This Monthly report is the 233th issue of this series of publication. This report presents a brief statistical overview of Bangladesh's foreign trade based on provisional data. It covers monthly export and import trends, trade balance, commodity-wise movements, essential imports, twelve-month performance of major items, the top trading partners, Re-Exports, Re-Imports, Temporary Exports, Temporary Imports.

The data used in this report have been collected from administrative sources. Merchandise trade data are primarily sourced from the National Board of Revenue (NBR), while data on trade in services are obtained from Bangladesh Bank (BB).

BBS has prepared HS Codes at the 2 to 4 digit level to cover all commodities under foreign trade.

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Executive Summary

Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics (BBS) compiles and publishes Foreign Trade Statistics (FTS) on a regular basis. This publication presents monthly trend of Bangladesh foreign trade statistics on top trading partners, essential import commodities and last twelve month's scenario of major export and import goods especially for June, 2026.

Merchandise trade data of this publication are provided by National Board of Revenue (NBR) while data on services from Bangladesh Bank. Data presented in this publication are provisional and subject to revision. All these provisional data will be subsequently reviewed and revised. Revised data are being presented in next issues.

In for June, 2026 total export and import of goods and services is recorded at decreased by Tk. 607.70 and increased by Tk. 1327.88 billion respectively resulting in a trade deficit at goods and services of Tk. 720.18 billion. The growth of export and import in for June, 2026 decreased by 0.79 and increased by 26.24 percent respectively comparing to for May, 2026 and it increased by 27.09 and increased by 58.94 percent respectively comparing to for June, 2025.

For the three months ending for June, 2026 the average of export of goods and services was Tk. 596.84 billion, while the moving average of import of goods and services was Tk. 1199.50 billion resulting in an average trade deficit of Tk. 602.65 billion. For the three months ending May, 2026 the average trade deficit was Tk. 539.72 billion reflecting average exports of Tk. 562.93 billion and average imports of Tk. 1102.65 billion.

In June, 2026 Bangladesh's merchandise trade was highly concentrated among top ten trading partners. China ranked first with a total trade value of Tk. 342583 million (20.25 percent), followed by the United States with Tk. 160651 million (9.49 percent) and India with Tk. 152652 million (9.02 percent). Other major partners included Singapore, Brazil, Malaysia, Germany, Indonesia, Korea REP. and the United Kingdom. These ten countries together accounted for the dominant share of Bangladesh's total foreign trade in goods during the reference month.

Indicators of this publication are expected to provide a good idea about the trend of export and import of the country over the previous months of a year. This monthly release would be a useful document for planners, policy makers, researchers, development partners/agencies, academicians and other stakeholders.

