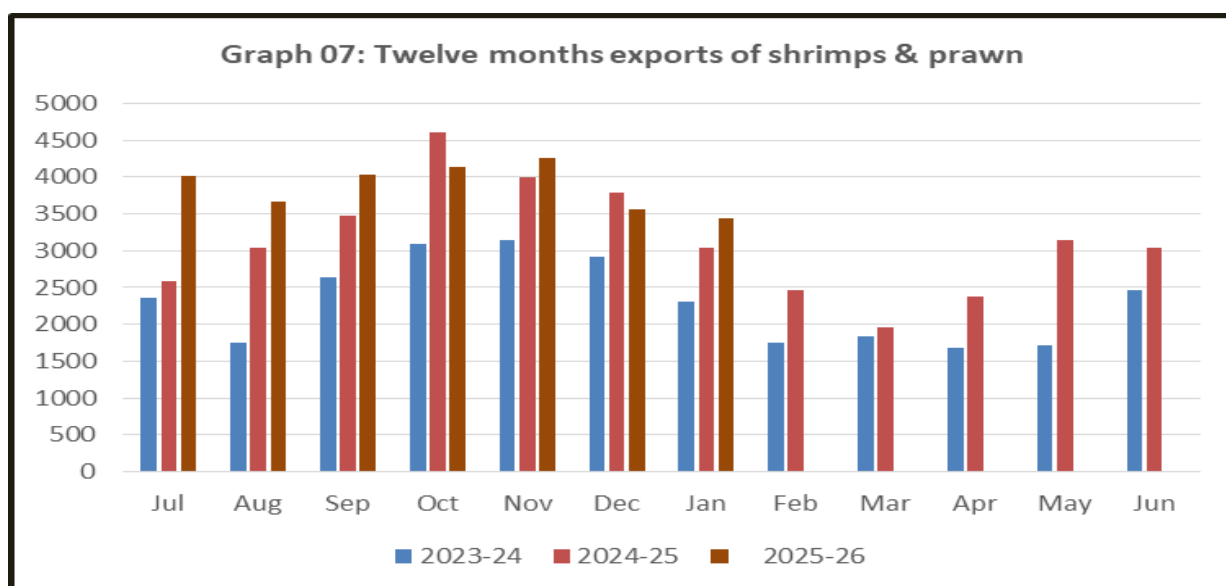

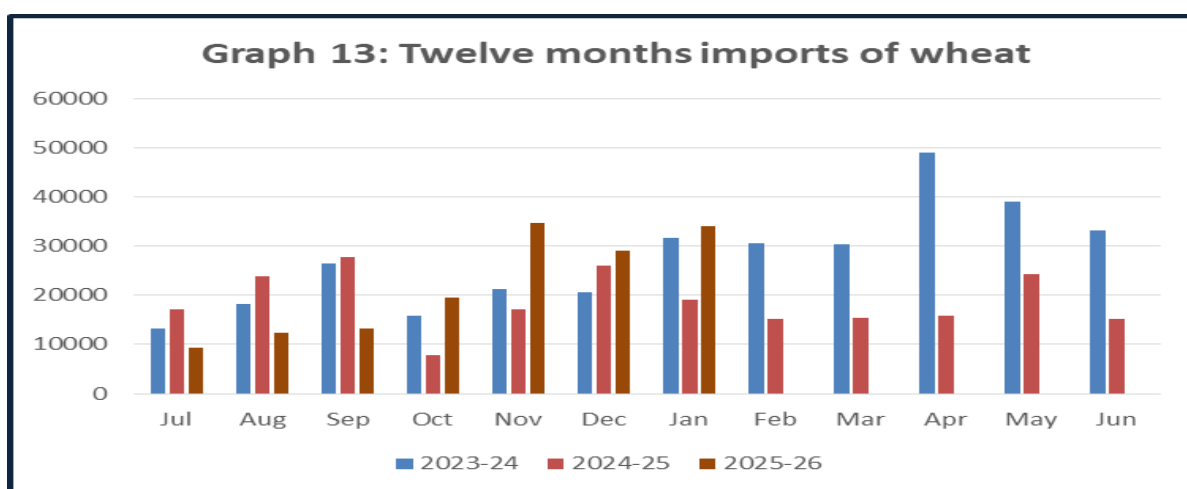

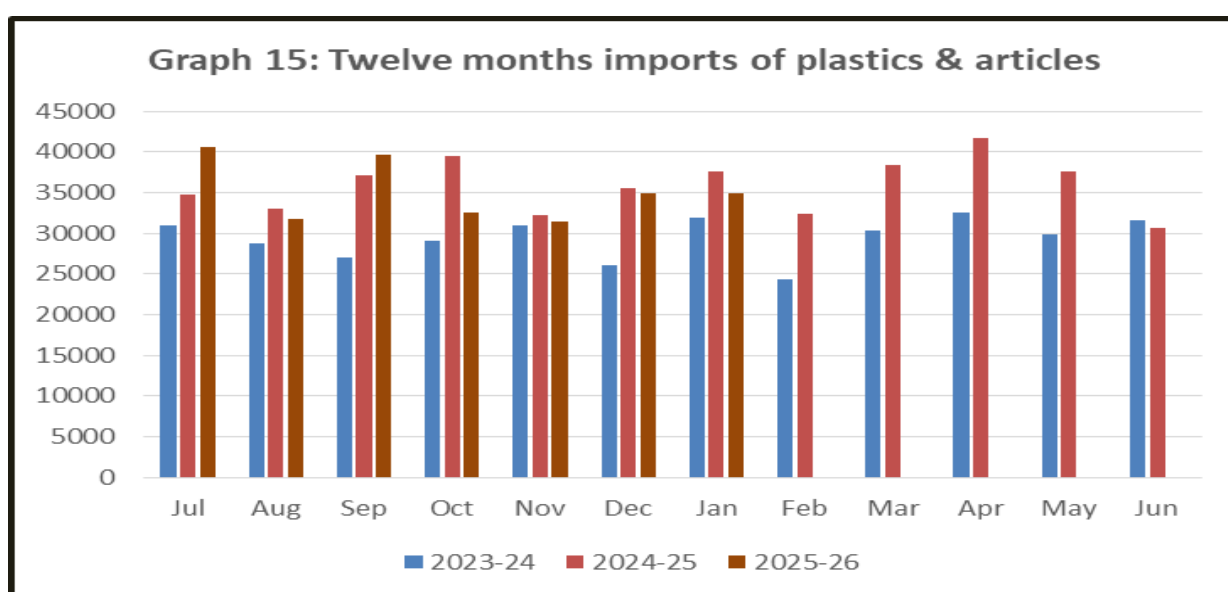
