19. Quotation is being requested on Unit-Rate basis.
20. Quotation shall be completed properly, duly signed-dated each page by the authorized signatory and submitted by the date to the office as specified in Para 6 below.
21. No Securities such as Quotation Security and Performance Security shall be required for submission of the Quotation and supply of the Goods (if awarded) respectively.
22. Quotation in sealed envelope or through electronic mail shall be submitted to the office of the undersigned on or before -22 /04/2026.at 12:00 am The envelope containing the Quotation must be clearly marked "Quotation for Automated Map Printing Tool for Settlement Press of DLR&S and DO NOT OPEN before -22/04/2026 at 12:30 am. Quotations received later than the time specified herein shall not be accepted.
23. Quotations received through electronic mail shall be sealed-enveloped by the Procuring Entity duly marked as stated in Para 6 above and, all Quotations thus received shall be sent to the Evaluation Committee for evaluation, without opening, by the same date of closing the Quotation.
24. The Procuring Entity may extend the deadline for submission of Quotations on justifiably acceptable grounds duly recorded subject to threshold of seven (7) days pursuant to Rule 92 (4) of the Public Procurement Rules, 2025.
25. All Quotations must be valid for a period of at least 60 (Sixty) days from the closing date of the Quotation.
26. No public opening of Quotations received by the closing date shall be held.
27. Quotationer's rates or prices shall be inclusive of profit and overhead and, all kinds of taxes, duties, fees, levies, and other charges to be paid under the Applicable Law, if the Contract is awarded.
28. Rates shall be quoted and, subsequent payments under this Contract shall be made in Taka currency. The price offered by the Quotationer, if accepted shall remain fixed for the duration of the Contract.
