Considering the significant role of foreign trade in economic growth, BBS has been publishing the FTS since 1973-74 regularly on Monthly and Yearly basis. This Monthly report is the 230<sup>th</sup> issue of this series of publication. This report presents a brief statistical overview of Bangladesh's foreign trade based on provisional data. It covers monthly export and import trends, trade balance, commodity-wise movements, essential imports, twelve-month performance of major items, the top trading partners, Re-Exports, Re-Imports, Temporary Exports, Temporary Imports.

The data used in this report have been collected from administrative sources. Merchandise trade data are primarily sourced from the National Board of Revenue (NBR), while data on trade in services are obtained from Bangladesh Bank (BB).

My sincere thanks are to officials of Foreign Trade Statistics, National Accounting Wing for their relentless efforts in bringing out this publication.

I gratefully acknowledge the cooperation extended by National Board of Revenue (NBR) and its customs stations in providing primary data on imports and exports. I also acknowledge the cooperation by Bangladesh Bank is provide data on trade in service.

BBS has prepared HS Codes at the 2 to 4 digit level to cover all commodities under foreign trade.

I would like to extend my deep gratitude to Director General, BBS and Deputy Director General, BBS, for their valuable advice and guidance in implementing this complex and demanding task in a timely manner.

## Executive Summary

Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics (BBS) compiles and publishes Foreign Trade Statistics (FTS) on a regular basis. This publication presents monthly trend of Bangladesh foreign trade statistics on top trading partners, essential import commodities and last twelve month's scenario of major export and import goods especially for March, 2026.

Merchandise trade data of this publication are provided by National Board of Revenue (NBR) while data on services from Bangladesh Bank. Data presented in this publication are provisional and subject to revision. All these provisional data will be subsequently reviewed and revised. Revised data are being presented in next issues.

In for March, 2026 total export and import of goods and services is recorded at decreased by Tk 505.95 and decreased by Tk. 1037.34 billion respectively resulting in a trade deficit at goods and services of Tk. 531.39 billion. The growth of export and import in for March, 2026 increased by 2.24 and decreased by 9.12 percent respectively comparing to for February, 2026 and it decreased by 15.86 and decreased by 3.34 percent respectively comparing to for March, 2025.

For the three months ending for March, 2026 the average of export of goods and services was Tk. 553.09 billion, while the moving average of import of goods and services was Tk. 1103.13 billion resulting in an average trade deficit of Tk. 550.14 billion. For the three months ending February, 2025, the average trade deficit was Tk. 373.01 billion reflecting average exports of Tk. 587.29 billion and average imports of Tk. 1127.09 billion.

In March, 2026 Bangladesh's merchandise trade was highly concentrated among top ten trading partners. China ranked first with a total trade value of Tk. 246110 million (18.49 percent), followed by India with Tk. 127125 million (9.55 percent) and the United States with Tk. 115871 million (8.70 percent). Other major partners included Singapore, Indonesia, the United Kingdom, Germany, Brazil, Spain, and Malaysia. These ten countries together accounted for the dominant share of Bangladesh's total foreign trade in goods during the reference month.

Indicators of this publication are expected to provide a good idea about the trend of export and import of the country over the previous months of a year. This monthly release would be a useful document for planners, policy makers, researchers, development partners/agencies, academicians and other stakeholders.

