

As one of the most climate-vulnerable countries, Bangladesh also faces frequent floods, cyclones, and heat stress, which exacerbate existing health and social disparities. A gender-responsive health system—one that integrates gender and equity considerations into policy, planning, and service delivery—is essential to address these intertwined challenges. The aim of the study is to examine how gender, climate change, and health inequities intersect in Bangladesh and how the health system can become more gender-responsive to tackle these overlapping challenges.
