### Training Workshop on RIIAP Facilitation Capacity Development

The Department of Behavioral Science of BPATC has organized a 3-day workshop for 10 faculty members of the Center during June 17-19, 2025, to develop their capacity in facilitating training interventions that are modeled on experiential learning. This capacity development initiative was linked to a problem-solving approach through the design and implementation of action plans addressing organizational problems. The approach is named the Reforms Initiative/ Innovation Implementation Action Plan (RIIAP). The workshop aimed to achieve three objectives, which are—

- (1) Understand the importance of applying the experiential learning model to RIIAP development;
