This is to certify that Ms. **Nusrat Alam Ela**, BMDC Registration / License No. **A127644**, was enrolled in the Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) program affiliated with the University of Chittagong, Bangladesh.

The MBBS curriculum prescribed by the Bangladesh Medical & Dental Council (BMDC) and implemented by the University of Chittagong is a full-time undergraduate medical program with a standard academic duration of five (5) years.

The curriculum is structured as follows:

- First Professional MBBS Phase – 1.5 years (18 Months)
- Second Professional MBBS Phase – 1 year (12 Months)
- Third Professional MBBS Phase – 1 year (12 Months)
- Final Professional MBBS Phase – 1.5 years (18 Months)

The total prescribed academic duration of the MBBS program is therefore five (5) years (60 months).

Upon successful completion of the Final Professional MBBS Examination and award of the MBBS degree, all graduates are required to complete one (1) year of compulsory rotatory internship training in recognized teaching hospitals as mandated by the Bangladesh Medical & Dental Council (BMDC) for full medical registration.

Accordingly:

- Academic MBBS Program Duration: 5 Years
- Compulsory Rotatory Internship: 1 Year
- Total Duration Including Internship: 6 Years

This certificate is issued to confirm the officially prescribed duration of the MBBS program for credentialing, licensing, and verification purposes, including submission to the Department of Health (DOH), Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates.