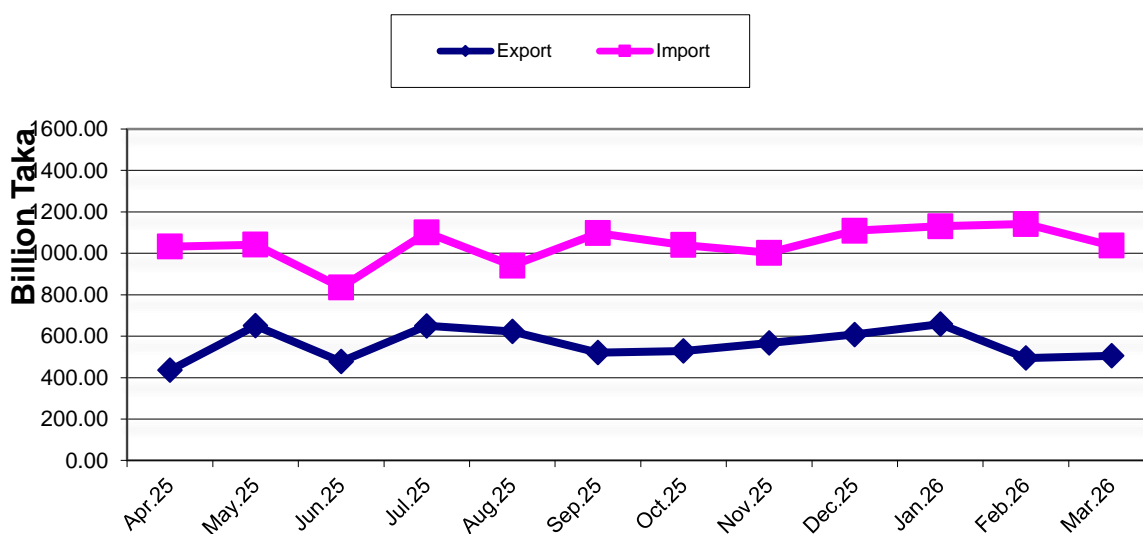

**Graph 01. Export and Import By Month**



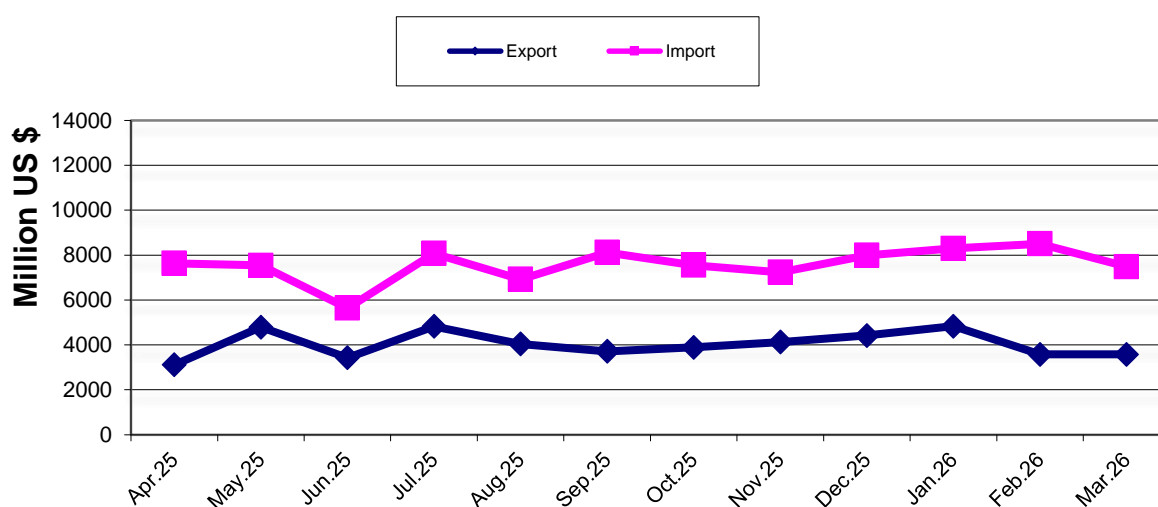

**Graph 02. Export and Import