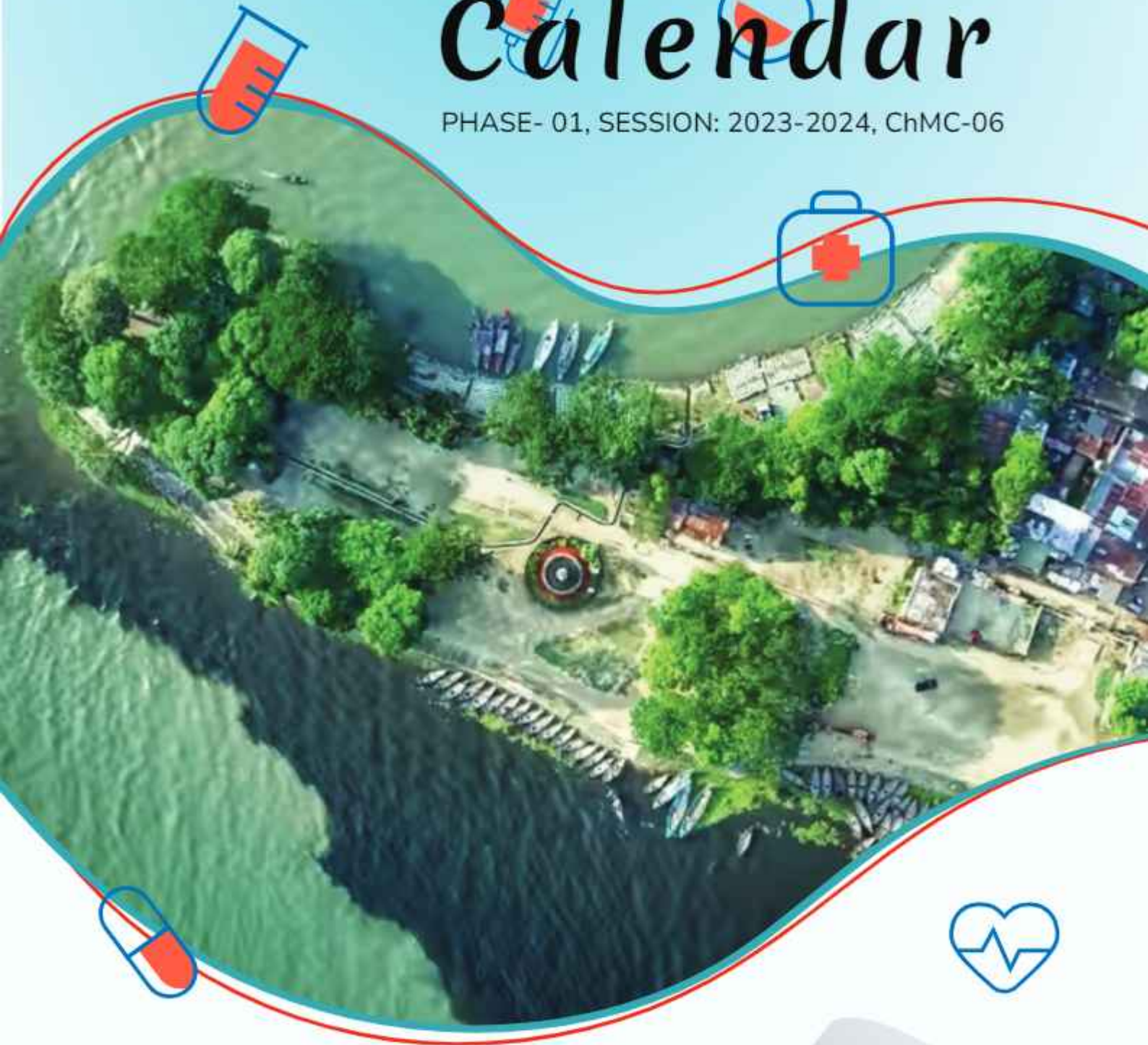

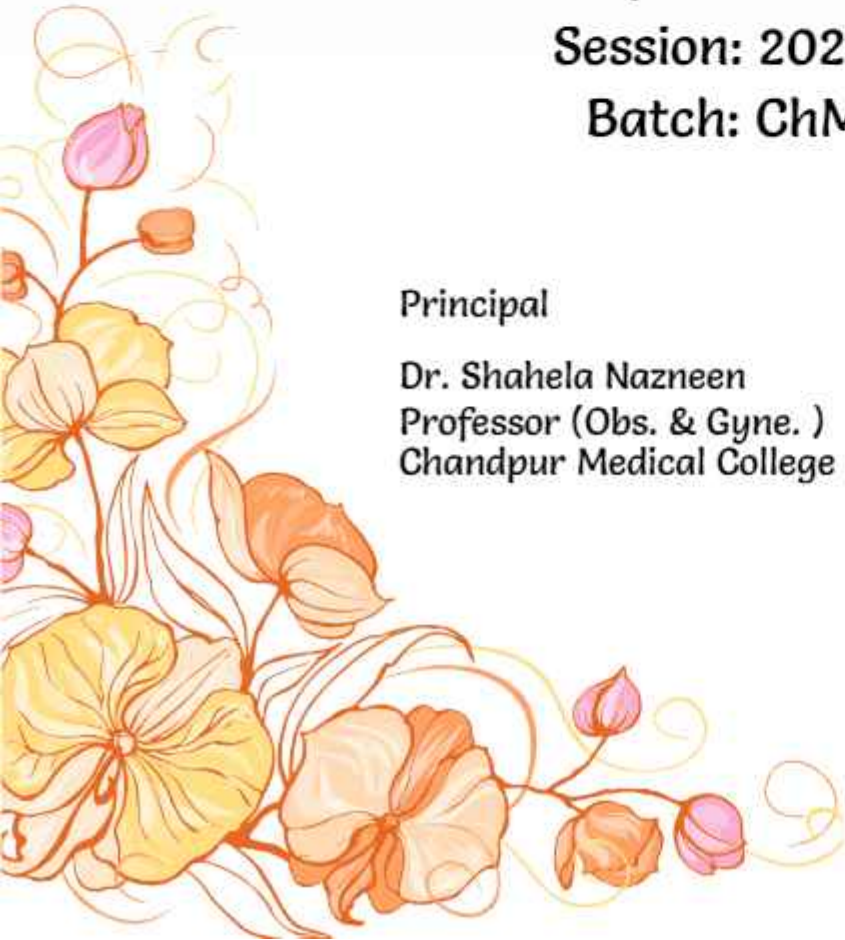

Chandpur Medical College at a glance

Chandpur medical college is a government medical college situated in Chandpur district, Chittagong division, which is conducting MBBS course in affiliation with Chittagong medical university. Academic activities of this college started from 10th January 2019 with 50 students from 2018-2019 session. This batch will be completing their MBBS journey this year.

The college is situated in the densely green land of Chandpur Sadar Upazilla, 169 km south-east from the capital city Dhaka, just within 2 kilometers of tri-tidal congregation of the rivers Padma, Meghna and Dakatia, in a land that is famous for the production of Hilsha fish, the national fish of Bangladesh. Every year, candidates from all over the country who have passed a very competitive admission test conducted centrally by DGME are selected after multiple migrations. Each year 50 students get the chance to be admitted after through admission procedures. However, the government decided to increase the number to 75 students from 2024, so the 6th batch will have total 75 students. Medium of teaching is English.

In March 2018, while addressing a public gathering, Honorable Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina announced that Our local MP Dr Dipu Moni as a doctor so I gift a medical college to Chandpur people and in the same year temporary campus of Chandpur Medical College was granted in 250 bed General Hospital, Chandpur Sadar. The 3rd floor of general hospital is dedicated to Chandpur Medical College. The permanent campus, however, has been approved by ECNEC near Dakatia River on 30.12 acres of land and expected to serve around 2.6 million people, construction work is expected to start very soon and expected to be completed by the year 2026. The temporary campus has lecture halls, tutorial rooms, departments. All of the rooms are air conditioned. One principal, one vice-principal, one professor, 16 associate professors, 18 assistant professors, 02 curators, 18 lecturers are the teacher and faculty members of the college. The library of the college is enriched with books and journals.

The medical college is attached with 250 bedded General Hospital, which has now become an academic hospital. The head of the hospital is Superintendent who is also a member of Academic Council of this medical college. After passing the final professional MBBS exam, students of this college will join the general hospital for completing one-year internship training.

