
This approval is granted under the following terms and conditions:

2. Terms and conditions

 - iii. The officials will draw their pay and allowances in local currency; no part of it shall be drawn in foreign currency;
 - iv. The International Centre for Integrated Mountain Development (ICIMOD) will bear all expenses related to the participation of the officials in this workshop. **There will be no financial involvement from the Government of Bangladesh**;
 - v. The officials shall not stay abroad beyond the approved duration, except for necessary travel time;
 - vi. They must return to their respective workplaces and report to their authorities immediately after completing the workshop;
 - vii. They are required to submit a report on the workshop to the Admin-2 Section of the Ministry of Environment, Forest, and Climate Change within seven days of their return.