By Month**

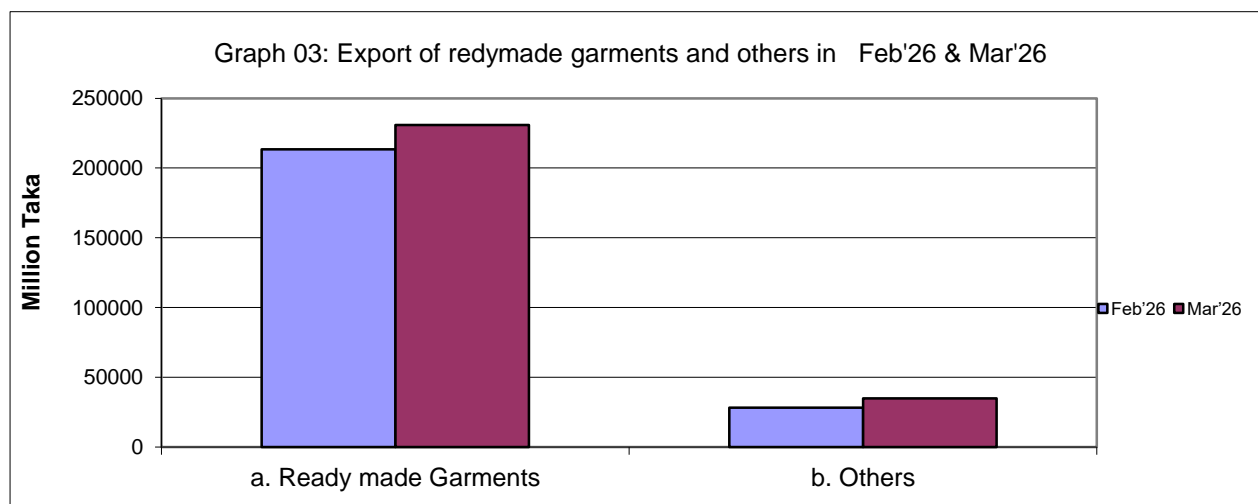

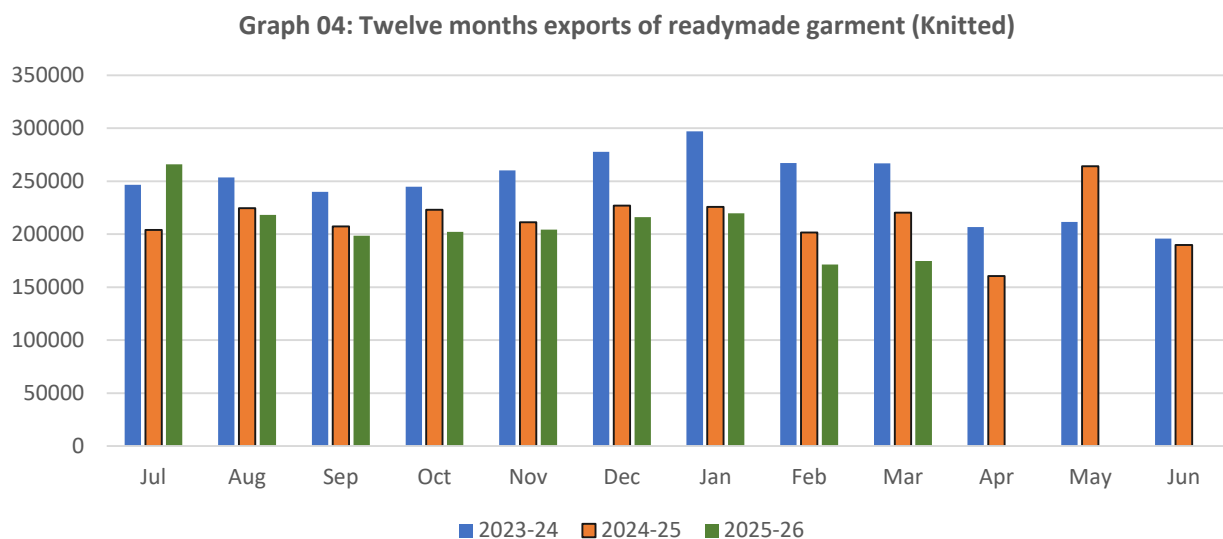

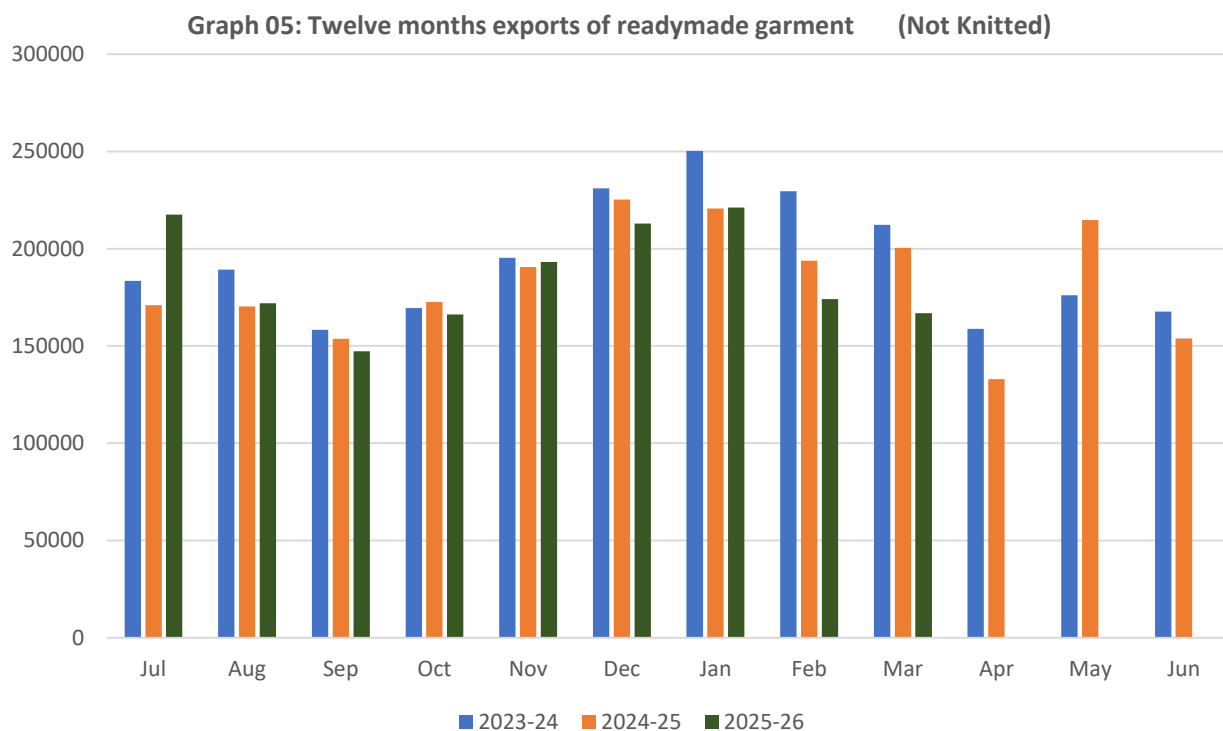

