



| 11. | Brief Description of the Assignment | The Health Economics Unit (HEU) is the designated focal point for conducting evidence based policy research. In 2016, the Health Economics Unit (HEU) initiated the fourth round of the Facility Efficiency Survey (FES), recognizing the need to assess whether there had been changes in service delivery efficiency following the implementation of successive sector programs. Recently, the Fourth Health, Population and Nutrition Sector Program (2017-2022) has come to an end. During this period, Bangladesh's health system has experienced significant transformations, including the expansion of Community Clinics (CCs) and the upgrading of Upazila Health Complexes (UHCs), the establishment of new Medical Colleges and specialized hospitals, and substantial investments in diagnostic facilities, oxygen supply, ICU capacity, and critical care units in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. In this context, HEU has decided to conduct the fifth round of the Facility Efficiency Survey (FES 2024) to capture these changes, reassess determinants and patterns of efficiency, and generate updated evidence to guide policy and health sector reforms. |
