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Guideline on Examination System for B.Sc. in Nursing

There are total 15 subjects in B.Sc in Nursing program. These subjects are grouped under three headings; (i) General courses (ii) Foundation courses and (iii) Professional courses. *General course* are: Communicative English and Information & Communication Technology and Behavioral Science. *Foundation courses* are: Anatomy & Physiology. *Professional courses* consist of 12 subjects namely Fundamentals of Nursing 1&2, Pediatric Nursing, Medical & Surgical Nursing 1&2, Orthopedic Nursing, Community Health Nursing, Psychiatric Nursing, Emergency & Critical Care Nursing, Midwifery, Nursing Education & Management & Research in Nursing, The courses will be assessed according to the University assessment process.

In this four-year B.Sc. in Nursing program, each year is divided into one term examination for effective implementation of the curriculum and another is university (written, oral and practical) examination called year final examination. The marks of term examination will be added with written formative marks for university final examination.

Examination System & Distribution of Marks

1. Regular final examination will be held twice in each academic year in December and June under the concerned university;
2. Each examination will be considered as regular;
3. Each academic year is divided into two terms of 26-week of duration;
4. A term examination will also be conducted internally in the each academic year by the individual institutions/colleges;
5. A student must appear in each year final examination. In order to pass each year of the overall course, a student must achieve a pass grade in all subjects in that year. In order to pass a subject, a student must pass in each individual assessment area of that specific subject;
6. Assessment area includes written and/or oral and/or practical/clinical of that specific subject;
7. Student who fails (obtains less than 60%) in any part of the subject(s), she/he will appear in the next exam;
8. If a student fails in the first year exam, she/he will get maximum four chances for passing the examination of that year. She/he may attend 2nd year classes but will not be allowed to appear in the 2nd year final exam until she/he passes all subjects of 1st year. The same rule is applicable for 2nd, 3rd and 4th year;
9. All assessment will be conducted according to set criteria. If any question arises, the examination committee will resolve that;
10. Examination committee to be formed before each year final exam to conduct examination;
11. If a student fails to meet the clinical & field practice requirements of the course for any genuine reason (sick, emergency leave etc.), she/he has to make up her/his clinical practice requirements in extra time with submission of necessary documents/medical certificate;
12. All examinations will be governed by the existing rules of the university;
13. Year final examination will be taken at the end of each academic year and re-examinee candidate will appear in the next exam;
14. The examination system and total marks for written, oral and/or practical is shown against each subject separately in the curriculum/syllabus;

15. Total marks in each year of B.Sc. in nursing programme are as follows:

First year final	= 1000
Second year final	= 1000
Third year final	= 900
<u>Fourth year final</u>	<u>= 900</u>
Grand total	= 3800

16. Marks of written examination in case of 100 marks will be as follows:

Written (SAQ+EAQ)	= 70

17. Marks of written examination in case of 70 marks will be as follows:

Written (SAQ+EAQ)	= 40

18. Formative Assessment: 10 marks is allocated for formative assessment of each paper, when a total mark of written exam is 70 or 100;

10 marks of formative assessment will be divided as follows:

Class attendance	= 2 ($\geq 80\%$)
Term examinations	= 4 (60%-69% = 2, 70%-79% = 3, $\geq 80\%$ = 4)
<u>In-course assignment</u>	<u>= 4 (60%-69% = 2, 70%-79% = 3, $\geq 80\%$ = 4)</u>
Total	= 10

** Eligible criteria for appearing final exam is 6 out of 10*

19. **Objective type questions** (it will cover 10 best & 10 correct answers): 20 marks is allocated for 20 MCQ, when total marks of written exam are of 70 or 100;

20. Rest of the marks of the written examination is allocated for SAQ and EAQ. The written script will be divided into two papers (Groups-A & B);

21. The oral and/or practical examination will be taken after final written examination;

22. Marks of practical examination in each subject will be as follows:

a. 10 marks are allocated for formative assessment. This includes attendance (clinical/field) and evaluation of clinical/field performance. Clinical/field performance may be evaluated through care plan, case studies & presentation, individual report, debate, oral presentation and teaching session;

b. 10 marks of formative (practical) assessment will be divided as follows:

Practical attendance	= 2 ($\geq 85\%$)
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Field visit/clinical assignment report = 4 (60%-69% = 2, 70%-79% = 3, $\geq 80\%$ = 4)