**Graph 05: Twelve months exports of readymade garment (Not Knitted)**

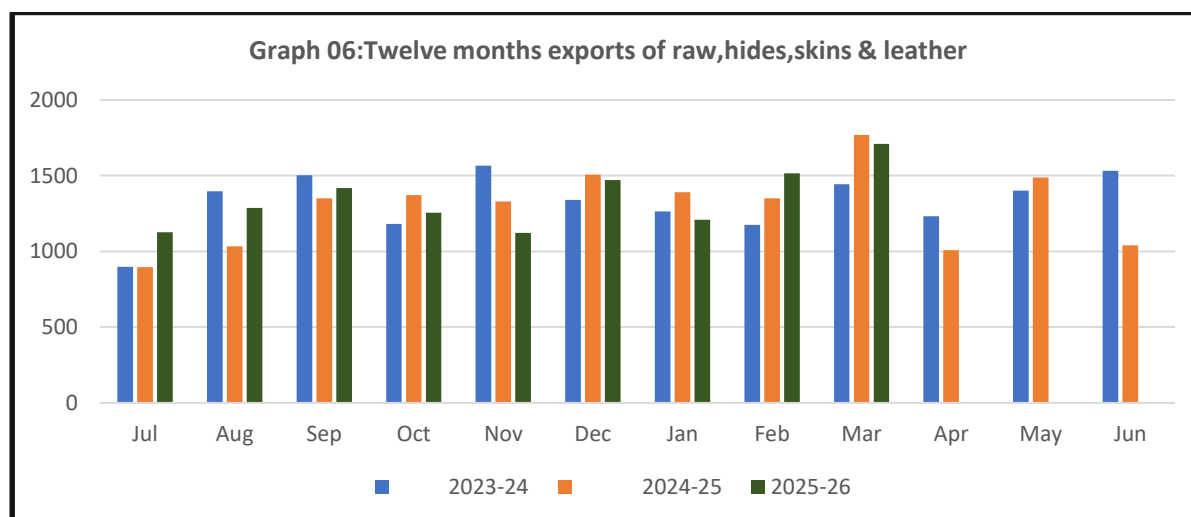

**Graph 06: Twelve months exports of raw, hides, skins & leather**