Instruction for the MBBS Student

Each student should strictly follow the rules and regulation of the college, Hospital and Hostel. In case of any violation, The Dicipinary Committee, the academic council will take proper action against individual student or group. Under no circumstances the student personally or in group are allowed to do anything that goes against discipline or healthy environment of the college.

Student must attend the classes regularly and must appear in all examinations arranged by the department and scheduled by the university. Without any valid reason absence in the class is punishable. If anyone fails to or will unable to attend the class due to some unavailable reason, he/she must apply to grant leave for the period of absence to the head of the department showing valid ground for absence.

Every student has the opportunity of issuing books from library. All library users should obey the rules of Library.


The students are instructed to establish and maintain good relationship among each other, with the teachers and other staffs of the institute.

The student will perform all sorts of academic activities according to BMDC rules-2021. And after passing MBBS course they will take 'Internship Training' in Chandpur Medical College hospital. No student can express his/her desire to migrate from one medical college to another medical college. It has been done only by automatic process of auto-migration conducted by the office of the director of Medical Education, DGME.

Hostel seat will be distributed according to existings rules and every student has to abide by the rules.

No student shall be permitted to maintain relationship with the neighbours/outsidars which is unnecessary and illegal.

Official dress with apron is mandatory for all students in classes & in hospital.



Basic Information About MBBS Course

1. Name of the course: Bachelor of Medicine & Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS)
2. Basic qualifications & pre-requisite for entrance in MBBS courses:
 - (i) HSC or equivalent with Science (Biology, Physics, Chemistry)
 - (ii) Candidate has to secure required grade point in the SSC and HSC Examinations.
3. Students selection procedure for MBBS course: According to decision by the proper competent authority as per merit.
4. Medium of Instruction: English
5. Duration: MBBS Course comprises of 5 Years, followed by logbook based rotatory internship for one year.
6. Course structure, subject with duration and professional examination
