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About Export Promotion Bureau:

The Export Promotion Bureau (EPB) is a government statutory body responsible for undertaking initiatives related to the development and promotion of Bangladesh's exports. It operates under the Ministry of Commerce and is governed by a 22-member Board of Directors representing both the public and private sectors. The Honorable Minister of Commerce serves as the Chairman of the Board, while the Chief Executive (CE) of EPB serves as the Vice-Chairman and is responsible for all executive functions of the Bureau. The Board includes six members from the private sector, nominated for a three-year term, representing the FBCCI and various exporters' associations.

Major Functions of the Export Promotion Bureau:

1. **Product development and diversification:** Undertakes product development activities through various programs and projects aimed at introducing diversified products into the export basket, thereby reducing the country's dependency on a single sector, particularly apparel
2. **Market Exploration and Promotion:** Participates in international trade fairs, organizes single-country fairs, sends trade missions, and arranges seminars in export-potential markets to expand and consolidate overseas market presence.
3. **Formulation of the National Export Policy:** The Bureau prepares the draft National Export Policy in consultation with Chambers of Commerce, exporters' associations, relevant ministries, government agencies, and private sector stakeholders. The draft is submitted to the Ministry of Commerce for approval, and the Bureau is also responsible for its implementation.
4. **Exporter Assistance and Advisory Services:** Supports exporters by organizing programs on export diversification, product development, and product adaptation to expand the national export basket.

5. **Marketing Missions and Buyer-Seller Meets:** Organizes marketing missions and buyer-seller meetings, in collaboration with exporters' associations, to identify and develop new markets for Bangladeshi products.
6. **Market Intelligence and Training:** Disseminates market intelligence and provides capacity-building support through seminars, workshops, and training programs under the National Export Training Program (NETP).
7. **Trade Information Center (TIC):** Maintains a Trade Information Center and library equipped with international trade directories, statistical publications, market surveys, and product profiles for exporters, researchers, and business stakeholders.
8. **Publications for Export Promotion:** Produces the Annual Report, product brochures, posters, the Export Directory, Export Statistics, the Export Guide, and other materials to promote Bangladesh's exportable products worldwide.
9. **Export Statistics Compilation:** Compiles, analyzes, and publishes statistical books and periodicals related to the country's export performance.
10. **International Trade Cooperation:** Strengthens collaboration with trade promotion organizations in major economies to enhance market access and export capabilities.
11. **International Institutional Support:** Seeks technical assistance and capacity-building support from international organizations with expertise in global trade and export development.
12. **Policy Advocacy for the Private Sector:** Advocates for private sector interests to align government trade policies with evolving global market conditions.
13. **Domestic Trade Fairs:** Organizes general and specialized international trade fairs at home, enabling local producers to showcase their exportable products and compare them with international exhibits.

Review of Export Performance: FY 2024-2025

Total export earning of Bangladesh from Goods & Service sector during FY 2024-25 amounted to US\$ 55191.24 million as against US\$ 51114.15 million during FY 2023-24 showing an increase of US\$ 4077.09. Hence the growth of export was + 7.98%.

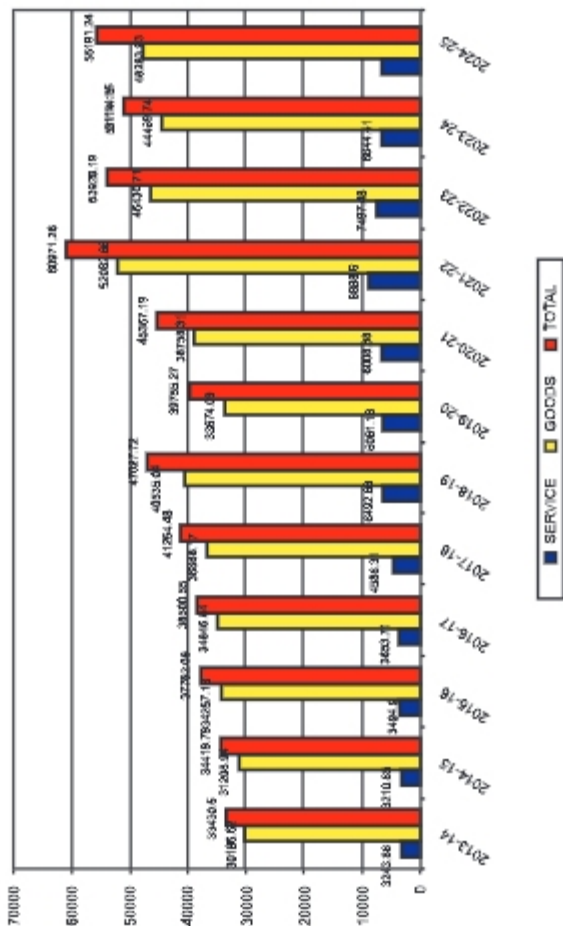
Export earning of Bangladesh from Goods and Service sector during FY 2024-25 amounted US\$ 48,283.93 million and 6,907.31 million respectively as against US\$ 44,469.74 million and 6,644.41 million in FY 2023-2024.

