| Contract (Form SADE-5) CLAUSE 12: ARBITRATION (Page No. 37) | If any question, difference or dispute whatsoever arises between the parties involved in this Agreement on any provision(s) herein contained or on the construction thereof, or as to any matter in any way connected therewith or arising therefrom, the matter in dispute shall be referred in Bangladesh to two arbitrators, one to be appointed by the Seller and other by the Buyer and in case the arbitrators are not unanimous in regard to the award they shall appoint an umpire to adjudicate on the reference or if they cannot agree on the appointment of an umpire the same shall be appointed by the court having jurisdiction in the matter under the provision of the Law of England, which shall also apply to all proceedings under this clause. | If any question, difference or dispute whatsoever arises between the parties involved in this Agreement on any provision(s) herein contained or on the construction thereof, or as to any matter in any way connected therewith or arising therefrom, the matter in dispute shall be referred in Singapore to two arbitrators, one to be appointed by the Seller and other by the Buyer and in case the arbitrators are not unanimous in regard to the award they shall appoint an umpire to adjudicate on the reference or if they cannot agree on the appointment of an umpire the same shall be appointed by the court having jurisdiction in the matter under the provision of the Law of England, which shall also apply to all proceedings under this clause. |