Case studies & presentation = 4 (60%-69% = 2, 70%-79% = 3, $\geq 80\%$ = 4)

Total = 10

**Eligible criteria for appearing final exam is 6 out 10*

23. Rest of the marks is distributed equally for oral and practical examinations where applicable;

24. Oral and practical examination will be conducted together and marks will be aggregated;

25. Oral examination will be done by structured questions and oral presentation involving internal and external assessors;
26. Practical examination may include OSPE (Objective Structured Practical Examination) or/and traditional methods, and practical note book/ laboratory notebook/lesson plan preparation/teaching session/reflective notebook;
27. **Pass mark:** 60% marks must be obtained in written, oral, practical and clinical examination of each subject & individual area;
28. If student fails in any paper, she/he will appear only failed paper. For example, if student fails paper I or II of the Anatomy & Physiology, the student has to appear only the failed paper;
29. **Honours mark:** Honours mark should be awarded when 80% and above marks is obtained in all subjects in year final examination in first attempt and will be declare passed with Honours mark.
30. **Distinction:** When 80% or more mark is achieved in a any (one or more) subject, this is called distinction.
31. Position should be based on the aggregated mark of written, oral and practical examination of all subjects;
32. Re-examinee student will not get the position, but may get distinction mark in individual subject;
33. **Attendance and Marks:**

34. There should be provision of preparing check-list book for assessing & improving the competencies of students;
35. Every subject should have a manual to conduct teaching learning activities of the curriculum in proper way;

Internship: After completion of the program every student has to perform 06 (six) months internship.

Certification and Licensure:

Bangladesh Nursing and Midwifery Council will issue license/registration as a registered nurse after passed comprehensive or licencing examination.

Methods of Assessment:

Methods of assessment are both formative and summative for theory as well as for practice. Major emphasis will be given in the acquisition of clinical skills of professional courses;

1. Formative Assessment

- 1.1 In the theoretical part, formative assessment will be done throughout the programme, which includes a combination of class attendance, term examinations (term examinations will be held as per institutional convenient time). Out of 100 marks a student must obtain 60% in written/ oral/practical examinations. However, in the terms examination students must obtain 3 out of 4 marks and in course assignment such as written assignment, preparation of posters, booklets, laboratory reports, practical notebook, case study, nursing care plan, oral presentation, report writing etc.
- 1.2 Practical part formative assessment includes attendance (clinical/field) and evaluation of clinical performance. Evaluation of clinical/ field performance will be done through observation, check list, preparation of nursing care plan, case presentation, report writing, practical notebook, health education session, teaching session and maintaining diary for reflective learning.

2. Summative Assessment

Summative assessment will be done at the end of the course which includes written, oral and practical examination.

System of Year Final Examination

The year final examination is divided into two, one is term exam and another one is university final exam. The class test or quiz is essential for appearing term and final exam in each year.

1. Quiz or Class Test

- i. Number of class test or quiz: At least two class tests or quizzes will be conducted in each individual subject in an academic year.
- ii. Number of questions: Depends upon the subject content of the syllabus.
- iii. Marks: The total mark is 25. The obtained marks will be converted into percentage and then graded accordingly.
- iv. Time: Time will be allocated according to types / nature of questions.
- v. Types of question: questions of quiz or class test should be based on:
 - a. Recall type = 60%,
 - b. Understanding or data interpretation or problem based type = 20%
 - c. Analytical = 20%

2. In-course Assignment:

- i. Number of in-course assignment: One assignment will be given in each individual subject in each year.
- ii. Type of assignment: Assignment depends on the individual subject. It may include essay writing, preparation of poster, individual/ group project, booklet, laboratory report, practical notebook, case study, nursing care plan, case presentation, debate, field report etc.
- iii. Marks: Assignment will carry 20 marks and the assignment should be submitted within time line.
- iv. Date of submission: Student will submit the assignment at least 3 months prior to the commencement of the year final examination.

- v. Instruction: There should be a clear guideline by individual subject teacher about written assignment for example; introduction, writing style, format of presentation, date of submission, word limit, conclusion, referencing style and any other instruction required for completing the assignment.

3. Marks of Formative Assessment

- i. Obtained marks of assessment of theory and practical part will be added in the final examination mark sheet separately.
- ii. All formative marks will be recorded by individual subject teacher.
- iii. During the final examination oral & practical formative marks will be shown to the external examiner. Both examiners will sign the mark sheet.
- iv. Finally the Principal of college will send these mark sheet to the controller.