National Export Earning of Bangladesh From Goods & Service Sector:



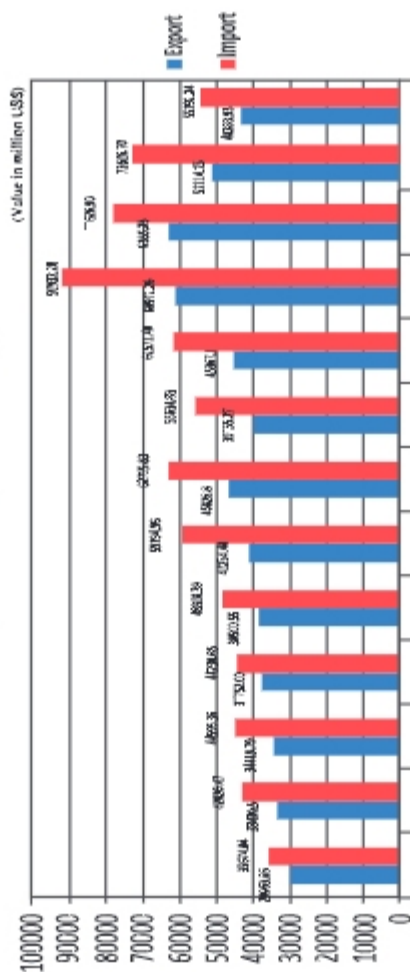
National Export, Import & Trade Balance (Goods & Service):

Total export earnings of Bangladesh from the Goods & Services sectors during FY 2024-25 amounted to US\$ 55191.24 million as against US\$ 51114.15 million during FY 2023-24, showing an increase of US\$ 4077.09. Hence, the growth of exports was + 7.98%. Of the total earnings in FY 2024-25, goods exports contributed US\$ 48,283.93 million, while services exports amounted to US\$ 6,907.31 million. In comparison, earnings from goods and services in FY 2023-24 were US\$ 44,469.74 million and US\$ 6,644.41 million, respectively. Total export of goods from Bangladesh during the FY 2024-2025 amounted to US\$ 48,283.93 million as against US\$ 44,469.74 million during FY 2023-2024 showing an increase of US\$ 3,814.19 million with growth of 8.58%.

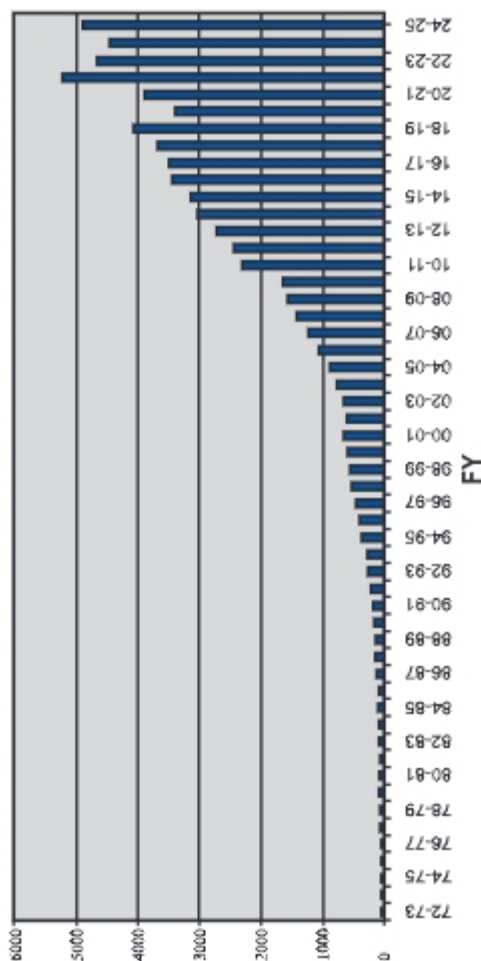

Export of Goods From Bangladesh (FY 1972-73 to FY 2024-25)

