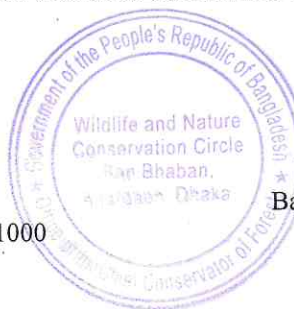

Conditions:

1. The above mentioned cage birds will have to import through Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport, Dhaka.
2. Imported birds must be kept in cages, so that they could not come in contact with any other animals.
3. Imported cage birds cannot be released in nature.
4. Dead birds must be buried deep in the ground.
5. After import, rings must be worn on the legs of imported birds within 7(seven) days and inform the licensing authority.
6. Importer will have to collect Quarantine Certificate from Livestock Quarantine Station, Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport, Dhaka.
7. This Permit is not transferable.
8. Imported birds must be verified by a forest officer immediate after reach at Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport before leaving the Airport premises.
