

| 11.  | Brief Description of the Assignment        | The Health Economics Unit (HEU) is the designated focal point for conducting Bangladesh National Health Accounts (BNHA) sub-accounts and has so far completed two rounds of the Disease Specific Accounts (DSA). HEU now envisages the development of the third round of DSA for the period 2023–2024. As in the previous round, the results will follow the ICD-10 framework, covering 21 disease categories and corresponding sub-categories, while codes from the 22nd chapter will be used for special purposes. This round will also place additional emphasis on Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs), including the collection of detailed facility-level data to better inform policy and resource allocation. It is planned to estimate the expenditure primarily using the System of Health Accounts (SHA) 2011 compatible BNHA framework.   |