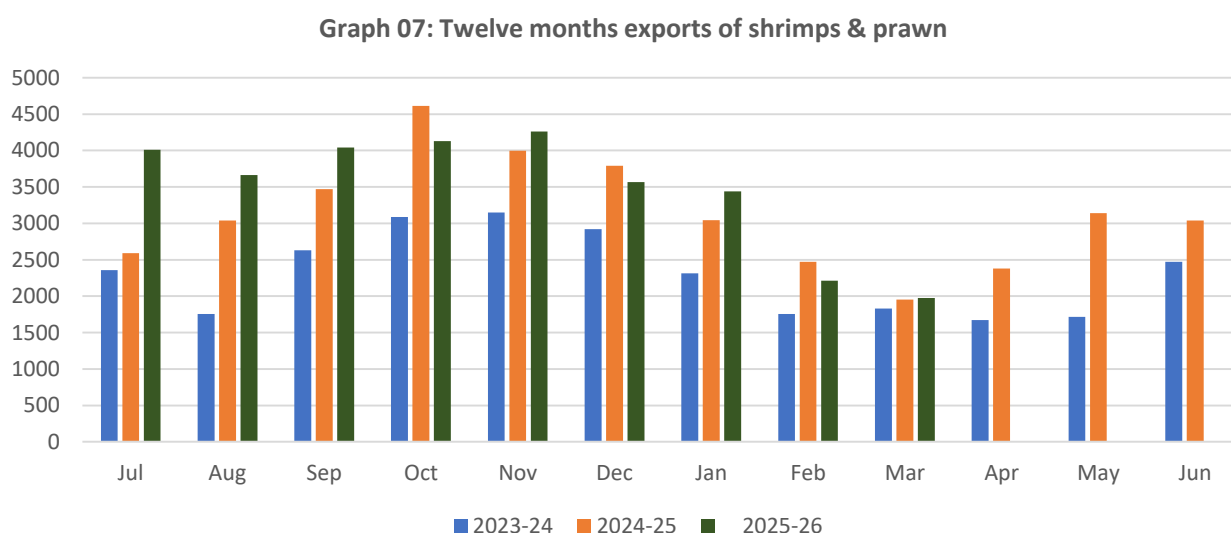

**Graph 07: Twelve months exports of shrimps & prawn**

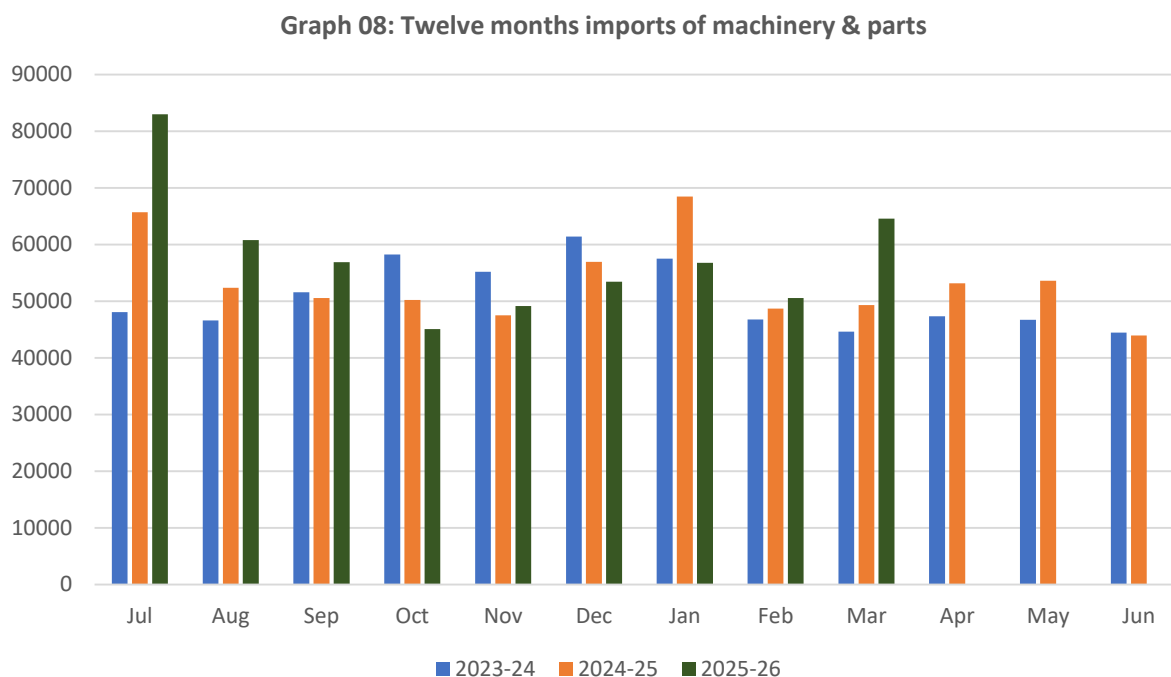

