Total number of participant were 15 (fifteen) and among them 11(eleven) were male and 04(four) were female participants. They all were Faculty Member of BPATC.

This Course was a comprehensive course module on locally led adaptation (LLA) for the Bangladesh Public Administration Training Center (BPATC). The course module, which was embedded in core training programs for Bangladeshi government officials and focus on institutionalizing LLA across sectors in Bangladesh by training public administrators on how best to address climate change impacts through inclusive and integrated locally led approaches.

Over the course of the week, participants was trained on the principles of LLA, the role of national and local public administrators in facilitating LLA, and tools for public administrators to implement locally led approaches.

Rector Sayeed Mahbub Khan and Member Directing Staff Md. Mohoshin Ali highlighted the initiative as a unique opportunity for BPATC and Bangladesh to integrate LLA in national responses to climate change.

In-House Training on Public Procurement

In-House Training on Public Procurement was held at BPATC from 14th September 2025 to 25th September 2025. Total number of participant were 19 (nineteen) and among them 12(twelve) were male and 07(seven) were female participants. They all were Faculty Member of BPATC.

Public procurement training was covered by PPA-2006, PPR-2008, and e-GP systems, focusing on Goods, Works, and Services procurement through courses or short refresher training. Key topics included procurement planning, tender evaluation, contract management, and ethics to improve transparency and efficiency in government purchasing.

Training Curriculum Components was Core Legal Framework, e-GP System, Procurement Cycle, Contract Management Managing performance, monitoring, and dispute resolution , Risk management, sustainable procurement, and procurement of consultancy services.

In the management of the course, Mr.B M Benojir Ahmed, Director acted as Course Director. There were two Course Coordinators on the team Ms. Alina Akter, Deputy Director and Dr. Md. Moshir Rahman, Deputy Director.

Training Workshop on RIIAP Facilitation Capacity Development (3rd Batch)

The Department of Behavioral Science of BPATC has organized a 3-day workshop for 10 faculty members of the Center during 23rd September 2025 to 25th September 2025, to develop their capacity in facilitating training interventions that are modeled on experiential learning. This capacity development initiative was linked to a problem-solving approach through the design and implementation of action plans addressing organizational problems. The approach is named the Reforms Initiative/ Innovation Implementation Action Plan (RIIAP). The workshop aimed to achieve three objectives, which are—

- (1) Understand the importance of applying the experiential learning model to RIIAP development;
- (2) Know the components of an RIIAP intervention; and
- (3) Apply the selected tools in developing an RIIAP intervention.

The 10 faculty members who participated in the workshop had undertaken 10 action plans to address 10 organizational problems of BPATC.
