1. The Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh takes pleasure in offering 01 (one) vacancy for military "On Gratis" basis and 01 (one) vacancy for civilian student "On Payment" basis to the **Federal Democratic Republic of Nepal** in any of the 04 (four) years Bachelor of Science programs (Civil Engineering; Computer Science and Engineering; Electrical and Electronic Engineering; Mechanical Engineering; Aeronautical Engineering; Naval Architecture & Marine Engineering; Nuclear Science and Engineering; Environmental, Water Resources and Coastal Engineering; Biomedical Engineering; Industrial and Production Engineering, Petroleum & Mining Engineering; Mathematics and Data Science, and Chemistry and Nano Science), 04 (four) years Bachelor of Urban and Regional Planning and 05 (five) years Architecture program which will commence from **07 June 2026** at MIST, Mirpur Cantonment, Dhaka-1216, Bangladesh. The selected students are required to arrive at least 2 weeks before the commencement of the programs. Financial terms and conditions are attached as **Annexure A** to this 'Offer Letter'.

2. Information about MIST, related to eligibility for admission, academic activities, miscellaneous points, conduct and discipline, etc are enumerated in the enclosed 'Information Booklet'. All related informations are available in MIST web link "**www.mist.ac.bd**".

3. The request for the vacancy of the required program (Department) needs to be forwarded to MIST (info@mist.ac.bd; admission@mist.ac.bd; cc: airtrg@afd.gov.bd) by **20 May 2026** with biodata, academic qualifications and passport details of the candidates. No reply/ response from the invited country by **20 May 2026** will automatically be considered as non-acceptance of this offer.

INFORMATION BOOKLET

Introduction

1. Military Institute of Science and Technology (MIST) is a government run technological institute under Ministry of Defence. It was established in 1998. The essence underlying the foundation of the institute includes commitment to produce technologically advanced intellectual leaders and professionals with high moral and ethical values. MIST is also committed to provide comprehensive education and conduct research in diverse disciplines of science, engineering, technology and engineering management. MIST is located at Mirpur Cantonment on the north-western end of Dhaka city. **At present 15% military and 85% civilian students are studying here.** So far MIST received students from **11 (Eleven) friendly countries.**

2. The institute sets out its academic curriculum as an affiliated body of the Bangladesh University of Professionals (BUP) to conduct undergraduate programs in Civil Engineering, Computer Science and Engineering, Electrical and Electronic Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Aeronautical Engineering, Naval Architecture & Marine Engineering, Nuclear Science and Engineering, Environmental, Water Resources and Coastal Engineering, Biomedical Engineering, Industrial and Production Engineering, Petroleum & Mining Engineering, Architecture, Urban and Regional Planning, Mathematics and Data Science, and Chemistry and Nano Science. A student of MIST is registered with the affiliating university for **a period of six (06) years**, except for the Architecture program, which has a registration **period of seven (07) years**, and is required to comply with the terms and conditions set by the university.

Aim

3. The aim of this paper is to articulate in details about the policy for admission and study of Foreign Students in MIST.

4. **General.** Foreign students, seeking admission may directly apply to MIST through email (**info@mist.ac.bd**, cc: **airtrg@afd.gov.bd**). The general requirements are as follows:

- a. Fluency in English language (medium of instruction in MIST is English).
- b. Medically fit.
- c. Sex - Male or Female.
- d. Having security clearance from respective Embassy/High Commission in Bangladesh.

5. **Qualifications for B.Sc Engineering and Bachelor Programs.** The candidates are to fulfill following requirements for admission in the engineering programs:

- a. **SSC or Equivalent:** The applicants who passed in 2023 or 2022 in Science Group obtaining a minimum GPA 4.00 (without fourth subject) on a scale of 5.00.
- b. **HSC or Equivalent:** The applicants who passed in 2025 or 2024 obtaining a minimum total Grade Point 18 in four subjects (Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and English) with a minimum Grade Point of 4.0 in each of Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry.

