INSTRUCTIONS TO AUTHORS

- 0 The Bangladesh Journal of Sugarcane annually publishes articles on Sugarcane agriculture and Sugar processing.
- 0 Articles must be original reports of research, not previously or simultaneously published.
- 0 The manuscripts should be written in English and typed in double space in one side of 11"X8½" size bond paper with good margin in all sides, The text, quotation, table, illustration foot note and literature citation all should be double spaced.
- 0 Numerical data should be presented in the form of either tables or graphs, but not in both Tables and figures with their caption should be numbered and submitted in separate sheet.
- 0 Photographs should be in glossy prints with good dark and light contrast with appropriate caption. Diagram, drawing should be drawn with durable ink on thick white drawing paper.
- 0 The article should have a concise but meaningful title. The author(s)' name and place of research should follow the title. A short and informative summary, not longer than 5% of the whole manuscripts, should precede the introduction of the paper. The paper should then be arranged in the following order (I) INTRODUCTION (II) MATERIALS AND METHODS (III) EXPERIMENTAL RESULTS AND DISCUSSION (IV) ACKNOWLEDGEMENT, IF ANY, AND (V) REFERENCES.
- 0 References should be cited in the text with the year of publication in parenthesis e. g. Rostron (1974), (Rostron, 1974. MacColl, 1976, Mitchell and Beardsley, 1978 ; Beardsley, et al, 1978), In the list of references the sequence of reference should be arranged alphabetically with the last name of the author(s), followed with initials (e. g. Beardsley, J. W. 1978). The reference should include names of all authors date of publication, complete title, Journal name, volume and page numbers. Book citation should include the place of publication and name of publishers. The title of the journal should be abbreviated according to the style of chemical abstracts.
- 0 Authors would receive 20 copies of reprints
- 0 The manuscripts should be submitted in duplicate to the EDITOR, BANGLADESH JOURNAL OF SUGARCANE, SUGARCANE RESEARCH INSTITUTE ISHURDI, PABNA, BANGLADESH.

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
