Overall position

1.1 Total export earnings of Bangladesh during the fy 1982-83 amounted to Tk. 16162.4 million as against Tk. 12555.4 million during the preceding year showing an increase of Tk. 3607.0 million i. e. 28.73%. In real terms, total export in US \$ during 1982-83 amounted to \$ 686.60 million as against \$ 625.89 million during the preceding year registering an increase of \$ 60.71 million i. e. 9.70%. In 1982-83, downward trend of export earnings of the last two consecutive years, in terms of dollar, could be arrested and significant rate of increase has been achieved.

1.2 During the year under review there has been an increase in the export earnings in respect of raw jute (26.85%), jute goods (28.85%), leather (8.86%), frozen food (60.28%), tea (44.21%), readymade garments (82.16%). Among the principal items, export in respect of petroleum by-products declined by 14.76% during the fy under review. Export earnings of chemical & pharmaceutical products increased during the fy 1982-83 from Tk. 11.0 million in 1981-82 to Tk. 267.3 million.

2. Jute & non-Jute items

2.1 Out of the total export of Tk 16162.4 million the share of jute sector was Tk. 10110.5 million i.e. 62.56% and the share of non-jute sector was Tk. 6051.9 million i.e. 37.44% during 1982-83 as against Tk. 7878.2 million and Tk. 4677.2 million i.e. 62.75% and 37.25% in jute & non-jute sector respectively during the preceding year.

2.2 The table below shows the total export earnings and the share of jute and non-jute items from 1972-73 to 1982-83 :

3. Traditional & non-traditional items

3.1 Export earning of traditional items amounted to Tk. 11150.7 million (68.99%) and that of non-traditional items stood at Tk. 5011.7 million (31.01%) during the fy 1982-83 as compared to 68.55% of traditional items and 31.45% of non-traditional items during the fy 1981-82.

3.2 The table below shows the export earnings of traditional and non-traditional items with their percentage shares from 1976-77 to 1982-83 :

4. Primary and manufactured commodities

4.1 Out of the total export earnings of Tk. 16162.4 million during the fy 1982-83, the share of primary commodities stood at Tk. 5724.1 million and that of manufactured products at Tk. 10438.3 million i.e. 35.42% & 64.58% respectively as against Tk. 4220.6 million & Tk. 8334.8 million i.e. 33.62% and 66.38% respectively during the fy 1981-82.

5. Achievement of target

5.1 Export target for the fy 1982-83 was set at Tk. 15500 million. As against this target actual export earnings stood at Tk. 16162.4 million showing an increase of Tk. 662 million i.e. 4.27%.

6. Price index

6.1 Total export from Bangladesh during the fy 1982-83, in terms of dollar, increased by 9.70% as compared to the corresponding period of last year. Export price index during this period increased by 3.94%. This indicates that volume-wise relative increase, in the export sector, during the fy 1982-83 was 5.76%.

6.2 Export earnings from the traditional items during the period under review, in terms of dollar, increased by 10.40% over the fy 1981-82. Export price index of traditional items during this period increased by 8.07% which indicates that volume-wise relative increase was 2.33%.

6.3 Export of non-traditional items from Bangladesh during the fy 1982-83 increased, in terms of dollar, by 8.17% over the fy 1981-82. But export price index of non-traditional items decreased by 5.66% the which indicates that volume-wise relative increase of this sector was 13.83% during the fy 1982-83 over 1981-82.

7. Exports : Country-wise

7.1 The destination-wise pattern of export during 1982-83 was that U.S.A. with an off-take of goods worth Tk. 1856.3 million surpassed Pakistan, the biggest buyer of Bangladesh products during the preceding year. Pakistan and Japan occupied the second and third positions respectively as the buyers of Bangladesh products. The other principal importing countries of Bangladesh products, in descending orders, were Iran, U.S.S.R., Italy, U.K., Belgium, Sudan, China, Egypt, Mozambique, Iraq, Syria, & Singapore.

Export Region-wise.

The region wise trend of export reveals that Asian region (Excluding Middle East) were the highest buyer of Bangladesh products. The other buyer region in order of total value of goods were E.E.C. region, African region, Middle East, American region, East European region and Occania.

Asian region (Excluding Middle East) : Of the total exports of Bangladesh during the fy 1982-83 amounting to Tk. 16162.4 million, export of the countries of Asian region (Excluding Middle East) stood at Tk. 4469.0 million covering about 27.65% of the countries total export :

E.E.C. Region : The 2nd largest buyer of Bangladesh products during the trade year 1982-83 were countries of E.E.C. region. Total export from Bangladesh to this region during the year under review amounted to Tk. 3003.0 million i.e. about 18.58% of the countries total export.

African Region : Countries of African region were the third largest buyers of Bangladesh products during the fy 1982—83 with an off take of goods worth Tk. 2124.2 million constituting about 13.14% of the country's total export.

Middle East : Middle East countries including Iran were the 4th largest buyers of Bangladesh goods during the trade year 1982—83 and goods worth Tk. 2122.8 million were exported to this region constituting 13.13% of the country's total exports.

American Region :- Countries of the American region were 5th largest buyers of Bangladesh products during the fy 1982—83 and goods worth of Tk. 2105.6 million were exported to this region covering about 13.03% of total export.

East European Region : The 6th largest buyer of Bangladesh products during the trade year 1982—83 were countries of East European region including U. S. S. R. Total export from Bangladesh to this region during the trade year under review stood at Tk. 1681.3 million constituting about 10.40% of the country's total export.
