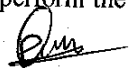
The Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, through the Bangladesh Forest Department (BFD), intends to engage an experienced Engineering Consulting Firm for consultancy services under the Elephant Conservation Project. The assignment will support survey coordination, planning, preparation of detailed engineering designs and cost estimates, preparation of bidding documents, and construction supervision for elephant conservation infrastructure.

The overall objective of the assignment is to provide professional engineering consultancy services for planning, design, estimate preparation, tender assistance and construction supervision of infrastructure under the Elephant Conservation Project, while ensuring quality, timely implementation, environmental safeguards and protection of elephant habitats and movement corridors.

The major components covered by the assignment include drainage structures; electrical supply works; solar power fencing; tree towers; water holes; saltlick areas; temporary treatment sheds; staff barracks; Elephant Rescue Centers at Gazipur Safari Park and Dulahazara Safari Park, Cox's Bazar; and an Elephant Sanctuary at Chunati, Chattogram with associated structures and utilities.

The Bangladesh Forest Department (BFD) now invites eligible Consulting Firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consulting Firms should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services.



The shortlisting criteria are:

- The firm shall be a registered consulting firm with at least ten (10) years of experience in construction supervision of civil works.
- The firm shall have successfully completed at least three (3) similar assignments within the last seven (7) years, preferably for government and/or autonomous organizations.
- Preference will be given to firms having prior experience in construction supervision projects in the environment and forestry sector.
- The firm shall demonstrate adequate qualified technical personnel and the necessary equipment, resources and logistical capacity to carry out the assignment.
- The firm shall possess valid Trade License, VAT Registration Certificate, Tax Identification Number (TIN) Certificate, Bank Solvency Certificate and Audited Financial Statements for the last three (3) fiscal years.
- Experience in planning/design and drawings, preparation of BOQ and cost estimates, tender/bid document preparation and construction supervision of conservation-related or environmentally sensitive infrastructure will be considered relevant to the assignment.

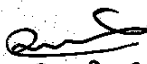
Key Experts will not be evaluated at the shortlisting stage. The key professionals identified in the TOR include a Team Leader (Design & Supervision), Structural Engineer, Environmental Safeguard Specialist, Quality Assurance Engineer, Cost Estimator/QS, Site Supervision Engineers and Electrical Engineer.

Attention of interested Consultants is drawn to the applicable provisions of the Public Procurement Rules, 2025 (PPR-2025), Public Procurement Act, 2006 (as amended), and other applicable Government of Bangladesh procurement requirements concerning conflict of interest, eligibility and association of consultants.

A Consulting Firm will be selected in accordance with the Selection Based on Consultants Qualification (SBCQ) method, as stated in the TOR and in accordance with the applicable procurement rules. Further information can be obtained at the address below during office hours.