Graph 01: Export and Import by Month

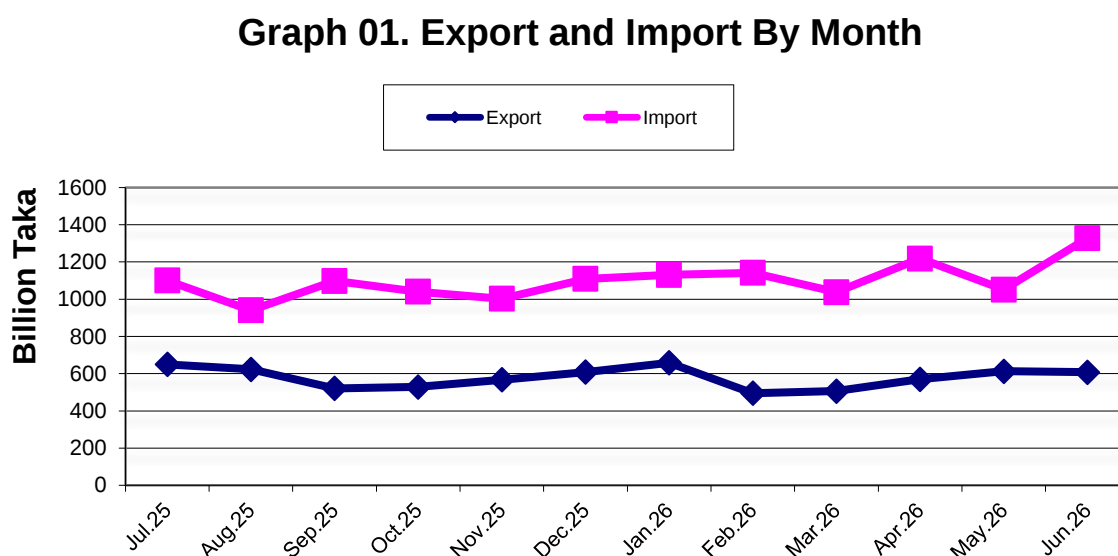

Graph 02. Export and Import By Month

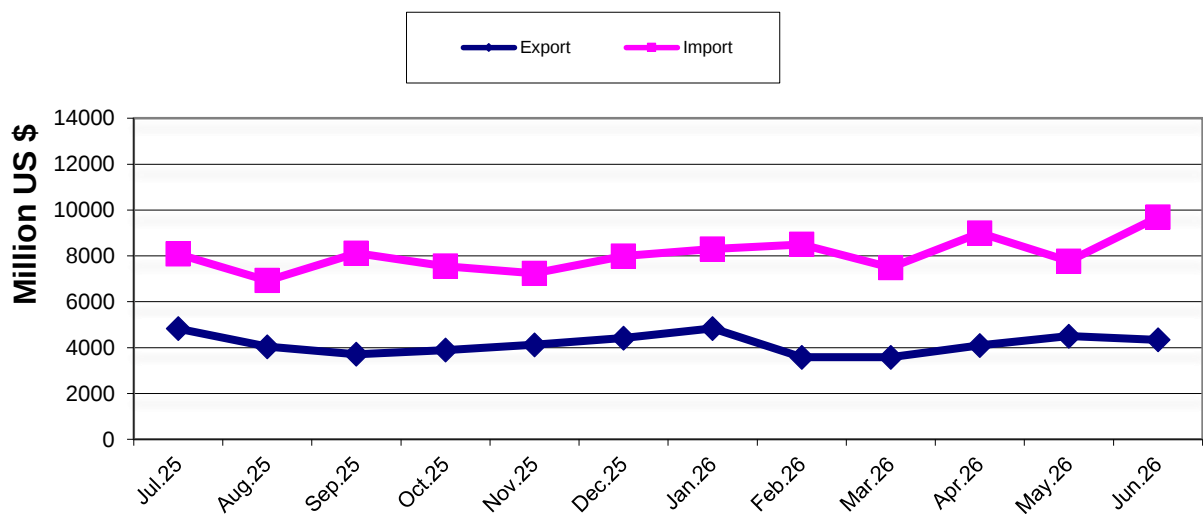

Graph 03: Export of redymade garments and others

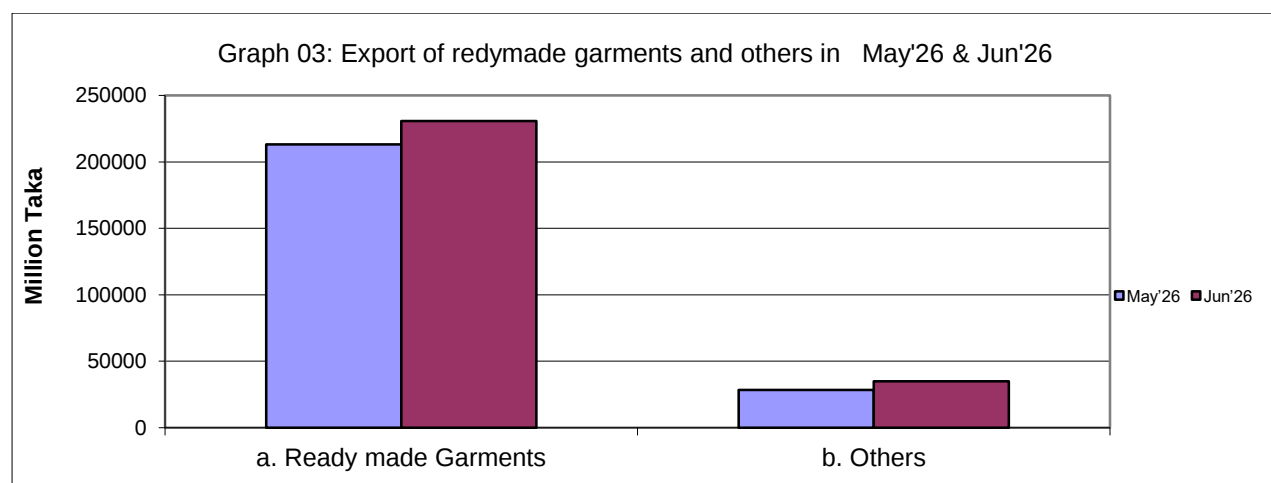

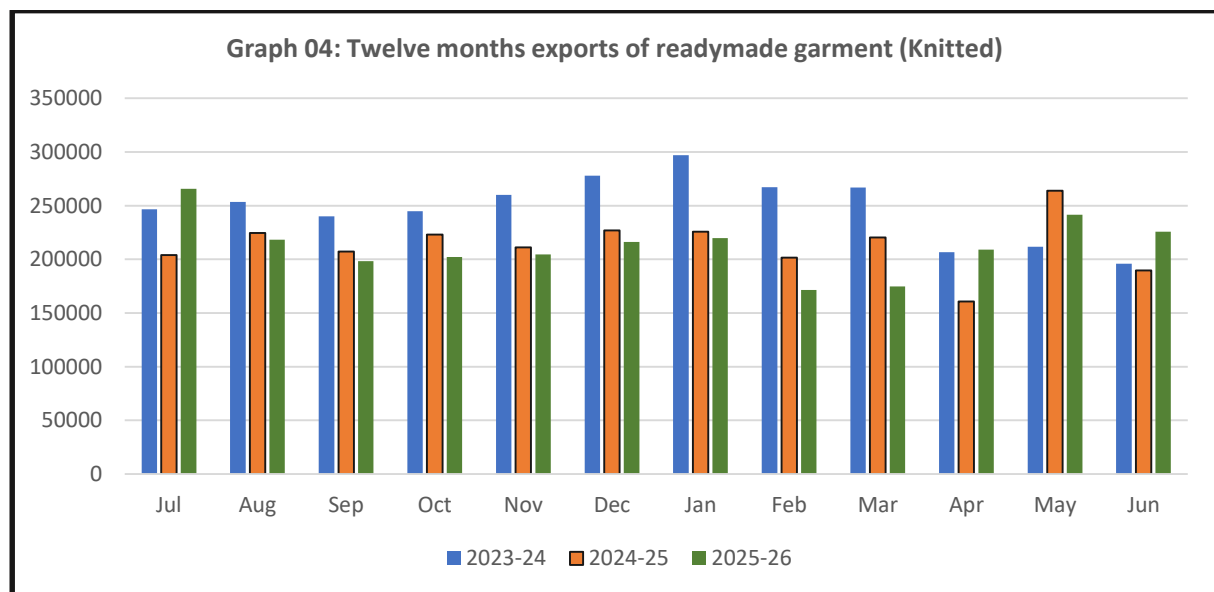

Graph 05: Twelve months exports of readymade garment (Not Knitted)