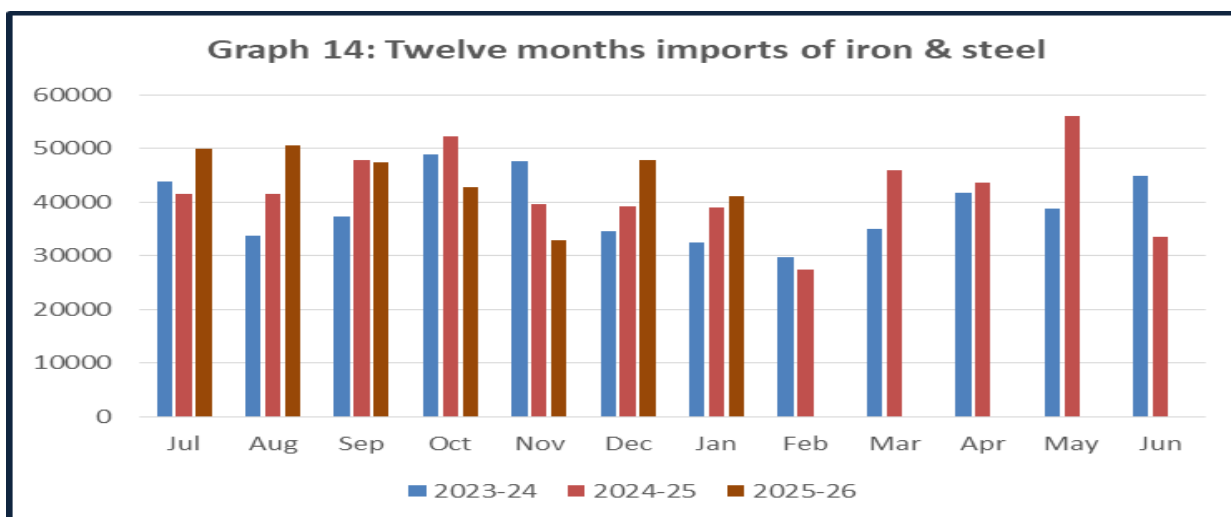

Graph 16: Top trading partners – total trade (goods), January-2026.

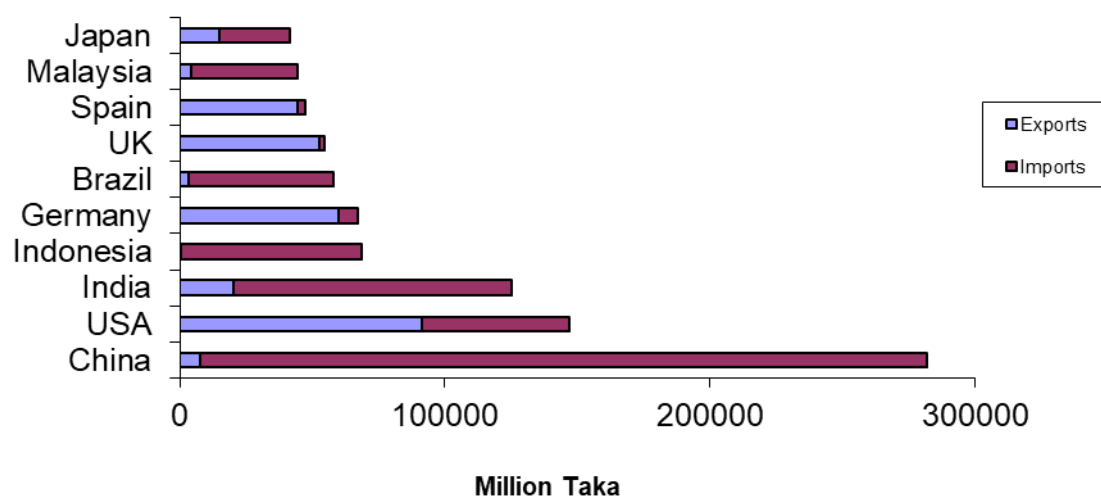
