This Monthly report is the 227<sup>th</sup> issue of this series of publication. This report presents a brief statistical overview of Bangladesh's foreign trade based on provisional data. It covers monthly export and import trends, trade balance, commodity-wise movements, essential imports, twelve-month performance of major items, the top trading partners, Re-Exports, Re-Imports, Temporary Exports, Temporary Imports.

The data used in this report have been collected from administrative sources. Merchandise trade data are primarily sourced from the National Board of Revenue (NBR), while data on trade in services are obtained from Bangladesh Bank (BB).

My sincere thanks are to officials of Foreign Trade Statistics, National Accounting Wing for their relentless efforts in bringing out this publication.

BBS has prepared HS Codes at the 2 to 4digit level to cover all commodities under foreign trade.

## Executive Summary

Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics (BBS) compiles and publishes Foreign Trade Statistics (FTS) on a regular basis. This publication presents monthly trend of Bangladesh foreign trade statistics on top trading partners, essential import commodities and last twelve month's scenario of major export and import goods especially February, 2026.

Merchandise trade data of this publication are provided by National Board of Revenue (NBR) while data on services from Bangladesh Bank. Data presented in this publication are provisional and subject to revision. All these provisional data will be subsequently reviewed and revised. Revised data are being presented in next issues.

In for February, 2026 total export and import of goods and services is recorded at decreased by Tk. 494.86 and increased by Tk. 1141.43 billion respectively resulting in a trade deficit at goods and services of Tk. 646.57 billion. The growth of export and import in for February, 2026 decreased by 24.85 and increased by 0.93 percent respectively comparing to for January, 2026 and it decreased by 9.12 and increased by 8.71 percent respectively comparing to for February, 2025.

For the three months ending for February, 2026 the average of export of goods and services was Tk. 587.29 billion, while the moving average of import of goods and services was Tk. 1127.09 billion resulting in an average trade deficit of Tk-373.01 billion. For the three months ending January, 2025, the average trade deficit was Tk. 469.36 billion reflecting average exports of Tk. 611.41 billion and average imports of Tk. 1080.77 billion.