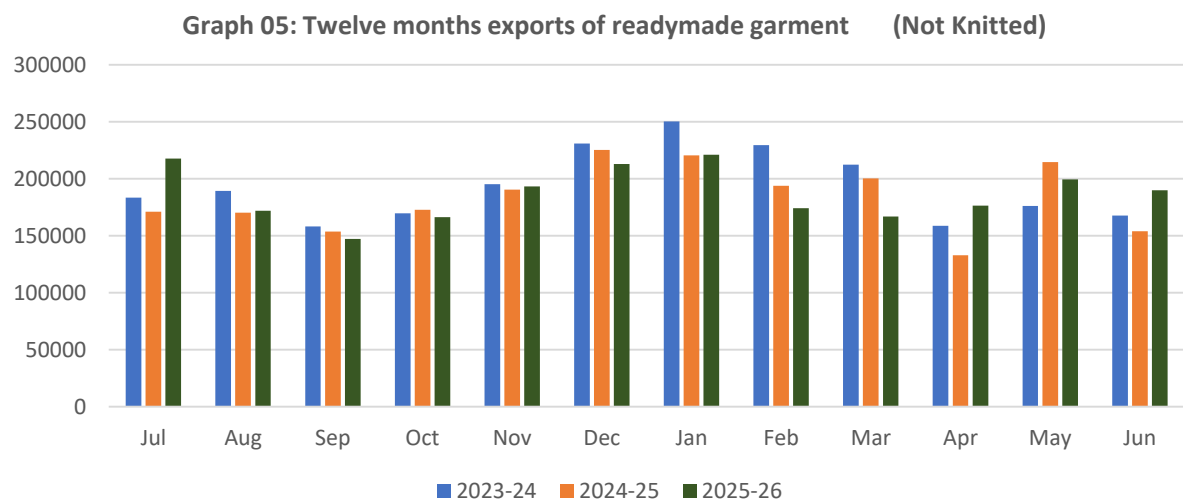

Graph 06: Twelve months exports of raw, hides, skins & leather

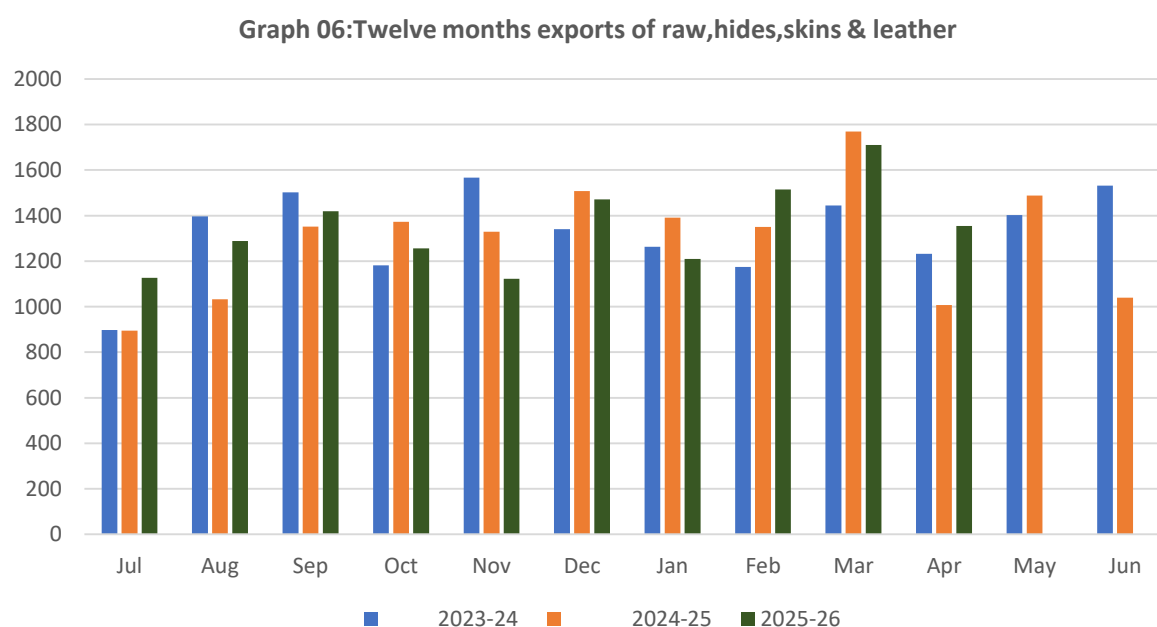

