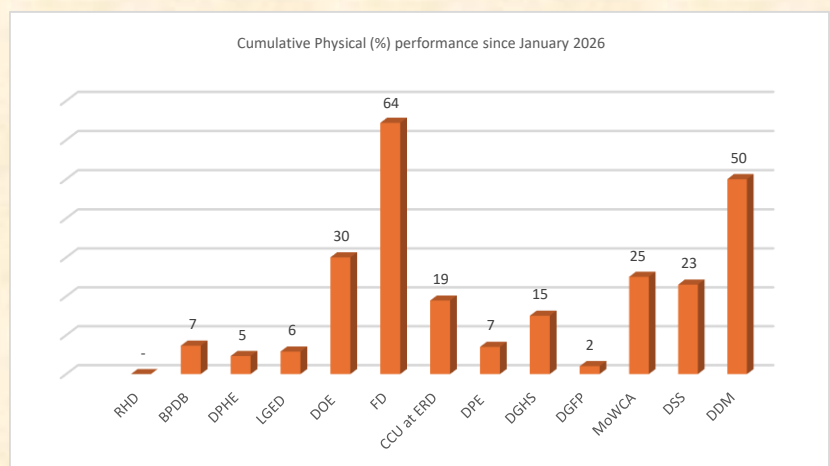
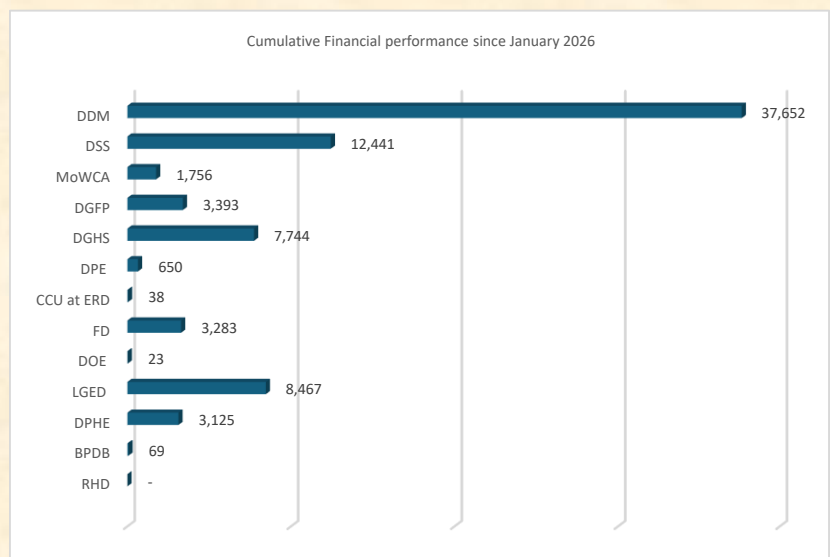
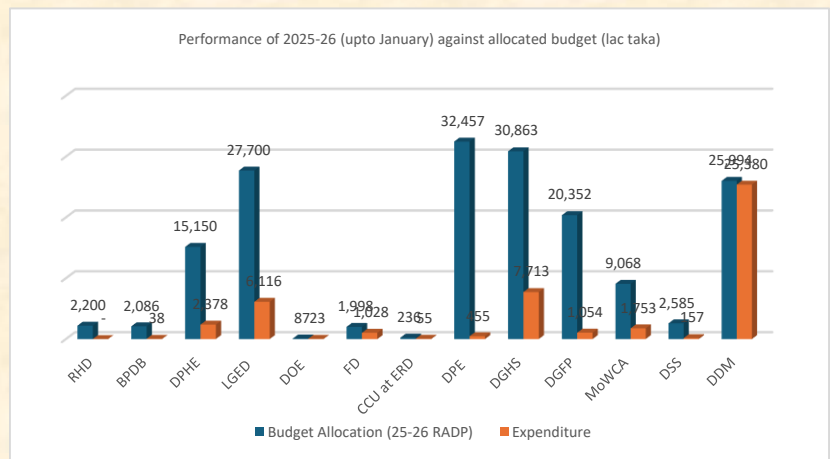

Forest Department

1,520 mangrove saplings were planted in the project area.
