About Export Promotion Bureau:

Export Promotion Bureau, a government statutory body, is entrusted with the responsibility of undertaking measures related to export development of the country. It is administered by a Board of Directors comprising of 22 members from public and private sectors. The Honorable Commerce Minister is the Chairman of the Board. Chief Executive Officer of EPB is the Vice-Chairman of the Board. CEO & VC is responsible for all executive functions of the Bureau. There are six members from the private sectors for a term of three years representing FBCCI & other associations.

Major Functions of the Export Promotion Bureau:

- a) Formulation of National Export Policy. In consultation with different Chambers of Commerce, Exporters Associations, Concerned Ministries, Govt. Departments, Public and Private Agencies, Export Promotion Bureau formulates the draft export policy and place it before the MOC for final approval of the govt. EPB also implements the policy.
- b) Assist and advise the exporters through organizing programs relating to diversification, product development, product adaptation for the expansion of our export baskets.
- c) Organize marketing missions and buyer-seller meet in co-operation with different exporters' association to find out new markets for exportable goods.
- d) Disseminates market intelligence and other information among the existing and potential exporters. EPB organizes seminars, workshops etc. under its National Export Training Program (NETP).

- e) Maintain a Trade Information Center (TIC) along with a library in which a large number of recently published international Trade Directories, Statistical books, Market Surveys and Product Profiles are preserved for the use of the business community, exporters, researchers and others.
- f) For the wider publicity of the exportable products of Bangladesh, EPB publishes various attractive and informative publication i.e Annual Report, Product Brochures, Posters, Export Directory, Export Statistics and Export Guide etc.
- g) Compile, analyze and publish books and periodicals on export statistics.
- h) EPB undertakes initiative to forge cooperation with trade promotion organizations of leading economies.
- i) Undertakes, initiative for assistance from renowned international organizations, especially from the organizations those have expertise on international trade, for capacity building.
- j) EPB does the advocacy for private sector that has role in trade and commerce to make alignment of government trade policies.
- k) With a view to exploring new market along with consolidating existing market, EPB participates in the international trade fairs, organizes single country trade fairs, sends trade missions and organizes seminars in the export potential countries.
- l) Organize general and specialized international trade fairs at home with a view to facilitating local producers to show-case their exportable and compare those in terms of quality with exhibits displayed by foreign participants.

Review of Export Performance: FY 2023-2024

National Export Earning of Bangladesh From Goods & Service Sector:

Total export earning of Bangladesh from Goods & Service sector during FY 2023-24 amounted to US\$ 51114.15 million as against US\$ 53928.19 million during FY 2022-23 showing an decrease of US\$ 2814.03. Hence the growth of export was -5.22%.


Export earning of Bangladesh from Goods and Service sector during FY 2023-24 amounted US\$ 44,469.74 million and 6,644.41 million respectively as against US\$ 46,430.71 million and 7,497.48 million in FY 2022-2023.

National Export, Import & Trade Balance (Goods & Service):


National export earnings during FY 2023-24 was US\$ 51,114.15 million and import payment for the same year was US\$ 72616.70 million which shows that export earning covered 70.39% of import bill. During 2022-23 and 2021-22 export earnings covered 68.88% and 68.43% of import bill respectively. Export earnings from goods sector during FY 2023-24 US\$ 44,469.74 million and import payment for the same fiscal year was US\$ 63,109.60 million. On the other hand, export earnings during FY 2023-24 was US\$ 6,644.41 million and import payment for the same year was 9,507.10 of service sector. Since inception Bangladesh is having trade deficit mainly due to heavy import of fuel, capital machinery, industrial raw material, essential consumer goods.

Total export of goods from Bangladesh during the FY 2023-2024 amounted to US\$ 44,469.74 million as against US\$ 46,430.71 million during FY 2022-2023 showing an decrease of US\$ 1,960.97 million with growth of -4.22%.



Export of Goods From Bangladesh (FY 1972-73 to FY 2023-24)



Bangladesh's Export Share of Major Products During FY 2023-2024




Export (goods) as a percentage to import:

Export earnings during FY 2022-2023 was US\$ 44,469.74 million and import payment for the same year was US\$ 63,109.60 million which shows that export earnings covered 70.46% of our import bill. During FY 2022-2023 and FY 2021-2022 export earnings covered 67.68% and 65.96% of import bill respectively.