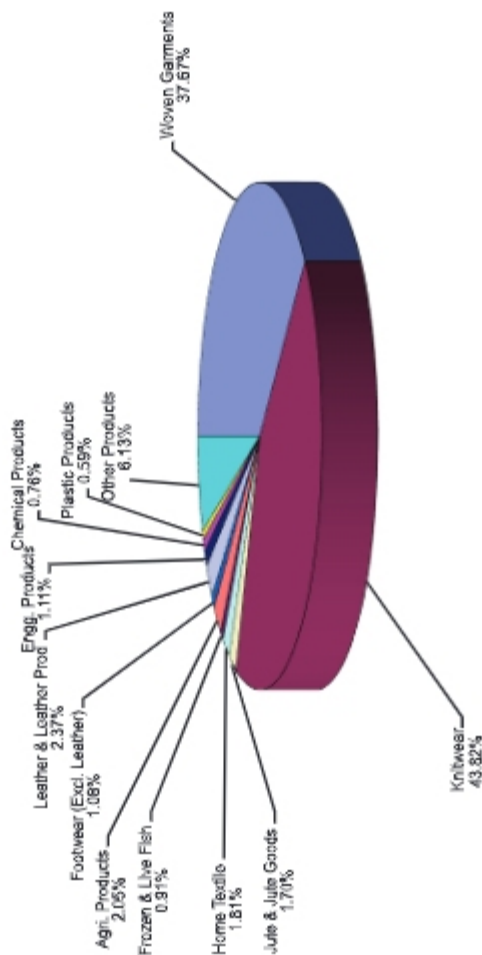

Bangladesh's Export Share of Major Products During FY 2024-2025

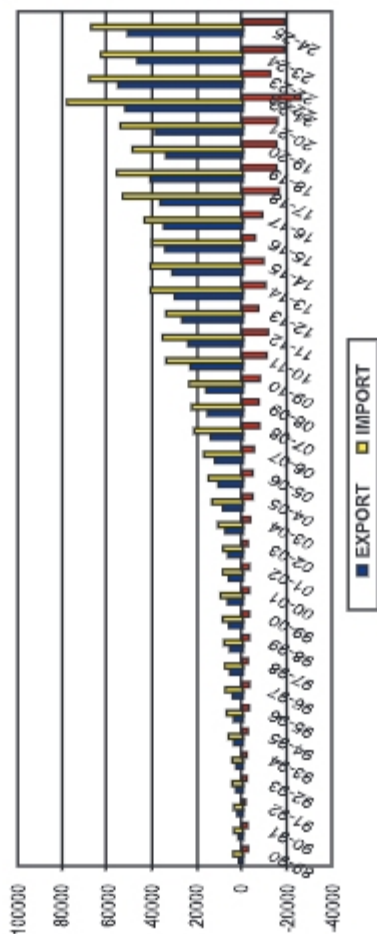


Export (goods) as a percentage to import:

