



Memorandum of Understanding

between

Macquarie University Centre for Environmental Law, Australia
and
Bangladesh Public Administration Training Centre (BPATC)

Macquarie University Centre for Environmental Law and the Bangladesh Public Administration Training Centre (BPATC), Savar, Dhaka, Bangladesh with an intention to cooperate on academic and executive education and related matters, do hereby agree to develop mutual collaboration and cooperation to achieve the shared goals.

The interested areas of collaboration and cooperation delineated below will be carried out with mutually agreed terms and conditions based on both parties' written consent, fund availability and approval of both institutions. The areas of interest of both parties might be as follows:

1. Exchange of faculty members and students;
2. Jointly organize training courses for BPATC at BPATC and Macquarie University, Australia;
3. Arrange study visit programme for mid and senior level executives of Bangladesh at Macquarie University;
4. Extend support in organizing e-courses/distance learning courses in the area of public policies, good governance, conflict management, negotiation and other areas of public administration.
5. Macquarie University faculty members may conduct sessions at BPATC, Dhaka;
6. Jointly organize international conference/symposium, seminar and workshop on areas/issues of mutual interest;
7. Conduct joint research and extend support in knowledge management.

The detailed areas of collaboration and cooperation and arrangement of funding under this Memorandum of Understanding will be negotiated under separate agreement.

This Memorandum of Understanding comes into force from the date of signing by both parties and will remain valid for 5 years. Any parties can terminate the MOU with 6 months prior notice.
