
Foreword

About Export Promotion Bureau:

Export Promotion Bureau, Government agency with a Statutory Body, is entrusted with the responsibility of undertaking measures related to export development of the country. It is administered by a Board of Management comprising of members from public and private sectors. The Honorable Commerce Minister, Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, is the Chairman of the Board of Management. Besides, two Director Generals of EPB, representatives from the Ministries of Commerce, Industries, Agriculture, Forest and Environment, Information and Communication, Textile and Jute, Foreign Affairs, Fisheries and Livestock, National Board of Revenue, Bangladesh Tariff Commission, Bangladesh Invest Development Authority, Bangladesh Export Processing Zone Authority, Bangladesh Bank are the members of the Board. Moreover, six members are there from the Private Sectors for a term of three years representing from FBCCI & other associations.

Major Functions of the Export Promotion Bureau

- a) Among the responsibilities the foremost important is formulation of national export Policy. In consultation with different Chambers of Commerce, Exporters Associations, Concerned Ministries, Govt. Departments, Public and Private Agencies, Export Promotion Bureau works as the Secretariat in formulating and implementing export policy.
- b) To assist and advise the exporters through organizing programs relating to diversification, product development, product adaptation for the expansion of our export baskets.
- c) To organize marketing missions and buyer-seller meet in co-operation with different exporters' association to find out new markets for exportable goods;
- d) EPB regularly disseminates market intelligence and other information among the existing and potential exporters. EBP

organizes seminars, workshops etc. under its National Export Training Program (NETP).

- e) To maintain a Trade Information Center (TIC) along with a library in which a large number of recently published international Trade Directories, Statistical books, Market Surveys and Product Profiles are prospered for the use of the business community, exporters, researchers and others;
- f) For the wider publicity of the exportable products of Bangladesh, EPB publishes various attractive and informative publication i.e Annual Report, Product Brochures, Posters, Export Directory, Export Statistics and export Guide etc.
- g) To compile, analyze and publish books and periodicals on export statistics on the basis of Bill of Export collected from different customs points of the country;
- h) In order to boost national export, EPB undertake initiative to forge cooperation with trade promotion organizations of leading economies.
- i) Undertake initiative for assistance from renowned international organizations especially from the organizations have expertise on international trade for capacity building.
- j) EPB does the advocacy for private sector with government bodies that has role in trade and commerce to make alignment of government policies to enhance export.
- k) With a view to exploring new market along with consolidating existing market, EPB participates in the international trade fairs, organizes single country trade fairs, sends trade missions and organizes seminars in the export potential countries.
- l) To organize general and specialized international trade fairs at home with a view to facilitating local producers to show-case their exportable and compare those in terms of quality with exhibits displayed by foreign participants.

Review of Export Performance: 2019-2020

National Export Earning of Bangladesh from Goods & Service Sector:

Total Export Earning of Bangladesh from Goods & Service sector during 2019-20 amounted US Dollar 39755.27 Million as against US\$ 47027.72 Million during 2018-19 Showing an decrease of US dollar (-) 7272.45 i.e (-) 15.46%.


Export earnings of Bangladesh from goods Sector and Service sector during 2019-20 amounted to US dollar 33674.09 and 6081.18 as against US\$ 40535.04 million and 6492.68 respectively.

National Export, Import & Trade Balance (Goods & Service):


National export earnings during FY 2019-20 was US\$ 39755.27 Million and import payment for the same year was US\$ 5634.83 million which shows that export earning covered 71.46 of import bill. During 2018-19 and 2017-18 export earnings covered 74.99% and 69.69% of import Bill respectively. Export earnings from goods during FY 2019-20 US\$ 33674.09 million and import payment for the same year was 48699.80 million. On the other hand, export earnings from service sector during FY 2019-20 was US\$ 6081.18 million and import payment for the same year was 6935.03 of service sector.



The principal commodities that registered increase in the export earnings during the year under review are Jute & Jute Goods 8.10%, Raw Jute 15.48%, Jute Yarn & Twine 10.12%, Ships 139.32%, Fruits 48.48%, Tobacco 26.89%, Pharmaceuticals 4.49%, Furniture 2.03%, Carpet 8.41%, Vegetables 64.53%, Engineering Equipment 26.06%, Handicrafts 2.86%, Others Manufacturing Products 7.86%, Tea 10.64%, Gold Shaft 20.00% and Footwear (Exc. Leather) 2.06%.

On the other hand, the commodities which registered decrease in export earnings are Knitwear, 17.65%, Woven 18.58%, Knit Fabrics 16.97%, Special Textile 19.38%, Agriculture Products 5.16%, Dry Food 14.70%, Crabs 42.12%, Chemical Products 3.08%, Ceramic Products 59.45%, Footwear (Leather) 21.28%, Petroleum by Products 88.48%, Terry Towel 27.67%, Paper & Paper Products 4.60%, Plastic Products 16.09%, Cap 7.43%, By Cycle 1.66%, Leather 40.28%, Leather & Leather Products 21.79%, Shrimps 7.89%, Copper Wiar 34.10%, Home Textile 10.90%, Spices 19.44%, Engineering Products 14.18%, Electric Products 35.65%, Frozen & Live Fish 8.84% and Rubber 3.46%.




Export earnings during FY 2019-2020 was US\$ 33674.09 million and import payment for the same year was US\$ 48699.80 million which shows that export earnings covered 69.15% of our import bill. During FY 2018-2019 and FY 2017-2018 export earnings covered 72.44% and 69.72% of import bill respectively. Primary and Manufactured Commodities:

Out of the total export earnings of US dollar 33674.09 million during the FY 2019-2020 the share of primary commodities stood at US dollar 1318.21 million and that of manufactured products at US dollar 32355.88 million i.e. 3.91% and 96.09% respectively as against US dollar 1409.37 million and US dollar 39125.68 million i.e. 3.48% and 96.52% respectively during the FY 2018-2019.