Graph 07: Twelve months exports of shrimps & prawn

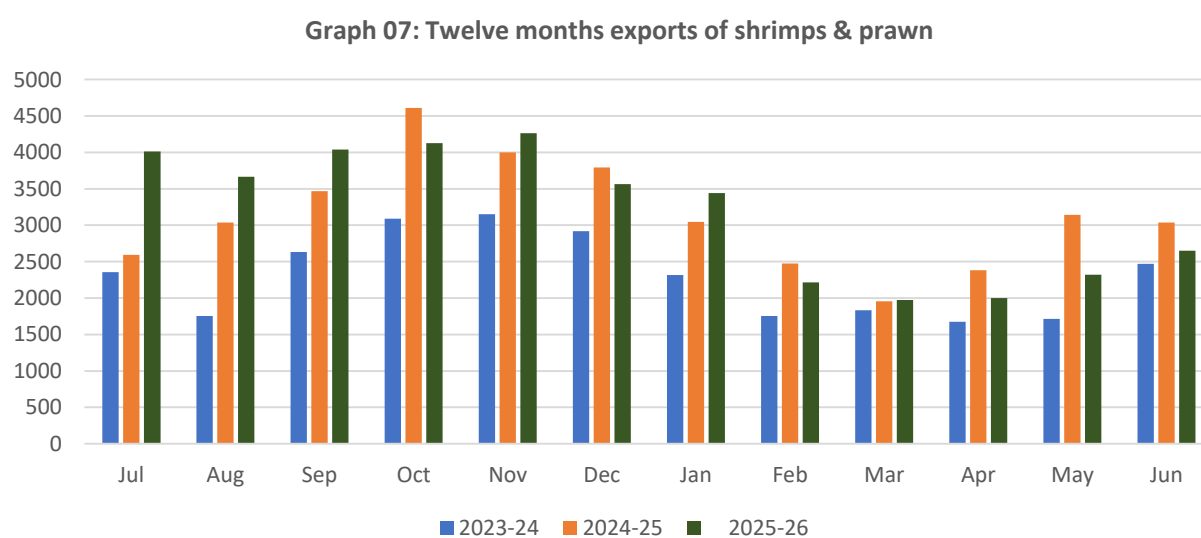
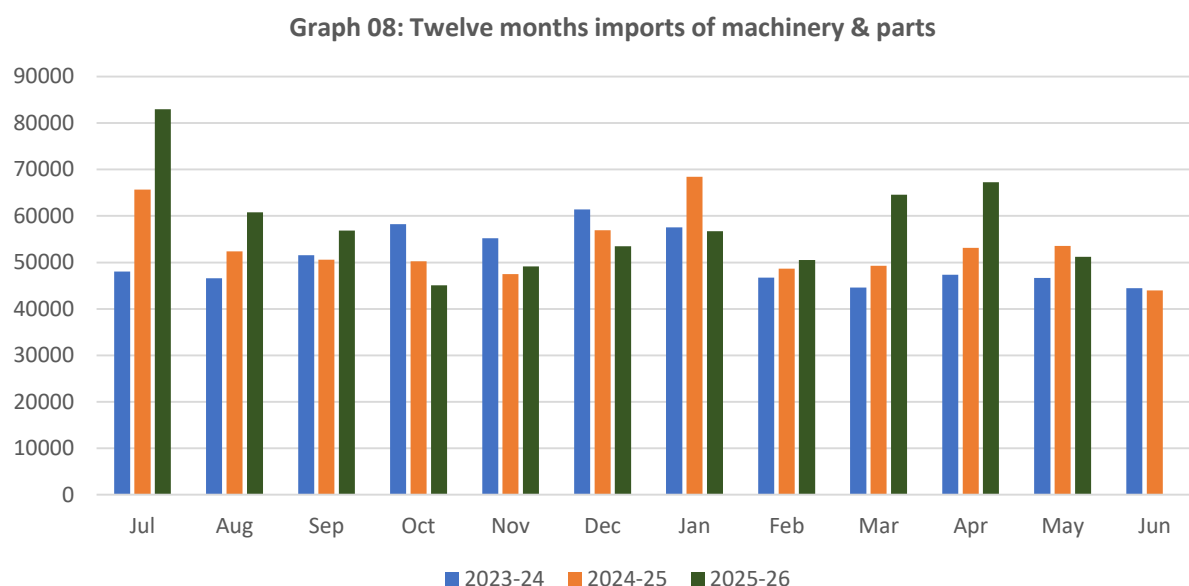