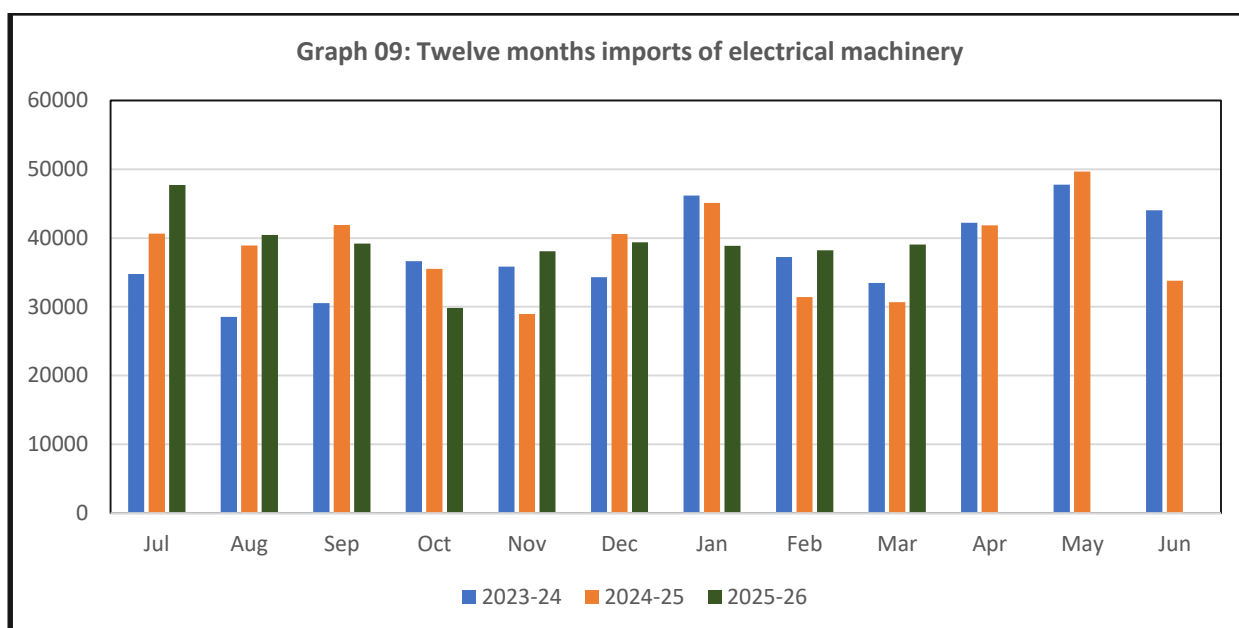

**Graph 09: Twelve months imports of electrical machinery**

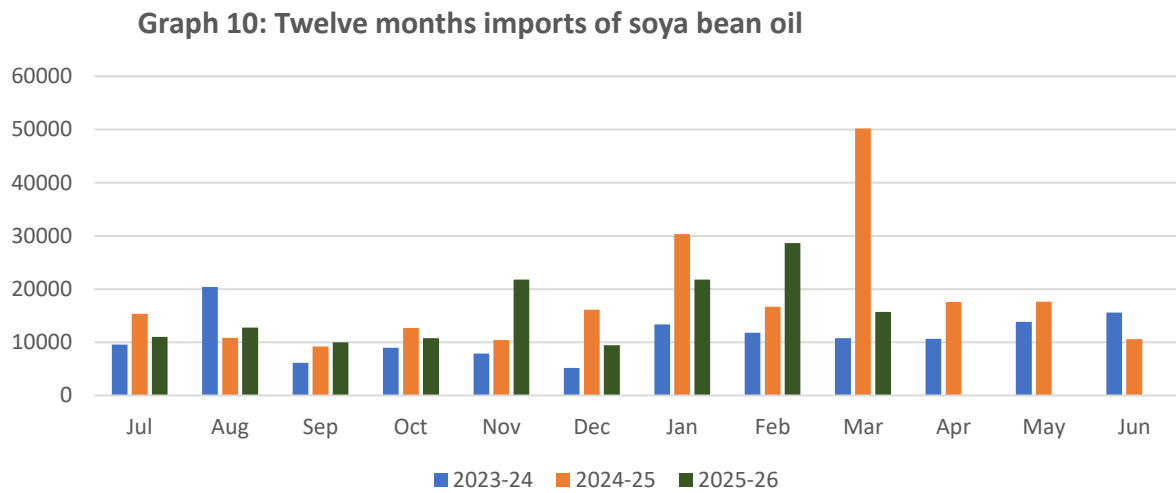

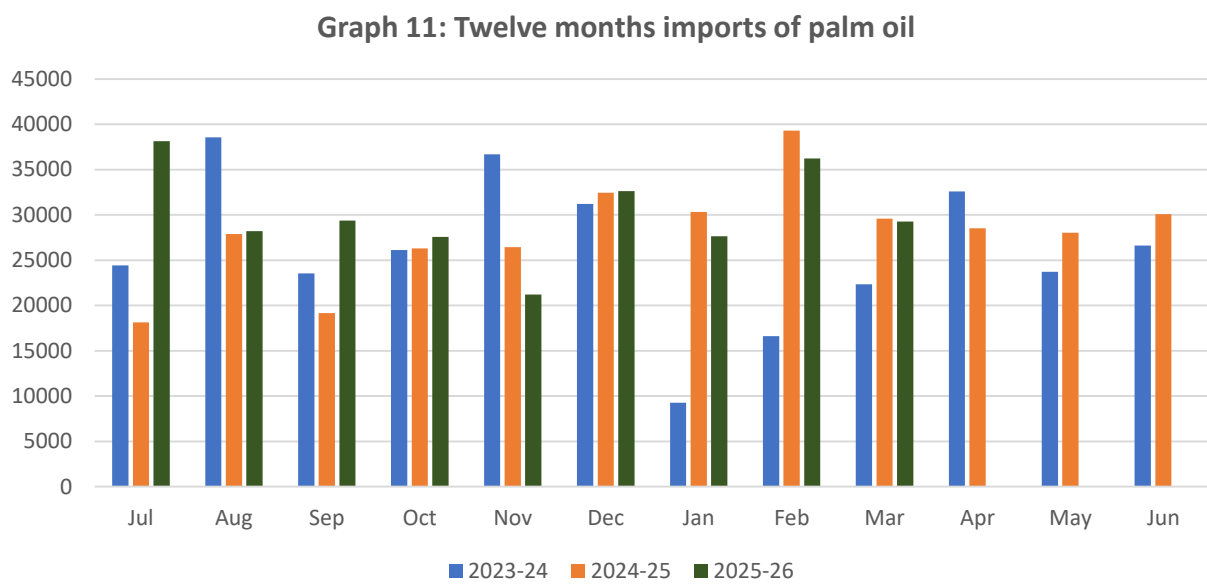