Export earnings during FY 2024-2025 amounted to US\$ 48,283.93 million, while import payments for the same year stood at US\$ 65175.70 million, indicating that export earnings covered 74.08% of the import bill. In comparison, export earnings covered 70.46% of the import bill in FY 2023-2024 and 67.68% in FY 2022-2023. 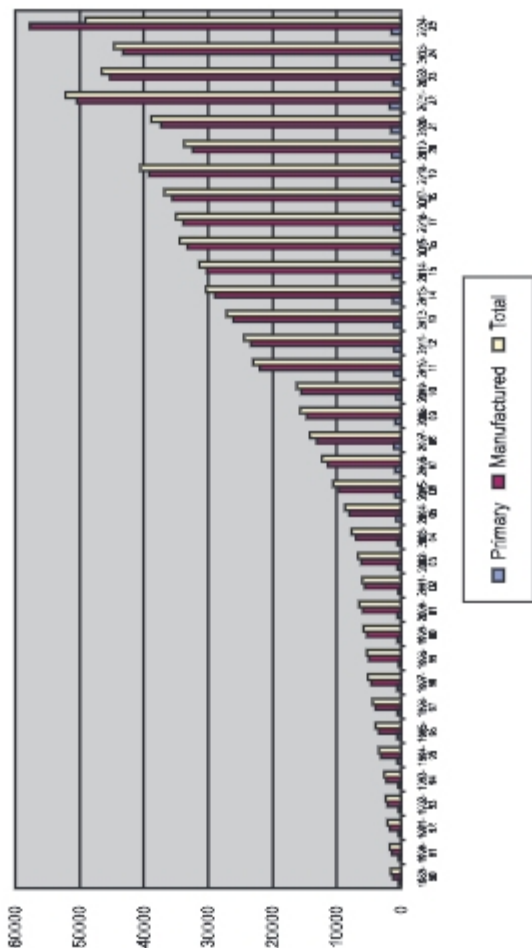