Graph 09: Twelve months imports of electrical machinery

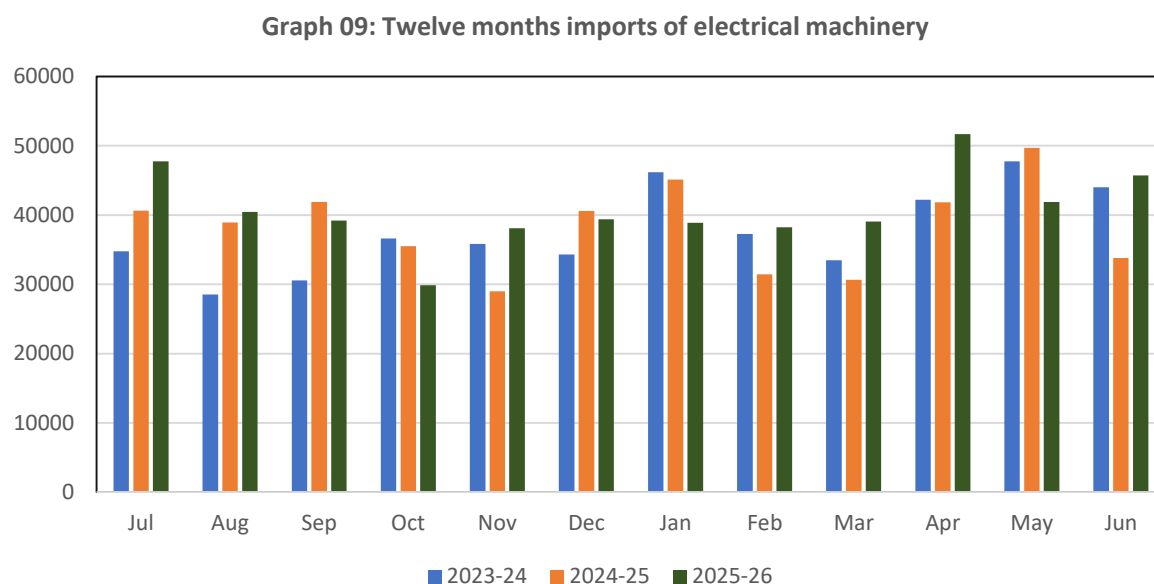
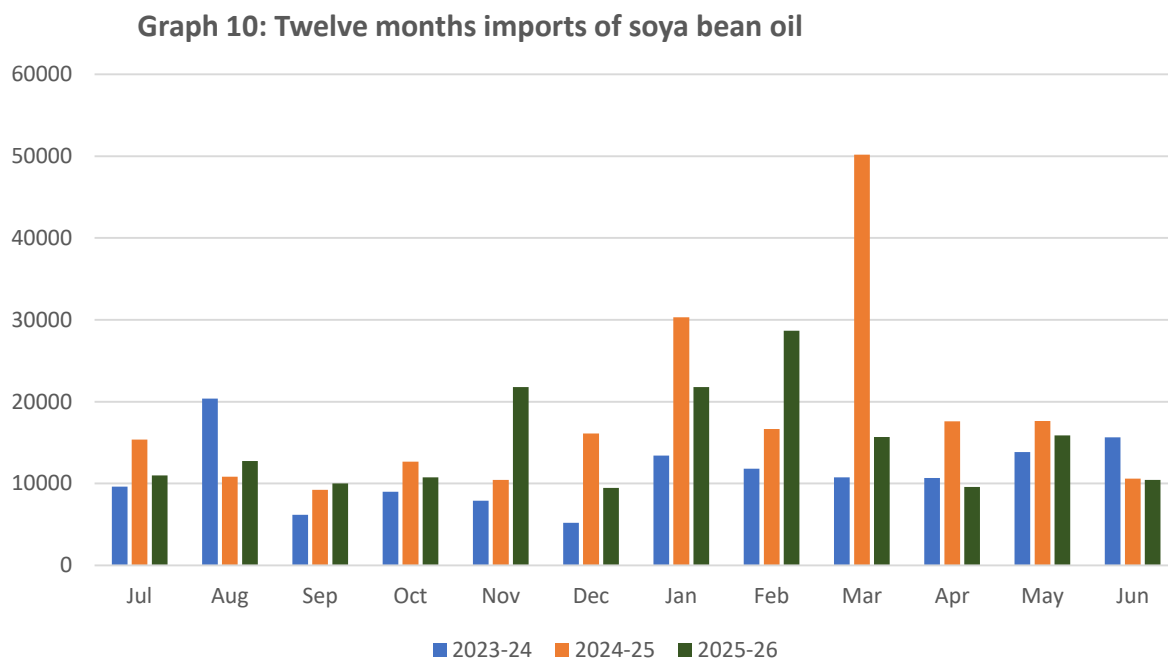