## Graph 11: Twelve months imports of palm oil

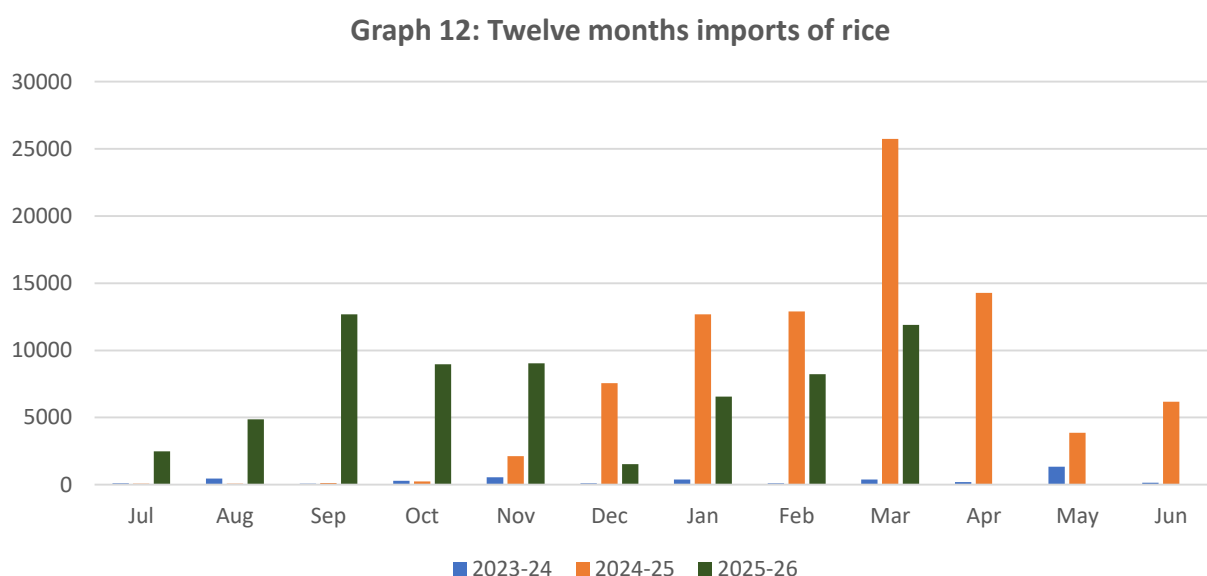

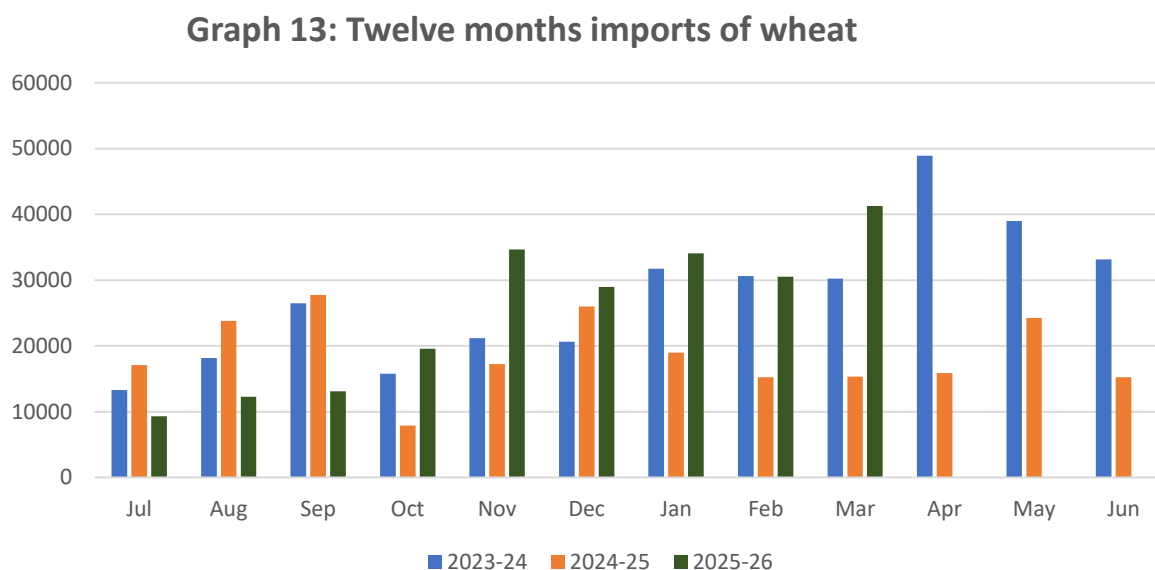

