3. Imported animals will be exhibited only in Dulahazara Safari Park, Cox's Bazar.
4. Importer will have to collect Quarantine Certificate from Livestock Quarantine Station, Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport, Dhaka.
5. This CITES Import Permit is not transferable and import of wild animal is strictly prohibited, except export quotes as per CITES Convention.
6. Imported animals and mentioned microchip number of each imported species must be verified by a forest officer immediate after reach at Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport before leaving the Airport premises.
7. This Permit is issued for one consignment only.