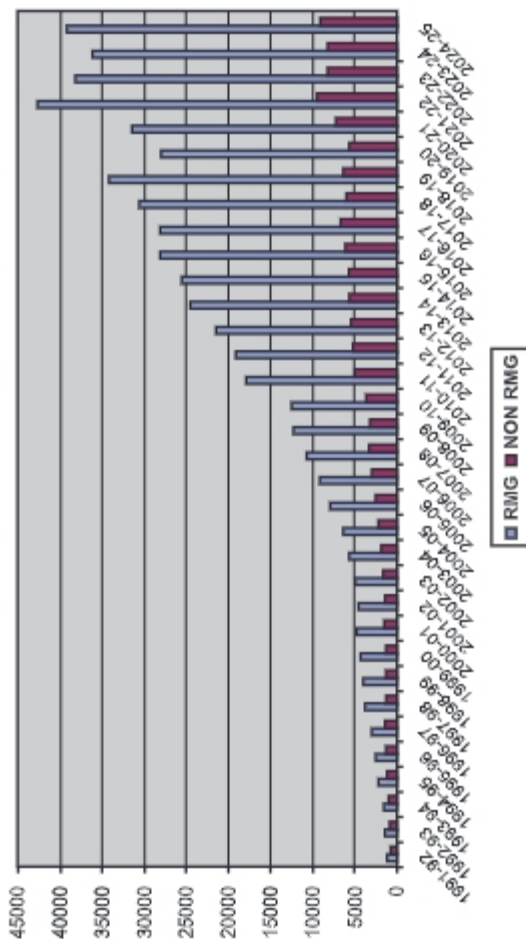

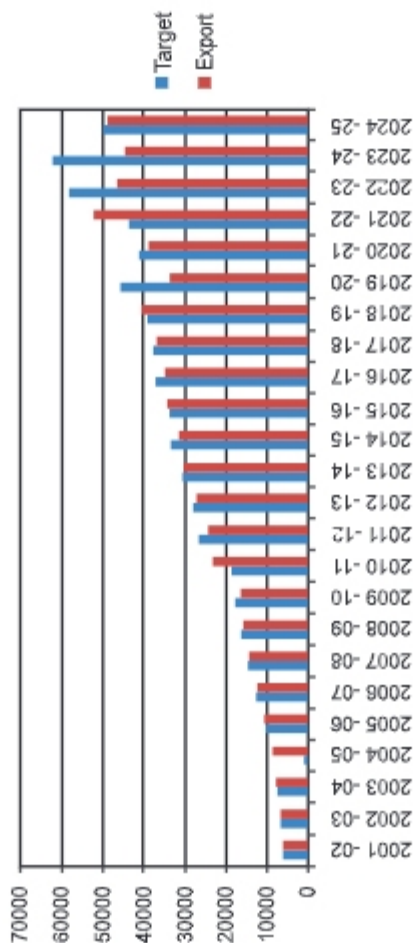

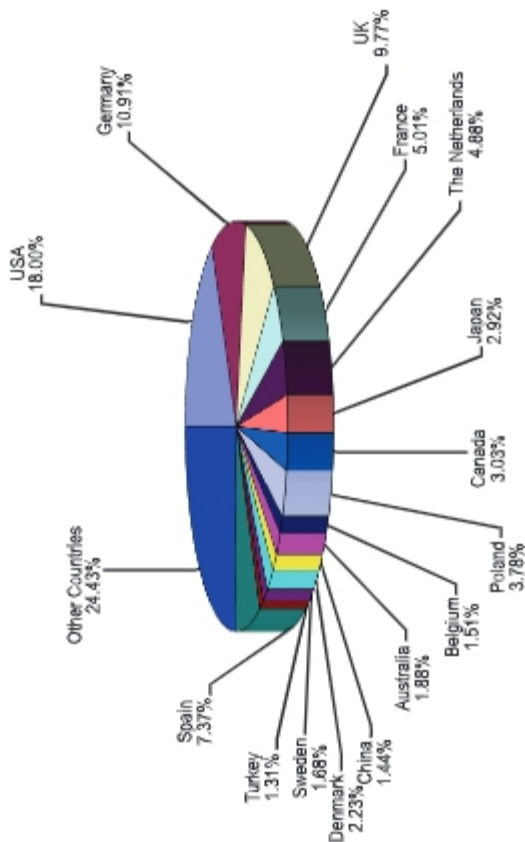

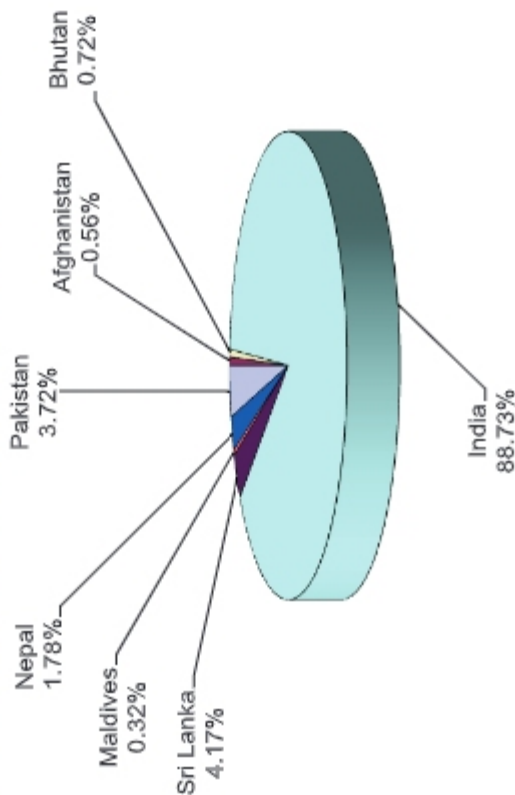

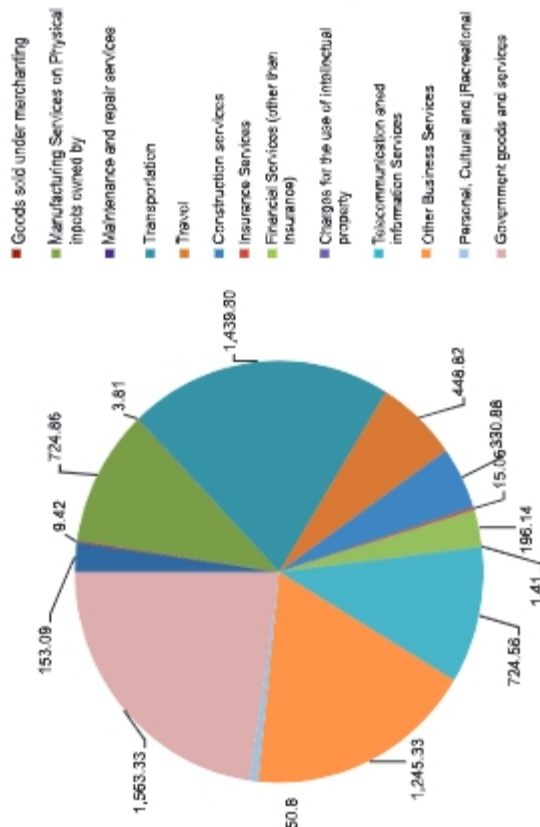
