REVIEW OF EXPORT EARNINGS : 1977-78

Over-all position :

Export earnings of Bangladesh during the trade year 1977-78 stood at Tk. 740.61 crore compared to Tk. 625.50 crore during 1976-77 showing an increase of Tk. 115.11 crore or 18.40%. The export earnings during the year under review exceeded the corresponding target of Tk. 725.00 crore by Tk. 15.61 Crore or 2.15%. Export earnings on account of raw jute & jute goods during the period under review constituted Tk. 518.91 crore or 70.07% of the total export.

Commodity-wise export earnings.

2. Commodity classification compared to the previous year revealed that the export earnings during the trade year 1977-78 increased mainly on account of jute goods (by Tk. 104.89 crore to Tk. 373.51 crore), tea (by Tk. 12.03 crore to Tk. 67.91 crore), tanned and Semitanned leather (by Tk. 9.35 crore to Tk. 68.07 crore), frozen food (by Tk. 2.95 crore to Tk. 29.17 crore), spices (by Tk. 0.10 crore to Tk. 2.06 crore), paper & allied products (by Tk. 7.62 crore to Tk. 12.00 crore), handicrafts (by Tk. 1.24 crore to Tk. 2.64 Crore) but decreased against raw jute (by Tk. 31.14 crore to Tk. 145.40 crore), Naptha & Furnace oil (by Tk. 4.71 crore to Tk. 17.49 crore).

The following table indicates the comparative position of export earnings from major commodities during 1977-78 and 1976-77 along with the relative shares of the jute and non-jute items in the total exports :

Primary and manufactured commodities.

. During the year under review, export earnings on account of primary commodities stood at Tk. 255·09 crore and manufactured goods Tk. 485·52 crore i.e, 34·44% and 65·56% respectively to the total exports as against Tk. 267·86 crore and Tk. 357·64 crore or 42·82% and 57·18% respectively during the preceding year.

Shares of jute and non-jute items

4. During the year under review contribution of jute and non-jute items of the total export earnings of the country were Tk. 518·91 crore (70·07%) and Tk. 221·70 crore (29·93%) as against Tk. 445·16 crore (71·17%) and Tk. 180·34 crore (28·83%) respectively during the corresponding period of last year.

The trend of exports indicates that while the total earning out of jute is increasing by value/volume, our dependence on jute is gradually being reduced and contributing towards diversified and more stable base of our export earnings.

Exports country-wise

5. As regards destination-wise pattern of exports, U.S.A. with an off-take of Bangladesh goods worth Tk. 97.37 crore continued to be most prominent buyer of Bangladesh goods during 1977-78 also. The other principal importing countries of Bangladesh products in descending orders were Pakistan, U.K., U.S.S.R., Mozambique, People's Republic of China, Italy, Egypt Arab Republic, Sudan, Belgium, Japan, Iran, Syria, Iraq, Australia, Netherlands, Poland, Federal Republic of Germany, Turkey and France.

Exports Region-wise :

6. The region-wise trend of export reveals that countries of the European Economic Community (EEC) were the highest buyer of Bangladesh products. The other buyer region in order of total value of goods were Asian Region (excluding Middle East), African Region, American Region, East European Region, Middle East and Oceania.

i) EEC Region

7. Of the total exports of Bangladesh during the Trade year 1977-78 amounting to Tk. 740.61 crore, export to the EEC countries amounted to Tk. 150.24 crore constituting about 20.29% of the country's total exports.

ii) Asian Region (Excl. Middle East).

8. Countries of the Asian Region excluding Middle East were the second largest buyers of Bangladesh products during the trade year 1977-78 with an off-take of goods worth Tk. 145.32 crore covering about 19.62% of the country's total exports.

iii) African Region :

9. Third largest buyer of Bangladesh Products during the Trade year 1977-78 were countries of African Region. Total exports from Bangladesh to this region during the trade year under review amounted to Tk. 128.69 crore or about 17.38% of the country's total exports.

iv) American Region :

10. Countries of the American Region were 4th largest buyer of Bangladesh Products during the trade year 1977-78 and goods worth

of Tk. 120.08 crore were exported to this region covering about 16.21% of total exports.

v) East European Region :

The 5th largest buyer of Bangladesh products during the trade year 1977-78 were countries of East European Region including U.S.S.R. Total export from Bangladesh to this region during the trade year under review stood at Tk. 85.03 crore constituting about 11.48% of the country's total exports.

vi) Middle East :

Middle East Countries including Iran were the 6th largest buyers of Bangladesh goods during the trade year 1977-78 and goods worth of Tk. 72.28 crore were exported to this Region constituting 9.76% of the country's total exports.