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c. GCE ('O' and 'A' Levels) or Equivalent: (1) The applicants who passed in 2023 or 2022 with minimum 'B' grade or equivalent in any five subjects including Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and English in GCE 'O' Level. (2) The applicants who passed in 2025 or 2024 with a minimum of three 'B' grades or equivalent in Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry in GCE 'A' Level.

d. Applicants interested in Biomedical Engineering, must have Biology in HSC or equivalent level with a minimum grade point of 'A' / GCE 'A' or equivalent level with a minimum grade point of 'C' or equivalent.

6. **Qualifications for B.Sc in Mathematics and Data Science, and Chemistry and Nano Science.** The candidates are to fulfill following requirements for admission in Mathematics and Data Science, and Chemistry and Nano Science programs:

a. SSC and HSC or Equivalent: In both the examinations (or equivalent public exams), applicants must have obtained a minimum GPA of 3.50 in each exam. Applicants who passed HSC (or equivalent) both in 2025 and 2024 can apply.

b. GCE ('O' and 'A' Levels) or Equivalent:

(1) The applicants who passed in 2023 or 2022 with minimum 'B' grade or equivalent in any five subjects including Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry in GCE 'O' Level.

(2) The applicants who passed in 2025 or 2024 with minimum 'B' grade or equivalent in Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry in GCE 'A' Level.

Academic Activities

7. **Duration of Programs.** The duration of various Engineering, Urban and Regional Planning, Mathematics and Data Science, and Chemistry and Nano Science programs are 04 years (04 levels) and Architecture program is for 05 years (05 Levels). It is mentionable that, each level comprising of 2 regular semesters in a year.

8. **Academic Schedule.** MIST strictly maintains a yearly academic schedule, which is almost similar for every year. The scheduled activities are currently planned from June/July to April/May each year except for the Level-4 students of all departments and the Level-1 students of Civil Engineering and Environmental, Water Resources and Coastal Engineering department. The Level-4 students of all departments are required to work for thesis/ projects/ internship in April and May and the Level-1 students of Civil Engineering and Environmental, Water Resources and Coastal Engineering department are to undertake "Survey Practical" works during the said period.

Miscellaneous Points

9. **Requirement of Documents for Admission.** Notarized/Attested copies of the following documents in English (or its authorized translated version) are to be enclosed with application duly filled in:

a. Certificate and mark sheet of Secondary School Certificate (SSC)/ 'O' level or equivalent examination.

b. Certificate and mark sheet of Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC)/ 'A' level or equivalent examination.

c. 08 (Eight) copies of recent 3.5 x 4.5 cm size colored photographs.

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10. **Transportation.** Transportation in Dhaka city may be provided for official purpose only and subject to the availability of the vehicle.
11. **Medical.** Medical facilities will be provided to military persons in Combined Military Hospital (CMH) and also civilian students in MIST Medical Center according to the existing medical policy of MIST.
12. **Accommodation and Food.** MIST, in principle is a residential institute. MIST offers accommodation and fooding facilities both for military (male/female) and civil (male/female) students.
 - a. **Military Students Officers.** MIST offers accommodation facilities to both bachelor and married officers, as offered to Bangladeshi Military Officers. Student Officers' Mess is under Wi-Fi internet coverage. MIST Student Officers' Mess also provides dining service for the residents on individual payment basis.
 - b. **Civilian Students.** MIST offers a modern residential hall named 'Osmany Hall' for the civilian students. Moreover, MIST also has foreign student accommodation with all modern facilities. It has male and female wings. Rooms in 'Osmany Hall' have internet browsing facilities. Fooding facilities are available in both the wings of the 'Osmany Hall' where students can have their daily messing on individual payment basis.

Conduct and Discipline

13. **General Rules and Regulations.** All students need to abide by the rules and regulations of MIST and affiliating university.
14. **Withdrawal.** Policy for withdrawal of foreign students from any program will be as per "Students Withdrawal Policy of MIST".
15. **Uniform/Dress.** All students will put on dresses as per "Dress Code" set by MIST.
