The interested individual consultant should submit expression of interest (EOI) for his/ her preferred position only through ADB's Consultant Management System (cms.adb.org) through the above-mentioned reference numbers providing requisite information and documentation demonstrating that he/she has necessary qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services which are detailed in Terms of Reference (TOR) in the CMS. The consultants shall have to submit their EOIs electronically through the ADB CMS by **11:59 PM (Manila local time) on 08 February 2026**. 5. Offline submission of EOIs is **NOT allowed**.
6. The expected date for commencement of the Services is 01 April 2026, and it is to be implemented over 36 calendar months from the commencement date with the consultant providing intermittent inputs. Country of eligibility for national consultants is same as country of assignment (Bangladesh).

The individual consultant will be selected in accordance with the Individual Consultant Selection (ICS) method following the Asian Development Bank (ADB)'s Procurement Policy (2017, as amended from time to time) and the Procurement Regulations for ADB Borrowers (2017, as amended from time to time).
8. The Consultant's contract award and signing will be subject to ADB's concurrence. The EOI submitted by a consultant will be rejected if he/she has been debarred by GoB or by the ADB.
