Notice

With reference to previous Notice no. 19.02.9992.400.01.01.25 dated 18 December 2025, this is to clarify that a General Power of Attorney (GPA) gives an agent broad authority to act on the principal's behalf, covering a wide range of financial and legal matters such as maintaining/regulating/transferring/operating moveable or immovable properties like land, building, flat, business, bank account and representing legal cases etc. together at a single Power of Attorney. On the other hand, a Special Power of Attorney (SPA) grants authority for a single, specific task or action, like maintaining/regulating/transferring/operating a particular moveable or immovable property or representing in a particular legal case.

Please note that the power for specific task or purpose will be authenticated, power for multiple tasks or purposes cannot be authenticated.
