Subject: To append of New Frequency Bands for NGSO Satellite Services

The Bangladesh Telecommunication Regulatory Commission (BTRC) would like to inform all concerned stakeholders that, considering the needs of the industry, additional frequency bands have been identified for providing Non-Geostationary Orbit (NGSO) Satellite Service as per the **Clause 19.2 of Regulatory and Licensing Guidelines for Non-Geostationary Orbit (NGSO) Satellite Operator in Bangladesh-2025(No. 14.32.0000.000.702.51.0050.25.177; Dated: 25-03-2025)**.

2. This update has been made in accordance with **Clause 19.1** of the *Regulatory and Licensing Guidelines for Non-Geostationary Orbit (NGSO) Satellite Operator in Bangladesh-2025* and relevant international and national regulations.

3. The newly identified frequency bands are appended under Clause 19.1:

Sl. No.	Frequency Range
(n)	7235–7250 MHz
(o)	8025–8175 MHz
(p)	235–243.055 MHz, 273–287 MHz, 315–322 MHz

4. Terms & Conditions:

- I. The above frequency bands shall be **assigned for NGSO satellite services** in line with the ITU Radio Regulations (2024), the National Frequency Allocation Table (NFAT-2018) & Footnote-5.254 in accordance with **Clause 19.2 & 19.4 of NGSO Guidelines**
- II. These frequency bands shall be assigned on a **shared and non-exclusive basis**, pursuant to **Clause 20.1-20.3 of NGSO Guidelines**.
- III. If any of the above bands are already assigned to others radio services as primary, NGSO satellite services **shall not claim protection** from those primary services, pursuant to **Clause 21.1-21.7 of NGSO Guidelines**.
- IV. Any future changes in the ITU Radio Regulations or the NFAT related to these frequency bands shall apply automatically.
- V. This circular shall be integral part of "**Regulatory and Licensing Guidelines for Non-Geostationary Orbit (NGSO) Satellite Operator in Bangladesh**" -2025 (No. 14.32.0000.000.702.51.0050.25.177; Dated: 25-03-2025), and vice-versa.

This circular shall be effective immediately from the date of issuance. All concerned service providers, operators, and interested parties are requested to follow this circular accordingly.