**Graph 13: Twelve months imports of wheat**

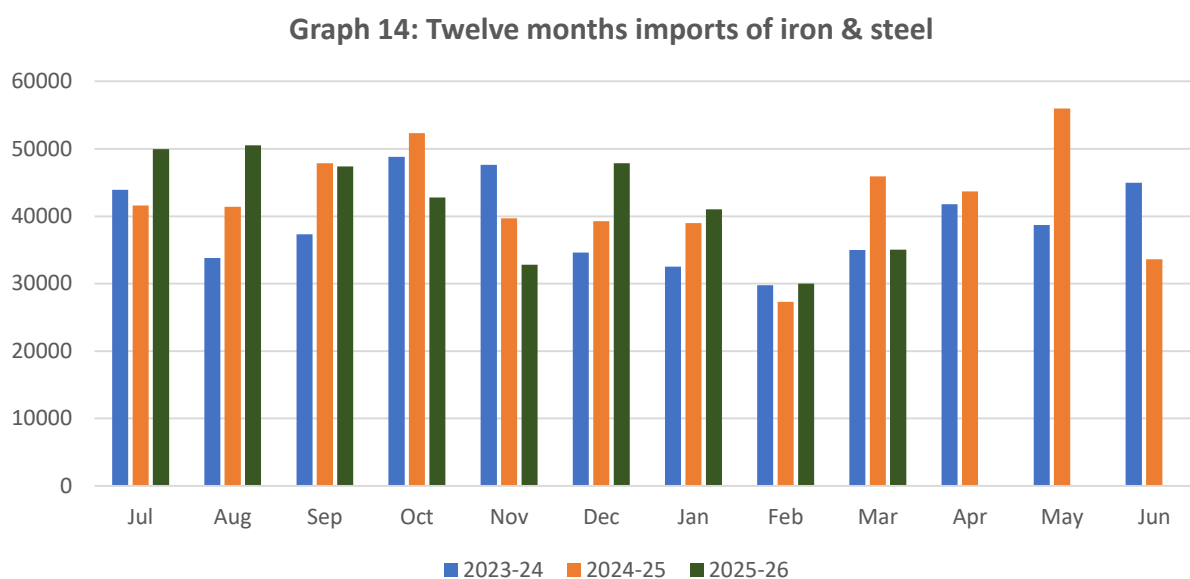

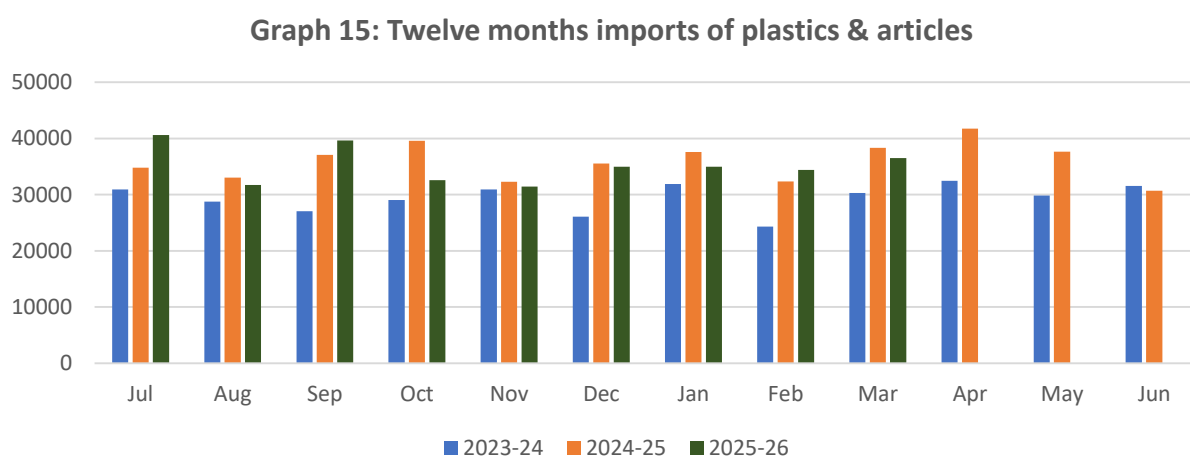

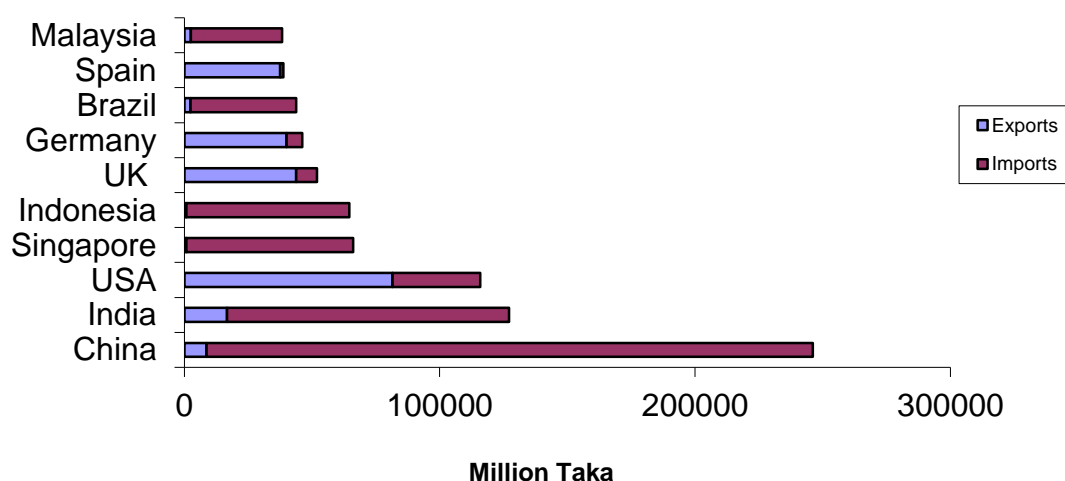