Graph 11: Twelve months imports of palm oil

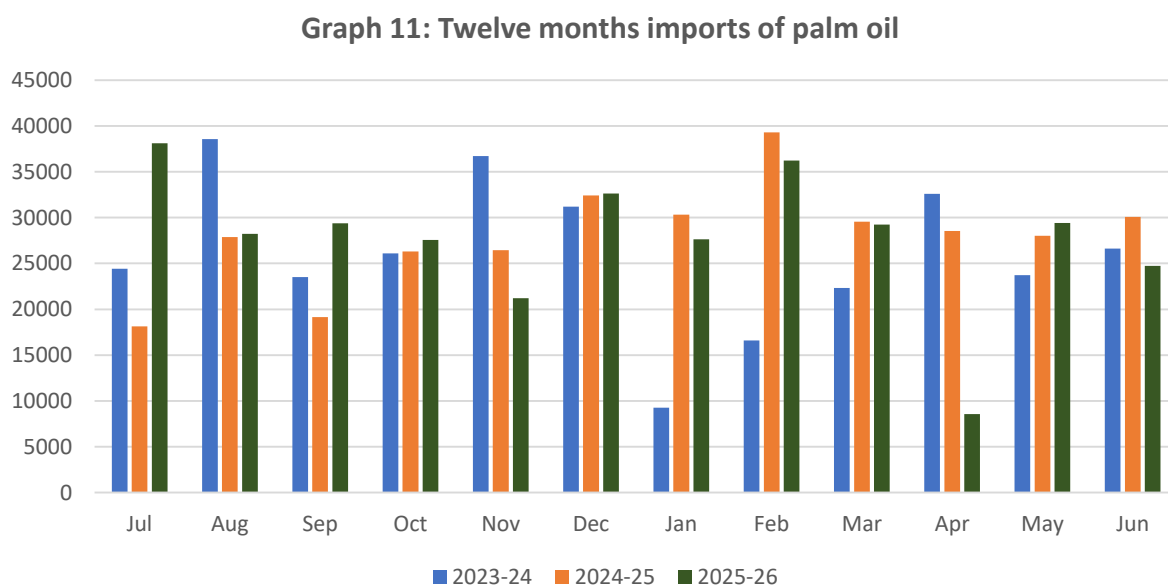
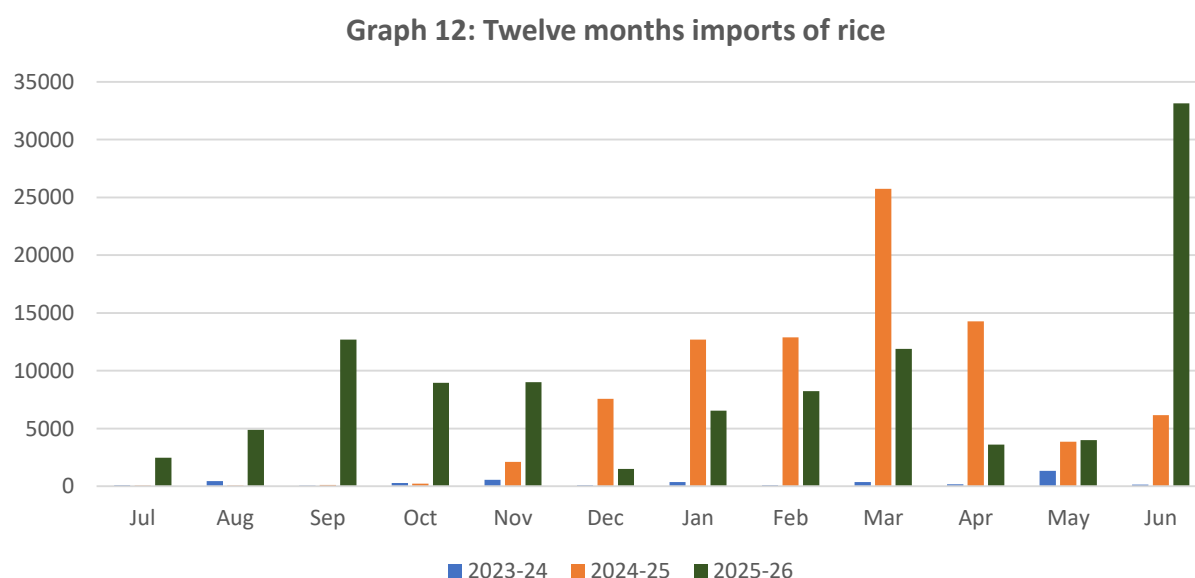

