Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh has applied for financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Emergency Multi-Sector Rohingya Crisis Response Project (EMCRP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The Department of Public Health Engineering (DPHE), under the Ministry of Local Government, Rural Development and Co-operatives, Government of Bangladesh, now invites eligible applicants ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services for the following positions. 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The Applicants are invited to provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (complete CV along with description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, general qualifications and financial proposal).

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to Section III, paragraph, 3.14, 3.16 and 3.17 of the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" July 2016 (Revised November 2020), setting forth the World Bank's policy on Conflict of Interest.

Selection of the consultant will follow the procedures for selecting Individual Consultants described in "The World Bank Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers", Procurement in Investment Project Financing Goods, Works, Non-Consulting and Consulting Services, July 2016 (Revised November 2020)".

Duration of the consultancy services will be 18 months or project closing date whichever is earlier.

Interested Applicants are requested to collect Terms of Reference (ToR) to understand detail requirements and task upon request from the address provided below either by e-mail or in person during the office hours (09-00 AM to 05-00 PM).
