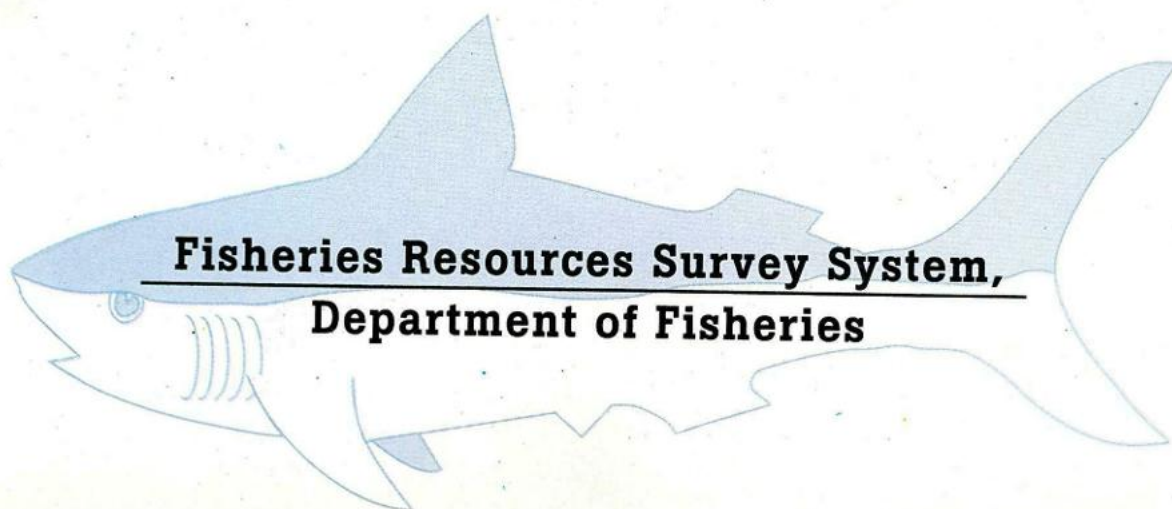
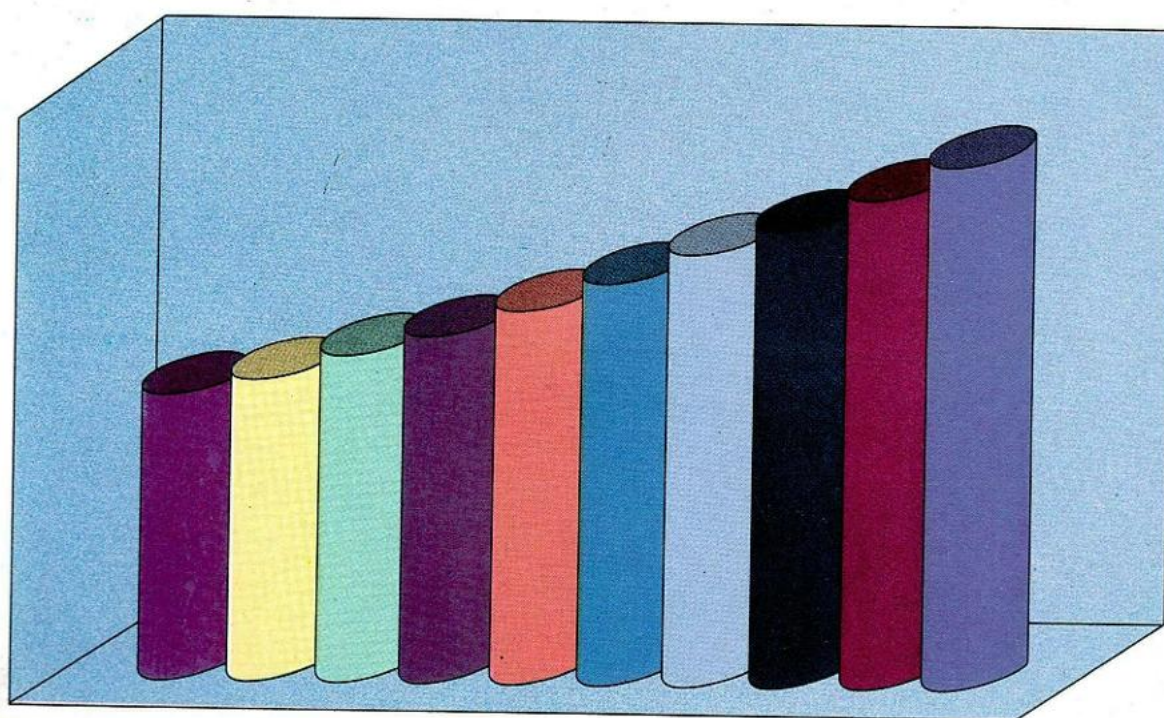

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PREFACE

The present report is the 18th in the series **The Fishery Statistical Yearbook of Bangladesh** contain information from July 2000 to June 2001.

This report contains the fish & shell fish catch (landed) by sectors, habitat, species and district-wise. Information on the carp spawn collected from natural sources & produced through induced breeding in hatcheries for aqua-culture; fish & fish products and other related matters are also presented in the report. For 1981-1983 district-wise catch was estimated on the basis of the Frame Survey of water area & fishing units.

It is hoped that this report will be useful for planning, development and management of the fisheries in Bangladesh.

Any comments for improving the fishery statistics would be highly appreciated.