Graph 13: Twelve months imports of wheat

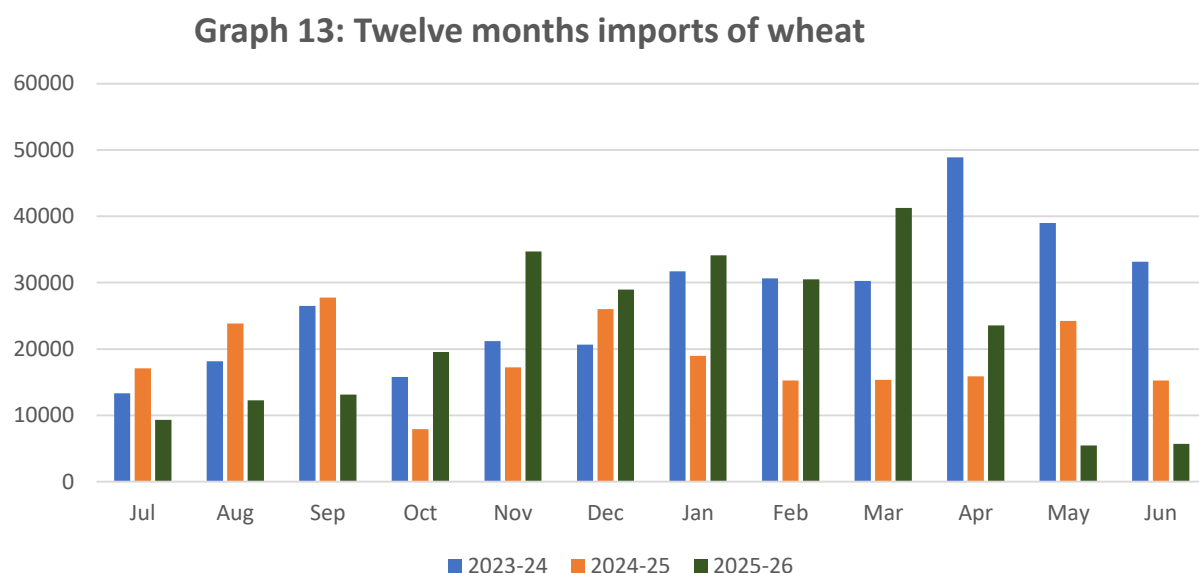
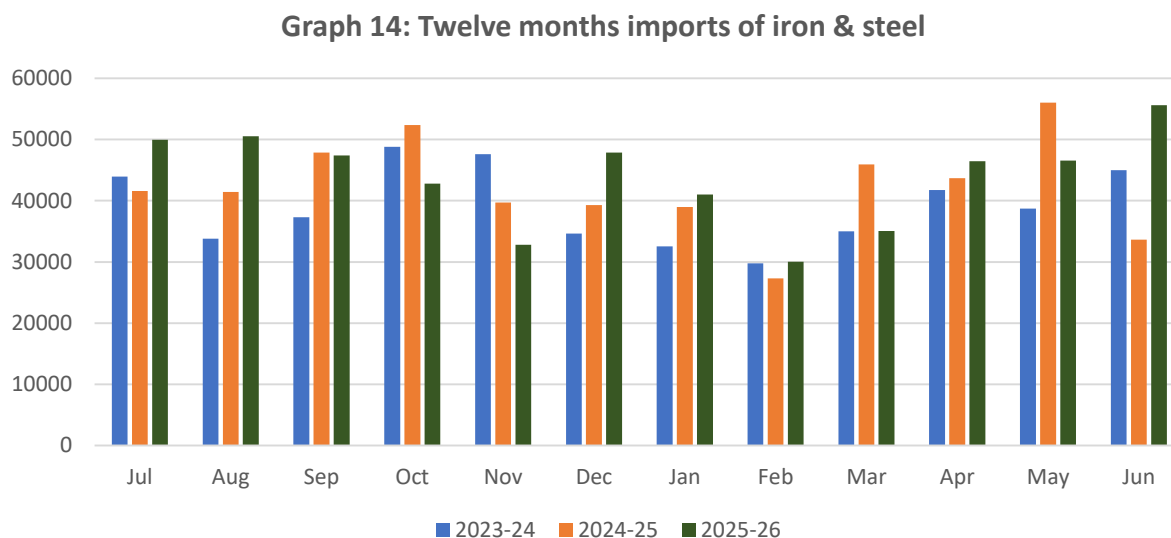

