



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1. REVIEW OF EXPORT PERFORMANCE

A. National Export Earning of Bangladesh From Goods & Service Sectors:


National export earning of Bangladesh from goods & services sectors during FY 2021-22 was US\$ 60971.26 million against US\$ 45367.19 million during FY 2020-21 showing an increase of US\$ (+) 15604.07 i.e 34.40% higher.

National Export Earning of Bangladesh from Goods & Service Sector:




B. National export, import & Trade Balance (Goods & Services):

National export earnings during FY 2021-2022 was US\$ 60971.26 million and import payment for the same year was US\$ 89108.70 million that shows that export earning covered 68.43% of import bill. During FY 2020-2021 and FY 2019-20 export earning covered 73.63% and 71.46% of import bill respectively. Export earnings from goods during FY 2021-2022 was US\$ 52082.66 million and import payment for the same year was US\$ 78949.70 million. On the other hand, export earnings from service sectors during FY 2021-22 was US\$ 8888.60 million and import payment for the same year was 10159.00 million.

C. OVERALL POSITION (GOODS):

Total export from Bangladesh during FY 2021-2022 was US\$ 52082.66 million against US\$ 38758.31 million during FY 2020-2021, showing an increase of US\$ 13324.35 million i.e. (+) 34.38%.

The principal commodities that registered increase in the export earnings during the latest fiscal year are Knitwear 36.88%, Woven 33.82%, Home Textile 43.28%, Terry Towel 32.30%, Chemical Products 29.76%, Pharmaceuticals 11.69%, By Cycle 26.34%, Copper Wiar 23.06%, Special Textile 140.50%, Plastic Products 44.21%, Knit Fabrics 107.70%, Leather Products 33.63%, Leather 27.05%, Cap 61.07%, Ceramic Products 32.95%, Golf Shaft 25.87%, Fruits 812.07%, Leather Footwear 32.69%, Shrimps 23.84%, Handicrafts 26.08%, Rubber 36.74%, Tobacco 24.39%, Furniture 38.87%, Paper & Paper Products 47.12%, Petroleum by Products 43.72%, Raw Jute 56.48%, Engineering Equipment 150.82%, Electric Products 48.34%, Carpet 9.75%, Footwear (Exc. Leather) 30.39%.






2. Export (Goods) as a percentage of import:

Export earnings during FY 2021-2022 was US\$ 52082.66 million and import payment for the same year was US\$ 78949.70 million showing that total export earning covered 65.97% of the total import bill. 