4. Multiple choice question (MCQ) and best answer question

- i. Number of item: 10 MCQ and 10 best answer question for each subject.
- ii. Time allocation: 20 minutes for 20 questions.
- iii. Type of questions: Multiple True/False type and best answer types.
- iv. Pattern of questions: Each question will have one stem with five (5) alternatives in case of MCQ and one stem with (four) 4 alternatives in case of best answer question.
- v. Marks: Each question will carry one mark where each alternative will carry 0.2 marks in case of MCQ and in case of best answer one question will carry (one) 1 mark.
- vi. In case of MCQ the ratio of true false in alternatives will be 3:2 or 2:3.
- vii. MCQ and best answer question will be divided into two groups- group A and group B. Each group will contain (five) 5 MCQ and (five) 5 best answer questions.
- viii. Key answer of the MCQ and best answer question for each group will be supplied to the script examiners separately.
- ix. MCQ and best answer question examination will be taken within the first 20 minutes of the written examination.
- x. No negative marks will be given for wrong answer.
- xi. Marks of MCQ, best answer questions, SAQ & EQ of a particular group should be sent together in the same envelop to the controller.
- xii. If there is fraction mark 0.5 or over will be considered as 1. If the mark is below 0.5 it will not be counted.

5. Short and Essay type question:

Recall type	60%
Analytical	20%
Problem based	20%

6. **Mixed questions:** A combination of Objective questions (OQ), SAQ and EAQ will be used for some subjects as mentioned earlier. The mixed questions will either have stem or not.

7. Oral or/and Practical/Clinical Examination

- i. Oral examination will be done by structured questions and/or oral presentation involving internal and external examiners.
- ii. Practical examination will include OSPE (Objective Structured Practical Examination) or/and traditional methods, and practical notebook/ laboratory notebook/lesson plan/teaching session/reflective notebook.
- iii. Clinical/Field performance will be assessed through checklist by using set criteria of scoring during the course.

- iv. Oral and practical examination will be conducted together after written examination.
- v. Student must pass oral and practical examination separately. Student must get 60% mark as pass mark.
- vi. Number of Examinee for each day: Student should not be more than 20.

8. Structured Oral Examination (SOE): Preparation of questions and conduction of examination

- i. Questions should be prepared by both internal and external examiner covering the whole contents of the subject.
- ii. Key answer should be provided.
- iii. Several questions will be developed from the contents for each box.
 - a. Recall type: Each box will contain at least 10-15 questions from the whole content of the subject.
 - b. Analytical question: At least 5-10 questions from the whole content of the subject will be prepared.
 - c. Problem based question: At least 5-10 questions from the whole content of the subject will be prepared.
- iv. There will be up to five boxes contain structured oral questions. Oral part will be taken by lottery system.
 - a. From recall type question boxes, student will draw up to 2 questions from one box i.e., 6 questions from the three boxes. (2+2+2=6)
 - b. Student will draw up to 2 questions from each analytical box.
 - c. Student will draw up to 2 questions from each problem based question box.
- v. Allocation of marks for each question: depend on types of questions.
- vi. Both the examiners will give marks separately for all questions answered, both the examiners mark will be added and find out the mean/average marks.
- vii. Student must get 60% mark as pass mark.

9. Conduction of Practical assessment:

- i. Practical assessment consists of OSPE, traditional examination or assessing the practical notebook.
- ii. OSPE (Objective Structured Practical Examination) consists of two kinds of station: Spotted station and procedures (Procedures will be applied where applicable).
- iii. For each spotted station will be 3 or 5 minutes.
- iv. In procedure station student will be asked to perform a particular nursing procedure/task. To assess student's performance 6 to 8 cards on different nursing procedure will be kept. Students will be instructed to draw up to 2 cards for performing the procedures. Checklists for specific procedures should be prepared beforehand and be available for examiners.
- v. During procedures station, for observing the activity of student, the examiner will use checklist. Examiner will give marks by observing the student's activity and may ask questions.
- vi. Marks of OSPE, traditional practical examination and/or practical notebook will be added together for counting total practical marks. The total practical marks from internal & external examiner will be added and do the mean and signed by both examiners. Students must get 60% marks for pass.