Graph 15: Twelve months imports of plastics & articles

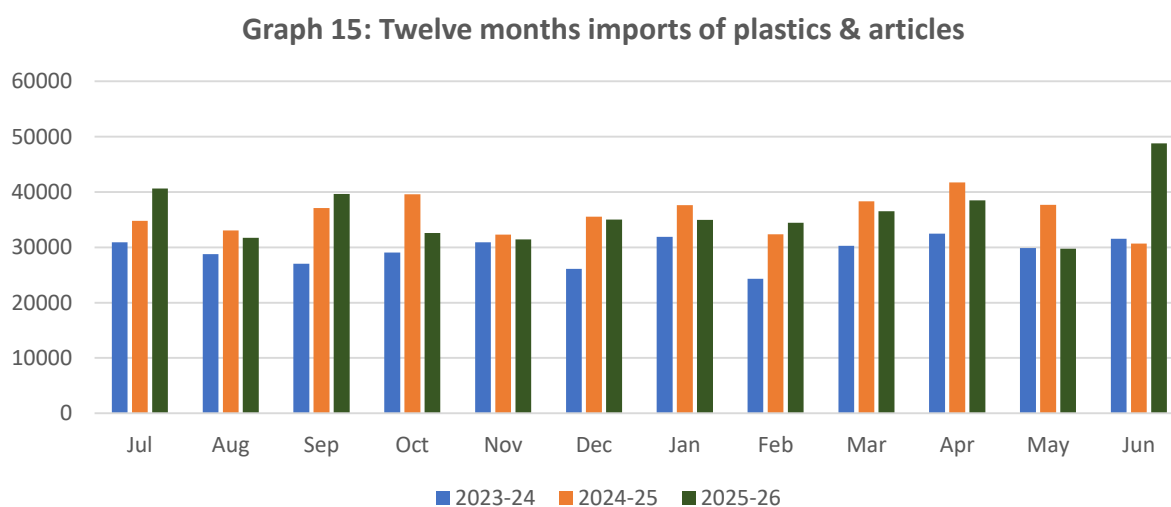

Graph 16:Top trading partners – total trade (goods), June-2026.

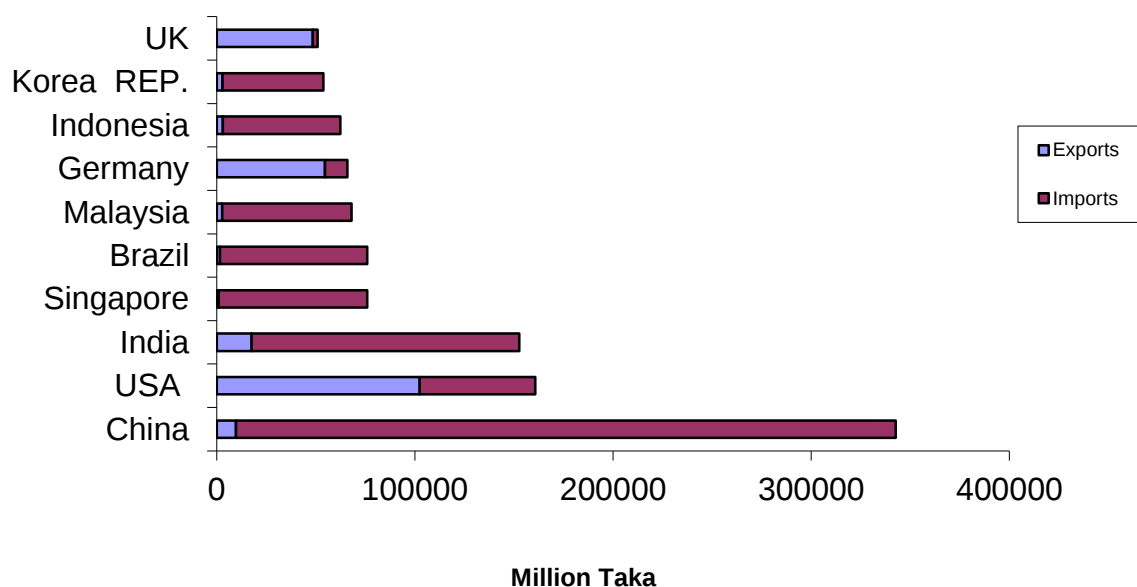