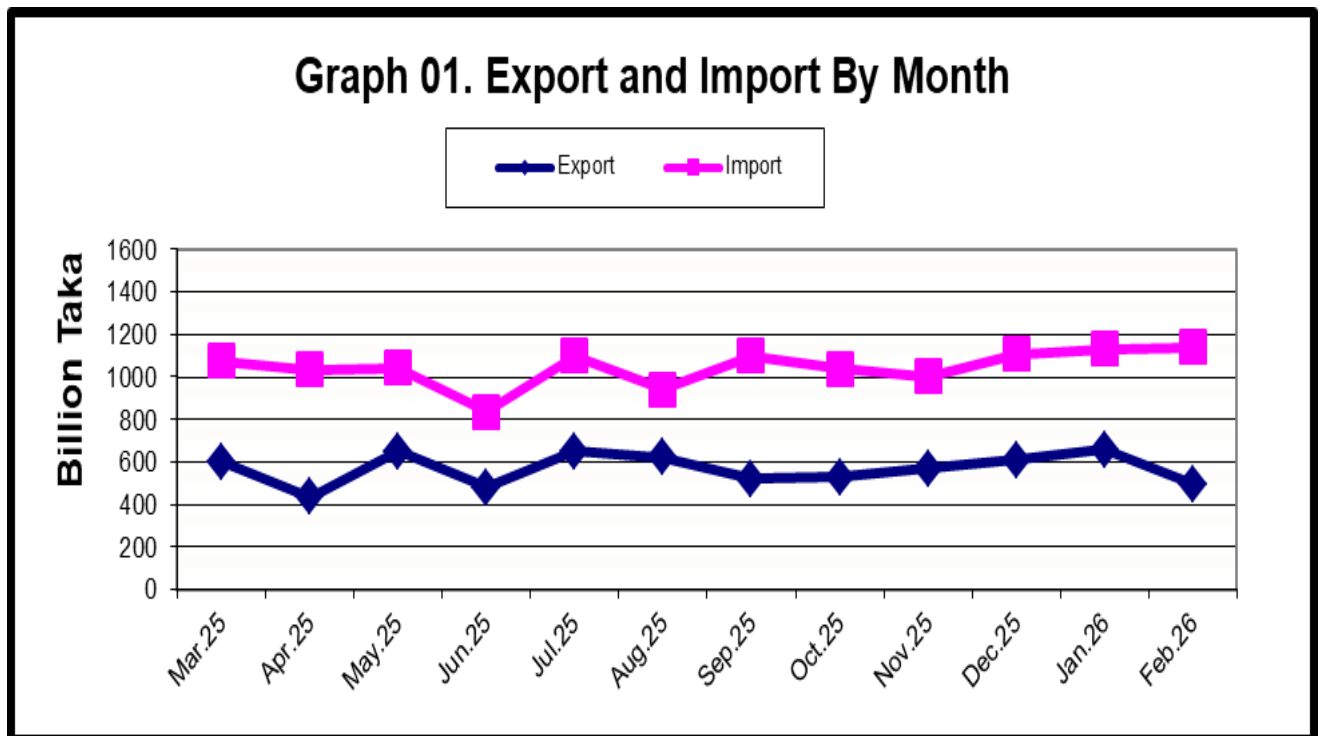
In February, 2026 Bangladesh's merchandise trade was highly concentrated among top ten trading partners. China ranked first with a total trade value of Tk. 308785 million (21.21 percent), followed by India with Tk. 123283 million (8.47 percent) and the United States with Tk. 123173 million (8.46 percent). Other major partners included Indonesia, Brazil, Singapore, Germany, the United Kingdom, Spain, and Malaysia. These ten countries together accounted for the dominant share of Bangladesh's total foreign trade in goods during the reference month.

Indicators of this publication are expected to provide a good idea about the trend of export and import of the country over the previous months of a year. This monthly release would be a useful document for planners, policy makers, researchers, development partners/agencies, academicians and other stakeholders.

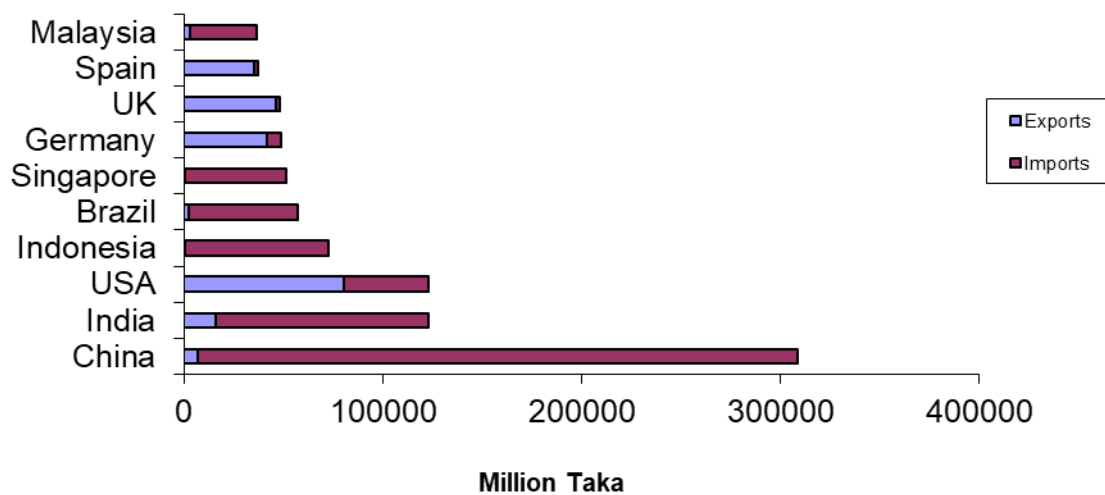
