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Preamble

BETWEEN

The Secretary, Ministry of Home Affairs, representing the Minister, Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh.

AND

The Cabinet Secretary, Cabinet Division, representing the Prime Minister, Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh.

The parties hereto agree as follows:

- 3 To ensure internal security through anti-terrorism activities, strengthening of intelligence activities and control and development of law and order

- 5 To conduct Fire Service and Civil Defence activities
- 6 To provide assistance to rescue operation during natural and social disaster
- 7 To maintain liaison with international organizations and countries and entering into agreements
